 RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a seven-game, seven-day road trip through Boston (3-1) and Toronto (1-0, 2 to play) this afternoon at Rogers Centre...Tampa Bay is in the midst of a 13-game stretch featuring matchups exclusively vs. AL East opponents (5-3 thus far), which began with a three-game series vs. the Yankees from May 10-12 (1-2)... the Rays return home for a three-game set with the Red Sox from May 20-22 to complete the 13-game stretch...the Rays are multiple games above .500 for the first time since entering play on April 21 (12-10), matching their season-high watermark after spending 12 consecutive days at or within one game of .500...they have been two games over .500 on five separate occasions, but lost the next game each time...the Rays have won three straight, four of five, five of seven, and 10 of their last 14 games on the heels of a 2-8 stretch from April 21-May 1.
 LHP Tyler Alexander retired each of his first 22 BF to open yesterday's game before allowing three consecutive hits, including a two-run homer to Davis Schneider, but the Rays held on for a 4-3 win to secure a winning road trip.
 Tampa Bay allowed a season-low four baserunners in the victory, its fewest since Sept. 15, 2023 at BAL (4)...Rays pitching did not issue a walk for the third time, joining April 22 vs. DET and April 28 at CWS.
 The Rays improved to 6-9 in series openers, going 5-1 in their last six after posting a 1-8 mark in their first nine.

- a 1-8 mark in their first nine. Tampa Bay has won three straight and five of its last seven games against AL East opponents following a 3-5 start...they are 5-3 against division rivals on the road, with all eight games being decided by two runs or fewer.
- The Rays have scored 4+ runs in a season-high seven consecutive games...prior to the streak, they had not accomplished the feat in more than three straight games. Tampa Bay has not trailed in its last 21 innings since overcoming a 2-1 deficit in the the integration of the streak streak accompliance of the streak streak accomplexity of the streak streak streak accomplexity of the streak streak streak streak accomplexity of the streak streak
- 6th inning on May 15 at BOS. With a win tonight, the Rays would claim their fourth series win in their last five tries (4-1-0) on the heels of an 0-4-1 stretch in series play...they would also move to a season-high three games above .500.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Earlier today, the Rays acquired **LHP Richard Lovelady** from the Cubs in exchange for **LHP Jeff Belge**...to make room on the 40-man roster, **RHP Jacob Waguespack** (right rotator cuff inflammation) was transferred to the 60-day IL.

NEARLY PERFECT – Tyler Alexander carried a perfect game in the 8th inning last night, retiring 22 consecutive Blue Jays before Danny Jansen's bloop single...it marked the second-longest individual perfect game bid in Rays history behind Drew Rasmussen, who sat down 24 BF on Aug. 14, 2022 vs. BAL before allowing a Jorge Mateo double on the first pitch of the 9th inning...along with Ryne Stanek's (2.0 IP) and Ryan Yarbrough's (6.0 IP) combined bid on July 14, 2019 at BAL, it was the third perfect game bid of 7.0+ IP in Rays history...he was attempting to pitch the 25th perfect game in MLB history (24th in regular season) and first since NYY Domingo Germán on June 28, 2023 at OAK.
 His pitch count by inning was 15-11-7-12-14-11-23-12...he was lifted from the contest after throwing a career-high 105 pitches, surpassing his previous mark of 102 (Aug. 7, 2019 vs. CWS)...entering the start, he had never pitched into the 8th inning of a start in his career.
 The 22 consecutive batters retired tied Matt Garza for the second most at any point in a game in Rays history behind Rasmussen...Garza turned the trick during his no-hitter on July 26, 2010 vs. DET, the only no-no in Rays history.

ON-BASE PAREDES—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in a career-high 16 consecutive games, slashing .368/.471/.526 (21-for-57) with 3 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI, drawing more walks (11) than strikeouts (8) during the run...it marks the longest active streak in the AL is tied for fourth longest in the majors, trailing MIL William Contreras (24G), SD Luis Arraez (22G) and SF LaMonte Wade Jr. (17G)...it marks the longest streak by a Ray since Brandon Lowe (17G) from Aug. 15-Sept. 7, 2023...Paredes extended the streak with a trio of walks last night, matching his career high (2x, last: Aug. 28, 2022 at BOS).
 Since the streak began on April 28, Paredes ranks among AL leaders in on-base pct. (2nd), batting average (4th), OPS (5th., 977) and hits (17th).
 Few players possess Paredes' unique skillset...he joins LAD Mookie Betts and SD Jurickson Profar as the only qualified hitters in the majors with a .450+ SLG, 10.0+ pct. walk rate and sub-20.0 pct. whiff rate.
 He is batting .337 (35-for-104) over his last 28 games since April 14, tied with KC Salvador Perez for the highest mark in the AL over that timeframe...he entered that stretch hitting .235 (12-for-51) through his first 14 contests.

PEN PALS—The Rays bullpen has turned in a 1.81 ERA (54.2IP, 11ER) since May 3, second lowest in the AL behind the Guardians (1.71) and fourth lowest in the majors behind the Dodgers (1.48) and Nationals (1.69)...they entered that stretch with an MLB-worst 5.55 ERA (123.1IP, 76ER) through their first 32 games...last night, the bullpen tossed only 1.2 IP, their fewest since Sept. 7, 2023 vs. SEA (1.0IP)...this, after recording 18.0 IP in the club's four-game series at Boston...on the season, their 178.0 IP are fourth most in the majors behind the Marlins (187.1), Athletics (180.1) and Dodgers (178.1).
 The Rays 15 saves are tied for second most in the majors behind the Yankees (18)... an MLB-leading eight different Rays have recorded a save, ahead of the Brewers, Dodgers and Mets (6 each).
 Riding a 10.0 scoreless inning streak, LHP Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed an earned run in 16 consecutive outings overall since April 6, tied for the third-longest active streak in MLB behind NYY Clay Holmes (19C) and PHI Matt Strahm (17G).
 RHP Jason Adam is 2-0 with a 0.54 ERA (16.2IP, 1ER) over his last 17 games.
 RHP Pete Fairbanks has retired all 12 BF across four scoreless appearances since returning from the 15-day IL on May 11, recording 6 SO...he recorded his 44th save last night, surpassing Brad Boxberger (43) for sixth on the club's all-time list, and is now one save shy of fifth-place Rafael Soriano (45).

DOWN TO THE WIRE—Each of the Rays last five games have been decided by two runs or fewer, the club's second-longest streak of the season behind a six-game run from April 16-21...on the season, their 25 such games are tied for third most in the majors behind the Brewers and Yankees (both 26G)...their 17-8 (.680) record in those contests ranks third behind the Phillies (13-5/.722) and Orioles (15-6/.680)...the Rays are 8-4 in one-run games, also third best in the majors behind the Phillies (9-4/.692) and Yankees (9-4/.692).

RAYS AND JAYS-Tampa Bay and Toronto meet for the second of four series this weekend in Ontario...the clubs split a four-game, season-opening set at Tropicana Field from March 28-31, with three of the four contests being decided by 6+ runs...following the weekend, the Rays will return to Toronto from July 23-25 as part of their first road trip after the All-Star break...the Rays have won six straight season series over the Jays since 2018, going 62-41 (.602) in that span...they have won five of the last seven meetings and are 10-6 in the previous 16 dating back to April 16, 2023.

- Toronto VP, Baseball Strategy James Click spent 14 years with the Rays, serving as VP of Baseball Operations from 2017-2019.
- Blue Jays **OF Kevin Kiermaier** spent 10 seasons with the Rays from 2013-22, winning three Gold Glove awards and one Platinum Glove...his 31.7 bWAR with the Rays rank fourth in club history.

SINGING THE BLUES—Eflin is 2-3 with a 6.43 ERA (28.0IP, 20ER) in six career appearances (5GS) opposite Toronto...took the loss on Opening Day on March 28, allowing six runs on six hits, one walk, three home runs and one hit batter over 5.2 innings.

after working 2.2 innings, conceding nine runs (eight earned) on nine hits, three walks and three home runs with two strikeouts... the 8 ER are still tied for his career high (also May 23, 2017 vs. COL)... the nine runs are the most he has ever allowed at a visiting ballpark.

HOMER HAPPENINGS-Eflin has allowed one home run in each of his allowed 1+ HR in five straight starts from July 3-Aug. 10, 2018 (6GS). He has allowed four homers with two outs, tied for fourth most in

the AL and tied for fifth most in the majors...he has also allowed 4 HR with two strikes.

 WFRE GOING STREAKING—Since June 14, 2022, he has walked two batters or fewer in 43 straight starts, the longest active streak in the majors, with the next closest being SEA George Kirby (40GS)...since 2010, only four starters have put together longer streaks: Phil Hughes (64GS), Clayton Kershaw (47GS), Michael Pineda (46GS) and Josh Tomlin (45GS).
 ^{*} Of Eflin's 43 starts with two walks or fewer, 40 have come with the Rays...he is two starts of tying franchise record held by Andy Sonnanstine, who walked two hitters or fewer in 42 straight starts from Aug. 5, 2007-Sept. 21, 2008. WE'RE GOING STREAKING-Since June 14, 2022, he has walked two

RIDING THE WAVE—In Rays wins (4GS), Eflin has pitched to a 1.85 ERA (24.11P, 5ER), holding opponents to a .213 (20-for-94) average while posting a 0.86 WHIP...in losses (5GS), he has turned in a 5.65 ERA (28.21P, 18ER), .300 (36-for-120) opp. average and 1.36 WHIP.

IT'S A MARATHON—In innings 1-5, Eflin has posted a 2.40 ERA (45.0IP, 12ER) and held opponents to a .212 (36-for-170) average and .584 OPS...from the 6th inning on, he owns a 12.38 ERA (8.0IP, 11ER), .455 (20-for-44) opp. average and 1.364 opp. OPS...he has allowed nine of his 24 total runs in the 6th frame, tied with LAA José Suarez for the second most by any pitcher

- 6th frame, tied with LAA José Suarez for the second most by any pitcher in the 6th inning, behind only TEX Martín Pérez (11).
 When his pitch count resides between 1-60, opponents are 30-for-145 (.207) against him...once he surpasses the 60-pitch mark, opposing hitters have gone 26-for-69 (.377).
 Opponents are batting .156 (12-for-77) against him the second time through the order, tied for the third-lowest mark in the AL and tied for seventh lowest in MLB (min. 75BF)...opponents are 19-for-81 (.235) the first time through and 24-for-52 (.462) the third time through.

QUALITY CONTROL—Eflin paces the majors in walk rate (1.8%) and walks per 9.0 IP (0.68) and ranks second in SO/BB ratio (10.25) behind DET Jack Flaherty (10.50)...he walked only two of his first 130 BF (1.5%) in 2024 before walking consecutive batters on April 26 at CWS...since issuing the back-to-back walks, he has strung together a 88 BF streak without a free pass.
 He has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 at 3.8 pct. (min. 1,750BF), ahead of Zack Greinke (4.4%).
 Eflin's 68.8 pct. strike rate since the beginning of last season ranks third in the majors (min. 200.0IP) behind SEA George Kirby (70.8%) and MIN Joe Ryan (69.0%)...his 8.11 SO/BB ratio ranks second behind Kirby (9.29) under the same parameters.
