BIRDLAND BITES: Today, Baltimore continues a six-game homestand against Washington (1-1, 1 to play) and Chicago-AL (3 to play)...The Birds return from a nine-game West Coast swing, going 4-5 against the Mariners (1-2), Dodgers (2-1), and Angels (1-2)...The O's enter play today 2.5 games back in the Wild Card and 10.0 games behind the Yankees in the AL East.

👉 Last night, **Brandon Young** threw 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on seven hits (1 HR) and two walks with a career-high eight strikeouts...Recorded a career-high 23 swings and misses, surpassing his previous high of 12 (3x, last: 5/30/26 vs. TOR)...The 23 whiffs were the most by an Oriole pitcher since Kyle Gibson (also 23) on July 9, 2023 at Minnesota.

👉 **Samuel Basallo** knotted the game, 3-3, in the eighth inning with a two-out, pinch-hit single...Became the second Oriole this season with a game-tying or go-ahead pinch-hit RBI in the eighth inning or later, joining **Adley Rutschman** (RBI 1B, 9th inn.) on May 5 at Miami.

👉 The Birds have lost or tied five straight series against the Nationals, including a three-game sweep at Camden Yards last season, but can end the streak with a win today.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to today's game, the Orioles announced the following roster moves: Reinstated **OF Dylan Beavers** (right oblique strain) from the 10-day Injured List, reinstated **C Adley Rutschman** from the 7-day Concussion Injured List, optioned **INF/OF Jeremiah Jackson** to Triple-A Norfolk after yesterday's game, and designated **C Sam Huff** for assignment.

HE'S A BRAD MAN: **Kyle Bradish** enters today's start having thrown 11.2 consecutive scoreless innings, the fourth-longest active streak among all MLB starters behind MIN's Mick Abel (14.0), AZ's Eduardo Rodriguez (12.2) and ATH's Gage Jump (12.0).

👉 He has thrown 7.0+ innings in consecutive starts for the second time in his career (also 8/26-9/1/22) and looks to become the first O's hurler to do so in three straight starts since **Trevor Rogers'** four-outing run from August 13-30, 2025.

👉 Is 2-0 with a 0.47 ERA (1 ER/19.0 IP) in three career starts opposite the Nationals.

SWING AND MISS STUFF: Baltimore pitching has tallied 10+ strikeouts in three straight games (41 K overall) and look to do so in a season-high-tying fourth consecutive contest today (also 3/28-31).

TIGHT SQUEEZE: The Birds have gone 6-13 (.316) in one-run games, the second-lowest winning percentage in MLB in such contests ahead of the Red Sox (5-12, .294).

START ME UP: Over the last 11 games since June 16, Baltimore starters have posted a 2.86 ERA (21 ER/66.0 IP) and a .225 opponent average.

👉 Over that span, the Birds 2.86 ERA is the sixth-lowest mark in MLB behind the Red Sox (2.06), Brewers (2.10), Nationals (2.59), Giants (2.62), and Guardians (2.84).

👉 Overall, O's pitching owns a 3.79 ERA across 43 games at Camden Yards compared to a 4.98 ERA over 41 road games.

TRAFFIC ON THE BELTWAY: **Taylor Ward** has reached base safely in each of his first 17 career games against the Nationals, including hits in 13 of the contests, batting .343 (23-for-67) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI, and 12 walks against 17 strikeouts...It is tied with STL's Alec Burleson for the second-longest active career-opening on-base streak against the Nationals behind CIN's Elly De La Cruz (22 G).

PETE AND THE NATS: In 110 career games against the Nationals, **Pete Alonso** is slashing .294/.391/.569 (118-for-401) with 24 doubles, one triple, 28 home runs, 76 RBI, and 54 walks.

👉 Since 2005, his 28 long balls against Washington are tied with LAD's Freddie Freeman for the fifth most by any MLB player behind Ryan Howard (43), NYY's Giancarlo Stanton (38), and PIT's Marcell Ozuna/Hanley Ramirez (both 31)...The 28 homers are his second most against any opponent behind the Marlins (33).

👉 Alonso has gone a career-high 19 straight games without a long ball against Washington, with his last coming on September 17, 2024.

👉 Overall, in 24 games this month, Alonso is batting .291 (25-for-86) with three doubles, seven home runs, 18 runs, 20 RBI, and 16 walks.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .370/.415/.546 (44-for-119) with 10 doubles, one triple, three home runs, 14 runs, 24 RBI, eight walks (1 IBB), five stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 45 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

👉 Since May 1, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 100 PA) in batting average (1st), on-base percentage (6th), and OPS (6th, .962).

👉 His seven games with at least three hits since May 1 are tied for the major league lead with NYM's Carson Benge, MIL's William Contreras, PHI's Bryce Harper, and PHI's Brandon Marsh.

👉 Alexander is batting .372 (16-for-43) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, and 22 RBI with runners in scoring position...His .372 RISP average is tied for eighth highest in MLB (min. 40 AB).

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 75 straight games since April 6, the second-longest active streak in the majors this season behind St. Louis (80).

👉 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season on April 5 at Pittsburgh...The Orioles join the Brewers as the only teams in MLB to have only one game with zero walks.

👉 Baltimore is 30-27 when drawing 3+ walks, compared to 9-18 when drawing two or fewer free passes.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 65), times on base (T-3rd, 149), and on-base percentage (12th, .389)...**Gunnar Henderson** led the team with 62 walks a year ago and with 78 free passes in 2024.

👉 Prior to Ward, the only Oriole player in team history (since 1954) to have more walks prior to July in a season was Randy Milligan (1990), who had 65 walks through June that season.

👉 Ward recorded 64 walks and 76 hits through 80 career games with the Orioles...The only other players to have at least 60 walks and 75 hits through 80 career games with the club in franchise history (since 1954) were Albert Belle (63 BB, 82 H), Bob Nieman (62 BB, 89 H), and Ken Singleton (68 BB, 89 H).

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his 17th start of the season and 84th of his career today in the series finale vs. Washington...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT: Bradish threw 8.0 scoreless innings to earn his fifth win of the season on June 22 at Los Angeles-AL, allowing six hits and one walk with nine strikeouts...Has thrown 7.0+ innings in back-to-back starts for the second time in his career (also 8/26-9/1/22)... Threw 101 pitches, 67 strikes.

- Over his last two starts since June 17, he's allowed one run over 15.2 innings with 21 strikeouts...Bradish is the third pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) to have 20+ strikeouts and no more than one run allowed over a two-start span in a single season, joining Mike Mussina (2000) and Erik Bedard (2007).
- Has recorded 12 strikeouts with his sinker over his last two starts, including a season-high seven punchouts on the pitch at Los Angeles-AL.

FAMILIAR FOE: Bradish is 2-0 with a 0.47 ERA (1 ER/19.0 IP) in three career starts opposite Washington but hasn't faced them since 2024...Has made one start vs. the Nationals at Camden Yards, tossing 8.0 shutout innings on three hits, two walks, and four strikeouts on September 26, 2023 in a 1-0 Orioles victory.

- Over 21 career Interleague starts, he is 6-3 with a 2.84 ERA (37 ER/117.1 IP)...The 2.84 ERA vs. Interleague opponents is the third-best mark (min. 20 GS) in the AL since 2022, behind DET's Tarik Skubal (2.65) and TB's Drew Rasmussen (2.70).

FIRST-INNING FOCUS: Bradish has allowed only two runs in the opening frame this season, during which opponents are slashing .222/.311/.352 (12-for-54).

WALK DON'T RUN: Bradish's 11.0 percent walk rate this season is the highest of his career (9.2%; 2024) and is the third-highest mark in the majors among qualified pitchers ahead of LAA's José Soriano (12.0%) and SF's Robbie Ray (11.5%)...However, has allowed three total walks over his last two starts since June 17 (15.2 IP).

- Has allowed at least three walks in 11 of his 16 starts this season... The 11 starts with 3+ walks mark the most such games among MLB starters behind Soriano (9 G).

ABOVE THE CURVE: Opponents are hitting .400 (6-for-15) off Bradish's curveball in June...However, batters have gone 2-for-11 with six strikeouts on the pitch over his last two starts since June 17 after going 4-for-4 off his curve with one double and two home runs across two outings from June 6-11.

- Over his first 12 starts this season, Bradish used it 23.0 percent of the time and held opponents to a .154 (8-for-52) average on the pitch with four doubles and no home runs.
- Bradish's 42.1 percent whiff rate on his curve is the fourth-highest mark among all MLB starters (min. 150 curveballs thrown) behind WSH's Jake Irvin (43.9%), BOS' Ranger Suarez (43.3%), and CWS's Davis Martin (43.1%).

SLIDE AWAY: Opponents have gone 21-for-81 (.259) off Bradish's slider with three doubles, two triples, and six home runs...His .568 opponent slugging percentage off the offering is the highest mark in MLB (min. 75 AB ending in pitch) with the next closest pitchers being DET's Jack Flaherty (.563) and AZ's Ryne Nelson (.533).

- Opponents slashed .063/.063/.156 (2-for-32) off his slider with one home run in 2025.

DAY TRIPPER: Bradish's 10 daytime starts this season are tied for the major league lead with WSH's Cade Cavalli and NYM's Freddy Peralta... His 3.06 ERA (64 ER/188.0 IP) in daytime starts since 2022 is the seventh-lowest mark in MLB (min. 35 GS) behind TB's Drew Rasmussen (1.99), DET's Tarik Skubal (2.46), TOR's Dylan Cease (2.66), CHC's Justin Steele (2.86), SF's Logan Webb (2.96), and DET's Framer Valdez (3.02).

- His 4.18 ERA (24 ER/51.2 IP) in day games this season is the highest mark of his career ahead of 2022 (3.98).
- Behind the eight ball: Bradish owns a 55.9 percent first-pitch strike rate, the third-lowest mark in MLB among qualified pitchers ahead of CLE's Joey Cantillo (54.4%) and ATH's J.T. Ginn (54.7%)...Has thrown 64 of 100 (64.0%) first pitches for strikes over four starts this month.
- In his six starts last season, Bradish posted a 63.5 percent first-pitch strike rate.

- Suffered his first blown save and loss of the season on 6/24 at LAA after allowing two unearned runs to score in the 10th inning...Marks his first blown save and loss since 8/27/25 vs. BOS
