RAY REPORT—The Rays conclude a seven-game, seven-day road trip through Boston (3-1) and Toronto (2-0, 1 to play) this afternoon at Rogers Centre...Tampa Bay is in the midst of a 13-game stretch featuring matchups exclusively vs. AL East opponents (6-3 thus far), which began with a three-game series vs. the Yankees from May 10-12 (1-2)...the Rays return home for a three-game set with the Red Sox over the next three days (May 20-22) to complete the 13-game stretch...the Rays are a season-high three games above the .500 mark and have won four straight, five of six, six of eight, and 11 of their last 15 games on the heels of a 2-8 stretch from April 21-May 1.

Yesterday, RF Jonny DeLuca hit a go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning to give the Rays a 5-4 win, completing the club's second-largest comeback win of the season, trailing only a five-run rally on April 6 at COL.

RHP Erasmo Ramírez tossed a scoreless 7th inning to earn the win...he has three wins and one save in his last five games, becoming the sixth Ray (7x) to accrue those decisions over a five-game span (last: Josh Fleming, July 30-Aug. 22, 2021).

The Rays have secured their fourth series win in their last five tries (4-1-0) on the heels of an 0-4-1 stretch in series play...they improved to 3-1-1 in their last five sets against the Blue Jays.

Tampa Bay has won four straight and six of its last eight games against AL East opponents following a 3-5 start...they are 6-3 against division rivals on the road, with all nine games being decided by two runs or fewer.

The Rays pitching staff has recorded its two lowest pitch counts of the season over the last two days (117, 118)...the 235 pitches are the club's fewest over any two-game span since Sept. 7-8, 2023 (232).

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

Record their second series sweep of the season, joining May 3-5 vs. NYM.

Earn their first sweep on the road since Sept. 26-27 at BOS, and their first in a series of 3+ games since April 3-5, 2023 at WSH.

Secure their 17th sweep over the Blue Jays, including their sixth on the road... they last swept Toronto from May 21-24, 2021 at Rogers Centre.

Win three straight over the Blue Jays for the first time since Sept. 15-23, 2022 (3).

Go 6-1 or better on a road trip of 7+ games for the fifth time in club history, joining May 18-24, 2021 (7-0), Aug. 10-20, 2020 (9-1), April 12-22, 2010 (9-1) and June 15-24, 2004 (8-1), according to Elias.

Win their fifth straight game, matching their longest streak of 2024 (also May 3-7).

Win five consecutive road games for the first time since April 18-29, 2023 (5).

**DOWN TO THE WIRE**—Each of the Rays last six games have been decided by two runs or fewer, matching their longest streak of the season from April 16-21...the club's last longer streak was a franchise-record 14-game run from June 14-29, 2022...on the season, their 26 such games are tied for second most in the majors behind the Brewers (27G)...their 18-8 (.692) record in those contests ranks second behind the Phillies (14-5/737)...the Rays are 9-4 (.692) in one-run games, tied for second in MLB behind the Phillies (10-4/.714).

COMEBACK KIDS—The Rays 12 comeback wins are tied for fifth most in the majors, trailing the Yankees (14), Tigers (14), Orioles (13) and Nationals (13)...they have recorded 10 wins after conceding the first run, tied for third most in the majors behind the Yankees (14) and Mets (11)...yesterday's victory marked the Rays fourth when trailing after seven frames, including the first since May 5 vs. NYM...the four such wins are tied for second most in the majors behind the Braves (5).

In the 8th inning or later, Tampa Bay ranks second in MLB in on-base pct. (.349) behind Atlanta (.365) and third in average (.271), trailing Atlanta (.287) and Texas (.273).

CONSISTENCY IS KEY—The Rays have scored 4+runs in a season-high eight consecutive games despite batting just .224 (17-for-76) with RISP in those contests...prior to the streak, they had not accomplished the feat in more than three straight games...it marks their longest streak since a nine-game run to open the 2023 season (March 30-April 9).

Part of the offensive resurgence has stemmed from an improved walk rate...their 87 free passes since April 26 are second most in the majors behind the Phillies...their 62 walks entering that stretch were tied with the Marlins for the fewest in MLB.

**RETURN OF THE CHAMP—Yandy Díaz** reached base a career-high-tying five times last night with three singles and two walks (5x, last: Sept. 23, 2023 vs. TOR)... three of the five such efforts in his career have come against the Blue Jays (also: Aug. 21, 2020 vs. TOR)... Díaz is batting .365 (23-for-63) with 4 2B, 2 HR, 12 RBI and a .952 OPS over his last 15 games since May 3...his eight multi-hit games over that period are tied with OAK **Brent Rooker** for second most in the majors behind OAK **Abraham Toro** (10)...he entered the stretch batting .184 (21-for-114) with a .479 OPS over his previous 29 games.

ON-BASE PAREDES—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in a career-high 17 consecutive games, slashing .377/.473/.541 (23-for-61) with 4 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI, drawing more walks (11) than strikeouts (10) during the run...it marks the longest active streak in the AL is tied for fourth longest in the majors, trailing MIL William Contreras (25G), SD Luis Arraez (22G) and SF LaMonte Wade Jr. (18G)...it marks the longest streak by a Ray since Brandon Lowe (17G) from Aug. 15-Sept. 7, 2023...the last longer streak was produced by Yandy Díaz (22G) from April 27-May 28, 2023.

Since the streak began on April 28, Paredes ranks among AL leaders in on-base pct. (2nd), batting average (4th), OPS (4th, 1.014), walks (T4th) and hits (T6th).

He leads the AL in batting average since April 14, hitting .343 (37-for-108) over 29 games...he entered that stretch hitting .235 (12-for-51) through his first 14 contests.

PEN PALS—The Rays bullpen has turned in an AL-leading 1.72 ERA (57.2IP, 11ER) since May 3, trailing only the Dodgers (1.38) in all of MLB...they entered that stretch with an MLB-worst 5.55 ERA through their first 32 games, dropping that mark to 4.33 entering today's game...they have allowed only 2 ER through six games on the current road trip, posting a 0.79 ERA (22.2IP, 2ER)...the bullpen has recorded only 4.2 IP over the last two games after totaling 18.0 IP in the previous four...on the season, their 181.0 IP are fourth most in MLB behind the Marlins (193.0), Athletics (183.1) and Dodgers (181.1).

Riding an 11.0 scoreless inning streak, LHP Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed an earned run in 17 consecutive outings since April 6, tied for the third-longest active streak in MLB behind NYY Clay Holmes (19G) and PHI Matt Strahm (18G).

RHP Jason Adam is 2-0 with a 0.51 ERA (17.2IP, 1ER) over his last 18 games.

RHP Pete Fairbanks has retired all 12 BF across four scoreless appearances since returning from the 15-day IL on May 11, recording 6 SO.

RAYS AND JAYS—Tampa Bay and Toronto conclude the second of four series in 2024 this afternoon...the clubs split a four-game, season-opening set at Tropicana Field from March 28-31...the Rays will return to Toronto from July 23-25 as part of their first road trip after the All-Star break...the Rays have won six straight season series over the Jays since 2018, going 63-41 (.606) in that span...they 6-2 in their last eight and 11-6 in their previous 17 games against the Blue Jays...the clubs have played in back-to-back one-run games after 24 of their previous 25 matchups were decided by multiple runs.

- Richie Palacios' brother, Joshua, was drafted by Toronto in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Pare Player Draft and made his MLB debut with the Blue Jays on April 9, 2021 in
- Rays manager **Kevin Cash** began his MLB playing career with the Blue Jays from 2002-04...he was also a major league advance scout for Toronto in 2012.
- Rays Hitting Coach Chad Mottola held the same position with Toron-to in 2013 after five seasons as a Blue Jays minor league coach... during his playing career, he was signed by the Jays three times and was a teammate of Kevin Cash with Triple-A Syracuse in 2002.
- Several Blue Jays hail from Florida: Bo Bichette (Orlando), Alek Ma-noah (Homestead), Nate Pearson (Odessa) and Daniel Vogelbach (Orlando).
- Toronto VP, Baseball Strategy James Click spent 14 years with the Rays, serving as VP of Baseball Operations from 2017-2019.
- Slue Jays OF Kevin Kiermaier spent 10 seasons with the Rays from 2013-22, winning three Gold Glove awards and one Platinum Glove...his 31.7 bWAR with the Rays rank fourth in club history.
- Blue Jays LHP Génesis Cabrera was originally signed by the Rays in 2013 before being dealt to St. Louis in a 2018 trade involving Tommy Pham.
- Blue Jays RHP Trevor Richards pitched for the Rays during parts of three seasons (2019-21), going 3-0 with a 4.28 ERA (67.11P, 32ER).

## NO FREE RIDES

Rays pitching has not issued a walk in back-to-back games for the first time since July 15 (G2)-July 16, 2023...the club-record streak of three consecutive walk-less games was set from Sept. 26 (G2), 2019...they have not recorded a free pass to their last 70 BF overall since Jason Adam's 9th-inning walk of Rob Refsnyder on May 16 at BOS.

**TODAY'S START**—Civale will take the ball for his 10th start of the season, including his sixth on the road...has gone 0-2 with a 8.87 ERA (23.1IP, 23ER) in his last five starts after pitching to a 2-1 mark and 2.74 ERA (23.0IP, 7ER) in his first four...is seeking his first win since April 9 at LAA... has gone 4-6 with a 5.60 ERA (91.2IP, 55ER) in 19 starts since the Rays acquired him from the Guardians on July 31, 2023.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Did not factor into the decision on May 14 at Boston after working 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on five hits with no walks and six strikeouts.

- Retired 10 of 11 BF through 4.1 innings, but was tagged for four hits the remainder of the outing, including a **Ceddanne Rafaela** solo HR in the 5th frame.
- Worked 5.0+ IP for the first time since April 21 vs. LAA (6.0IP).

**BATTLING THE BLUE JAYS**—Civale has made four career starts opposite Toronto, going 2-2 with a 4.66 ERA (19.1IP, 10ER)...he earned his first victory of the 2024 campaign on March 29 vs. the Blue Jays (6.0IP, 4H, 1ER, 1BB, 6SO).

In six starts against AL East opponents since joining Tampa Bay last season, Civale is 1-2 with a 5.20 ERA (27.2IP, 16ER).

**THE RIGHT DIRECTION**—He worked 5.0 innings in his last start at Boston, snapping a streak of four straight starts of 4.2 innings or fewer...Civale did not issue a free pass in the outing, marking the third time he has done so in his nine starts...has allowed three runs or fewer in back-to-back starts after allowing 5+ runs in each of his previous three starts.

His 8.87 ERA (23.1IP, 23ER) since April 21, however, is the highest in the majors (min. 20.0IP), with the next closest pitchers being LAA Reid Detmers (8.46) and SF Keaton Winn (8.41).

STARTING AT THE TOP—Civale has limited opposing lead-off hitters to a .120/.185/.240 (3-for-25) line, tied for the fifth-lowest opp. AVG in the AL (min. 35BF)...five- and six-hole hitters have given him the most trouble, as they are hitting a combined .351 (13-for-37) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 9 RBI... overall, opposing 5-9 hitters have gone 29-for-93 (.312) with 4 2B, 6 HR and 19 RBI off Civale...1-4 hitters are 20-for-93 (.215) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 8 RBI.

CRUISING, THEN BRUISING—From innings 1-3, Civale has posted a 2.33 ERA (27.0IP, 7ER) and a .200 (20-for-100) opp. average...from the 4th inning on, he owns a 10.71 ERA (19.1IP, 23ER) with a .337 (29-for-86) opp. average... he has allowed a combined 23 runs in the 4th and 5th innings compared to eight tallies in all other frames...this includes 14 runs allowed in the 5th inning, tied with STL Miles Mikolas for the most in the majors.

He has struggled to escape innings, allowing opponents to slash .313/.380/.531 (20-for-64) with two outs...16 of the 27 RBI recorded against him have come with two outs, including 4 of the 9 HR.

**BIT BY THE LONG BALL**—Civale's 9 HR allowed are tied for third most in the AL, one shy of teammate **Tyler Alexander** and CWS **Michael Soroka** (both 10HR)...he has yielded at least 1 HR in eight of his nine starts this season and 14 of his last 16 dating back to Aug. 23, 2023 vs. COL...entering that stretch, he had permitted just 1 HR in his previous 10 starts from June 25–Aug. 16, 2023.

Over half (16) of the 31 runs he has allowed this season have come on the 9 HR against him.

3 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER—For his career, Civale is 31-1 with a 3.41 ERA (316.2IP, 120ER) in games when he receives three or more runs of support... he has a 2-28 record with a 5.14 ERA (205.0IP, 117ER) in games receiving two or fewer runs of support.
