RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals conclude their three-game trip to Milwaukee this afternoon, looking to extend their winning streak to seven games, which would be a season high...following today's game, the Cardinals will return home for an eight-game home stand beginning on Friday with Cincinnati (4 games) and San Francisco (4), as they approach September...the Cardinals are in a stretch of 15 of 18 games at home...today's game completes a run of 16 straight games without an off-day (Aug. 13-28).

TIME TO FLY: Winners of 9 of 10 and 15 of their last 18, St. Louis sports the best record (15-3) across Major League Baseball since August 9 and are tied with Houston for the majors' best winning pct. (.674, 29-14) since the All-Star break. The Cardinals enter today a season-high 15 games over .500 and in first place in the NL Central, 3.0 games ahead of Chicago & 6.5 in front of Milwaukee.

YADI-OS!!! Yadier Molina enjoyed his 7th career multi-HR game last night, tops among all Cardinals catchers and moved past **Joe "Ducky" Medwick** into 12th place on the Cardinals all-time homers list with 153...his 3-hit, 3-run, 3-RBI, 2-HR game was the 2nd of his career (also 8/16/07 at MIL).

BADER DAYS ARE HERE AGAIN: **Harrison Bader** matched his career high with 3 hits last night, hitting in his 5th-straight game and scoring for the 5th-straight game...since his recall on 8/20, he's reached base safely in all 8 games played, batting .360 with a .500 OBP & 1.140 OPS while striking out just four times.

BEER BASHER: **Paul Goldschmidt** has hit 13 home runs in 32 career games played at Miller Park, and is batting .390 (48-123) over his career...he tops all players including Brewers (min. 125 PA's) in OPS (1.272), SLG (.797) OBP (.476) and BA at the ballpark...Goldy matched his career single-game high in both HR's (3) and hits (4) on March 29...it was his 2nd career 4-hit game at Miller Park (also 6/29/12)...with four games left in the Cardinals-Brewers series in 2019, **Goldschmidt's** six home runs against Milwaukee rank T2nd among all Cardinals in a single season with **Jhonny Peralta**, who hit six home runs in 19 games in 2014. Only **Albert Pujols**, who hit eight home runs in 15 games in 2010 has hit more in a single year. The Cardinals single-season mark for RBI vs. MIL is 18 by **Scott Rolen** over 13 games in 2003, with Goldschmidt currently at 13 in 14 games.

DRESSED TO THE NINES: Reliever **John Gant** improved to 9-0 with Monday night's win, tying **Adam Wainwright** for 2nd on the team in victories...Gant is the first St. Louis bullpener to post nine wins since **Braden Loper** (9-3) did so in 2006...the lone Cardinals reliever to finish a season with a perfect 9-0 mark was lefty **Frank DiPino** in 1989.

SIX RUN SIX PACK: The Cardinals have scored six or more runs in six straight games, doing so for the first time since Aug. 8-14, 2018...the club record for consecutive 6+ run games is 9 from July 4-13, 1945.

THE GOLDY STANDARD: With his next home run, **Paul Goldschmidt** will reach 30 on the season, doing so for the 5th time since 2013...only four other players have had five or more 30-homer seasons since 2103: **Edwin Encarnacion** (7), **Nelson Cruz** (6), **Nolan Arenado** (5) and **Mike Trout** (5).

THE FUTURE IS NOW: Cardinals starters **Jack Flaherty** (23 yrs, 8 wins) and **Dakota Hudson** (24 yrs, 13 wins) have posted a combined 21 wins this season, the majors' top duo among starting pitchers 24 years & younger...the Rockies' **German Marquez** and **Antonio Senzatela** are 2nd with 20 combined wins...the last 24 & younger starting duo for St. Louis with as many as 20 combined wins was **Carlos Martínez** (14) and **Michael Wacha** (17), who combined for 31 wins in 2015.

POWER IN THE PEN: Cardinals relievers **John Brebbia** (78) & **Giovanny Gallegos** (80) are the first pair of Cardinals relievers with 70+ strikeouts in a season since **Trevor Rosenthal** (83) and **Kevin Siegrist** (90) did so in 2015.

WELCOME TO THE WINNER'S CIRCLE: Rookie **Ryan Helsley** gained his first ML win on Sunday, as did lefty **Tyler Webb** last Tue...there have been 10 different Cardinals relievers who have recorded wins this season, one shy of the club record (11 relievers) in both 2018 & 2002.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Paul DeJong graduated from nearby Antioch (Ill.) High School...resides in Hazelhurst, Wisc.

Marcell Ozuna was a Marlins teammate of Brewers outfielder **Christian Yelich** (2013-17).

Dexter Fowler and **Jordan Lyles** were traded for each other during the 2013-14 offseason (Dec. 3, 2013)...Colorado sent Fowler to Houston for Lyles and outfielder **Brandon Barnes**.

Yadier Molina hit his first Major League home run off Milwaukee's **Matt Wise** (Sept. 23, 2004).

Tyler Webb pitched for Brewers in two games in 2017...claimed off waivers by San Diego (April 2018).

Cardinals Pitching Coach **Mike Maddux** previously served as the Brewers Pitching Coach from 2003-08...oversaw Brewers staff that ranked 2nd in the NL with a 3.85 ERA in 2008, lowest mark by a Milwaukee club in 16 years, en-route to securing the Brewers' first postseason berth in 26 years.

Devin Williams was born in Florissant, Mo. and resides in Maryland Heights...was First Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Preseason High School All-American as a senior at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the University of Missouri before being selected by Milwaukee in the 2nd round of the 2013 MLB Draft.

Cardinals Hall of Famer, broadcaster and Special Assistant **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Cardinals Director of Medical Operations/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay, Wisc...earned his Master's in Physical Therapy from The University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Cardinals Special Assistant to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** started in professional baseball serving as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Cardinals Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played 13 seasons with St. Louis (1968-80), where he was a six-time NL All-Star and 1980 Silver Slugger Award winner...later traded by St. Louis with pitchers **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** to Milwaukee for outfielders **David Green** and **Sixto Lezcano** and pitchers **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**...played five seasons with the Brewers (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against the Cardinals in the 1982 World Series.

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...originally traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for catcher **Jimmie Coker** and outfielder **Gary Kolb** (April 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 27th start of the season and his 60th career start (61st appearance).
- Is lifetime 8-0 with a 0.70 ERA (64.0 IP/5 ER) in 10 career starts in the month of August, limiting the opposition to a .132 BA & .203 SLG pct.
- Has allowed just one run in his last 34.0 innings. Logged 23.0 scoreless IP streak (7/26-8/13), which longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher since Adam Wainwright's 25.0 scoreless innings in 2014.
- His 0.28 ERA in the month of August is the lowest in the Majors and lowest by a Cardinal in the month of August in Cardinals history. Ranks T1st in NL in wins (4) and T2nd with his 40 August strikeouts.
- In eight starts post All-Star Break, ranks 1st among MLB pitchers with an 0.73 ERA.
- Leads the Cardinals with 159 strikeouts Post All-Star Break over the last two seasons and ranks 3rd among National League pitchers.
- Is 2-3 in nine matinee starts this season, but ranks 4th among NL starting pitchers in ERA (1.73) and 9th in average against (.196).
- His 8 scoreless starts in 2019 are most by a Cardinal since A. Wainwright (12) in 2014.
- Has made 14 starts this season pitching 6.0 or more innings while holding his opposition to four hits or fewer, most in the NL. (Justin Verlander 17; Gerrit Cole 16).
- Allowed just four runs in a seven start span from July 7 to Aug. 13 covering 45.1 IP for a 0.79 ERA. It was the lowest ERA in seven start span by a Cardinals starter since Chris Carpenter in 2005 (0.45) and Bob Gibson in 1968 (0.43). *Elias*

- Scattered three singles while striking out nine over 6.0 scoreless innings in 8-3 win over Colorado last Friday at Busch Stadium. Marked his third straight winning decision to tie his single-season high for wins (8) from last season.

- Averages 12.41 strikeouts/9 IP against the Brewers over 41.1 career innings, 3rd-highest all-time against the Brewers among pitchers with 6 or more starts, trailing Jonathan Sanchez (12.64), and Mark Prior (12.59).
- Struck out then season-high 10 batters vs. MIL (4/22) over 6.0 innings. Allowed four runs on three home runs, the only three hits he allowed, in a 13-5 win.
- Had a rough start in his 4/16 outing at Miller Park, allowing a career-high nine hits and tied his career-high in earned runs allowed (5) over 2.2 innings in an 8-4 loss.
- Tied career-high with 13 strikeouts over 7.0 innings vs. MIL (6/22/18), in a start he took a no-hitter into the 7th inning before Jesús Aguilar broke it with a solo homer.
