AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their season-long 10-game homestand today with the final game of a three-game set vs. Toronto (1-1 thus far)...will also play a three-game series vs. Houston (Tues.-Thurs.) and a four-game set vs. Boston (8/28-30)...went 4-2 on their recent six-game road trip after going 1-2 at Toronto and sweeping a three-game set at Baltimore.

- **Their 73-56 (.566) record is the second-best in the American League and the sixth-best in the Majors**, trailing only Milwaukee (81-49, .623), Los Angeles-NL (79-51, .608), Tampa Bay (76-53, .589), Atlanta (75-55, .577) and Chicago-NL (74-56, .569).
- Had their five-game winning streak snapped on Saturday (8/16-21)...had matched their second-longest winning streak of the season, trailing only an eight-game streak from 4/17-25 (also 5G from 5/24-29 and 5/1-5)...**have won seven of their last 11 games (since 8/11) and nine of their last 14 games (since 8/7)...are 19-12 in their last 31 games (since 7/19) and 23-14 in their last 37 games (since 7/9)**.
- Have had 26 of their last 36 games decided by 2R-or-fewer (since 7/10), going 17-9 in those games...are 37-29 (.561) in games decided by 2R-or-fewer this season...their 37 wins in games decided by 2R-or-fewer are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the second-most in the Majors.
- **Have won four of their last six completed series (since 7/31) and have won or split nine of their last 12 completed series since 7/6 (are 7-3-2 in those series)**.
- Are 17 games over .500, one game shy of their season-high mark (18G at 45-27 on 6/17, 46-28 on 6/19 and 73-55 on 8/22).

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees fell to the Blue Jays, 4-3, on Saturday at Yankee Stadium...**LHP Ryan Weathers** (3.1IP, 8H, 2R/ER, 0BB, 3K, 0HR) started and took the loss...exited the game in the fourth inning with left forearm discomfort...**2B Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (2-for-4, 1 double, 1SB) recorded two of the Yankees' four hits, including the club's first hit of the game with a two-out single in the seventh inning...**C Austin Wells** (1-for-3, 1RBI, 1BB) reached base twice and drove in the club's first run with an RBI single in the seventh inning...**1B Luis García Jr.** (1-for-3, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI, 1BB) hit his 26th home run of the season with a two-run shot in the eighth inning...**RHP Fernando Cruz** (1.1IP, 1H, 2K) tossed 1.1 scoreless innings of relief.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: INF **Luis García Jr.** hit his career-high 26th home run of the season (and third as a Yankee) with a two-run shot in the eighth inning on Saturday vs. Toronto...has hit .279/.311/.546 (116-for-416) with 54R, 23 doubles, 5 triples, 26HR, 82RBI, 20BB, 2SF and 4SB in 120 games this season...ranks fourth in the Majors in SLG, is tied for fourth in multi-HR games (four) and tied for seventh in RBI.

- **Has hit 2HR in his last three games** (since 8/20).
- Over his last 86 games (since 5/9), has batted .295/.329/.620 (91-for-308) with 40R, 17 doubles, 4 triples, 25HR, 66RBI, 16BB, 1SF and 2SB...during that stretch, leads the Majors in SLG, is tied for second in HR, ranks third in RBI, fourth in XBH (46) and sixth in OPS (.949).
- Has batted .293/.322/.580 (104-for-355) with 23 doubles, 5 triples, 23HR and 16BB vs. right-handed pitchers this season.
- Has hit .314/.333/.524 (33-for-105) with 7 doubles, 5HR, 50RBI, 4BB and 2SF with runners in scoring position this year.

MERRY GRISHMAS: OF **Trent Grisham** has walked in a season-high-tying four straight games since 8/19 (also 4G from 4/1-5)...is batting .300/.375/.680 (15-for-50) with 8R, 4 doubles, 5HR, 11RBI, 6BB and 2SB over his last 13 games (since 8/8).

- Has reached base multiple times in four of his last five games (since 8/18) and nine of his last 12 games (since 8/9).
- Has stolen a base in back-to-back games for only the fifth time in his career and for the first time since 4/21-22/21 with San Diego.

NEW YORK 'PEN STATION: Yankees relievers allowed just 2R/ER over 5.2IP on Saturday vs. Toronto (7H, 2BB, 3K, 1HR, 1WP)...**have allowed just 3ER over their last 24.1 innings** (since the eighth inning on 8/16 at Toronto)...**have posted a Major League-best 2.45 ERA (261.0IP, 71ER) over their last 69 games (since 6/3)**, holding opponents to a .200 (189-for-943) BA during that stretch.

- **Own the best inherited runners scored percentage in the Majors this season (21.1%) and the second-best bullpen ERA (2.99, second in AL)**...also rank third in the Majors in opponents' BA (.221, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.300, second in AL), opponents' OPS (.649, second in AL) and WHIP (1.20, second in AL), fourth in opponents' SLG (.349, second in AL), fifth in HR/9.0IP (0.92, second in AL) and ninth in K/BB (2.52, fifth in AL).

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF **Cody Bellinger** was reinstated from the injured list prior to today's game...had hit .372/.438/.465 (16-for-43) with 6R, 4 doubles, 3RBI and 5BB over his final 12 games from 7/9-25 before being placed on the injured list.

- **Has hit .338/.402/.488 (27-for-80) with 5 doubles, 2 triples, 1HR, 36RBI, 12BB and 5SF with RISP this season**.
- According to FanGraphs, his 19DRS in LF are tied for second in the Majors at any position.

RODOMINANT: LHP **Carlos Rodón** will make his 11th start of the season in today's series finale vs. Toronto...in 10 starts this year, is 4-2 with a 3.22 ERA (50.1IP, 18ER) and 56K...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of those starts and 2ER-or-fewer in six starts.

- **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in five of his last eight starts (since 5/21), posting a 2.76 ERA (42.1IP, 13ER) over that stretch**.

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starting pitchers have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 20 of their last 23 starts (since 7/28), including 1R-or-fewer in 16 of those starts, posting a 2.10 ERA (128.1IP, 31R/30ER) during that span...marks only the 10th time in franchise history Yankees starters have allowed 31R-or-fewer in a 23-start span (also did so nine times in 2024)...have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 23 of their last 28 starts and 1R-or-fewer in 19 of those starts (since 7/22-G2), posting a 2.36 ERA (152.1IP, 40ER) with 168K during that span.

- **Have allowed 2R-or-fewer in a season-high nine straight starts (since 8/13), posting a 2.11 ERA (47.0IP, 11ER) over that span**...marks just the third time in the last seven years (since 2020) the Yankees have recorded as long of a streak in a *single season* (also a 16-start stretch from 5/12-29/24 and a 10-start streak from 4/14-24/22).
- **Have allowed 1ER-or-fewer in seven of their last nine starts (since 8/13) and nine of their last 12 starts (since 8/9)**.
- **Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 102 starts this season, their most such starts through their first 129 games of a season in franchise history** (previous: 100GS in 2021)...have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 78 games this season, their second-most starts through their first 129 games of a season in franchise history, trailing only their 80 starts in 2022.
- Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 34 of their last 38 starts (since 7/8), including 2R-or-fewer in 29 of those starts, posting a 2.71 ERA (202.1IP, 61ER) during that span.
- **Yankees starters own the best ERA in the Majors (3.36)**, rank third in strikeout rate (25.2%, first in AL) and K/9.0IP (9.34, first in AL), fourth in strikeouts (718, second in AL), opponents' BA (.227, second in AL), opponents' OBP (.292, second in AL), opponents' OPS (.665, second in AL), HR/9.0IP (1.04, second in AL) and opponents' SLG (.373, third in AL), sixth in K/BB (3.29, third in AL) and WHIP (1.16, fourth in AL), and ninth in BB/9.0IP (2.84, fifth in AL).

PITCH PERFECT: Yankees pitchers have posted a Major League-best 3.21 ERA (1,152.2IP, 411ER) this season...have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 19 of their last 28 games (since 7/22-G2), including 2R-or-fewer in 15 of those games, posting a 2.47 ERA (255.0IP, 70ER) during that stretch.

- Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 24 of their last 36 games (since 7/10), posting a 2.66 ERA (328.0IP, 97ER) with 349K during that span.
- Their 476R allowed this season are their second-fewest through their first 129 games of a season in the last 48 162-game seasons (since 1977), trailing only their 450R allowed in 2022 (excludes the 60-game season in 2020 and the strike-shortened 1981 season).

CRUZ CONTROL: RHP **Fernando Cruz** tossed 1.1 scoreless innings of relief on Saturday vs. Toronto and stranded both of his inherited runners...has stranded 40 of his 46 inherited runners this season...his 13.0% inherited runners scored percentage ranks fifth among Major League relievers (fourth in AL).

- Has gone 3-6 with two saves, a 2.58 ERA (45.1IP, 13ER) and 54K over his last 49 relief outings (since 4/25)...has not allowed a run in 37 of those games...over that span, has stranded 36 of his 39 inherited runners.

PUT TO BED: RHP **David Bednar** has reached the 30-save mark for the second time in his career (also 39 saves in 2023 with Pittsburgh)...his 30 saves are the fifth-most in the Majors this season (third in AL) and match the most by a Yankee in the last seven seasons since 2020 (also Clay Holmes in 2024 and Aroldis Chapman in 2021).

- **Has not allowed a run in 29 of his last 32 appearances (since 5/22), going 5-0 with 19 saves, a 0.74 ERA (36.1IP, 3ER) and 40K during that span**...opponents are batting .115/.180/.156 (14-for-122) over that stretch.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP CARLOS RODÓN (4-2, 3.22 ERA)

LHP Carlos Rodón will make his 11th start of the season in today's series finale vs. Toronto...the 33-year-old will make the start on regular four days' rest...made his 10th start of the year and first since 6/28 at Boston on Tuesday at Baltimore, allowing 1R/ER in 4.0IP without recording a decision (2H, 2BB, 4K, 1HR)...was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day injured list on 8/18...made two rehab appearances with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and Double-A Somerset (7.0IP, 3ER)...is 4-2 with a 3.22 ERA (50.1IP, 34H, 21R/18ER, 28BB, 56K, 4HR) over 10 starts this season...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in each of his starts and 1ER-or-fewer in five of those starts...went 18-9 with a 3.09 ERA (195.1IP, 132H, 74R/67ER, 73BB, 203K, 22HR) in 33 starts last season...set career highs in wins, starts and innings pitched...was named to his third All-Star team and first as a Yankee (also 2021 with Chicago-AL and 2022 with San Francisco)...opponents batted .188/.272/.321 (132-for-701, 22HR); LH .177/.257/.285 (28-for-158, 5HR); RH .192/.277/.331 (104-for-543, 17HR)...recorded 203K, his second-most in a single season in his career (237K in 2022 with San Francisco)...since 2021, ranks fourth in the Majors with an 10.63 K/9.0IP ratio...is also tied for seventh in double-digit strikeout games (21) over that span, trailing only Dylan Cease (33), Gerrit Cole (26), Blake Snell (26), Zack Wheeler (26), Kevin Gausman (25) and Corbin Burnes (22)...has recorded at least 10K and 0BB in nine games, tied for the fifth-most such games in the Majors during that stretch, trailing only Wheeler (14), Gausman (12), Cole (11) and Jacob deGrom (11)...has pitched over parts of 12 Major League seasons with the Chicago White Sox (2015-21), San Francisco Giants (2022) and Yankees (2023-26)...has finished in the top-six of Cy Young voting three times (fifth in 2021 and sixth in 2022 and '25)...is a three-time All-Star (2021-22, '25)...has made six Opening Day rosters (2016, '19-22, '24-25)...began the 2017, 2018, 2023 and 2026 seasons on the injured list...was originally selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 16th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign and went on to play three seasons at North Carolina State University (2012-14)...was selected by the Chicago White Sox in the first round (third overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft...signed a six-year Major League contract with the Yankees extending through the 2028 season on 12/21/22.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 10th start of the year and first since 6/28 at Boston on Tuesday at Baltimore, allowing 1R/ER in 4.0IP without recording a decision (2H, 2BB, 4K, 1HR)...was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day injured list prior to the game.

- HOME SWEET HOME:** Will be making his fourth home start of the year today...in three starts at Yankee Stadium this season, is 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA (16.0IP, 12H, 5R/ER, 7BB, 21K, 1HR).
- Has allowed 1R-or-fewer in two of his three home starts this season...has recorded at least 7K in each of his starts at Yankee Stadium this year.
 - Went 10-4 with a 2.98 ERA (90.2IP, 48H, 30R/ER, 32BB, 93K, 13HR) in 15 starts at home in 2025...allowed one-or-zero ER in seven of those starts.
 - Has gone 10-3 with a 2.61 ERA (89.2IP, 50H, 26R/ER, 30BB, 94K, 10HR) over his last 15 starts at Yankee Stadium (since 5/5/25)...has won seven of his last 10 starts at home (since 6/19/25) and 11 of his last 14 (since 5/16/25).
 - Is 16-5 with a 2.75 ERA (147.1IP, 45ER) and 162K over his last 25 regular season starts at Yankee Stadium** (since 7/22/24).

- VS. TORONTO:** Has made 10 career regular season starts vs. the Blue Jays, going 2-4 with a 4.44 ERA (52.2IP, 54H, 28R/26ER, 24BB, 61K, 5HR)...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in nine of his starts and 2ER-or-fewer in seven of those starts.
- Made his last start vs. the Blue Jays earlier this season on 5/21 at Yankee Stadium, taking the loss despite allowing just 1R/ER in 5.0IP (3H, 3BB, 7K, 0HR).
 - As a Yankee (since 2023), has gone 1-4 with a 5.83 ERA (29.1IP, 19ER) and 36K in six regular season starts vs. Toronto...has made two starts against the Blue Jays at Yankee Stadium, going 1-1 with a 3.48 ERA (10.1IP, 4ER) and 15K.
 - Made the start vs. Toronto in 2025 ALDS Game 3 at Yankee Stadium, allowing 6R/ER in 2.1IP without recording a decision (6H, 2BB, 2K, 1HR, 1HP).

- ALL THAT'S LEFT:** In his career, left-handed batters have hit just .213/.289/.330 (220-for-1,035)...has also surrendered just 26HR.
- Is just the fourth left-handed Yankees pitcher in the last 48 seasons (since 1979) to allow 3R-or-fewer in each of his first 10 starts of a season, joining Jordan Montgomery (first 13GS in 2022), Nestor Cortes (first 10GS in 2022) and CC Sabathia (first 11GS in 2016).**
 - His 9.90 K/9.0IP ratio since his Major League debut in 2015 ranks fourth among left-handed pitchers in that span (min. 1,000.0IP), trailing only Chris Sale (11.70), Blake Snell (11.20) and Robbie Ray (10.64).
 - Since 2015, his 1,465K are the fifth-most among active left-handed pitchers...his 28 double-digit strikeout games over that stretch among active lefties are the fourth-most in the Majors, trailing only Sale (76), Ray (40) and Snell (39).

- 2026:** In 10 starts this year, is 4-2 with a 3.22 ERA (50.1IP, 34H, 21R/18ER, 28BB, 56K, 4HR)...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of those starts and 2ER-or-fewer in six starts.
- Was returned from his rehab assignment reinstated from the 15-day injured list on 8/18...was placed on on the 15-day injured list with left elbow inflammation on 7/3 (retroactive to 6/30)...missed 40 team games.
 - Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in five of his last eight starts (since 5/21), going 4-1 with a 2.76 ERA (42.1IP, 13ER) over that stretch.**
 - The Yankees have won six of his last seven starts (since 5/29).
 - Has tossed at least 6.0IP in three of his last seven starts and allowed 1ER-or-fewer in four of those starts.
 - Has held opponents to a .190/.300/.307 (34-for-179) slash line this season...has allowed just 4HR to his 211 batters faced, posting a 0.72 HR/9.0IP ratio.
 - Is holding right-handed batters to a .182/.297/.273 (24-for-132) slash line this year.
 - Has allowed 4H-or-fewer in eight of his 10 starts, allowing just 13XBH (9 doubles, 4HR).
 - Missed the first 40 team games of the season...was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day injured list on 5/10...made three rehab starts with High-A Hudson Valley, Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, posting a 3.38 ERA (16.0IP, 13H, 7R/6ER, 3BB, 16K, 3HR)...was placed on the 15-day injured list on 3/25 (retroactive to 3/22) recovering from left elbow surgery...underwent a left elbow arthroscopy procedure on 10/15/25...the procedure was performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache at the Kerlan-Jobe Surgery Center in Los Angeles, Calif

RODOMINATE: Over the last three seasons with the Yankees (2024-26), has gone 38-20 with a 3.47 ERA (420.2IP, 323H, 176R/162ER, 158BB, 454K, 57HR) in 75 starts...among Major League pitchers since 2024 (min. 400.0IP), ranks fourth in wins (tied for first in AL) and seventh in H/9.0IP (6.91, third in AL) and opponents' BA (.209, third in AL)...also ranks fourth in the AL in K/9.0IP (9.71), fifth in strikeout rate (26.2%), sixth in WHIP (1.14), opponents' SLG (.368), opponents' OBP (.289) and opponents' OPS (.658), and eighth in strikeouts.

- With his 16 wins in 2024 and 18 wins in 2025, became the first Yankees pitcher to record at least 16 wins in consecutive seasons since CC Sabathia in three consecutive seasons from 2009-11** (19 wins in 2009, 21 wins in 2010 and 19 wins in 2011).
