TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners face their division rival Athletics for the 2nd of 3 games (1-0)...Seattle is coming off a series loss at Kansas City (1-2) on the road trip...following Thursday's off-day, Seattle will host the Arizona Diamondbacks (3 G, 5/29-31) and New York Mets (3 G, 6/1-3)...tonight's game will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call and **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...Seattle won yesterday's game by a 9-2 final score over the A's after belting a season-high-tying 4 home runs (also: 3/26 vs. CLE, 5/1 vs. KC and 5/8 at CWS)...Seattle is 23-14 when they hit a home run and 19-5 when they score at least 5 runs.

- **In West Sacramento** - Seattle holds a 4-3 record against the A's in Sutter Health Park.
- **Ouch!** - Mariners batters rank T-4th in the Majors with 36 HBP this season, trailing only the St. Louis Cardinals (38 HBP), Los Angeles Angels (38) and Chicago White Sox (37).
- **Roster Moves** - Today the Mariners reinstated LHP **Gabe Speier** from the 15-day Injured List (left shoulder inflammation) and optioned RHP **Nick Davila** to Triple-A Tacoma (post-game May 25)...Speier has been on the IL since May 4 and made 2 minor league rehab appearances.
- **Length** - Last night, **Luis Castillo** (4.0 IP, 0 R) and **Bryce Miller** (5.0 IP, 2 R) covered all 9 innings...it marked the first time since Sept. 21, 1999 that multiple Mariners pitchers tossed at least 4.0 innings and allowed 2-or-fewer runs in a 9-inning game.

HE'S RALEY CRUSHING IT...**Luke Raley** went 2-for-5 including his 11th home run of the season in yesterday's win...overall in 2026, he is batting .270 (37x137) with 20 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 11 home runs, 29 RBI, a .329 OBP and slugging .562 for an .891 OPS in 49 games...over his last 16 games (5/8-c), he is batting .311 (14x45) with 1 double, 5 home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.034 OPS.

RANDY! RANDY! RANDY!...**Randy Arozarena** is having a huge month of May, batting .313 (26x83) with 6 doubles, 4 home runs, 14 RBI and 7 stolen bases with a .932 OPS across 23 games during the month...Arozarena is also batting .369 (24x65) with 6 doubles, 3 home runs, 13 RBI, and a 1.055 OPS over his last 18 games (5/6-c), ranking 4th in average and 7th in OPS during that span (min. 50 PA).

J-ROD Y EL TRIDENTE...**Julio Rodríguez** has hit a home run in 6 of 7 series played in May...he's also hit 7 of his 9 home runs this month, T-4th most in the majors only trailing Kyle Schwarber-PHI (9 HR), Christian Walker-HOU (8) and Byron Buxton-MIN (8)...Rodríguez homered in both series played at Sutter Health Park in 2025 and has 13 home runs against the Athletics, tied for the most against any opponent in his career (also: Angels and Rangers)...overall he is batting .269 (25x93) with 15 runs, 5 doubles, 7 home runs, 11 RBI and an .862 OPS in 23 games in May.

REALLY GOOD ARMS...the Mariners pitching staff has posted a combined 3.63 ERA (197 ER, 488.1 IP) with an MLB-fewest 142 walks, along with 472 strikeouts...among Major League pitching staffs they rank 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.32), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.62), 7th in ERA, 7th in WHIP (1.23) and 9th in strikeouts...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 312.1 innings pitched and ranks 5th in strikeouts (296)...the Seattle bullpen ranks 6th in the Majors in ERA (3.17).

JOSH SPICE...over his last 32 contests (4/17-c), **Josh Naylor** is batting .331 (41x124) with 14 runs, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 17 RBI, 13 walks and 12 stolen bases, getting on base at a .391 clip, slugging .444 with an .835 OPS in 138 plate appearances...during that span, Naylor's .328 average ranks 6th in the big leagues (min. 100 PA)...Naylor's 12 stolen bases are tied for second most in the Majors since April 17, trailing only Nasim Núñez-WSH (15).

COLT'S BIG DAY IN KC...on Sunday, **Colt Emerson** went 4-for-4 with 3 doubles and an RBI against the Royals...at 20 years, 308 days, he became the youngest player to record 3 doubles in a game since Hall of Famer Roberto Clemente (20 years, 284 days, 5/29/55 vs. PHI) and the youngest player in Mariners history to accomplish the feat...he also joined Ken Griffey Jr. (4x) and Alex Rodriguez (3x) as the only trio of Mariners to record 4 hits in a game before turning 21.

J.P. PRESENTS STEELHEADS UNIFORM TO NLBM...prior to the game on Saturday, **J.P. Crawford** presented his game-worn, autographed Seattle Steelheads uniform to **Bob Kendrick**, President of the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum located in Kansas City...manager **Dan Wilson** also presented Kendrick with a check for \$25,000 from the Mariners Care Foundation as a donation to the museum in support of its Buck O'Neil Education and Research Center...video and audio can be found on Marinersmedia.com.

ON THE UPCOMING HOMESTAND...following the current road trip, the Mariners return to T-Mobile Park for a 6-game homestand against the Diamondbacks (3 G, May 29-31) and Mets (3 G, June 1-3)...featured on the homestand is '90s weekend (May 29-31) with '90s Fireworks Night on Friday, **Julio Rodríguez** '90s Jersey Night on Saturday and '90s Pin Day on Sunday, as well as Pride Night on June 1.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Randy Arozarena** is off to a splendid start in 2026, batting .299 (59x197) with 38 runs, 15 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs, 25 RBI, 14 stolen bases and an .867 OPS, and...**YOU MAY ALSO KNOW**...that he ranks among the AL leaders in average (6th), OBP (8th, .390), hits (5th), runs (3rd), stolen bases (14) and doubles (T-2nd), but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Arozarena is also on pace to record 50 doubles this season?...if he were to reach that mark, he would become the 2nd player in Mariners history (done 3x) with 50 doubles in a season, joining Edgar Martinez (2x, 1995-96) and Alex Rodriguez (1996).

ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 26

- **1995** - After homering in the fifth inning Ken Griffey Jr. makes a spectacular catch crashing into the outfield wall. The result was two fractured bones in his left wrist. Junior underwent surgery the next day and was out until August 15.
- **2002** - Jamie Moyer allowed just one run in eight innings in an 8-1 win over Baltimore to run his career record to 13-1 against the Orioles.
- **2015** - Kyle Seager hit a grand slam in the 8th inning, then added a solo home run in the 10th as the Mariners escaped with a 7-6 win in 10 innings. Nelson Cruz went 2-for-5 with career hit No. 1,000 with a leadoff single in the 10th. Joe Beimel recorded his fifth career save and first since June 11, 2009.
- **2018** - Mike Zunino hit a walk-off home run in the bottom of the 12th at home against the Twins to win 4-3, the 2nd of his career. Both of his walk-off home runs have come against Minnesota (also: 6/17/17). It was his 3rd career walk-off hit.

ABOUT EMERSON HANCOCK...

- The 26-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 11th start of the season and the 42nd start of his career...this will be his 48th career appearance including the 6 relief appearances he made throughout the 2025 regular season...it will mark his 2nd start against the Athletics this season, 4th career appearance and 4th career start against the Athletics.
Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (6th overall) of the 2020 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Scott Hunter on June 25, 2020.
Spent 3 seasons at the University of Georgia, 2018-20...in 2020, was named Vince Dooley Athlete of the Year as the top male student-athlete at the University of Georgia.
Was named to CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team in 2020.

LAST TIME OUT...on May 20 vs. White Sox, tossed 6.0 innings and allowed 2 runs (2 ER) on 5 hits and 3 walks with 4 strikeouts...he threw 86 pitches (46 strikes) in his 10th start of the year.

THE ROAD SO FAR...in 4 away starts this season, Hancock owns a 1.135 WHIP with a 6.9 K/9...in all 4 outings on the road he has thrown 6.0+ innings...in 3 of the 4 starts has allowed 2-or-fewer runs and 2-or-fewer walks...has allowed 3-or-fewer runs over 5.0+ IP in 9 of his 12 road starts since 2025.

EARLY BIRD...throws a first pitch strike 66.5% of the time, tying for 9th highest in MLB...earns a first pitch swing from the batter 38.7% of the time, tied for the 5th highest in the league...in at-bats where the 1st pitch is swung at, Hancock has 25 strikeouts to 2 walks (12.50 K/BB) with a 0.77 WHIP.

KEEP THE K'S COMING...continues his early-season strike throwing through his first 4 starts in May...his career K/9 of 7.5 during May is tied for the highest of any month...in 2026 his May K/9 (10.5) tops his March/April marks of 8.3...is tied for the 10th most strikeouts (28) in May this season and the 8th best K/9 among AL pitchers (min 20.0 IP)...ranks 6th in the AL (min 20.0 IP) with a 28.9 K%, just ahead of Luis Castillo (28.1) and Bryan Woo (27.8).

CAREER STRETCH...over his last 10 starts he has struck out 60 batters and thrown 58.2 IP for a 3.07 ERA, all career best marks over a 10-game span in a single season...is 1-of-6 pitchers this season to have 60+ strikeouts and 13-or-fewer walks through their first 10 starts...owns a 4.62 K/BB and a 26.2 K% through his first 10 games of 2026, both marks outpacing his career-high 2.06 K/BB and 16.6 K% recorded in 2025...his 6 quality starts this season already surpass his career high 5 such games set in 2025.

CROSS FIRE...owns a 1.05 WHIP against left-handed batters, ranking 10th best among AL pitchers (min. 20.0 IP) while ranking 9th in K/BB (4.3)...is tied for the 6th fewest walks issued to lefties and owns a K/9 of 9.5...has thrown the cutter the 2nd most against left-handers (89 times), owning a .100 (1x10) opponent batting average on the pitch to rank 4th lowest among pitchers with at least 50 cutters thrown to lefty batters...also owns the 4th highest whiff rate (38.2) and 3rd highest K% (36.4).

SWING BATTER BATTER SWING...recorded a career high 21 swings and misses in his May 2 start, the most in a single game among a Mariners pitching rotation that is tied for the 3rd most swing and misses in MLB this season (1,023)...has 57 whiffs on his 4-seamer, ranking 9th most in MLB.

TRAFFIC CONTROL...his 64 base runners allowed over 58.2 innings in his first 10 starts, are 7th fewest among pitchers in 2026 through their first 10 games (min. 58.0 IP)...owns a baserunners-per-9 of 9.39, ranking 11th in AL in 2026, (min. 55.0 IP)...ranks t-14th in WHIP (0.96) with runners on base in the AL in 2026 (min. 20.0 IP) while tying for the 5th fewest runs allowed in runners on situations among AL pitchers (min 20.0 IP).

QUALITY CONTROL...has recorded a quality start in 6 of his 10 starts this season...is 1-of-4 pitchers in 2026 to have 5 quality starts with 1-or-fewer walks and 5+ strikeouts...the Mariners are 9-6 when Hancock logs a quality start since 2023 and are 7-4 since the start of 2025...3-of-4 away starts this season have been quality starts with 2-or-fewer walks.

NO FREE PASSES...is 1-of-5 pitchers this season to have allowed 3-or-fewer walks over 5.0+ IP in each of their first 10 starts, along with George Kirby...his 1.99 BB/9 is the 8th best in the AL (min. 50.0 IP)...has contributed 6 starts with 6.0+ IP and 2-or-fewer walks to a Mariners pitching staff that leads the league in such games (28) in 2026.

UP TO BIG UNIT STANDARDS...on May 2, followed up Mariners legend Randy Johnson's number retirement ceremony with a performance of his own, setting the single-game high in strikeouts this season with 14 Ks and becoming the 4th player with 14+ strikeouts and no walks allowed in Mariners franchise history, joining Randy Johnson (done 2x), George Kirby (done 2x) and Mark Langston...is 1-of-5 pitchers in MLB to have 14+ strikeouts and no walks since the start of 2023, along with George Kirby (2x, last: 9/14/25), Max Meyer-MIA (4/21/25), Tyler Glasnow-LAD (4/9/24), and Pablo López-MIN (9/10/23)...is the most recent pitcher to record 13+ strikeouts in a game, joining George Kirby (14, 9/14/25 vs. LAA), Bryan Woo (13, 9/13/25 vs. LAA) and Logan Gilbert (13, 8/24/25 vs. ATH) as 4 of the last 7 pitchers in MLB to record 13+ strikeouts in an outing.

- **IL Time** - Placed on 15-day Injured List (right lat inflammation) on May 1 (retroactive to April 30) and reinstated on May 20.
- **2025 Totals** - Went 1-3 with 4 saves, a 2.47 ERA (13 ER, 47.1 IP), 18 walks, 58 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP in 53 relief appearances...held opponents to a .236 average while recording 21 holds.
