THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 12
2019 - The Astros outslug the Mariners in Seattle by a score of 10-6... Houston smacks three home runs, including grand slams from **2B Jose Altuve** (2x5) and **3B Yuli Gurriel** (3x5)...it marks just the third time in club history for the Astros to hit two grand slams in the same game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros look to stop a six-game losing streak as they continue their 10-game road trip with the third game of a four-game series against the Seattle Mariners at T-Mobile Park in Seattle, WA...**RHP Cody Bolton** will be on the mound for the Astros opposite **RHP Logan Gilbert** and the Mariners.

ABOUT BOLTON: **RHP Cody Bolton** will make his second career start today against the Mariners... in his first career start on Tuesday, April 6 at COL, he allowed two runs on three hits and two walks with five strikeouts in 4.1 innings...last season, he split the season between the Mariners, Guardians and Astros organizations...appeared in one MLB game with the Guardians (3ER/2IP) and 11 minor league games between the three organizations...the right-handed pitcher has pitched in each of the last four Major League seasons with the Pirates (2023), Mariners (2024), Guardians (2025) and Astros (2026)...has combined to go 1-0-1 with a 5.47 ERA (30ER/49.1IP) in his 36 career appearances, including one start...has recorded 50 strikeouts in his 49.1 innings of work.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 12 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (982), trailing only the Dodgers (1,047).

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the international free agent market.

AT THE HELM: Manager **Joe Espada** is in his third season as the Astros skipper...in 2025, for the second consecutive season, Espada and his staff were forced to deal with an extremely high number of injuries...despite an ever-changing roster that often was missing key players, to his credit, Espada managed to navigate his club to an 87-75 record, finishing in a tie for the final AL Wild Card berth (lost tiebreaker to DET).

ROAD TRIP: Today is the ninth game of a 10-game road trip for the Astros...the Astros are 1-7 so far on this road trip...Houston went 41-40 on the road last season...following this four-game series in Seattle, the Astros will face the Colorado Rockies for a three-game series at Daikin Park from April 14-16.

AGAINST THE MARINERS: The Astros and Mariners face each other today for the third of 13 scheduled matchups in 2026...the Astros went 5-8 against the Mariners in 2025, including 2-4 record at T-Mobile Park...Houston owns a 132-99 all-time regular season record against Seattle...the Mariners will travel to Daikin Park for the first of two road trips to Houston from May 11-14 for a four-game series.

ULLOLA INJURY: **RHP Miguel Ullola** left last night's game for Triple A Sugar Land due to a left ankle sprain.

PEÑA INJURY: Astros SS **Jeremy Peña** left last night's game due to right knee posterior tightness... he will get further evaluation today.

LAST NIGHT'S GAME: The Houston Astros lost to the Mariners, 7-8 on a walk-off single last night at T-Mobile Park...**RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (4.1IP, 5 H, 6 ER, 2 BB, 4 K)...**DH Yordan Alvarez** (3x6, HR, RBI), **3B-SS Carlos Correa** (3x5, 2B), **RF Cam Smith** (4x5, 2 2B, 2 RBI) and **CF Taylor Trammell** (2x4, 2B, 3 RBI) were outstanding at the plate for the Astros.

OFFENSIVE FIREWORKS: The Astros lead the American League in runs (92), doubles (41), total bases (242), hits (147), walks (75), SLG (.462), OBP (.377) and OPS (.839)...individually, **2B Jose Altuve** and **IF Carlos Correa** rank second in the AL in runs (12)...**1B Christian Walker** ranks third in the AL in doubles (6) and tied for fourth in RBI (13).

TUVE VS. THE MARINERS: **2B Jose Altuve** has hit .310 (243x783) with 48 doubles, 21 homers, 96 RBI and an .827 OPS in 192 career games against the Mariners...he already ranks third all-time in hits vs. SEA, trailing only **Cal Ripken Jr.** (261) and **Michael Young** (259), and ranks eighth all-time in games played vs. the Mariners.

MOVIN' ON UP: **LF Yordan Alvarez** recorded his 175th career home run on Fri. night at SEA...the home run moved into sole possession of seventh place on the Astros all-time home run list, passing franchise icon **OF George Springer**...next up on the Astros all-time list is **3B Alex Bregman** (191 HR).

AIR YORDAN: This season, **LF Yordan Alvarez** is batting .360 (18x50) with 12 runs, four doubles, six home runs, 14 RBI, 14 walks, and a 1.315 OPS (.515 OBP/.800 SLG)...in the Majors, he ranks first in OPS, SLG and OBP, while ranking tied for first in walks, tied for first in home runs, tied for third in runs and tied for fifth in RBI.

YORDAN'S CYCLE: On July 21, 2024 at Seattle, **DH Yordan Alvarez** recorded his first career cycle and the 10th cycle in Astros franchise history...it was the second cycle in T-Mobile Park history (also, **Miguel Tejada** on Sept. 29, 2001)...it was also the first cycle by an Astros left-handed hitter since **Luke Scott** hit for the cycle on July 28, 2006 vs. ARI...he also became the only DH to hit for the cycle in Astros history and ninth in MLB history (last, **Jake Bauers** on June 14, 2019).

DOWN ON THE FARM: Astros number two overall prospect **IF Xavier Neyens** went 2x4 with a solo home run, walk and a stolen base...marked his first career home run in his professional career.

ON THE MEND: **LHP Bennett Sousa** (left oblique strain) began a rehab assignment with Triple A Sugar Land last night...in his outing, he walked one and struck out two in one scoreless inning.

AIRCRAFT CARRIER: **RF Cam Smith** went 4x5 with two doubles, two RBI and a run scored last night at SEA...marked his second career four-hit game, also June 17, 2025 at ATH.

LAST APPEARANCE (4/6 at COL): made his first career start last Monday night at COL and pitched 4.1 innings, giving up 2 runs on 3 hits and 2 walks with 5 strikeouts...hurled 4.0 scoreless frames before allowing 2 baserunners on a single and a walk with 1 out and was taken out of the game...those runs would later come around to score...tossed 65 pitches (35 strikes), a career high in pitches...his 4.1 innings pitched were also a career high, beating his previous career-high of 3.0 IP, which he reached in his prior appearance.

ABOUT BOLTON: right-handed hurler is making his second Major League start tonight after making his first career one last week in Colorado...has appeared in Major League games with the Pirates (2023), Mariners (2024), Guardians (2025) and Astros (2026) making 35 career relief appearances...has combined to go 1-0-1 with a 5.47 ERA (30ER/49.1IP) in the Majors...joined the Astros by signing a 2-year minor league contract on July 24, 2025...finished his 2025 season at Triple A Sugar Land.

BOLTON IN 2026: broke camp with Triple A Sugar Land, but did not pitch in the Space Cowboys opening series before being selected to the Astros Major League roster on March 30...pitched twice since his selection, a relief appearance on March 31 vs. BOS and a start on April 6 at COL.

SPRING TRAINING: was a non-roster invite at Astros Spring Training...made 1 appearance for the Astros on Feb. 22 vs. STL (1ER/0.2IP)...was reassigned to minor league camp on March 2.

VS. THE MARINERS: will be making his first career start and appearance against the Mariners.

BOLTON'S JOURNEY: the California native was selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 6th round of the 2017 Draft...traded to the Mariners on Nov. 2, 2023, and then to the Guardians on April 8, 2025...was released by the Guardians on June 6, 2025...was injured at the time of his release...signed by the Astros to a 2-year minor league contract on July 24, 2025...finished his season in the Astros organization.

COMMANDER CODY: is just the third player with the first name of Cody to appear in a game with the Astros...he joined **IF Cody Ransom** (19g in 2007) and **C Cody Clark** (16g in 2013).

SLOW START: was activated off the 15-day IL (right knee strain) on Monday and made his season debut that night...suffered the injury early in camp, which did not get him into an official Spring Training game until March 20...began the season on the IL and made 4 minor league relief appearances, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings, before his activation.

2025 SEASON: was a strong contributor out of the Astros bullpen in the second half after signing an MLB contract on Aug. 7...recorded a 4.03 ERA (10 ER/22.1 IP) and 9.7 SO/9IP through 22 appearances with the Astros.
