TODAY'S GAME: After falling behind with last night's loss, the Giants look to even out the series with a win this afternoon.

- ▶ The Giants enter play at 50-72 (.410), a season-worst 22 games under .500...they own the fifth-worst record in MLB and second-lowest winning percentage in the NL behind only this weekend's opponent, the Rockies (49-73, .402).
- ▶ SF has lost 10 of their last 13 games, averaging just 2.62 runs per game in that span and scoring two runs or fewer in six of those 13 contests...their 34 runs scored and .192 team batting average both rank last in the Majors in this stretch.
- ▶ Since the All-Star break, SF's 9-17 (.346) record is tied with the Mariners for the third-worst record in the Majors, ahead only of the Athletics (7-19, .269) and Guardians (8-18, .308).
- ▶ Lastly, the Giants have dropped each of their first two series of this homestand thus far (1-2 vs. Detroit & Houston) and are 2-5 in the homestand.

ROCK OF AGES: The Giants are 5-6 in 11 games so far this season with the Rockies (3-2 here at home and 2-4 at Coors Field) with this series determining season-series winner.

- ▶ The Giants will need to win their next two games to avoid dropping a season series to the Rockies for the first time since 2020, when they went 4-6 during the pandemic-shortened season...SF has won the season series in six of the last seven seasons dating to 2019.
- ▶ The Giants have won each of their last eight home series vs. Colorado dating to Sept. 2022 and have won 12 of their last 13 home series vs. Colorado dating to the start of 2021.
- ▶ SF's eight home series win streak is its longest against the Rockies in their matchup history...it's tied for SF's longest active streak versus any team (also the Phillies) and tied for its longest against a divisional opponent all-time (two eight home series win streaks versus San Diego from 1970-73 and 2011-2014) (*Stats, LLC*).

HELLO, OLD FRIEND: RHP Logan Webb will take the hill today to face a very familiar opponent...the right-hander will be matching up against the Rockies for the 22nd time in his career and third time this season...Webb's 21 games vs. Colorado are tied for this most vs. any single opponent, matching his 21 outings against the Dodgers.

- ▶ Overall, Webb is 11-4 with a 3.39 ERA (45er, 119.1ip) and 111 strikeouts in 21 games (20 starts) vs. Colorado...his 11 wins against the Rockies are second-most among active pitchers, trailing only Patrick Corbin (13).
- ▶ Both of Webb's starts against the Rockies this year (May 29 and July 3) have come at Coors Field...here at Oracle Park, the righty has been especially dominant, sporting a 7-1 record with a 1.49 ERA (9er, 54.1ip), 53 strikeouts and a 1.09 WHIP across nine games (eight starts)...the Giants are 8-1 in those games.

ROOKIE SZN: Yesterday, IF Bryce Eldridge lined a 409' solo shot to center field to record his 13th homer of the season...Eldridge became is the first Giants rookie aged 21 or younger to hit 13 homers in a season since **Jack Clark** (13) in 1977.

- ▶ Eldridge is just the fifth Giants rookie 21 years or younger to hit 13+ homers in a season, joining Clark, **Willie McCovey** (13 homers in 1959), **Orlando Cepeda** (25 homers in 1958) and **Willie Mays** (20 homers in 1951).

LET THE KIDS PLAY: In addition to Eldridge, the Giants have been highlighted by a youth movement that has taken over the club since the trade deadline...yesterday, SF selected **OF Turner Hill** from Triple-A after a breakout season in Sacramento that saw him establish a franchise-best 26-game hitting streak and earn PCL Player of the Month honors in July..Hill, who is still looking for his debut, could become the 10th Giants player to debut this season.

- ▶ Overall, the Giants' nine debuts this season are tied with the Rockies for most in the NL and fifth-most in MLB.
- ▶ Out of SF's current 26-man roster, nine are rookies...SF's nine active rookies are tied with the Tigers and Mets for second-most in MLB behind the Angels (10).

STARGAZING: Major League Baseball announced yesterday that Oracle Park will be the site of the 2028 Major League Baseball All-Star Game presented by Mastercard...it will be the second time Oracle Park has hosted the Midsummer Classic (also July 10, 2007).

WEBBMASTER: Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023...the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision after matching a season-high 8.0 innings last Sunday in SF's 3-1 loss to Detroit...held Tigers batters to one run on four hits with a walk and two strikeouts...batters were 0-for-7 with a strikeout off his change-up...overall, Webb's four starts of 8.0+ innings this season are tied for most in the Majors, matching MIA's Sandy Alcantara and LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto.

VS. COLORADO: Will face the Rockies for the 22nd time in his career and third time this season...the right-hander is 11-4 with a 3.39 ERA (45er, 119.1ip), 111 strikeouts and a 1.24 WHIP in the 21 games (20 starts)...in the two starts this year, both of which came at Coors Field, Webb is 0-1 with a 9.82 ERA (8er, 7.1ip) and a .400 opposing average (14x35)...overall, Webb's 11 wins against the Rockies are second-most among active pitchers, trailing only Patrick Corbin's 13 wins, while his 20 starts are fourth-most behind Corbin (29), Robbie Ray (25) and Walker Buehler (21).

HOMEFIELD ADVANTAGE: Webb has been especially dominant against the Rockies here at Oracle Park, where he's gone 7-1 with a 1.49 ERA (9er, 54.1ip) with 53 strikeouts and a 1.09 WHIP across nine games (eight starts)...the Giants are 8-1 in those games.

UP AND DOWN: After a tough month of July in which he had a 6.59 ERA in five starts, Webb is bounced back this month, posting a 0.64 ERA (1er, 14.0ip) in two starts so far...Webb has seemingly alternated between good and bad months this season (see *full chart to the right*).

STAYGROUNDED: Has a 52.5% ground ball rate this season, fourth-best in the Majors behind PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (57.6%), STL's Andre Pallante (56.1%) and DET's Framer Valdez (55.0%).

HOME, SWEET HOME: Has a 3.58 ERA (29er, 73.0ip) and .589 opponents OPS in 11 starts at home...overall, he is 42-29 with a 2.93 ERA in 101 career games (98 starts) at Oracle Park compared to a 3.91 ERA in 100 starts on the road... since 2021, Webb's 2.77 ERA at home is fifth-best in the Majors (min. 60 GS).

SINK OR SWIM: His sinker has a +13 run value this season, tied for fourth-highest in the Majors and currently his highest value of any pitch since 2024, when he finished the year with a +17 run value on his sinker...batters are hitting .226 with a .351 slugging percentage off his sinker this season, which he throws 29.7% of the time...had a .294 BAA and .438 SLG with the pitch in 2025.

BABY I'M BACK: Since returning from the 15-day IL on May 29 at Colorado, Webb is 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA (26er, 85.0ip), 0.91 WHIP and a .195 BAA in 13 starts...he was 2-4 with a 5.06 in eight starts before the injury...Webb landed on the IL on May 9 and missed 20 games with right knee bursitis in what was his first trip to the injured list since October 2022 (low back strain).

IN PLAY...: Has struck out 103 batters in 133.0 innings this season...Webb's 19.1% strikeout rate is down from 26.2% last season and currently his lowest in any full season (excluding 2020).

TOUGH LUCK: SF is 8-13 in Webb's 21 starts this year after going 18-16 in his 34 starts a season ago...since 2022, SF as a team is 75-78 in Webb's 153 starts, yet his 3.27 ERA in that time is sixth-best in MLB among starters (min. 100 GS).
