TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue their 6 game homestand today with the second of 3 games against the Atlanta Braves (1-0)...Seattle also hosted the Kansas City Royals (0-3) on the homestand... following an off-day on Thursday, Seattle will open a 7-game road trip with the Chicago White Sox (3 G, May 8-10) and Houston Astros (4 G, May 11-14)...tonight's game will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Dave Valle** on the call with **Angie Mentink** serving as field analyst...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners beat the Braves in comeback fashion by a 5-4 score last night...Seattle is 7-4 over its last 11 games and 9-6 over its last 13 games.

- **Walter's Big Day** - Happy birthday to **Logan Gilbert**, who celebrates his 29th birthday today.
- **Small Margins** - The Mariners have played an MLB-leading 14 one-run games this season, going 6-8 (.429) in those contests...Seattle leads MLB in one-run games (281) since 2021 and their 156-125 (.555) record in one-run games during that span ranks 2nd in MLB behind the Brewers (.564/136-105).
- **Let Me Lead** - Seattle ranks 3rd in the Majors with 16 go-ahead home runs this season, trailing only the Braves (19 HR) and Yankees (25 HR)...in 2025, the Mariners ranked 2nd with 81 go-ahead homers behind only the Yankees (92 HR).
- **On Rehab** - INF/OF **Brendan Donovan** (left groin muscle strain) is set to begin a rehab assignment with Double-A Arkansas tonight...INF **Patrick Wisdom** (left oblique strain) is also slated to begin a rehab assignment with Triple-A Tacoma this evening...OF **Victor Robles** began a rehab assignment with Tacoma on Sunday, striking out in both plate appearances.

J-ROD SHOWING OFF...over his last 22 games since April 11, **Julio Rodríguez** is batting .341 (30x88) with 12 runs, 7 doubles, 4 home runs, 14 RBI, 7 walks and is 3-for-3 in stolen base attempts, getting on base at a .396 clip, slugging .557 with a .953 OPS in 96 plate appearances...he has hit safely in his last 6-consecutive contests (4/28-c), tallying multiple hits in 3 of those games.

HAMMER AND NAYLZ...over his last 13 games (4/17-c), first baseman **Josh Naylor** is batting .370 (20x45) with 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 10 RBI, 5 walks and 4 stolen bases, reaching base at a .417 clip and slugging .537 for a .954 OPS...since Naylor made his Mariners debut on July 25, 2025, he is 23-for-25 in stolen base attempts, ranking T-7th in the Majors and 5th in AL in stolen bases over that span.

PATIENCE & POWER AT THE PLATE...**J.P. Crawford** last night drew 2 walks and hit a go-ahead, 2-run home run in the 6th inning to give the Mariners the 5-4 win over the Braves...he has hit safely in his last 6 games (4/28-c) and posted a .367 OBP in 120 plate appearances this season...overall this season, Crawford ranks 9th in the Majors with a 18.3% walk rate and 3rd in MLB with a 1.22 walk-to-strikeout rate...since 2022, his 310 walks rank 7th in MLB and 2nd in the AL behind only Aaron Judge-NYY (483 BB).

GEORGE'S GAME...**George Kirby** ranks 5th in the Majors in innings pitched this season, tossing 45.0 innings over 7 starts...he is one of 2 pitchers this season to toss a complete game, along with Sandy Alcantara-MIA, and has made 4 quality starts...overall, Kirby is 4-2 with a 3.00 ERA (15 ER, 45.0 IP) with 11 walks, 34 strikeouts and a 1.13 WHIP.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES...the Mariners yesterday announced a series of roster moves...LHP **Josh Simpson** was recalled from Triple-A Tacoma and LHP **José Suarez**, who was claimed off waivers from Atlanta on Sunday, reported to the club...as corresponding moves, LHP **Gabe Speier** was placed on the 15-day Injured List (left shoulder inflammation, retroactive to May 3) and RHP **Cole Wilcox** was optioned to Triple-A Tacoma...on Sunday, OF Rhyllan Thomas was designated for assignment to clear 40-man space for Suarez.

RANDY JOHNSON'S NUMBER 51 RETIRED...**Randy Johnson's #51** was retired on Saturday, joining fellow Hall of Famers **Ken Griffey Jr. (#24)**, **Edgar Martinez (#11)**, **Ichiro Suzuki (#51)** and Jackie Robinson (#42) as the only numbers retired by the Mariners...Johnson became the 14th player in MLB history to have his number retired by multiple teams, as his and Ichiro's #51 became the 8th number to be retired by the same team for multiple players (in addition to #42 which is retired across Major League Baseball)...Randy was inducted into the Mariners Hall of Fame in 2012 and the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 2015...the Arizona Diamondbacks retired his #51 in 2015.

- **Johnson Statue Coming In 2027** - Mariners Chairman & Managing Partner **John Stanton** announced Saturday that **Randy Johnson** will be honored with a statue at T-Mobile Park in 2027...Johnson will join **Dave Niehaus** (2011), **Ken Griffey Jr.** (2017), **Edgar Martinez** (2021), and **Ichiro Suzuki** (2026), as well as **Mike Cameron** and **Mark McLemore** raising the American flag in 2001 statue, set for later this year, as Mariners legends to be immortalized with a statue at T-Mobile Park.

K KINGS...the Mariners have had 4 of the last 5 pitchers to record 13+ strikeouts in a game: **Emerson Hancock** (14, 5/2/26 vs. KC), **George Kirby** (14, 9/14/25 vs. LAA), **Bryan Woo** (13, 9/13/25 vs. LAA) and **Logan Gilbert** (13, 8/24/25 vs. ATH)...Max Fried-NYY (13, 9/18/25 at BAL) is the last non Mariner with 13+ SO in a game.

COLE YOUNG'S RUN...over his last 17 games (4/16-c), **Cole Young** is batting .317 (20x63) with 8 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 10 RBI, 3 walks and 2 stolen bases...the 22-year-old leads second basemen and ranks T-2nd in MLB with 7 defensive runs saved (*Sports Info Solutions*).

AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Julio Rodríguez** has been great at the plate recently, hitting safely in his last 6-consecutive contests (4/28-c) and recording 3 multi-hit games during that span, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that since his Major League debut in 2022, Julio has recorded 198 career multi-hit games which ranks 7th most in MLB?...Rodríguez ranks ahead of Shohei Ohtani-2Tms (8th, 192 G), Nico Hoerner-CHC (191) and Aaron Judge-NYY (190), trailing Luis Arraez-4TMs MLB-leading 228 multi-hit games...Rodríguez also ranks 6th in the Majors in 3+ hit games during that span with 55.

ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 5

- **1991** - Greg Briley hit the game winning home run off Rich Monteleone to end the longest game in Kingdome history, a 16-inning 5-4 win over New York.
- **2001** - **Dan Wilson** hits his 1st career pinch-hit home run to lead off the 7th inning against Toronto.
- **2010** - Ken Griffey Jr. tied Rafael Palmeiro in 6th place on the all-time extra base hits list...his double put him just one behind Ted Williams on the all-time doubles list...Williams is 37th overall.
- **2012** - Kyle Seager went 2-for-4 with 4 RBI and Félix Hernández allowed 1 hit over 8.0 shutout innings as the Mariners defeated the Twins 7-0...Steve Delabar added a perfect 9th inning for the 3rd combined one-hitter in club history.
- **2018** - Robinson Canó recorded his 1,200th and 1,201st RBI, becoming the third second baseman in MLB history to record at least 1,100 runs, 2,000 hits, 500 doubles, 300 home runs and 1,200 RBI, joining Rogers Hornsby and Jeff Kent.

ABOUT GEORGE KIRBY...

- The 28-year-old right-hander is making his 8th start of the season and 1st against the Braves...is making the 120th start of his career and his 3rd career start against Atlanta.
- Is in his 5th season with Seattle; selected by the Mariners in the first round (20th overall) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Ty Holub.
- Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2023.
- Named AL Rookie of the Month in August 2022 after posting a 2.15 ERA and 5-0 record.
- Is the highest drafted player out of Elon University.

LAST TIME OUT...ND on April 29 at Minnesota...tossed 5.2 innings and allowed 2 runs (2 ER) and 2 walks with 5 strikeouts in his 7th start of the season...he threw 97 pitches (64 strikes).

LENGTH ON THE MOUND...has reached the 6th inning in each of his 7 starts this year...his 45.0 innings pitched this season are 3rd-most in MLB and are his most through his first 7 starts of a single season.

THE LAST 10...across his last 10 home starts since July 31, 2025, he is 6-2 with a 2.76 ERA (18 ER, 58.2 IP) and 67 strikeouts to 18 walks allowed...he has thrown 6.0+ IP in 7 of those 10 starts, including 6 quality starts with the Mariners going 7-3 in his last 10 home starts.

AGAINST ATLANTA...making his 3rd career start against the Braves and his 2nd at T-Mobile Park...has tossed 6 strikeouts over 6+ innings in each of his 2 starts against Atlanta...in his first start against the Braves at home on Sept. 10, 2022, he threw 6.0 innings without allowing an earned run on 3 hits with no walks and 6 strikeouts.

#50...is 1 win away from 50 career wins...will become the 12th player in franchise history with 50+ wins...if he factors into the win in his next start, his 120 games will be the 4th-fewest to reach 50 wins with the Mariners, behind: Jamie Moyer (100 G), Freddy Garcia (100 G), and Marco Gonzales (118 G).

QUALITY STUFF...has thrown a quality start in 4 of his 7 starts this season (last: 4/24 at STL)...has thrown 67 quality starts across his career, tied for 9th-most in MLB since 2022...has thrown 35 quality starts at home, 8th-most among pitchers since 2022.

MORE QUALITY FROM KIRBY...has thrown a quality start without any walks in 36 career starts (1x this season, 4/7 at TEX), most in MLB since 2022, ahead of Tarik Skubal-DET (26), and Logan Webb-SF and Zack Wheeler-PHI (25 G)...has also tossed a quality start with no walks at home in 20 career games, most since 2022, ahead of Wheeler (17).

CRUISE CONTROL...tossed 8.0 innings on April 7 vs. Texas on the road, his 2nd career complete game (also: 8/12/23 vs. BAL) and is 1 of just 2 pitchers with a complete game so far this season (also: Sandy Alcantara-MIA, 4/1 vs. CHW)...became the first Mariners pitcher to toss 8.0+ IP since Logan Gilbert did so twice in 2024 (last: 9/7/24 at STL)...Kirby has thrown 8.0+ IP without a walk in 3 career games (last: 4/7 at TEX) and is 1 of 8 pitchers in MLB with 3-or-more such games since 2023, joining fellow teammate Logan Gilbert (3 G, last: 6/16/24 vs. TEX).

BEST IN ALL THE LAND...among starting pitchers since 2022 (min. 600 IP), he leads the Majors in fewest walks allowed (104), strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.30), walks-per-nine innings (1.37), and walk rate (3.7%).

FOR THE M'S HISTORY BOOKS...leads the Mariners franchise (min. 100 GS) in fewest walks-per-nine innings (1.4), ahead of Hisashi Iwakuma (1.9) and Logan Gilbert (2.0)...also leads franchise in strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.30), also ahead of Gilbert (4.85)...ranks 5th in franchise history in career ERA (3.55), ahead of Luis Castillo (3.61) and Logan Gilbert (3.61)...12th in total strikeouts (655 SO).

NO FREE PASSES...has not allowed more than 3 walks in any start over his first 118 career games, the 2nd-longest such streak in MLB history to start a career by a starting pitcher, behind only Carlos Silva's 150 game streak from 8/2/2003-8/15/2008...Kirby's 38 career games of 6.0+ IP without a walk are the most such games among a pitcher's first 119 career games, ahead of Hall of Famer Cy Young (37 G)...has also tossed 6.0+ IP with no walks in 20 home starts, most such games in MLB since 2022, ranking ahead of teammate Logan Gilbert (18 G).

FEW FREE BAGS...has allowed 1-or-fewer walks in 96 starts and 2-or-fewer walks in 111 career starts, both the most such games in MLB through a starting pitcher's first 119 career starts.

GOING THE DISTANCE...since 2025, the Mariners are 12-6 when he pitches 6.0+ innings compared to 6-6 when he tosses fewer than 6.0 innings...across his career, they are 49-25 when he tosses 6.0+ innings and are 18-27 when he tosses fewer than 6.0 innings.

2025 TOTALS...went 10-8 with a 4.21 ERA (59 ER, 126.0 IP) with 29 walks and 137 strikeouts over 23 starts last season...wrapped up the 2025 season with career-best marks in both strikeouts-per-nine innings (9.8) and strikeout percentage (26.1%)...tossed a combined 31 strikeouts across his last 3 starts of the 2025 regular season (9/14-9/26) which is the most by a Mariners pitcher across a 3-game span since James Paxton tossed 33 strikeouts from April 26-May 8, 2018.

14:0 (x2)...tossed a career-high 14 strikeouts without a walk twice during the 2025 regular season, on June 8 at Los Angeles-AL then on Sept. 14 vs. Los Angeles-AL at home, the only pitcher to throw 14+ strikeouts without a walk in multiple starts last season.
