**AHOY MATEY:** The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates kick-off a four-game series tonight at PNC Park ... Tonight marks the first Cardinals four-game set in Pittsburgh since Aug. 26-29, 2021 (2-2 record) and their first four-game April series in the Steel City since April 10-13, 1987 (2-2 record).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis has lost four in a row and five of its last six, entering today tied with Milwaukee in 4th place in the National League Central, 3.5 games back of first place Cincinnati ... Tonight's game is their 4th of a season-high 17 straight without an off day (April 24-May 10).

**BURIED TREASURE:** Despite dropping 14 of its last 19 games here since Oct. 5, 2022, the Cardinals (116) rank 2nd to the Cubs (117) among visiting teams in all-time win at PNC Park (2001-present), while their .563 win pct. trails only the Padres (.625) and Dodgers (.578) for 3rd among annual Steel City visitors.

**DIVISION DANDIES:** Tonight is the Cardinals first Divisional game of the season, Game no. 28 on the schedule ... The only other time St. Louis played its first divisional game this late into the season was May 7, 1993 at Philadelphia's Veterans Stadium (also Game No. 28), when the Cardinals were one of seven teams in the National League East Division.

• The Cardinals host the Brewers in Game No. 35 on May 4, tying the 1998 Redbirds for the latest St. Louis has played its first home divisional game ... But as their 19th home game, this sets a franchise record for latest to play their first home divisional game. -- *Elias*

**SHIVER ME TIMBERS:** St. Louis enters tonight's game having not scored a run its last 28 consecutive innings at PNC Park... The Cardinals last plated a run in the 13th inning of a 2-1 loss on April 9, 2025.

• The longest Cards runless streak at any road ballpark is 36 innings, also in Pittsburgh, from **August 4-October 3, 1976 at Three River Stadium.**

• PNC Park's all-time three longest scoreless innings streaks by team batters include the Pirates (31, September 7-18, 2019), White Sox (30, June 17, 2010-May 16, 2018), and Cardinals (28). -- *Elias*

**HURTS SO GOOD:** St. Louis paces MLB with 23 hit by pitches, highlighted by an MLB-leading eight by **Iván Herrera** and six from rookie **JJ Wetherholt** (T-3rd in MLB) ... 2014 **Jon Jay** (20) was the last Cardinal to lead all of Major League Baseball in hit by pitches.

**CHECK OUT MY ABS:** **Iván Herrera** shares the MLB lead with five successful batter ABS challenges (8 others), and after successfully challenging four calls at catcher yesterday vs. Seattle, moved to 9-1 in ABS catcher challenges, tied with Seattle's **Mitch Garver** for best pct. among MLB backstops.

**CASE OF THE MONDAYS:** St. Louis (0-4) and Detroit (0-3) are the only two winless Major League teams on Monday this season.

**IT IS YOUR BIRTHDAY:** Happy 51st birthday to Cardinals Hall of Famer **Chris Carpenter** ... Other notables born on this date include **Corey Seager** (32), **George Gervin** (74), **Enos Slaughter** (1916-2002), **Rogers Hornsby** (1896-1963), & **Ulysses S. Grant** (1822-85).

**Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

**Victor Scott II** grew up a fan of **Andrew McCutchen** and **Staring Marte** as a child...Scott's father was Pirates fan from Pittsburgh, although Victor II grew up a Braves fan as an Atlanta native.

**Nathan Church** (2018) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

**JJ Wetherholt** graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School and resides in Gibsonsia, Pa., but was born in Baltimore, Md., and grew up a fan of the Baltimore Ravens.

**Justin Bruihl** pitched in seven games for the Pirates in 2024.

**Alec Burluson** tallied his first career hit on Sept. 11, 2022 at Pittsburgh.

**Lars Nootbaar** smacked his first career home run on Aug. 12, 2021 at Pittsburgh.

**Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC) and Special Assistant to the President of Baseball Operations **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004 at PNC) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

**Marcell Ozuna** played in 278 games for St. Louis from 2018-19 after the Cardinals acquired him in a trade with the Marlins on Dec. 14, 2017 in exchange for **Sandy Alcantara**, **Zac Gallen**, **Magneuris Sierra** and **Daniel Castano**.

**Hunter Dobbins** and **Mason Montgomery** were teammates at Texas Tech from 2019-20.

**Evan Sisk** was selected by St. Louis in the 16th round of the 2018 MLB Draft and pitched in the Cardinals minor league system from 2018-21 before St. Louis traded him along with **John Gant** to Minnesota in exchange for **J.A. Happ** and cash considerations on July 30, 2021.

**Nick Yorke** made his MLB debut at St. Louis on Sept. 16, 2024.

Pirates Color Analyst **Neil Walker** collected his first career hit vs. St. Louis on Sept. 6, 2009.

Pirates Dir. of Hitting Development **Tim McKeithan's** grandfather, **Jerry McKeithan Sr.**, played in the St. Louis minor league system, and his brother, **Aaron McKeithan**, was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

Pittsburgh Special Advisor of Pitching Development **Dewey Robinson** coached at the University of Missouri from 1984-86...received his bachelor degree in finance from SIU Carbondale and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2023.

**Brant Brown** played in 130 games for the Pirates in 1999 before being traded to the Marlins for OF **Bruce Aven** (Dec. 13, 1999)...traded by the Cubs to Pittsburgh for RHP **Jon Lieber** (Dec. 14, 1998).

**Riley O'Brien's** great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his grandfather **Johnny O'Brien**, played part of four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

**Yohel Pozo** made his Cardinals debut on April 7, 2025 at Pittsburgh in front of approximately 15 family members based in Harrisburg, Pa.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956...played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** was the general manager of the Pirates from 1992-93.

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Manager **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Senior Director, Communications & Content **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a PR Specialist in the Cardinals Comm. dept.(2010-11).

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The 28-year-old **Dustin May** makes his 6th start as a member of the Cardinals this evening; It's his 63rd career start (77th appearance).
- Enters on a three-game win streak, longest active on the Cardinals and T-4th in MLB. Matches his career-long.
- A win tonight would set a new career-high win streak of 4-games.**
- A win tonight would also boost his career winning percentage over .500.
- Has three caught stealing on attempted base stealers, tied with **Jacob deGrom** (TEX) and **Casey Mize** (DET) for the most in MLB among pitchers.
- Signed as a free-agent deal for 2026 with mutual option for 2027, in December. St. Louis becomes his 3rd team, having previously pitched for the Dodgers (2019-25) & Red Sox (2025).
- Is 8-4 with a 3.72 ERA in 18 career April starts; his most wins in any calendar month.
- Is the 27th Cardinal to wear uniform No. 3, but the first Cardinals pitcher to have worn the number: notable former Cardinals to wear #3 are **Édgar Rentería**, Brian Jordan, Carlos Beltrán and most recently Dylan Carlson.

**LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, April 21 at Miami):** W, 5-3; 5.1 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 1 ER, HR, 1 BB, 5 SO, 97 pitches.

- Threw a season-high 97 pitches and struck out a season-high five batters.
- Held his opposition to one earned run for the 3rd straight start; T-3rd longest of his career (4, twice, w/LAD in 2021 & 2023).
- Received a season-high five runs of support

## 2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**KICKING THE BABIP HABIT:** Over half his hits came in his first two starts (17-of-33). Has the lowest Opp BA of any Cardinals starter (.254) since April 10, over his last 3 starts.

**DON'T WALK TO STRANGERS:** Has the lowest walk/batters faced percentage of any Cardinals starting pitcher 4.7% and is in the 92% of all MLB pitchers (34th overall).

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Struck out more batters in each start with three in his Cardinals debut, three starts with four and five in his last start at MIA (4/21).

**BACK-TO-BACK JACK:** Gained a 5-3 win vs. CLE (4/15) as he paired back/back quality starts & wins over BOS & CLE during that homestand.

**MILESTONE WIN:** Bested his former team the Red Sox in the homestand opener (4/10) in a 3-2 win. It was his 1st win as a member of the Cardinals and his 20th career win.

**TIGER STRIKE:** Was hit for a season-high seven runs on seven hits (and struck in leg by line drive) over 3.1 innings in an 11-6 loss at Detroit (4/4) in his second start. First Cardinals pitcher since **Mike Parisi** (2008) to begin a season allowing 6 or more runs in his first two starts of a season; and the first Cardinal to pitch the Opening Day series since **Dizzy Dean** (1936).

**OPENING ACT:** Took the loss in his Cardinals debut at Busch Stadium vs. TB (3/29) allowing six runs over 4.0 inning. Tied his career-high allowing 10 hits, the first Cardinals pitcher to allow double-digit hits in his debut in 55 years since **Chris Zachary** surrendered 10 to the Phillies (5/3/1971) *Elias*. Recorded his 300th career strikeout retiring **Junior Caminero**.

## MAY VS. PITTSBURGH:

- Is making his 2nd career start and appearance vs. Pittsburgh; first as a member of the Cardinals. Faced the Pirates last season with Boston at Fenway Park (8/30/25).
- Pitched 5.1 innings allowing seven runs (6 ER) on eight hits with five strikeouts with a home run (Oneil Cruz) in his 2nd-to-final-start of the season.
- Has yet to pitch at PNC Park and Great American Ballpark, the only two stadiums among fellow N.L. Central opponents he's yet to appear at.

**LAST START VS. PIRATES (August 30, 2025 at Fenway Park):** L, 10-3: 5.1 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 6 ER, HR, 4 BB, 5 SO; 97 pitches.
