## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (74-85) vs. NEW YORK YANKEES (93-66)

SEPTEMBER 27, 2024 AT YANKEE STADIUM, BRONX, NY - 7:05 EDT - GAME #160/ROAD #79

RHP JARED JONES (6-8, 4.14 ERA) vs. LHP CARLOS RODÓN (16-9, 3.98 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:** went 1-2 against the Brewers in their final homestand of the season...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have won eight games when trailing after seven innings (their most since winning nine times in 2019 when trailing after seven frames)...Have played in 51 one-run games, which are the second-most in the National League behind the Brewers (53); it's also the most one-run games for the team since also playing in 51 one-run contests in 2018...Have the best stolen base percentage (85.4 percent) in MLB...Have recorded 12 shutouts this year, which are tied for the sixth-most in the National League.

**NEW YORK STATE OF MIND:** The Pirates will close out the 2024 campaign with this three-game weekend series at Yankee Stadium...This is Pittsburgh's third visit to the new Yankee Stadium (also 2014 and 2022)...The Pirates lost two of three games against the Yankees last season at PNC Park from September 15-17.

**FOR STARTERS:** Jared Jones gets the start tonight in the opener of this weekend series against the Yankees...Pirates starting pitchers have a 3.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio this year...Pittsburgh's starters have never finished a season with a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.00 or better in the modern era.

**THAT'S A FIRST:** The 2024 season marks the first time in club history the Pirates have had a left-handed hitter (Oneil Cruz), a right-handed hitter (Andrew McCutchen) and a switch hitter (Bryan Reynolds) with 20-plus homers in the same season.

**IN GOOD COMPANY:** Bryan Reynolds comes into today leading the Pirates in both hits (168) and RBI (85)...According to StatsPerform, he is looking to become the first switch hitter in MLB to lead his team in both hits and RBI in four consecutive seasons since the Yankees' Mickey Mantle did so from 1956-59.

**DENNIS DEALING:** Dennis Santana needed a total of just five pitches to retire each of the three batters he faced in the eighth inning Wednesday night...Santana has allowed one unearned run in 23.1 innings while recording an .070 batting average against (5-for-71) dating back to his outing on August 8...Since June 18, he has also recorded a 1.11 ERA (40.2ip/5er)...That's the third-lowest ERA among all relievers in MLB among pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched behind A.J. Puk (0.21) and Emmanuel Clase (0.45).

**SOUTHPAW SIGHTING:** The Pirates have been opposed by right-handed starters in each of their last 13 games since facing Miami's Jonathan Bermeuz on September 11...Pittsburgh is 23-23 in games started by opposing lefties this season.

**PIRATING:** Oneil Cruz has been successful in each of his last 20 attempts since being caught for the only time on April 22...The last Pirate to steal at least 20 consecutive bases without being caught in a single season is Nate McLouth (21 straight) from May 2 to September 28, 2008...Pittsburgh's 85.4 percent stolen-base success rate leads MLB...Since 1951, the only seasons in which Pittsburgh led MLB in that category are 1979 and 1997.

**KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES:** Andrew McCutchen comes into today one run shy of tying Arky Vaughan (936) for 10th all time in Pirates history...McCutchen is also two extra base hits shy of 800 in his career.

**SAVING THE DAY:** Aroldis Chapman comes into today first in the National League with seven saves this month...That's his most in a month since he also had seven in May of 2021 while pitching for the Yankees...Chapman ranks 16th all time in saves in MLB history with 333 (Rollie Fingers is 15th with 341)...The only three southpaws in MLB history to record more saves than Chapman since saves became an official stat in 1969 are John Franco (424), Billy Wagner (422) and Randy Myers (347).

September 27, 2013: A.J. Burnett surrendered one run on five hits over 8.0 innings to help the Bucs beat the Reds 4-1 at Great American Ball Park. Marlon Byrd and Pedro Alvarez recorded five of Pittsburgh's six hits on the night. Byrd delivered a two-run bases-loaded single in the third inning while Alvarez added insurance in the sixth with a two-run homer off Reds starter Homer Bailey.

 HOW ACQUIRED: Selected by the Pirates in the 2nd round of the 2020 Draft.

**STARTING OFF:** The 23-year-old righthander is in his first Major League season with the Pirates...Was named to the Opening Day roster after being a non-roster invitee to big league camp...The Whittier, California, native was Pittsburgh's second-round draft selection in 2020 out of La Mirada (CA) High School.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Jones allowed six runs in 5.0 innings and lost a 7-1 decision at Cincinnati on September 21.

**VS. NEW YORK (AL):** Has never faced the Yankees.

**AS A PROSPECT:** Jones entered the 2024 season rated as the team's No. 3 prospect and the No. 74 prospect in all of baseball according to Baseball America.

**THE CENTURY MARK:** Jones amassed 120 strikeouts in his first 20 starts this season... Since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893, the only other three Pirates to reach 100 career strikeouts in fewer than 20 games are Gerrit Cole in 2013 (19), Jose DeLeon in 1983 (13) and Paul Skenes (13).

**A CALL TO ARMS:** Jared Jones comes into today ranked fourth among all National League rookies with 125 strikeouts...Jones and Paul Skenes are the second rookie duo in Pirates history with at least 100 strikeouts...The other was in 1993 when Steve Cooke had 132 strikeouts while Paul Wagner had 114 punchouts.

**BODY OF WORK:** Is making his 22nd career start and appearance...He has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 17 of his 21 starts, as well as two or fewer 11 times and one or fewer five times.

**WHAT A DEBUT:** Jones became the first Pirate since Tim Wakefield in 1992 and the third pitcher in team history to record at least 10 strikeouts in his big league debut on March 30 at Miami...In addition, he became one of just five starting pitchers since 1900 to strike out at least 10 batters in less than 6.0 innings in a big league debut...Prior to Jones, Milwaukee's Freddy Peralta was the last pitcher to record 10-plus strikeouts in a big league debut when he did so on May 13, 2018 (13 punchouts)...Dick Hall struck out 11 batters in his first MLB start, but he made his MLB debut as a third baseman for the Pirates on April 15, 1952.

**GET YOU A MAN THAT CAN DO BOTH:** Was committed to being a two-way player at the University of Texas prior to signing with the Pirates... As a senior in high school, he hit .394 with 32 extra base hits and 59 RBI... Batted .457 (43-for-94) with three home runs and 16 RBI as a junior.

**NO WALK SIGN IS ON:** Jones opened his career with a streak of 21.1 consecutive innings without issuing a walk before issuing his free pass to Blake Perkins in the fifth inning on April 22 vs. Milwaukee...It was the fifth-longest streak by a Major League pitcher within their first five career games since 1971 and the longest since Cleveland's Cody Anderson had a streak of 25.2 consecutive innings without issuing a walk in 2015.

- Through five career starts, he had 39 strikeouts against just four walks, making him the only pitcher since 1893 when the mound to plate distance was set at 60'6", to record 35-plus strikeouts and four or fewer walks in a pitcher's first 5 career MLB games.

**ON DECK:** The 22-year-old Skenes will be making his 23rd start tomorrow...Struck out nine batters in 5.0 innings while earning the win in the team's 2-0 shutout in his last start Sunday at Cincinnati...Has posted the lowest ERA (1.99) in all of MLB since making his debut on 5/11...Has a 1.38 ERA (39.0ip/6er) in his last seven starts since allowing a season-high four runs on 8/10...His 11 wins are the most by a Pirates rookie since Josh Fogg won 12 games in 2002.
