## SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (23-25) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (22-26)

May 21, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #49/HOME #22

RHP LOGAN WEBB (4-4, 3.03 ERA) vs. LHP MARTÍN PÉREZ (1-3, 4.86 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:**...had the day off yesterday...Went 4-3 on their road trip against the Brewers (1-2) and Cubs (3-1)...Have played in 11 games decided by one or two runs in their last 16 contests...Have also played in 17 one-run games overall, which are tied for the second-most in MLB along with the Tigers (the Cubs lead the way with 18)...Have gone 18-3 when scoring at least four runs in a game...Won each of their first four extra inning games before losing for the only time on May 12 against the Cubs...Are 17-1 when leading after eight innings (their only loss came on April 9 against the Tigers)...Rank fifth in the National League and eighth in all of MLB with a .988 fielding percentage this month...Rank third among all National League teams with 21 home runs this month, trailing only the Dodgers (30) and Brewers (23).

**A PROMOTION IS IN ORDER:** The Pirates recalled infielder/outfielder Ji Hwan Bae from Triple-A Indianapolis prior to tonight's game...Right-handed pitcher Ryder Ryan has been optioned to Triple-A...Bae was hitting .379 (22-for-58) with three doubles, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBI, .471 OBP, .569 slugging percentage and 1.040 OPS in 16 games this month prior to being promoted to Pittsburgh...Bae also ranked first in the International League in batting (.367) and OBP (.479) and sixth in OPS (1.030) for the season coming into today.

**TAKING A STAND:** Tonight the Pirates begin a six-game homestand that gets underway against the Giants...The homestand will conclude with three games against the Braves this weekend...Two of Pittsburgh's three games against the Giants at Oracle Park last month were decided in the last at-bat.

**EVEN SPLITS:** Connor Joe is hitting .276 against left-handed pitchers and .282 against righties...He is one of five hitters hitting above .275 against both in 2024 (min. 55 at-bats versus RHP and LHP)...The other players currently doing so are Alec Bohm, Mookie Betts, Ryan McMahon and Shohei Ohtani...Courtesy of StatsPerform.

**ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER:** Martín Pérez gets the start tonight in the opener of this three-game series...Pérez is tied for the National League lead with nine double plays induced this season and leads the Majors with 1.62 double plays per 9.0 innings.

**AGAINST THE GIANTS:** Martín Pérez has an 0.72 WHIP in three career starts against the Giants... It's the fourth-lowest of any pitcher with at least three starts against the Giants in the live-ball era...According to StatsPerform, only John Fulgham (0.61), Trevor Richards (0.63) and Kirk Rueter (0.71) have lower WHIP's against them.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Pittsburgh's starting rotation posted a 1.75 ERA (25.2ip/5er) during the team's four-game series against the Cubs this past weekend...Pittsburgh's starting rotation ranks second among all National League teams in innings pitched (271.1)...The starting rotation's 3.68 ERA also ranks fifth among all National League teams behind the Phillies (2.63), Dodgers (3.24), Cubs (3.32) and Braves (3.51).

**TAKING OFFENSE:** The Pirates had two wins with double-digit hits in their previous series against the Cubs, improving to 13-0 in games with 10-plus hits in 2024 (the only MLB team undefeated in such games)...It's Pittsburgh's longest winning streak in games with 10-plus hits to begin a season since 2012 (also 13)...The last time the Pirates had a longer streak was in 1939 (14)...Specials thanks to StatsPerform.

**THE RENEGADE:** David Bednar has converted each of his last nine save opportunities, which is the third-longest active streak among National League pitchers behind St. Louis' Ryan Helsley (14) and San Diego's Robert Suarez (13)...Since the beginning of last season, Bednar also ranks second in all of MLB with 49 saves, trailing only Emmanuel Clase (58).

**CLOSING IN ON 700:** Bryan Reynolds comes into today one hit shy of 700 in his career...Since the beginning of the 2019 season, Reynolds' 698 hits are the second-most among all switch hitters in MLB behind Jose Ramirez (722).

**GOING THE EXTRA MILE IN MAY:** Oneil Cruz leads all National League hitters with 10 extra base hits this month...Bryan Reynolds is tied for the second-most extra base hits (nine) this month along with Ezequiel Tovar, William Contreras and Pete Alonso...Reynolds is also tied with Alonso for the most doubles (seven) among National League players this month.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER

**JARED JONES:** The 22-year-old righthander will make his 10th start tomorrow night in the middle game of this three-game series against the Giants...Allowed three runs in 6.0 innings, struck out seven batters, and won a 5-4 decision in his last start Thursday night against the Cubs...Has five games of seven-plus strikeouts and no walks allowed in his first nine career starts...That's two more than the previous Major League record by a pitcher to start their career (Stephen Strasburg and Masahiro Tanaka held the previous high of three such games)...Has thrown 5.0-plus innings and allowed three or fewer earned runs in each of his nine career starts, making him the 15th player since 1900 to put up those numbers in each of his first nine career games and the first since Cleveland's Aaron Civale did so in 2019.

**vs. SAN FRANCISCO:** 0-1 in one start earlier this year on 4/28...He allowed three runs (all in the third inning) in 5.0 innings and lost a 3-2 decision on 4/28 at Oracle Park.
