THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 29
2017 - In a Memorial Day matchup in Minnesota, the Astros trailed 8-2 before scoring 11 runs in the 8th inning en route to a 16-8 win over the homestanding Twins...it marks just the fourth 11-run inning in franchise history and the first since the 1994 season...in the inning, the Astros hammer out eight hits, including just one homer, a three-run shot by **DH Carlos Beltrán**...four different Astros record three-plus hits, including Beltrán (4x5), **2B Jose Altuve** (3x5), **SS Carlos Correa** (3x5) and **1B Marwin Gonzalez** (3x5).

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros, who have won six of their last seven games, will open a 10-day, nine-game homestand tonight against the NL Central division leading Brewers...**RHP Kai-Wei Teng** (3-3), a native of Taiwan, will get the start for the Astros tonight on AAPI night at the ballpark...he'll be opposed by rookie **RHP Coleman Crow** (0-0), who's making just his third Major League start.

AAPI NIGHT: The Astros will honor Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) Heritage Night tonight...the celebration will include a private pregame reception in the 42 Room, pregame performance by the Taiwanese Association of America, local community and organizational tabling throughout Hall of Fame Alley, a ceremonial first pitch, and more.

FOR STARTERS: Astros starters have a combined ERA of 3.20 (27ER/76IP) over the last 13 games (since May 15) with a 1.01 WHIP...in that span, they have allowed just 44 hits in 76.0 innings for a Major League-best .169 opponent average, while also ranking first in the AL in WHIP and fifth in ERA... additionally, Astros starters have allowed one-or-fewer runs seven times in the last 13 games.

HOMER HAPPY: The Astros have slugged 16 homers in their last seven games...Houston now ranks second in the AL in homers with 76, trailing only the Yankees (83) in that category.

LAST NIGHT'S WIN: The Astros completed their 10-game road trip last night with a 5-1 victory over the Rangers in Arlington...**RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (1ER/6IP) picked up the win after allowing just three hits and a walk in his 6.0 innings...the Astros did their damage in a three-run 1st inning, as **SS Jeremy Peña** (2x4) hit a leadoff homer and **1B Isaac Paredes** (1x3) hit a two-run shot in the frame.

SPENCER'S GIFTS: **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** has made a strong case for the AL Pitcher of the Month award, going 4-1 record, a 0.93 ERA (3ER/29IP) and a .165 opponent average (16x97) in five starts in May...during the month, he's posted the lowest ERA among AL starters, while ranking tied for first in wins and second in opponent average.

ABOUT THE TRIP: Last night, the Astros completed a 10-game road trip, going 7-3 on their travels through Minnesota (1-2), Chicago-NL (3-0) and Arlington (3-1)...this marked the Astros first road trip with seven-plus wins since they went 10-0 on a trip from June 7-17, 2018.

AIR YORDAN: **DH Yordan Alvarez** had a three-game span from Monday thru Wednesday in Arlington in which he went 6x12 with five homers and eight RBI...some notes on his sizzling run:

- he became the first Astros player with multiple homers in back-back games since **Jose Altuve** turned the trick, Sept. 4 (2 HR) and Sept. 5 (3 HR) at TEX.
- he matched the club record for HR in a three-game span...that record is shared by **Jose Altuve** (2023), **Richard Hidalgo** (2000) and **Glenn Davis** (1990).
- he became the fifth Astros player with multiple homers in consecutive games...the others: **Jose Altuve**, 9/4-5, 2023 at TEX; **Richard Hidalgo**, 9/9-10, 2000 at CHC; **Moises Alou**, 8/13/2000 at PHI, 8/14/2000 vs. PIT; **Doug Rader**, 7/20-21/1973 vs. NYM.

FROM THE TRAINER'S ROOM: The Astros have 12 players on the Major League Injured List...below are updates on a few:

- **RHP Ronel Blanco** (rt. elbow surgery) and **RHP Hayden Wesneski** (rt. elbow surgery) have began live BP progressions in West Palm Beach.
- **RHP Hunter Brown** (rt. shoulder sprain) will make his second rehab start tonight at Triple A Sugar Land...he worked 2.0 scoreless innings on 35 pitches in his first rehab outing on Sunday at Double A Corpus Christi.
- **LHP Josh Hader** (lt. biceps tendinitis) made his ninth rehab app. last night, tossing 22 pitches in 0.2 of an inning at Triple A...Hader also pitched on Wednesday, giving him appearances on back-to-back days.
- **RHP Cristian Javier** (rt. shoulder strain) is scheduled to throw live batting practice today at Daikin Park.
- **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (rt. shoulder inflammation) and **LHP Bennett Sousa** (lt. elbow inflammation) have began throwing progressions.
- **LHP Brandon Walter** (lt. elbow surgery) continues his throwing progression this week in West Palm Beach.
- **2B Jose Altuve** (lt. oblique strain) was in West Palm Beach rehabbing earlier this week...he has rejoined the team in Houston to continue his baseball activity.
- **C Yainer Diaz** (lt. oblique strain) has began baseball activity.
- **OF Joey Loperfido** (rt. quad strain) continued his rehab assignment last night at Triple A Sugar Land, going 0x4 in a start at DH...he also played on Wednesday night at Triple A (1x2, 2 BB).

ON THE LEADER BOARD: **DH Yordan Alvarez** currently leads the Majors in OPS (1.073), SLG (.654) and total bases (134)...in the AL, he ranks first in extra-base hits (31), tied for first in HR (20), second in batting avg. (.307), second in OBP (.419), tied for second in hits (63), fourth in RBI (39), tied for seventh in walks (37), and ninth in runs (37).

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** has four homers and nine RBI in his last five games...for the season, he has been one of the top hitters in the AL, ranking third in the AL in RBI (40), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (25), sixth in HR (15), seventh in SLG (.519) and seventh in total bases (108)...Walker also has not committed an error in his 57 games played.

ABOUT THE NO-NO: The Astros got back in the record books on Monday night at TEX, tossing their 17th regular season no-hitter and their 18th no-hitter overall in club history...a few notes on the no-no:

- prior to Monday, the Astros last no-hitter was thrown by **RHP Ronel Blanco** on April 1, 2024 vs. TOR, which was the first managerial win for **Joe Espada**.
- on Monday, **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (6IP), **LHP Steven Okert** (1IP) and **RHP Alimber Santa** (2IP) produced the fifth combined no-hitter in club history and the first since Nov. 2, 2022 at PHI (World Series, Game 4).
- per Elias, **RHP Alimber Santa** became the first pitcher since 1900 to pitch in a no-hitter in his ML debut...according to their records, it happened one other time, which was on Oct. 15, 1892, when **RHP Bumpus Jones** of Cincinnati hurled a 9.0-inning, complete game no-hitter in his Major League debut.
- Monday's no-hitter was the Astros seventh since 2019, which is the most in the Majors in that span...additionally, the Astros 18 no-hitters overall are the most in the Majors since the franchise was born in 1962.

LAST START, MAY 23 at CHC: Was stellar in 6.0 shutout innings of work vs. the Cubs at Wrigley Field, allowing just 2 hits and 3 walks with 6 strikeouts...threw 89 pitches (56 strikes)...his 6.0 innings pitched marked a career high, beating his last high from Sept. 1, 2025 at COL, when he was a member of the Giants and threw 5.1 innings...marked the 2nd start of his career in which he allowed no runs (also, May 16, 2026 vs. TEX...also posted the first quality start of his career.

ABOUT TENG: An offseason acquisition, Teng has transitioned to the Astros starting rotation after making 13 relief appearances...as a reliever, Teng has impressed with a 1-1 record and a 1.80 ERA (4ER/20IP) in 13 appearances...prior to moving to the rotation, he ranked 9th in innings (20.0), 7th in opponent batting average (.145) and 11th in WHIP (0.85) among AL relievers. (min. 15 IP)...of his 13 relief appearances, 9 were for multiple innings, including 6 appearances of 2.0+ innings.

HARD TO HIT: Has limited opponents to a .188 (24x128) opponent average, including a .152 (10x66) average to right-handed hitters...also owns a 1.05 WHIP.

AS A STARTER: Has made 11 career starts, 4 with the Astros this season and 7 with the Giants in 2025...has posted huge strikeout numbers as a starter, fanning 51 hitters in 41.2 innings pitched for 11.02 strikeouts per 9.0...has 3 career Major League wins as a starter, including his most recent start on May 23 at CHC...a win tonight would give him a 3-game winning streak in three consecutive games, which he has never accomplished before.

VS. MIL: Is facing the Brewers for the first time in his career today...has not faced any of the current Milwaukee hitters.

2025 SEASON: Went 2-4 with a 6.37 ERA (21ER/29.2IP) and 39 strikeouts across 8 games (7 starts) with the Giants...appeared in 26 games (4 starts) with Triple A Sacramento, going 3-2 with a 3.63 ERA, .197 BAA and 89 strikeouts across 57.0 innings.

THE TAIWANESE TENG: The Taiwanese righty was acquired from San Francisco on Jan. 29, 2026 in exchange for catching prospect **Jancel Villarroel**...has appeared in parts of 3 seasons with the Giants (2024-25) and Astros (2026) making 25 career Major League appearances (10 starts)...upon pitching for the Astros this season, he became the 2nd Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in their history, joining **RHP Chia Jen-Lo**, who made 19 relief appearances with the Astros in 2013.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/28 at TEX): Worked a scoreless 9th inning in last night's win at TEX, striking out 2...picked up 1 save and logged 3.0 scoreless innings through 4 appearances over the last road trip, holding opponents to a .111 average (1x9).

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 2-0-2 through 9 consecutive scoreless appearances (8.2 IP), dating back to May 3, also posting a .148 opponent average (4x27) and 1.04 WHIP over that span...prior to this streak, posted a 12.54 ERA (13ER/9.1IP) in his first 11 games of the season...his 9-appearance scoreless streak is the longest active streak (by games) among Astros pitchers...is also tied for the 5th-longest active such streak in the AL.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...ranks 7th all-time in appearances (337) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also among Astros relievers, he ranks 4th all-time in strikeouts (471).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: His 244 career strikeouts at Daikin Park are 3 away from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most by a reliever in the venue's history...reached 179.2 career innings pitched at Daikin Park with his outing on May 16 vs. TEX, surpassing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for 4th-most by a reliever in the venue's history.

VS. MIL: Has tossed 5.0 scoreless innings with 6 strikeouts in 5 career games vs. the Brewers...struck out 3 batters through 2.0 innings in 2 scoreless and hitless appearances vs. the Brewers last season.

CAREER: In 337 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.85 ERA (110ER/347.2IP) with 471 strikeouts, a 1.21 WHIP, a 12.19 K/9 and a 0.75 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
