THE TWINS: Have gone 1-5 through six games on their seven-game, eight-day homestand, going 1-3 against the Tigers last weekend, followed by consecutive losses to the Athletics over the last two nights...today, the Twins will host the A's for the three-game series finale... after the game, the Twins will travel to Chicago to play a three-game weekend series against the White Sox...after that, they will travel to Toronto to play the Blue Jays for three games from Monday-Wednesday.

TWINS DROP GAME 2 TO A'S IN EXTRAS: The Twins lost to the A's last night at Target Field by a score of 4-2 in 10 innings, making them 4-9 in extras this season...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...the Twins bullpen held the A's scoreless, until a two-run homer from Shea Langeliers off Genesis Cabrera in the top of the 10th inning... the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Brooks Lee...Minnesota went 2-for-15 with runners in scoring position and left 12 men on base.

TWINS AND A's: The Twins and A's are playing for the seventh and final time this season...Twins have gone 3-3 this season, going 3-1 in Sacramento from June 2-5 and 0-2 at Target Field.
₱ Twins are 9-4 in their last 13 against the A's, 15-5 in their last 20 and 19-6 in their last 25, dating back to May of 2022.

₱ A win today would secure the season series over the A's for the fourth consecutive season... they went 6-1 in 2024, 5-1 in 2023 and 5-1 in 2022.

₱ Trevor Larnach is hitting, 316 (18-for-57) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, four walks and an 817 OPS in 15 career games against the Athletics.

₱ Royce Lewis has hit safely in 13 of 16 career games against the A's...in those 16, he is hitting .304 (17-for-56) with five doubles, four home runs, seven RBI and a .978 OPS.

UNBE-LEE-VABLE: Brooks Lee has hit safely in seven-straight games, hitting .346 (9-for-26) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, nine RBI, two walks, a .769 slugging percentage and a 1.162 OPS in that span...it is tied for second-longest of his career...his career-high is 19, done earlier this season, from May 28-June 20.

◆ Over his last 12 home games, he is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with three home runs, 16 RBI, a .727 slugging percentage and a 1.097 OPS.

99 PROBLEMS: Byron Buxton enters today with 99 hits on the season, one short of reaching 100 for the second time in his career...he hit 117 in 2017, his single-season career-high...additionally, at 25 home runs. he is three short of his single-season career-high of 28, hit in 2022

♣ He enters today with 499 career runs scored, looking to become the 18th player in Twins history (since 1961) to reach 500 runs scored.

♣ One run scored and he will be the third player in Twins history to reach 500+ runs, 150+ home runs, 100+ stolen bases and 400+ RBI...the others: Kirby Puckett and Torii Hunter.

♣ Buxton is leading off for the 60th time this season...from the leadoff spot, he is hitting .291 (67-for-230) with 19 home runs, a .360 on-base percentage, a .609 slugging percentage and a .969 OPS...his OPS from the number one spot ranks third in baseball, trailing Ronald Acuña Jr. (1.029) and Shohei Ohtani (1.028).

KEA PLAYER: After going 2-for-4 last night with a single, double, a walk and stolen base, Luke Keaschall has now hit safely in 18 of 21 games to start his career...he has raised his on-base percentage to .430, reaching base 37 times (26 hits, 9 walks, 2 hit-by-pitch) in 86 plate appearances...to the right are Iwins all-time OBPs through their first 21 career games.

JAMES, OUT-STANDING: In six career games at Target Field, James Outman has now hit safely in five of those games and has posted a 1.043 OPS in those six...as a Twin, he is 3-for-12 with two doubles and a triple in three games here...as a Dodger in 2024, he was 4-for-11 with two home runs and four RBI in this ballpark.

© Over his last eight games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota (since August 10), he is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with three doubles, two triples, two home runs, eight RBI, a .727 slugging percentage and a 1.116 OPS.

BREAKING BROOMS: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the fifth time this season...the other four were in three games at St. Louis (March 27-30), three games at Atlanta (April 18-20), three games at Houston (June 13-15) and three games vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22).

◆ Other than those four sweeps, the Twins have entered a finale and avoided a sweep seven times this season: April 13 vs. Detroit, June 8 vs. Toronto, June 19 at Cincinnati, July 20 at Colorado, August 3 at Cleveland, August 13 at New York-AL and August 17 vs. Detroit.

◆ The last time the Twins were swept by the A's came April 20-21, 2021 in three games...last time the A's swept the Twins in Minnesota came April 7-10, 2014.

THE PLAYERS HAVE CHANGED, BUT THE GAME IS THE SAME: Over their last seven games, since August 13, the Twins bullpen has posted a 1.91 ERA (33.0 IP, 7 ER) with one home run allowed, 13 walks, 29 strikeouts and a .173 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank fourth in baseball in ERA and opponent batting average.

ST. PAULI BOYS: Right-handed pitcher Pablo López and Simeon Woods Richardson are both scheduled to pitch for Triple-A St. Paul tonight vs. Round Rock at CHS Field...López (right shoulder strain) will be making his first rehab start after being placed on the IL during the Athletics series in early June...Woods Richardson (illness) will be making his second rehab appearance for the Saints.

Pablo is scheduled to throw either three innings or 45 pitches...SWR is expected to pitch about four innings or 65 pitches.

HBD VAZKY!: Christian Vázquez is celebrating his 35th birthday...Vazky is currently on the 10-day Injured List with a left shoulder infection.

TWINS ON A STICK: The Twins yesterday announced details for their presence at the 2025 Minnesota State Fair, with interactive games, giveaways and special appearances all part of the team's daily lineup...the Minnesota Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am-9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration (through Monday, September 1).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2022, the Twins inducted The World Champion, aka The Dazzle Man, aka The Wrench, aka The Cupertino Kid, aka The Radio Stallion, Dan Gladden into the Twins Hall of Fame.

TIGER KING Last appeared as the bulk pitcher on August 15 vs. Detroit, and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 0-7, shutout defeat...allowed two hits, one walk and three strikeouts in 5.2 shutout innings...took over for Pierson Ohl in the third inning, only hits allowed were a single in the sixth to Javier Báez and a single to Wenceel Pérez in the seventh.

THE ROYAL TREATMENT: Started on August 10 vs. Kansas City, opposite Ryan Bergert, but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-3, 11-inning, walk-off victory...allowed one run on three hits, with a season-high four walks and one strikeout in 3.0 innings...only run allowed came on an RBI single to Adam Frazier in the first, scoring Mike Yastrzemski.

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE, MAN: After signing a one-year minor league contract with the New York Mets in February, Ureña is pitching for his fourth different organization already...after starting the year on the development list for Triple-A Syracuse, Ureña was activated to Syracuse's roster before making three appearances in the International League before a big league call-up...he would pitch in just one game for New York before being designated for assignment...because of his over eight In just one game for New York before being designated for assignment...because of his over eight years of MLB service time, he elected free agency rather than accept an assignment to Triple-A and has bounced around between the Blue Jays and Dodgers since, each time being DFA'd and electing free agency to sign with another club...over the past four seasons (2022-25), Ureña has been DFA'd or released a combined six times and pitched for nine different organizations (7 of them in the majors)...over his 17-year professional career, he's pitched for nine different MLB franchises and pitched for 33 different clubs between the major leagues, minor leagues and winter ball teams following his first appearance as a St. Paul Saint following his first appearance as a St. Paul Saint.

STRAIGHT-A'S: Ureña is facing the Athletics for the ninth time in his career...has two starts in 2017 with Miami, two appearances (1 start) in 2021 with Detroit, three appearances (1 start) in 2024 with Texas and one appearance in 2025 with Toronto...has gone 3-1, posting a 3.74 ERA (33.2 IP, 14 ER) with nine walks, 23 strikeouts and a .252 (34-for-135) opponent batting average.

© Last appeared against the Athletics on May 29 with the Blue Jays at Rogers Centre where he did not factor into the decision of Toronto's 12-0, shutout victory...allowed one hit with two strikeouts in 2.0 shutout innings of relief

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Ureña has gone 16-46 with a 4.56 ERA (507.1 IP, 257 ER), 6.05 K/9, 3.19 BB/9 and 1.22 HR/9 in 122 games (80 starts) at home compared to 28-31 with a 4.94 ERA (472.0 IP, 259 ER), 5.93 K/9, 3.53 BB/9 and 1.26 HR/9 in 122 road games (76 starts).

◆ He is 0-0 in seven games (1 start) at home so far this season with a 2.16 ERA (16.2 IP, 4 ER), seven walks and nine strikeouts; compared to 0-0-1 with a 6.28 ERA (14.1, 10 ER), four walks and eight strikeouts in five games (3 starts) on the road.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through 12 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .242/.315/.485 in 66 at-bats vs. Ureña, while righties have slashed .315/.356/.463 in 54 at-bats... lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 89.9 mph and a whiff rate of 17.9; compared to righties' 87.3 mph and 17.9 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ureña has used a four-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...he primarily uses his sinker and changeup against left-handed batters while favoring his slider and 4-seamer against right-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown through nine major league games so far:
