TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to even the series on this final City Connect Tuesday after dropping yesterday's opener 6-5 to the Cardinals.

- ▶ Last night's game marked the Giants' 55th one-run game of the season, second-most such games in the Majors behind Pittsburgh (58)...it was also SF's 29th one-run loss of the season, fourth-most such losses in the Majors.
- ▶ Prior to the break, the Giants were 22-17 (.564) in one-run games...since the break, SF is 4-12 (.250) in such games.
- ▶ The Giants went 2-for-3 with runners in scoring position yesterday and have been hitting .351 (61x174) with a .973 OPS with RISP since August 29 (23g), both of which are best in the Majors over that span.

LOGAN'S WEBB: RHP Logan Webb is set to take the mound for his 33rd start of the season and eighth career start vs. the Cardinals...he is 3-3 with a 5.30 ERA (22er, 37.1ip), a 1.55 WHIP and .309 opponent average in seven career starts vs. St. Louis...his 5.30 career ERA vs. the Cardinals is his highest against any of the 16 clubs he's faced at least four times in his career.

- ▶ At 195.2 innings pitched this year, Webb looks to become the first Giants pitcher to record three consecutive seasons of 200+ innings pitched since **LHP Madison Bumgarner** did so in six straight seasons from 2011-2016.
- ▶ Over his last 10 starts since July 30, Webb has posted a 3.00 ERA (20er, 60.0ip) with a 1.25 WHIP and 67 strikeouts.
- ▶ Webb leads the National League with 195.2 innings and 211 strikeouts, and ranks ninth with a 3.27 ERA and third with a 2.71 FIP.
- ▶ Webb has relied most heavily on his sinker this season, throwing it 33.9% of the time, with opponents hitting .281 off the pitch...however, opponents have posted a .375 (9x24) average against the pitch this month, his highest mark of any month since June of 2022 (S/S)...the Cardinals' .694 OPS off the sinker this season is lowest in MLB.

RAMOS ON A ROLL: OF Heliot Ramos hit his fifth career leadoff home run in yesterday's game...his five leadoff homers are the most by a Giant in a single season since **LaMonte Wade Jr.** also had five in 2023.

- ▶ Ramos became one of two players in Giants franchise history to have five or more leadoff home runs in a single season as a right-handed batter, joining **Bobby Bonds** who did so three times (11, 1973; 5, 1969; 5, 1970).
- ▶ Ramos also logged his 40th multi-hit games on the year...the last Giant to record 40 multi-hit games in a season was **Buster Posey** in 2017 (47), and the last Giants outfielder to do so was **Denard Span** in 2016 (46) (Stats, LLC).

ARM BARN: The Giants bullpen combined for another 4.2 scoreless innings last night, marking the staff's 63rd shutout appearance of the season, fifth-most such appearances in the Majors (fourth in the NL).

- ▶ SF's 3.46 bullpen ERA this season ranks second-lowest in the Majors behind SD (3.05).

VS. PALLANTE: The Giants will face RHP Andre Pallante for the second time this season...Pallante allowed two runs on five hits across 6.0 innings in STL's 3-2 win over San Francisco on September 6 in St. Louis.

- ▶ Among Giants with a history against Pallante, **IF Matt Chapman** is 6-for-10 with three doubles, **IF Willy Adames** is 3-for-9 with a homer, **IF Rafael Devers** is 2-for-8 with a homer, **OF Heliot Ramos** is 2-for-6 with a homer and **C Patrick Bailey** is 3-for-7.

I CAN GET USED TO THIS: In his 85th game with SF, **IF Rafael Devers** hit his 18th home run as a Giant last night (33 total homers this season).

- ▶ He became one of seven Giants in the SF era (since 1958) to have 18 home runs through their first 85 games as a Giant, joining **Mike Yastrzemski** (18, 2019), **Jeff Kent** (19, 1997), **Barry Bonds** (24, 1993), **Kevin Mitchell** (18, 1987-88), **Willie McCovey** (22, 1959-60) and **Orlando Cepeda** (19, 1958).
- ▶ Since joining the Giants on June 17, he's produced the fifth-highest hard-hit rate in MLB (56%)...he is hitting .504 on hard-hit balls this season (S/S).
- ▶ His 108 walks this season are third-most in MLB behind NYM's Juan Soto (123) and NYY's Aaron Judge (117)...his 52 walks with SF are most by a Giant through their first 85 games with the franchise since **José Cruz** had 57 walks through 85 games in 2003.

WEBBMASTER: Webb is in his seventh season with San Francisco...he finished last season with an NL-leading 204.2 innings...he was named an All-Star for the second time in his career (also 2024) this season, pitching a scoreless 3rd inning of relief.

MR. 200: Already with 211 strikeouts, and sitting at 195.2 innings this season, Webb needs to pitch at least 4.1 innings tonight to join the 200/200 club...he would be the first Giants pitcher to record 200.0 innings and 200 strikeouts in the same season since **Madison Bumgarner** (207.2ip, 203 strikeouts) did so in 2019...he would be the first Giants right-hander to accomplish the feat since **Jeff Samardzija** (207.2ip, 205 strikeouts) in 2017...he would also be the first Giants pitcher to reach 200.0 innings in three straight seasons since Bumgarner did so in six straight seasons from 2011-2016.

LAST TIME OUT: Had a strong bounceback performance vs. the Dodgers despite receiving the loss...allowed two runs (one earned) on four hits and a walk while striking out five across 7.0 innings at LAD on September 18.

VS. ST. LOUIS: This will be Webb's lone start of the season vs. the Cardinals...Webb is 3-3 with a 5.30 ERA (22er, 37.1ip), 33 strikeouts and a 1.55 WHIP in seven career starts vs. the Cardinals...in two career starts vs. STL at Oracle Park (last in 2023), Webb is 1-1 with a 4.63 ERA (6er, 11.2ip) and 14 strikeouts.

WHEN YOU'RE 15: Webb is one win shy of tying his career-high for wins (15) set in 2022...the only other Giants since 2000 with multiple 15-win seasons are **Madison Bumgarner** (four), **Tim Lincecum** (three) and **Jason Schmidt** (two).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: The righty is 7-4 with a 3.18 ERA (37er, 104.2ip) and 113 strikeouts at Oracle Park (17 starts)...in 15 road starts, Webb is 7-7 with a 3.36 ERA (34er, 91.0ip) and 98 strikeouts.

HELPING THE CATCHER: Webb has drastically improved his ability to keep runners in check this season and limit stolen bases...he has +6 Net Bases Prevented (a sum of advanced prevented and outs added assigned to the pitcher), which is tied for 11th-best in the Majors on *Baseball Savant*...he had scores of -5 in 2024, -9 in 2023 and -4 in 2022, -1 in 2021 and -3 in 2020...from 2020-2024, Webb allowed an average of 14 stolen bases off him per season (72 in five seasons)...this season, Webb has allowed a total of eight stolen bases.

SINK OR SWIM: His sinker has a +11 run value on *Baseball Savant*, making it his most valuable pitch...after throwing the pitch just eight times on September 13 vs. LAD, Webb used the pitch 32 times on September 18, holding the Dodgers to an 0-for-5 mark...the Cardinals have a .694 OPS vs. sinkers this season, which is the lowest mark in the Majors.

4S UP: Over Webb's last 10 starts, opponents are 2-for-16 (.125) with 10 strikeouts and just one extra-base hit (a double) vs. his four-seam fastball...overall, opponents are batting .164 (10x61) with a .128 xBA and a .200 xSLG vs. his 4SFB.

SWEEP IT: Webb has thrown his sweeper at least 35 times in each of his last three starts...the pitch has a -4 run value per *Baseball Savant*, a -7 drop-off from 2024...even so, there has been just one extra-base hit (a double) off Webb's sweeper over his last seven starts (193 pitches)...batters are 11-for-41 (.268) with 13 strikeouts off his sweeper over that span.
