REMAINING SPRING SLATE: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their final week of Grapefruit League play and 29th Spring Training in Jupiter (1998-2026) as they celebrate the first day of Spring and travel to Port St. Lucie to face the New York Mets today, the 26th of 28 scheduled Grapefruit League games for the Redbirds.

• The Cardinals fly to Springfield, Mo. on Monday to play an exhibition with the Double-A Cardinals at Hammons Field ... First pitch is 6:05 p.m. CT.

• In six days, the Cardinals open their 135th season of play in the National League by hosting the Tampa Bay Rays on Thursday, March 26, the earliest Opening Day in franchise history ... St. Louis played on March 27 last season vs. Minnesota, a 5-3 Redbirds winner at Busch Stadium.

SPRING BREAKOUT: The top Cardinals prospects came from behind to beat the Nationals top young talent, 9-8, yesterday at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium as part of MLB's third annual Spring Breakout showcase.

• RF **Joshua Baéz**, and LF **Ryan Mitchell** each homered, while 2B **JJ Wetherholt** was 2-3 with a walk a pair of runs scored.

• RHP **Tanner Franklin** (win) and RHP **Yhoiker Fajardo** (save) both struck out three over 3.0 innings pitched.

• St. Louis prospects were managed by **Jason Isringhausen**, with Guest Coaches **Adam Wainwright** and **Yadier Molina** on hand in the dugout.

MARCH MADNESS: St. Louis is 8-10 all-time in March games during the regular season (3-3 at Busch Stadium III) ... 18 different Cardinals have homered in the month of March, led by five bombs by **Paul Goldschmidt** ... The four current Cardinals with March home runs are **Lars Nootbaar** (2), **Nolan Gorman** (1), **Victor Scott II** (1), and **Pedro Pagés** (1).

• The Cardinals are 0-2 all-time against the Mets in the month of March, dropping the first two games of the 2018 season at Citi Field.

LIBERATORE TO START OPENING DAY: Manager **Oli Marmol** recently named LHP **Matthew Liberatore** as the Cardinals Opening Day starter vs. Tampa Bay on March 26 at Busch Stadium.

• The 26-year-old makes his first career Opening Day start, becoming the first Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** on April 5, 1999 vs. Milwaukee, the same year Libby was born.

• The last Cardinals Opening Day lefty starter to be credited with a win was **John Tudor** in a 9-3 win over the Cubs on April 7, 1987 at Wrigley Field.

• Libby will be facing his drafting team the Tampa Bay Rays (1st round, 2018) for the 3rd time in his career and for the 2nd time at Busch Stadium. The southpaw pitched arguably his finest career outing against the Rays at Tropicana Field (Aug. 10, 2023) firing a career-high 8.0 scoreless IP of two-hit ball with a season-high seven strikeouts in a 5-2 win.

• The rest of the Cardinals season-opening rotation is projected to include RHP **Dustin May**, RHP **Kyle Leahy**, RHP **Michael McGreevy**, and RHP **Andre Pallante**.

BIRDS ONE OF THE BEST IN ABS: According to *Baseball Savant*, the Cardinals are an MLB-best 73% (24-9) in successful overruns as a fielding team in MLB's Automated Ball-Strike (ABS) Challenge System this Spring.

• Catcher **Pedro Pagés** is a perfect 8-0 in challenges, best of any backstop with 6+ challenge opportunities.

• Overall as a challenging batting team this Spring, St. Louis is 11-11 (50%), tied for 6th-best in MLB.

FEELING A DRAFT: The Cardinals own six of the top 86 picks (13, 32, 50, 68, 72, 86) in the upcoming 2026 MLB Draft, the most of any Major League team ... Since the DeWitt ownership group (1996-present), 2026 will be only the third time St. Louis has possessed as many as six of the top 86 selections, following 2005 (6 of top 78) and 2012 (6 of top 86).

RED JACKETS: 12 Cardinals Hall of Famers scheduled to be present on 2026 Opening Day at Busch Stadium include **Ozzie Smith**, **Tony La Russa**, **Ray Lankford**, **Ted Simmons**, **Vince Coleman**, **Scott Rolen**, **John Tudor**, **Jason Isringhausen**, **Willie McGee**, **Mark McGwire**, **Al Hrabosky**, and **Édgar Rentería**.

TODAY'S PITCHERS

#32 MATTHEW LIBERATORE · LHP · 6-5 · 220 LBS · AGE 26

- Announced as the Cardinals 2026 Opening Day starter vs. Tampa Bay.
- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher Sandy Koufax, whom he grew up admiring.
- Made his Major League debut at Pittsburgh on May 21, 2022 at PNC Park, a day after childhood friend and Cardinals teammate Nolan Gorman did so at PNC Park.
- Made full-time transition to the starting rotation in 2025 and set single-season career highs in nearly every category.
- His 29 starts in 2025 were the most by a St. Louis southpaw since Jaime García (32 in 2011), and the most by any Cardinals left-hander age 25 or younger since the same 24-year-old García in 2011.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP Tink Hence.
- Is a career 13-21 with a 4.87 ERA (253.0 IP) in his 53 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.

#66 SCOTT BLEWETT · RHP · 6-6 · 245 LBS · AGE 29

- Originally a 2nd round draft pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 out of Baker High School in Baldwinsville, N.Y.
- Signed by the Cardinals as a minor league free agent with an invitation to 2026 Major League Spring Training.
- Has been signed as a minor league free agent by the White Sox (2022), Braves (2023) and Twins (2024). Was traded twice from the Braves to Orioles and back to the Braves six weeks later.
- Played the second half of the 2023 season with the Uni-President 7-Eleven Lions with the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Pitched in 43 career Major League games posting a 4-1 record with a 4.21 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 72.2 innings.
- Made his Major League debut with the Kansas City Royals against the Milwaukee Brewers, Sept. 18, 2020.

#47 JUSTIN BRUIHL · LHP · 6-0 · 215 LBS · AGE 28

- Acquired by the Cardinals from the Guardians for cash considerations, January 6, 2026.
- Former non-drafted free agent looking to appear in games with fifth Major League club, previously appearing in 94 total games with the Dodgers (65), Blue Jays (15), Rockies (7) and Pirates (7). Signed as a free agent with the Reds in 2024, but did not pitch in a Major League game.
- Pitched in 15 games in relief for the American League Champion Blue Jays.
- Appeared in four career postseason games, three with the Dodgers in the 2021 National League Championship Series and one with the Blue Jays vs. NYY in the 2025 American League Division Series. Did not allow a run in his three appearances vs. ATL with one hit and five strikeouts.
- Played college baseball at California Polytechnic State University at San Luis Obispo (Cal Poly-SLO), the same college that produced Cardinals Hall of Fame shortstop Ozzie Smith and former Cardinals relief pitcher Bud Norris.
