Elvis Pequero notched the first save of his Major League career yesterday in Cleveland.....Peguero is one of five pitchers to earn at least 1 save for the Brewers this season, joining Matt Bush [1], Joel Pavamps [1], Bryse Wilson (3) and Devin Williams (13).

# Rebel Yeli

Since June 6. Christian Velich has hit .338 (22-for-65) with 2 HR and 9 RBI in 17 games while he has produced a .419 OBP/.585 SLG/1.004 OPS.

# Take Me To Your Leader

Christian Yelich is the team leader in runs (52 - T8th in NL), hits (74), walks (37), SB (17 - T5th in NL), doubles (15), total bases (118), extra-base hits (25). OBP (.363), SLG (.431) and OPS (.794) and tied for the team lead in RBI (34).

Rookie Blake Perkins is batting .375 (12-for-32) with 2 HR and 10 RBI in 15 games since he was recalled on June 3 from Triple-A Nashville....he hit just .083 (1-for-12, Ohr, Orbi) in his first stint with the team (4/19-4/30).

# It's Milner Time!

Hoby Milner is unscored upon in each of his last 14 appearances (11.2ip) to lower his ERA from 4.50 to 2.73.

# Four Goodness Sake!

The Brewers are a Major League-best 36-6 (.857) when scoring 4+ runs.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell - the longest-tenured active manager in the National League and third in the majors - is in his ninth season as Brewers manager (655-592) and eighth full season.....he has the most wins (655) and games managed (1,247) of any manager in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through the 2023 season.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (3rd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (2nd season), bulloen coach **Jim Henderson** (2nd season), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (5th season), third base coach Jason Lane (8th season, 3rd as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (4th season), bench coach Pat Murphy (8th season) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (2nd season) all returned from the 2022 staff.....Néstor Corredor, who was bullpen catcher (2021-22), is now a coach.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 16 replay challenges this season, going 7-9.....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/25 at Cleveland as an out call at first base on a pickoff attempt of Blake Perkins stood.

#### TONIGHT'S STARTER: #48 - RHP COLIN REA [13a, 12as, 3-4, 4.88]

REA AT A GLANCE: Colin Rea, 32, will be making his 14th appearance and 13th start of the season.....Rea last started last Tuesday vs. Arizona and received no decision in the Brewers' 7-5 win [5.1ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 1bb, 2k, 1hr, 74 pitches].....the team is 7-5 in his starts.....he has 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .243 [57-for-235, 10hr].....he has also made 2 starts at Triple-A Nashville this season, going 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA [7ip, 6h, 2r, 0er, 0bb, 9k].....after pitching in Japan in 2022, Rea re-signed with Milwaukee on January 27 [non-roster invitee]....his only outing for the Brewers prior to this season came in relief on 10/2/21 at Los Angeles-NL.....his name is pronounced "RAY."

LAST SEASON: Rea pitched in Japan, where he went 5-6 with a 3.96 ERA in 23 games/16 starts with the Fukuoka SoftBank Hawks.

CAREER: Is 11-12 with a 4.89 ERA in 49 games/39 starts (217ip, 118er).....has pitched for San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Chicago-NL (2020) and Milwaukee (2021, '23)..... is 10-12 with a 4.89 ERA as a starter (200.2ip, 109er) and 1-0 with a 4.96 ERA as a reliever (16.1ip, 9er).....Rea was originally selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana State University.....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 11/11/16, causing him to miss the entire 2017 season.....he was named 2019 Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Year after going 14-4 with a 3.95 ERA in 26 starts at Triple-A lowa (Cubs).

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-2 with a 4.75 ERA in 8 games/7 starts, all coming this season (36ip, 19er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 4-6 with a 5.26 ERA in 21 games/14 starts (87.1ip, 51er)....is 1-2 with a 5.06 ERA in 5 starts this season (26.2ip, 15er).

CAREER vs. METS: His only outing against the Metropolitans came in a start with the Padres on 5/5/16 at Petco Park.....he earned a 5-3 win (8ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr).

# BREWERS ON THE MOUND

#### TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP JULIO TEHERAN (6qs, 2-2, 1.53)

RHP Julio Teheran will be making his seventh start of the season.....Teheran last started last Wednesday vs. Arizona and received no decision in the Brewers' 5-1 loss (5ip, 2h, 0r, 4bb, 3k, 1hbp, 88 pitches).....the team is 2-4 in his starts.....he has 4 quality starts.....opponents are batting .192 (23-for-120, 3hr).....the team has scored 11 runs in his 6 starts (1.8 rpg).....he signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on May 25 after opting out of his contract with San Diego on May 22.....prior to his Brewers debut, he had not pitched in the majors since April 2021.....Teheran has gone 10-9 with a 2.98 ERA in 29 career games/28 starts against the Mets (169.1ip, 56er), including 6-3 with a 2.40 ERA in 14 starts at Citi Field (82.1ip, 22er).
