RAY REPORT-The Rays continue a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Mets (3-

stretch from June 3 (G2)-June 9, 2023...the Rays have won back-to-back games by 4+ stretch from June 3 (G2)-June 9, 2023...the Rays have won back-

Tampa Bay is above the .500 mark for the first time since April 21st (12-11).
The Rays have won six straight home games, their longest stretch at Tropicana Field since winning a franchise-best 14 straight home games to open the 2023 eason (March 30-Aprith ...it is tied with Los Angeles-NL for the second-longest active home winning streak in the majors behind Philadelphia (11G).
(last: 3G, April 22-24) the Rays homered in each of their first six games this season Rays batters struck out three times on Monday and four times last night it marks he first time they have had four or fewer strikeouts in consecutive games since une 2-3, 2022...the last time they had 4 SO or fewer in three straight was June 20$23,2014(4 \mathrm{G}) . .$. Rays hitters have 18 walks and 18 strikeouts in the last three games. Rays pitching has turned in a 1.50 ERA (18.0IP, 3ER) this series, including 7.0 scoreless frames from the bullpen.
The Rays have committed multiple errors in three straight games for the first time since July 27-29, 2020 (3G) ...their 17 errors since April 16 lead the majors.

WHAT'S AT STAKE-With a win tonight, the Rays would:
Secure back-to-back series sweeps for the first time since sweeping Detroit (3G), Nashington (3G), Oakland (3G) and Boston (4G) in order to open the 2023 season. Sweep Chicago at home for the second straight season (3G, April 21-23, 2023) and earn a season series split after being swept at Guaranteed Rate Field from April 26-28. Improve to a season-high-tying two games over .500 (also 12-10 on April 20).
RELIEF RENAISSANCE-The Rays bullpen has pitched to a 0.81 ERA (21.1IP, 2ER) while limiting opponents to a 120 ( 9 -for-75) average over the last five games...since April 16, the Rays 'pen ranks among MLB in opp. average (2nd, 180), hits/9.0IP (3rd, 5.88), opp. OBP (3rd, 282), WHP (3rd, 1.06), opp. SLG (4th, .297), opp. OPS (4th, .579) and ERA (6th, 3.00) RHP Kevin Kelly has recorded six scoreless appearances (8.0IP) since being recalled from Triple-A Durham on April 22...Kelly has retired 22 of 24 BF since plunking DET Mark Canha on April 22.
HP Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed an ER in his last 11 outings, yielding only three hits in that span (3-for-30/.100)...he has struck out 1+ batter in a career-best RHP Jason Adam awnces
RHP Jason Adam owns a 0.71 ERA (12.2IP, 1ER) in his last 12 appearances...RHP Phil Maton has turned in a 1.17 ERA (7.2IP, 1ER) in his previous nine outings.
Overall, Tampa Bay relievers have not allowed a HR in a season-high four straight games...the Rays bullpen has allowed 8 HR in 20 games since April 16 after permitting an MLB-high 14 HR in 17 games to open the season.

ON THE OFFENSIVE-During the Rays current five-game winning streak, they are slashing .303/.402/.479 (50-for-165) with $102 \mathrm{~B}, 23 \mathrm{~B}$ and 5 HR...they have plated 33 runs during this stretch ( $6.6 \mathrm{R} / \mathrm{G}$ ) after tallying 13 runs in their previous five games from April 27-May 1 (2.6 R/G).

Harold Ramírez is batting . 378 (14-for-37) with 2 2B, 3 RBI, 6 R and 2 SB in 11 games since April 23...he recorded career-high-tying four hits on May 6 (also Aug. 19, 2023 at LAA).
Richie Palacios has an eight-game on-base streak, batting . 333 (9-for-27) with 12 B , $1 \mathrm{HR}, 8 \mathrm{BB}$ and 4 SB during the run...he is one game shy of matching his career long nine-game on-base streak from Sept. 24, 2023-March 29, 2024.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE-Tampa Bay has drawn 4+ walks in six straight games, its longest such streak since June 20-26, 2021 (6G)...the last time the Rays drew 4+ walks in seven consecutive games was May 23-30, 2021

Tampa Bay has 32 BB overall during this stretch, their most in a six-game period since July 4-9, 2022 (32BB).
Randy Arozarena has drawn 10 walks in his last 11 games since April 26, tied with SF LaMonte Wade Jr. for the third-most free passes in the majors during that time behind PHI Bryce Harper (13BB) and OAK JJ Bleday (11BB).

NO JOSHING AROUND-Josh Lowe has hit safely in a career-best 13 straight games dating back to Sept. 15, 2023, batting .377 (20-for-53) with 7 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI and 3 SB... it is the longest active streak in the AL and second longest in MLB behind CIN Noelvi Marte's 16-game run

DELUCA'S DOMINANCE-In five games since making his Tampa Bay debut on May 3 , Jonny DeLuca is 7-for-18 (.389) with 1 2B, a walk-off 3B (May 5 vs. NYM), 1 HR, 10 RBI and 2 SB he has recorded an extra-base hit in a career-long three straight games...he also has multiple hits in a career-best three straight games.

His streak of three straight games with at least 1 XBH is tied for the longest run by a Ray this season...Randy Arozarena is currently in the midst of a three-game XBH streak...the others to accomplish the feat are José Caballero (April 20-22) and Isaac Paredes (April 22-24)

IROP TALK-Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 18 straight home games, the third longest active streak in the AL behind LAA Mike Trout ( 21 G ) and LAA Luis Rengifo (19G)...the last Ray with a longer streak was Yandy Diaz (21G) from May 2-June 25, 2023 Paredes has reached base safely in his last eight games overall, batting. 414 (12-for 29) with 2 HR...he has drawn six walks during the streak with only 2 SO.

SOUTH SIDERS IN ST. PETE-The Rays and White Sox conclude a six-game season series tonight at Tropicana Field...Chicago swept a three-game set at Guaranteed Rate Field from April 26-28, earning its first sweep over Tampa Bay since Aug. 3-5, 2018.

The Rays are 9-3 vs. the White Sox at Tropicana Field since July 21, 2019, outscoring Chicago, 68-39 (+29), during that time...prior to the 12-game stretch, the White Sox won five straight games in St. Pete from Aug. 3, 2018-July 20, 2019
Isaac Paredes has multiple hits in six of his last nine games vs. Chicago dating to
April 28, 2023, batting .366 (15-for-41) with $42 \mathrm{~B}, 3$ HR and 9 RBI.
REHAB UPDATES-Pete Fairbanks and Brandon Lowe both began rehab assignments yesterday with Triple-A Durham...Fairbanks threw a scoreless 8th inning, scattering wo hits with no walks and one strikeout...he threw 16 pitches ( 10 strikes)...Lowe went 1 -for-2 with one double and one walk while playing 5.0 innings at second base.

Making his eighth rehab appearance with Durham, DH Jonathan Aranda went 4-for-5 with one double, 1 RBI, one walk and two runs... he entered play yesterday batting 077 ( 2 -for-26) with 14 SO.

TONIGHT'SSTART-Civale will take the mound for his eighth start of the season, including his fifth at home, in tonight's series finale... has gone 0-1 with an 11.85 ERA (13.2IP, 18ER) in his last three starts after pitching to a 2-1 mark and 2.74 ERA (23.0IP, 7ER) in his first four...is seeking his first win since April 9 at LAA....has gone $4-5$ with a 5.71 ERA (82.0IP, 52ER) in 17 starts since the Rays acquired him from the Guardians on July 31, 2023.
LAST TIME OUT-He was tagged for a season-high 7 ER, but did not factor into the decision of the Rays 10-8 win over the Mets on May 3 (4.1IP, 6H, 7ER, BB, 5SO, HR)...recorded a trio of 3-up, 3-down innings (1st, 3rd, 4th)...permitted 3 straight hits in the 2nd frame, capped by a Brett Baty 3-run HR....retired seven straight following the homer, but yielded a Starling Marte sac-fly before Francisco Lindor chased him with a tworun double...marked his most ER allowed since Sept. 23,2021 vs. CWS (7).

CIV AND THE SOX-This marks Civale's first career start opposite the White Sox at Tropicana Field...in five home starts against Chicago a Progressive Field during his stint with the Guardians, he went 3-1 with a 6.41 ERA (19.2IP, 14ER)...his 11 career starts against Chicago are tied with Detroit for his most against any opponent

He is 17-9 with a 3.43 ERA (230.2IP, 88ER) in 41 career starts against AL Central opponents, his lowest mark vs. any division...however he owns a 7.41 ERA (13.2IP, 11ER) in three starts against AL Central clubs since joining the Rays last August.
Civale has a career 3.43 ERA vs. the AL Central (41GS) while posting a 4.61 ERA (281.1IP, 144ER) against all other opponents (45GS).

ROUGH WATERS-Civale has allowed 5+ ER in three straight starts for the first time in his career...his 11.85 ERA (13.2IP, 18ER) since the streak began on April 21 is the highest in the AL (min. 10.0IP), lower than only NYM Adrian Houser (12.15) in all of MLB.

He has failed to reach the 5.0-inning mark in three consecutive starts for the third time in his career, including the first instance since a career-long four-start streak from April 11-29, 2022.. excluding openers, it marks the longest single-season streak by Rays starter since Josh Fleming (3GS) from April 14-Oct. 5, 2022. In his career, he owns a 4.84 ERA (154.1IP, 83ER) in 27 starts from March thru April compared to a 3.75 ERA (357.2IP, 149ER) in 66 starts from June 1 on.

CRUISING, THEN BRUISING-From innings 1-3, Civale has posted a 3.00 ERA (21.0IP, 7ER) and a . 222 (18-for-81) opp. average...from the 4th inning on, he owns a 10.34 ERA (15.2IP, 18ER) with a 313 (21-for-67) opp. average.. he has allowed a combined 15 runs in the 4th and 5th innings compared to eight tallies in all other frames.

He has struggled to escape innings, allowing a . 308 (16-for-52) opp. average with two outs... 14 of the 22 RBI recorded against him have come with two outs, including 4 of the 7 HR.

BIT BY THE LONG BALL-Civale's 7 HR allowed are tied for sixth most in the AL, two shy of co-leaders CLE Logan Allen and DET Kenta Maeda (both 9HR)...he has yielded at least 1 HR in six of his seven starts this season and 12 of his last 14 dating back to Aug. 23, 2023 vs. COL...entering that stretch, he had permitted just 1 HR in his previous 10 starts from June 25-Aug. 16, 2023

Half (13) of the 26 runs he has allowed this season have come on the 7 HR against him.

3 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER-For his career, Civale is 31-1 with a 3.38 ERA (311.2IP, 117ER) in games when he receives three or more runs of support.. he has a 2-27 record with a 5.17 ERA (200.1IP, 115ER) in games receiving two or fewer runs of support.
