# San Francisco Giants (16-21) at Colorado Rockies (8-27) RHP Jordan Hicks (2-1, 1.89) vs. RHP Peter Lambert (2-1, 5.66)

TODAY'S GAME: Following a win to snap a four-game losing streak yesterday, the Giants will look to secure a series win with a victory tonight in the second game of this three-game series in Colorado.

- SF is 2-6 through the first eight games of its longest road trip of the season after going 1-2 in Boston, 0-4 in Philly and 1-0 so far here in Denver.

ROSTER MOVES: OF Heliot Ramos was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento today...OF Jorge Soler was placed on the 10-day IL (retro to May 5) with a right shoulder strain.

TIP OF THE CAP: Last night, LHP Kyle Harrison became the sixth Giant to throw at least 7.0 shutout innings at Coors Field. with his 7.0 inning, shutout performance last night...the others are listed below... of the six, Harrison was the secondyoungest to do it behind a 22 year, 198-day-old Matt Cain.

MORE ON LAST NIGHT: SF also improved to 6-2 in LHP Kyle Harrison's starts this season, now having won each of his last five starts dating to April 15 at Miami...Harrison has a 2.25 ERA (7er, 28.0ip) in that time.

- Furthermore, each of Harrison's eight starts this year have followed a Giants loss so he's also played the role of stopper this year with the Giants winning six of his eight outings.
- Last night's win was SF's fourth win here at Coors all-time where they allowed no runs and held the Rockies to four or fewer hits...the other three times were the Barry Zito game mentioned above (April 9, 2012), August 3, 2010 (10-0 win with three hits allowed) and the Jason Schmidt game above (July 17, 2004)

YEAH HAR, WE'REIN THE ROCKIES: Since 2021, the Giants are $19-8$ vs. the Rockies at Coors Field with a +56 run differential.

- In 52 overall games against the Rockies since 2021 the Giants are 39-13 with a +118 run differential.
- The Giants are 18-4 in their last 22 games against Colorado (regardless of venue) dating to August 21, 2022.

MORE...MORE!: SF snapped its 11-game streak where they'd scored four or fewer runs by scoring five in last night's win. it was the Giants first time scoring five or more since April 23.

- In fact, the Giants have only scored five or more runs in consecutive games twice this season - March 29 at SD (eight runs) and March 30 at SD (nine runs) and April 22-23 vs. NYM (five runs apiece).
- Even with last night's five-run output, the Giants are still slashing .217/.287/. 323 over their last 12 games dating to April 24...in that span they are averaging 2.67 runs/game in that stretch, scoring 32 runs in 12 games
- Last night's win brought the Giants to 9-0 this season when scoring five or more runs...the Giants are the only team the Majors without a loss when scoring five or more runs this season


JORDAN 8'S: RHP Jordan Hicks will take the hill for his eighth start of the season, matching the total number of starts he'd made in his Major League career before this season (all eight came in 2022 with the Cardinals).

- Hicks enters today with a 1.89 ERA, the eighth-best ERA in the Majors...in the NL specifically, Hicks' 1.89 ERA is sixth-best while his .187 batting average against is tied for seventh-best.
- The Giants, however, haven't taken full advantage of Hicks' strong start as after the team won each of his first three outings they have lost each of his last four starts while Hicks has posted a 2.70 ERA (6er, 20.0ip) in that time.
- He enters this start with a $58.1 \%$ groundball percentage, fourth-best in the Majors behind ATL's Max Fried (67.9\%), PHI's Ranger Suárez (59.8\%) and teammate Logan Webb (58.1\%)

LOOKING FOR LENGTH: Giants starters logged at least 6.0 innings in five of six games from April 22-28 with the lone exception being an opener going 1.0 inning...LHP Kyle Harrison became the first Giants starter in eight games on this trip to pitch at least 6.0 innings with his 7.0 -inning start last night.

- When the Giants get at least 6.0 innings from their starter this year they are 13-4
- SF's rotation has a 6.37 ERA (21er, 29.2ip) on this sevengame trip so far.
WADE AND SEE: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. delivered the big hit that the Giants have been searching for most of this trip last night with his two-run, two-out single in the 4th inning to put a more crooked number on the scoreboard.
- Wade is slashing . $351 / .485 / .442$ with four doubles, one homer and 10 RBI in 35 games so far this season...his . 485 on-base percentage is best in MLB (min. 100 PA) while his .351 average is third-best.
- With three more walks last night, Wade has a $20.8 \%$ walk rate, also tops in the Majors min. 100 PA ahead of PHI's Bryce Harper (17.4\%) and CHC's Mike Tauchman (17.1\%)
- Lastly, Wade enters today with a 177 wRC+, sixth-best in MLB (min. 100 PA) behind LAD's Shohei Ohtani (217), LAD's Mookie Betts (193), NYY's Juan Soto (185), BOS' Tyler O'Neill (179) and SD's Jurickson Profar (179).

WELCOME TO SF: Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth $\$ 44$ million.... he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.
PUSH TO START: Is transitoning from a relief role into a traditional starting role...has made 15 career starts entering today, seven of which have come this season...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.
THIRD TIMES A CHARM: So far this season, he's done well when pitching longer into the game with opponents going 3 -for- 25 (.120) the third time through the lineup

LAST OUTING: Suffered his first loss in a Giants uniform, as he threw 4.0 innings and allowed four runs (two earned) on May 3rd at Philly, marking his shortest start on the year...did not receive much help from SF's defense with an error by Matt Chapman to start a Phillies rally in the 3rd inning and a passed ball by Tom Murphy in the 4th, which allowed Trea Turner to score...Hicks also matched his season-high with four walks allowed.

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Has posted a 1.89 ERA over his first seven outings, which currently ranks as the eighth-best ERA in the Majors....his 1.03 WHIP is tied for the 10th-best figure in the National League
VS. COLORADO: Is slated to make his eighth career appearance and first career start against the Rockies ... he's held Colorado hitters to a 207 ( 6 -for-29) average over his career, however he's issued six walks, compared to just five strikeouts over his seven relief outings...has pitched here at Coors four times in his career, posting a 4.50 ERA (2er, 4.0ip).

LEFT, LEFT, LEFT, RIGHT, LEFT: Right-handed hitters have gone 12-for-75 (.160) versus Hicks thus far in 2024...however, they are 8 -for-26 (.308) off him in his last two starts after starting the season just 4 -for-49 (.082)...lefties, on the other hand, are 13 -for- 59 (.220), and are just 2 -for-their-last-21 (.095) off him over his last three starts.

SWEPT AWAY: Opponents are hitting just . 083 (2-for-24) off his sweeper, compared to a 260 (19-for-73) off his sinker.

BANANA SLG: Opponents are slugging . 246 vs. Hicks so far this season, second-lowest in MLB (min. 30 IP)...only SD's Dylan Cease has had a lower SLG\% against (.245).

FEEL THE HEAT: Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league... he has thrown 4,709 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 (35.7\%) clocked at over $100 \mathrm{mph} .$. .so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph on March 30 at San Diego.

2023 SEASON: Made 65 relief appearances between the Cardinals ( 40 games) and Blue Jays (25 games), posting a combined 3.29 ERA ( $24 \mathrm{er}, 65.2 \mathrm{ip}$ ) with 12 saves...his 81 strikeouts, $11.1 \mathrm{~K} / 9.0 \mathrm{ip}$, and 28.4 strikeout percentage were all career bests...threw 470 pitches at 100+ MPH ( $42.2 \%$ off his total pitches) and 24 pitches at $103+$ MPH, both second in MLB to Jhoan Duran.
DIABETIC PHENOM: Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself.. Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise...he wears cleats that say "Type 1" on them when he pitches.

- Threw 23 pitches last night, getting work in for just the second time in eight days on this 10-game road trip.
- Is 2-0 with a 2.84 ERA and 6-for-6 in save chances in 13 games.
- Has struck out 17 batters over 12.2 innings of work (12.1 SO/9.0)
- 13 of his 17 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- Righties are just 2-for-22 (.091) off him, while lefties are 7-for-25.

Earned his first career All-Star selection last season and wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
