RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a seven-game, seven-day road trip through Boston (3-1) and Toronto (3 to play) tonight at Rogers Centre... Tampa Bay is in the midst of a 13-game stretch featuring matchups exclusively vs. AL East opponents (4-3 thus far), which began with a three-game series vs. the Yankees from May 10-12 (1-2)...the Rays return home for a three-game set with the Red Sox from May 20-22 to complete the 13-game stretch... Tampa Bay has been at or within one game of the .500 mark for 12 consecutive days, but has claimed sole possession of third place in the AL East standings for the first time since entering play on April 19 (11-9)...the Rays have won three of four, four of six, and nine of their last 13 games on the heels of a 2-8 stretch from April 21–May 1.

- ✦ Tampa Bay pushed across a pair of runs in the 9th last night at Fenway Park to secure a 7-5 victory, marking their second win of the season when tied entering the 9th, joining April 20 at NYY...they have been tied entering the 9th in two of their last three games compared to just two of their first 42 contests.
- ✦ The Rays drew seven walks and saw 196 total pitches in the win, their most in a nine-inning game since Sept. 11, 2023 at MIN (198)...Jonathan Aranda and Isaac Paredes led the way, facing 27 pitches apiece.
- ✦ The Rays have recorded back-to-back wins despite being out-hit in both contests (8-7, 9-8)...they had lost each of their last nine games in which they were out-hit.
- ✦ The Rays are just 5-for-33 (152) with RISP over their last three games, but they have scored 4+ runs in a season-high six consecutive games...prior to the streak, they had not accomplished the feat in more than three straight games.
- ✦ The series win at Boston was Tampa Bay's first on the road since April 8-10 at LAA, snapping a three-series skid in opposing ballparks...overall, the Rays are 3-1-0 in their last four sets following an 0-4-1 stretch.

FLIPPED THE SCRIPT—The Rays have won four of their last five series openers...entering that stretch, their 1-8 record in series-opening contests was tied with the White Sox for second worst in MLB, ahead of only the Marlins (0-9).

ON-BASE PAREDES—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in a career-high 15 consecutive games, slashing .375/.455/.536 (21-for-56) with 3 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI... despite fanning four times in his last two games, he has still drawn as many walks (8) as strikeouts during the run...it is tied for the fifth-longest active streak in the majors and tied for second longest in the AL behind TEX Leody Taveras (18G)...it marks the longest streak by a Ray since Brandon Lowe (17G) from Aug. 15–Sept. 7, 2023.

- ✦ Since the streak began on April 28, Paredes ranks among AL leaders in batting average (3rd), on-base pct. (3rd), hits (6th) and OPS (6th, .991)...he is also hitting .381 (8-for-21) during an active five-game hitting streak.
- ✦ Few players possess Paredes' combination of power and contact...he is one of six qualified hitters in the majors with a .500+ SLG and sub-.200 pct. whiff rate, joining LAD Mookie Betts, PHI Alec Bohm, SD Jurickson Profar, BAL Adley Rutschman and HOU Kyle Tucker.

THE LOWE DOWN—Since being reinstated from the 10-day IL on May 6, Josh Lowe leads the Rays and is tied for sixth in the AL with 6 XBH...he has collected an extra-base hit in four of his last five games and 10 of 15 overall dating to Sept. 23, 2023...the 6 XBH are the most by a Ray in their first nine games of a season since Lowe recorded the same total to open the 2023 campaign...over the club's last five games, he has been responsible for five of the Rays 14 total extra-base hits.

WALKIN' ON SUNSHINE—Tampa Bay has drawn an AL-best 80 walks since April 26, trailing only the Phillies (86) in all of MLB...entering that stretch, the Rays 62 walks were tied with Miami for the fewest in the majors...on the season, their 8.4 pct. walk rate ranks sixth in the AL and is in line with their 2023 mark (8.3%).

- ✦ Last night, the Rays drew four free passes in the 6th inning, but failed to score a run after José Caballero was caught stealing following his lead-off walk...it marked the first time in franchise history the Rays did not score despite drawing 4+ BB in a frame, and the first instance by any major league club since the Yankees did so on Sept. 30, 2015 vs. BOS (8th inn.).

PEN PALS—The Rays bullpen turned in a 1.00 ERA (18.0IP, 2ER) over four games in Boston and has produced a 1.87 ERA (53.0IP, 11ER) since May 3, second lowest in the AL behind the Guardians (1.60) and fifth lowest in the majors behind the Dodgers (1.59), Nationals (1.82) and Rockies (1.83)...they entered that stretch with an MLB-worst 5.55 ERA (123.1IP, 76ER) through their first 32 games.

- ✦ Last night, Erasmo Ramirez became the MLB-leading eighth Ray to record a save, tallying the final out at Fenway Park after the Rays were forced into a pitching change due to attempting a mound visit after exhausting their allotted four...the Brewers and Dodgers are the next closest teams, both having six pitchers with a save. Since 2020, an MLB-high 35 different pitchers have recorded at least one save for the Rays, six more than the next closest clubs (29 - CHC/LAD).
- ✦ Riding a 10.0 scoreless inning streak, LHP Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed an earned run in 16 consecutive outings overall since April 6, tied for the third-longest active streak in MLB behind NYY Clay Holmes (18G) and PHI Matt Strahm (17G).
- ✦ RHP Jason Adam is 2-0 with a 0.54 ERA (16.2IP, 1ER) over his last 17 games.
- ✦ RHP Pete Fairbanks has retired all 9 BF across three scoreless appearances since returning from the 15-day IL on May 11, recording 5 SO.

DOWN TO THE WIRE—Each of the Rays four games in Boston were decided by two runs or fewer...on the season, their 24 such games are tied for fifth most in MLB, but are one shy of the league lead...their 16-8 (.667) record in those contests ranks third behind the Orioles (15-6/.714) and Phillies (12-5/.706)...their 7-14 (.333) mark in games with a differential of 3+ runs is third worst, ahead of the Marlins (7-18/.280) and White Sox (5-19/.208).

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—The Rays have been out-homered, 11-5, over their last five games...on the season, their -22 (60-38) home run differential is second worst in the majors, better than only the White Sox (-23, 55-32)...the 60 HR allowed are the most in MLB, while the 38 HR they have hit rank 12th in the AL/23rd in the majors.

SOMETHING'S GOTTA GIVE—Rays hitters are among the lowest-ranked offenses in the majors in whiff rate (27th, 27.9%), hard-hit rate (28th, 35.6%) and average exit velocity (29th, 87.8 mph)...Blue Jays pitching ranks at the bottom of the AL in all three categories, posting a 22.4 pct. whiff rate, 43.2 pct. hard-hit rate and 89.8 mph average exit velocity.

RAYS AND JAYS—Separated by 2.5 games in the AL East standings, Tampa Bay and Toronto meet for the second of four series this weekend in Ontario...the clubs split a four-game, season-opening set at Tropicana Field from March 28-31, with three of the four contests being decided by 6+ runs...following the weekend, the Rays will return to Toronto from July 23-25 as part of their first road trip after the All-Star break.

- ✦ The Rays have won six straight season series over the Jays since 2018, going 61-41 (.598) in that span...they have won four of the last six meetings and are 9-6 in the previous 15 dating back to April 16, 2023.

CONNECTIONS

- ✦ Bally Sports Sun announcer Brian Anderson made his MLB debut at Rogers Centre (then SkyDome) on Sept. 10, 1993 in relief for the California Angels...the first batter he faced was Hall of Famer Paul Molitor.
- ✦ Richie Palacios' brother, Joshua, was drafted by Toronto in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft and made his MLB debut with the Blue Jays on April 9, 2021 in Toronto.
- ✦ Rays manager Kevin Cash began his MLB playing career with the Blue Jays from 2002-04...he was also a major league advance scout for Toronto in 2012.
- ✦ Rays Hitting Coach Chad Mottola held the same position with Toronto in 2013 after five seasons as a Blue Jays minor league coach... during his playing career, he was signed by the Jays three times and was a teammate of Kevin Cash with Triple-A Syracuse in 2002.
- ✦ Several Blue Jays hail from Florida: Bo Bichette (Orlando), Alek Manoah (Homestead), Nate Pearson (Odessa) and Daniel Vogelbach (Orlando)...Pearson graduated from Bishop McLaughlin High School (Spring Hill) and attended Florida International University before transferring to The College of Central Florida.
- ✦ Toronto VP, Baseball Strategy James Click spent 14 years with the Rays, serving as VP of Baseball Operations from 2017-2019.
- ✦ Blue Jays OF Kevin Kiermaier spent 10 seasons with the Rays from 2013-22, winning three Gold Glove awards and one Platinum Glove...his 31.7 bWAR with the Rays rank fourth in club history.
- ✦ Blue Jays LHP Génesis Cabrera was originally signed by the Rays in 2013 before being dealt to St. Louis in a 2018 trade involving Tommy Pham.
- ✦ Blue Jays RHP Trevor Richards pitched for the Rays during parts of three seasons (2019-21), going 3-0 with a 4.28 ERA (67.1IP, 32ER).

TONIGHT'S START—Alexander will take the mound for his ninth appearance of the season this evening, including his sixth start...he is 1-2 with a 4.45 ERA (30.1IP, 15ER) in his last six appearances (4GS) after posting an 8.68 ERA (9.1IP, 9ER) in his first two (1GS)...he is 0-1 with a 4.61 ERA (13.2IP, 7ER) in three road starts.

LAST TIME OUT—Suffered his second defeat of the season on May 12 vs. New York-AL...threw a career-high-tying 7.0 innings, but yielded a season-high six runs on seven hits, two walks and a career-high-tying three home runs.

- All six of his runs came in innings 1-5, but he worked 2.0 scoreless frames to complete the outing.
- He joined **Zach Eflin** (May 7 vs. CWS) as the only Tampa Bay pitchers to reach 7.0 innings in a start this season.

FLYING NORTH—Alexander has made five career appearances (3GS) vs. Toronto, going 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA (25.2IP, 11ER)...in his last start opposite Toronto on July 28, 2022, he took the loss at Rogers Centre after working 4.0 innings, allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits and one walk with one strikeout.

- In his lone appearance against Toronto this season, he worked as a bulk reliever behind **Shawn Armstrong** and allowed five runs on six hits and two walks with four strikeouts over 5.0 innings.
- Alexander's career high is 7.0 IP (5x, last: May 12, 2024 vs. NYY)...two of those five starts have come against the Blue Jays (Aug. 20, 2021 and July 21, 2019).

BOTTOMS UP—The 7-9 spots in the opposing order are a combined 19-for-53 (.358) with a 1.024 OPS against him...he has held 1-6 hitters to a .223 (23-for-103) average and .708 OPS.

- Nine-hole hitters are 10-for-18 (.556) with 2 2B and 1 HR...min. 15 BF, the .556 AVG is the highest in MLB, with the next closest pitcher being **WSh Patrick Corbin** (.474/9-for-19).
- In comparison, Alexander has limited opposing lead-off hitters to a .100 (2-for-20) clip with 6 SO.

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—He allowed a career-high-tying 3 HR in his last start (3x, last: Oct. 5, 2022 at SEA)...he has allowed 1+ HR in back-to-back outings after going three straight appearances (2GS) without conceding a long ball.

- He became the first Tampa Bay pitcher to work 7.0+ innings while allowing 3+ HR since **Chris Archer** on May 12, 2018 (G1) at Baltimore (7.0IP, 7H, 6ER, 3BB, 3HR, 4SO).
- In his last 16 GS since Aug. 14, 2022, Alexander has yielded 20 home runs (2.27 HR/9.0IP), allowing a homer in 12 of the 16 outings.

FIRST THINGS FIRST—Alexander has recorded a career-high 75.1 pct. first-pitch strike rate, up from 72.4 pct. last season...min. 150 BF, it signals the highest mark in the majors, ahead of **AZ Brandon Pfaadt** (74.1%)...however, to this point, he has had more success in hitter's counts, holding opponents to a .240 (6-for-20) average when he is behind in the count compared to .257 (19-for-74) when ahead...opponents are 17-for-57 (.298) against him in even counts, including 6-for-19 (.316) on the first pitch.

LEFT SIDE, BEST SIDE—Alexander is holding left-handed hitters to a .186 (8-for-43) clip and .583 OPS, but three of the eight hits have gone for extra bases (2B, 2HR)...right-handed hitters are batting .301 (34-for-113) against him with a .901 OPS—they had gone 18-for-47 (.383) in his first three outings, but are 16-for-66 (.242) in his last five.

- He limited lefties to a .100 (3-for-30) mark in his first five outings, but they are 5-for-13 (.385) over his last three appearances.

SWINGMAN—Of his 128 career appearances, 48 (37.5%) have come as a starter while 80 were in relief...his 41 relief appearances of 2.0+ IP since 2020 are tied for sixth most in the majors—he has gone 7-3 with a 3.51 ERA (110.1IP, 43ER) in those outings.

- In his five starts this season, Alexander has produced a 5.58 ERA (24.2IP, 15ER)...in three outings working behind an opener, he has recorded a 5.40 ERA (15.0IP, 9ER).
- For his career, he is 4-22 with a 4.79 ERA (223.2IP, 119ER) in 48 starts vs. 8-3 with a 4.06 ERA (157.1IP, 71ER) in 80 relief appearances.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP ZACH EFLIN (3-4, 3.91)

LAST START—Earned his second consecutive victory on May 13 at Boston...tossed 5.0 innings, allowing three runs (all in the 1st inning) on six hits with zero walks and three strikeouts...has struck out three batters or fewer in back-to-back starts for the first time since June 19-25, 2022.

vs. BLUE JAYS—Has made six career appearances (5GS) opposite Toronto, going 2-3 with a 6.43 ERA (28.0IP, 20ER)...Eflin took the loss on Opening Day vs. Toronto, conceding season highs in runs (6) and home runs (3) across 5.2 innings.
