TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a brief 3-game road trip vs Ethan Wilson's Mets.

- Cin is coming off what was originally scheduled to be a 3-game homestand from Fri to Sun against **StL**...the first game of that set was postponed by rain and made up as a part of a doubleheader on Sat, with the Reds suffering an 8-1 loss in Game 1 before a 7-6, 11-inning win in the nightcap.
- Sun's series finale against **StL** was also postponed by rain and will be made up as part of a doubleheader on Mon, 8/17.
- Following Wed's series finale here at **Citi Field**, the Reds have an off day on Thu (5/28) before returning to **Cincinnati** for a 6-game homestand vs **Atl** (5/29-5/31) and **KC** (6/1-6/3).

SERIES OF FORTUNATE EVENTS: The Reds' 9 series victories this season (last: 2-1, 5/18-5/20 at **Phi**) are tied for fifth-most in the majors...only the **Braves** (14), **Brewers** (11), **Rays** (11), and **Dodgers** (10) have more series wins.

- The Reds' 9 series victories in 2026 are their most before the end of May since 2013 (11-7-0).
- Are on pace for 27 series wins, which would be the club's most since the 2012 National League Central Division championship team went 29-17-6 (.615) in series play.
- Are 9-8 in series openers (.529)...have dropped 6 of their last 7 series openers after having won 5 in-a-row and 8 of their first 10.

POWER SURGE: The Reds have homered 44 times over their last 29 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), second to only **CWS** (46) for most in the majors during that time...have homered in 3 straight games and 22 of their last 27 games.

- Entered the 4/21 game at **TB** ranked T17th in the majors with 22 HR...enter today's game ranked T5th in the majors with 66 HR, trailing only the **Yankees** (75), **Braves** (72), **White Sox** (70), and **Dodgers** (68).
- 106 of their 229 runs scored this year have come via HR (46.3%).

STEERING THE BUS: OF/INF Spencer Steer has hit safely in each of his last 18 road games (since 4/18 at **Min**), the longest-active streak in MLB and longest by a Red since **Joey Votto** and **Brandon Phillips** (18g each) in 2013.

- The last Red with a longer streak is **Sean Casey** (21g, 2005)...**Jake Daubert** owns the club's longest road hitting streak since 1900 (28g, 1923).
- Since 4/18, has slashed .316/.395/.482 in 32 G (36-for-114, 4hr, 13rbi, 11xbh, 51 times on base)...during that time, ranks among NL leaders in runs (23, T4th), batting average (6th), and on-base percentage (9th).
- His recent 11-game hitting streak (5/9-5/22) was his second this season of at least 10 games (also from 4/28-5/7, 10g)...became the first Red with multiple double-digit-game hitting streaks within the club's first 50 games of a season since **SS Zack Cozart** in 2017.

BATTERS UP: Reds batters are slashing .227/.310/.393 with a .703 OPS.

- Over their first 23 games, Reds batters slashed .205/.297/.334 with a .631 OPS (3.65 R/G, 0.96 HR/G, 17.9% barrel rate).
- In 29 games since (beginning 4/21), Cin has produced a .244/.320/.438 line with a .758 OPS (5.00 R/G, 1.52 HR/G, 23.8% barrel rate).
- Barrel rate is defined by TruMedia as the percentage of batted balls with an exit velocity greater than 95 mph and a launch angle between 10 and 35.*

STARTING FIRE: Reds starting pitchers have combined for a 17-15 record with a 4.61 ERA with 16 quality starts through their first 52 games of 2026.

- The Reds went 20-13 through their first 33 games (through 5/2) in which the starting staff produced an 11-10 mark with a 5.04 ERA (11qs, .273/.346/.433).
- In 19 games since then (beginning 5/3), the team has gone 7-12 but the starters have posted a 6-5 record with a 3.90 ERA (5qs, .231/.314/.425).

LOWE AND BEHOLD: DH Nathaniel Lowe homered in both games of Sat's doubleheader vs **StL**, becoming the first Reds batter to accomplish that feat since **Joey Votto** did it on 9/14/20 vs **Pit**...along with **Votto**, also joined **Drew Stubbs** (8/31/09 vs **Pit**) as the only Reds to homer in both legs of a twinbill at **Great American Ball Park**.

- Each of his 8 HR this season have come since 4/24...only **Phi's Kyle Schwarber** (12), **Min's Byron Buxton** (11), **NYM's Juan Soto** (9), **SF's Casey Schmitt** (9), & **Hou's Christian Walker** (9) have more in that time.
- Is on pace for what would be a career-high 34 homers...in 27 games since 4/18, is slashing .289/.340/.622 with a .962 OPS.

SERIES NOTES:

- The Reds and **Mets** are meeting for the first time in 2026...Cin won the season series in 2025, 4-2 (2-1 at **Citi Field** from 7/18-7/20 and 2-1 at **Great American Ball Park** from 9/5-9/7)...it was just the second time since 2014 the Reds won the season series (also: 2023, 4-2).
- Last season, the final Wild Card spot in the National League Postseason field came down to the Reds and **Mets**...although the two clubs each finished the year with an 83-79 record, Cin earned its first trip to the Postseason since 2020 by virtue of winning the season series.
- Dating back to 9/24/13, the Reds are 25-46 vs **NYM**, including a 14-game losing streak from 9/7/14 to 9/7/16 that ranks as Cin's longest-ever skid against the **Mets** and was its longest against any team since a 16-game losing streak vs **AZ** from 5/8/01 to 8/13/03.

ELLYTRICITY: In Sat's doubleheader vs **StL**, **SS Elly De La Cruz** went 2-for-8 with a home run (#12), a single, and a walk.

- This season, **De La Cruz** leads all Major League shortstops in extra-base hits (25), runs scored (37), and total bases (110).
- Has managed to reach in 44 of his 52 games (82 times on base).
- 5 of his 12 HR have come off left-handed pitching (63 PA)...hit 5 HR off lefties last year (210 PA).
- Is 2 stolen bases shy of 150 for his career...aiming to become the youngest Red (currently 24 years, 134 days old) since 1900 to reach the mark (**Eric Davis**, 25 years, 82 days old).
- Is also 2 stolen bases shy of ranking among the fastest players since the live-ball era (since 1920) to reach 400 hits, 200 RBI, and 150 stolen bases for his career (468 career games).

EL CABALLO DE HIERRO: **SS Elly De La Cruz** has appeared in each of Cin's last 270 games, beginning 7/30/24...it's the third-longest streak of consecutive games played by a Red since 1970 (**Pete Rose** 2x, 678g & 281g)...is also the third-longest active streak of consecutive games played in the majors, behind only **Matt Olson** (836 w/**Atl**, **Oak**) and **Pete Alonso** (469 w/**NYM**, **Bal**).

KEEPIN' IT CLEAN: 2b Matt McLain has produced a career-high 84 consecutive errorless games at second base, beginning 8/11/25.

- McLain's** last error at the keystone came on 8/10/25 at **Pit** (throwing error in the 8th inning).

- LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision in the 5-4 loss at Phi on Mon, 5/18 (5.2ip, 3h, 3r/3er, 5bb, 3k, 1hr, 97TP).
 • His 5 walks matched a career high set on 10/1/22 at Chc.
 • Reached 96.5 mph for the first time since last June at Cle.
 • 9 of his 24 batters reached.
 • Threw 25 pitches in the 1st inning...loaded the bases with no outs and allowed 2 runs to score in the frame.
 • Faced the minimum in innings 2-4, and pitched a scoreless 5th...faced 5 batters in the 6th (K, HR, HB, LO, BB) before handing it over to Tejay Antone to finish the inning.

- MAY 13 vs WSH:** Did not factor in the decision in the 10-inning, 8-7 loss vs Wsh on Wed, 5/13 (4.0ip, 6h, 5r/5er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 87 TP).
 • Had a 5-run lead entering the 2nd inning.
 • 10 of his 22 batters reached.
 • Issued 3 walks for the first time since 8/22/24 at Pit (3bb).

- SEASON DEBUT, MAY 8 vs HOU:** In his first ever appearance vs the Astros, suffered the 10-0 loss on Fri, 5/8 (5.1ip, 5h, 4r/4er, 1bb, 2k, 2hr, 1hb, 78TP).
 • Was his season debut...activated earlier in the day from the 15-day IL (blister on left index finger).
 • Produced 7 swings-and-misses and 17 batted balls in play.
 • Allowed 6 hard-hit balls, his most since 7/18/25 at NYM.
 • 7 of his 21 batters reached base.
 • Began the 6th inning with a groundout, hit batter, a 2-run homer (Yordan Alvarez) and a double (Isaac Paredes) before turning it over to Pierce Johnson who escaped the inning without further damage.

- REHAB ASSIGNMENT:** Was in his second stint on a rehab assignment when activated from the injured list...was sidelined with blister issues on his left index finger.
 • Made his first rehab appearance on 4/2 for A-Daytona vs Jupiter, faced 8 batters before he was removed from the game due to the recurrence of a blister on his left index finger...was returned from rehab the following day.
 • Began his second rehab stint on 4/26 for A-Dayton vs South Bend and pitched 5.0 shutout innings...his assignment was transferred to AAA-Louisville on 5/2...allowed 2 runs on 5 hits in 4.1 innings in that night's 8-4 loss at Omaha (2bb, 6k, 79TP).

- LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the 4-1 win on Tue, 5/19 at Phi (6.0ip, 3h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 9k, 86TP).
 • Was his fifth straight quality start (sixth QS over his last 7 outings) and his ninth career QS.
 • Just 24 of the 42 swings he produced resulted in contact...generated 18 misses for the second consecutive outing.
 • Allowed 11 batted balls in play, the fewest he's given up since his first start of the season on 3/30 vs Pit (9).
 • Allowed just 3 hard-hit balls.
 • Only 3 of his 20 batters reached...matched his season high with 9 strikeouts...retired each of his last 10 batters.
 • Was hit by a comebacker in the groin/hamstring area in the bottom of the 6th...was not injured.
 • The Reds improved to 7-3 when he pitches.
