THE LONG AND WINDING ROAD: Fresh off an 8-2 homestand vs. Kansas City (3-1), San Diego (2-1) and Baltimore (3-0), their longest homestand of the year, the Detroit Tigers tonight begin an 11-day, 10-game, three-city road trip with the first of three games against the Houston Astros ... this trip, their longest of the season, continues this weekend with four games against the Angels and concludes next week with three games against Colorado.

- At 18-10, the Tigers have the best record in the American League, 1.0 game ahead of the Yankees ... the Tigers have started a season by winning at least 18 of their first 28 games for just the third time in the last 40 years, joining 19-9 starts to both the 2006 and 2014 seasons.
- This road trip touches the Central, Pacific and Mountain time zones and is bookended by a pair of Eastern time zone series in Detroit ... this marks the first time in Tigers history that they will play four consecutive series in each of the four different time zones in the continental U.S.
- Tonight marks Detroit's first visit to Houston since sweeping the American League Wild Card Series here in two games last October, Detroit's first playoff appearance in 10 years.
- The Tigers tonight continue their stretch of 23 games in 24 days through this Sunday, May 4.

A FINE 25: The Tigers have gone 18-7, a .720 winning percentage, in their last 25 games starting March 31 since enduring a three-game sweep to start the season at Dodger Stadium ... their 18-7 record starting March 31 is tied with the Mets for best in all of baseball in that span.

WE WERE ON A BREAK: While the Tigers lead the American League with an 18-10 record this season, they've also got the best record in the A.L. dating back to last year's All-Star Break ... the Tigers are 57-36 since the start of the "second half" last year, good for a .613 winning percentage and 3.5 games ahead of the next-closest A.L. club, the New York Yankees and their 53-39 mark (.576) ... overall, the Tigers have the fourth-best record in all of baseball since last year's Break.

THIS DIFFERENCE ISN'T NEGLIGIBLE: The Tigers begin the day with the best record in the American League on the strength of a +42 run differential this year, tied with the Yankees for the best mark in all of baseball ... the Tigers are one of only six A.L. teams in positive run-differential territory, with them and the Yankees well ahead of the next-closest the Seattle Mariners (+15) ... overall, the Tigers and Yankees enjoy a slim lead over Cincinnati (+41) for that best mark in the majors.

TOUGH LUCK, JACK: Tigers starter Jack Flaherty tonight makes his sixth start of the season and his third on the road ... Flaherty has just a 1-2 record despite a 2.63 ERA, joining Milwaukee's Chad Patrick (1-2, 2.45), Philadelphia's Taijuan Walker (1-2, 2.78) and Atlanta's Spencer Schwellenbach (1-2, 2.83) as the only four qualifying starting pitchers to have a sub-.500 record and a sub-3.00 ERA ... 33 other qualifying starting pitchers have a sub-3.00 ERA and a .500 or better record this season.

- Flaherty came back to the Tigers this offseason by signing a two-year contract after starting last year with the club before being sent to the Los Angeles Dodgers around last July's trade deadline, netting the Tigers shortstop Trey Sweeney and catcher Thayeron Liranzo ... Flaherty and the Dodgers won the World Series, Sweeney helped the Tigers to the playoffs for the first time in 10 years, and Liranzo is one of Detroit's many exciting top prospects.

HE MANAGES JUST FINE: Tigers Manager A.J. Hinch enters tonight's game with the fifth-most wins among active managers with 895 ... among all-time club managers, Hinch ranks 11th in Tigers history with 325 wins (with Top 8 in sight this year) and is second in Astros history with 481 wins.

IT TAKES A VILLAGE: Jack Flaherty (2.63 ERA) is one of four Tigers starters with a sub-3.00 ERA so far this season, joining Casey Mize (2.12 ERA), Tarik Skubal (2.34 ERA) and Jackson Jobe (2.70 ERA).

- The Tigers are the only team in all of baseball to have four starting pitchers with sub-3.00 ERAs ... across the rest of baseball, only the New York Mets have as many as three starting pitchers with sub-3.00 ERAs this season while only a few others have as many as two.
- Collectively, Tigers starters lead the American League with a 2.89 ERA (49 ER/152.2 IP) this season, second in the majors behind only the New York Mets (2.36 ERA).

THE MIGHTY PEN: The Tigers bullpen has combined to post a 2.66 ERA (28 ER/94.2 IP) this season, the fourth-lowest mark in all of baseball and second-lowest in the American League just behind only Houston (2.62 ERA from their bullpen) ... Tigers relievers have also combined to limit opponents to a .582 OPS, the fourth-lowest mark in the majors and second lowest in the A.L., a single point behind the Yankees (.581) ... Detroit's 94.2 relief innings pitched are the fourth fewest in the A.L.

IN THE BIG INNING...: The Tigers are averaging seeing 20.5 pitches in the first inning this season, the best mark in the A.L. and second-best in the majors behind only the Phillies ... the Tigers lead the majors with a .401 on-base percentage (16 points higher than the Phillies) and a .314 (37-for-118) batting average (six points ahead of the Yankees) in the first inning this year.

AND FINALLY: The Tigers have won eight-straight series openers since losing Opening Day at Dodger Stadium, their best such streak since an eight-game run August 18-September 12, 2016 ... at 8-1, the Tigers are tied with the Guardians for the best series-opener record in the majors this year.

- Won the World Series with the Dodgers in 2024...went 1-2 with a 7.36 ERA in five postseason starts and started the final game of the World Series.
- Went 7-5 with a 2.95 ERA (35ER/106.2IP) in 18 starts with Detroit and was 6-2 with a 3.58 ERA (22ER/55.1IP) in 10 starts for the Dodgers in the regular season.
- Delivered 6.0+ innings in 16 of his 28 starts last season, including fours starts of 6.2 or more innings.

- Earned a spot on his first career Opening Day roster after a standout spring camp, during which he didn't allow a single earned run over 10.2 innings (nine games) of relief...went 1-0, surrendering seven hits and three walks while striking out nine
- Appeared in 21 games (three starts) for the Tigers in 2024, posting a 1-1 record with a 1.84 ERA (6ER/29.1IP), six walks and 23 strikeouts...also made 34 appearances with Triple-A Toledo last year, going 1-2 with one save, a 5.17 ERA (27ER/47.0IP) and 53 strikeouts.
- Made his first career Major League start on Aug. 8 at Seattle...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, became the first Tigers pitcher to finish and then start consecutive games since Steve Sparks, who finished the July 26, 2000, game vs. Tampa Bay and started on July 27, 2000, at Texas.
- Allowed only one earned run over 13 outings from Aug. 4-Sept. 7, posting a 0.49 ERA (1ER/18.1IP) with 13 hits allowed, three walks and 12 strikeouts.

- Tied for the team lead in strikeouts among relief pitchers with 12 in his 11.2 innings pitched to start the year.
- Spent the entire 2024 season with the Tigers, pitching in 66 games (nine starts) and going 7-2 with eight saves, a 2.19 ERA (23ER/94.1IP) and 77 strikeouts.
