AT HOME: The Brewers are 47-33 at home, going 15-9-2 in series play, including this series.....the team has had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks (5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers went 46-35 on the road this season, going 15-9-2 in series play....went 21-10 in their last 31 road games.....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks (4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23. replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54).....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009)....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator **Walker McKinven** (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach), Matt Erickson (infield coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 43 replay challenges this season, going 25-18.....their last challenge (won) came on 9/26 at Pittsburgh as a safe call at first base on a pickoff attempt involving Oneil Cruz was overturned.

REA AT A GLANCE: Colin Rea, 34, will be making his 32nd appearance and 27th start of the season.....Rea last pitched on Tuesday at Pittsburgh in relief (1.1ip, 2h, 0r, 0bb, 2k, 28 pitches).....he is 10-5 with a 4.48 ERA as a starter (142.2ip, 71er) and 2-0 with a 1.86 ERA in relief (19.1ip, 4er).....the team is 17-9 in his starts.....he has a career-high 8 quality starts.....opponents are batting .252 (159-for-631, 28hr).....he has 10+ wins for the first time.....he also has career highs in innings pitched (162.0) and strikeouts (130)..... Rea is signed through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025.....name is pronounced "RAY."

CAREER: Is 26-19 with a 4.53 ERA and 1 save in 93 games/75 starts (441ip, 222er).....has pitched in the majors for San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Chicago-NL (2020) and Milwaukee (2021, '23-24).....is 22-18 with a 4.72 ERA as a starter (395ip, 207er) and 4-1 with a 2.93 ERA in relief (46ip, 15er).....Rea was selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana State University.....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 11/11/16, causing him to miss the entire 2017 season.....Rea also pitched in Japan with the Fukuoka SoftBank Hawks in 2021 and 2022.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 9-7 with a 4.29 ERA in 31 games/26 starts [153ip, 73er].....is 7-3 with a 3.92 ERA in 16 games/14 starts this season [87.1ip, 38er].

RHP Freddy Peralta went 11-9 with a 3.68 ERA in 32 starts this season.....the team went 19-13 in his starts.....he made 11 quality starts.....opponents batted .224 [143-for-639, 26hr].....he set career highs in starts (32) and innings pitched (173.2).....he produced 200+ strikeouts (200) for the second time in his career and for the second straight season (210 in 2023).....he joined Teddy Higuera (2x), Corbin Burnes (3x) and Yovani Gallardo (4x) as the only pitchers in franchise history with multiple 200+ strikeout seasons.....he ranked sixth in the National League in strikeouts.....Peralta is O-1 with a 3.46 ERA in 4 career games/2 starts in the postseason (13ip, 7h, 5r, 5er, 6bb, 17k, 2hr).
