SNAKEBITES

THE NL CHAMPS: The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled C **Jose Herrera** from Triple-A Reno and placed C **Gabriel Moreno** on the 10-day injured list (sprained left thumb).

TV UPDATE - ROKU ON SUNDAY: Sunday's 8:35a AZT/11:35a ET game will be broadcast on the Roku Channel App and available to stream via MLB.TV/DBACKS.TV subscriptions.

♦ **Roku Channel App on Sunday:** Roku TV is not required to watch the game...the Roku Channel app is available for download on all smart TVs and devices or via the Roku Channel website.

• Sunday's 11:35 a.m. ET first pitch (8:35 a.m. AZ) will be the earliest ever @ Citizens Bank Park.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won last night, 5-4, @ Phillies.

♦ **Jordan Montgomery** earned his third consecutive win (4th in last 6 starts) after tossing a quality bid (2 ER in 6.0 IP, 5 K).

♦ **Lourdes Gurriel Jr., Joc Pederson** and **Gabriel Moreno** each had multi-hit nights with a homer.

♦ **Paul Sewald** collected his second save in as many games and is 9-for-9 on the season.

MAKE OUR SNAKES ALL-STARS: **Ketel Marte**, in second place among NL second basemen (608,807 votes), leads D-backs vote getters in first balloting update for 2024 MLB All-Star Game.

♦ **Christian Walker** currently sits at sixth among first basemen (112,385 votes) while **Joc Pederson** sits at sixth among designated hitters (81,340 votes).

♦ Phase 1 balloting ends on Thursday, June 27 at 9:00 a.m. AZ with finalists announced later that day at 3:00 p.m. AZ on MLB Network.

BACK TO .500: The D-backs have a record of .500+ for the first time since April 16 (.500, 9-9)...the last time they were over .500 was April 3 (4-3, .571).

SIX STRAIGHT SERIES OPENERS: The D-backs have won their last 6 series-opening games (June 3-21) after going 3-15 in their previous 18 to start the season (March 28-May 30).

GOING 4 THE SERIES: With a victory today, the D-backs would secure their fourth straight series win (also: vs. Angels, vs. White Sox, @ Nationals)...they have won or split their last 6 series since May 30.

CREATING CHAOS: The D-backs' 84.2 stolen base pct. since 2023 is second in the Majors, behind the Mets (87.2).

♦ The D-backs have stolen 5 bases in 8 attempts over their last 4 games, including 4 stolen bases in their last 2 games.

AT THE BANK: The D-backs have won 3 consecutive games @ Citizens Bank Park (since Game 6 of the 2023 NLCS on Oct. 23).

♦ Last season, the D-backs became the sixth team in MLB history to win a 7-game Postseason series after losing the first 2 road games (lost on Oct. 16-17 @ Phillies).

♦ Since 2022, the D-backs are 4-3 @ Citizens Bank Park in the regular season...last season, Arizona took the 3-game set 2-to-1.

POWER - ON: Last night marked the first time the D-backs hit 3+ home runs @ Citizens Bank Park since June 10, 2019, when they collected a franchise-record 8 homers.

PRODUCTIVE PIÑA: **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 7 straight road games (since June 7) and reached base in 21 straight road games (since May 8).

♦ Since May 8, Gurriel Jr. is hitting .329 (28-for-85)/.851 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers and 10 RBI on the road.

♦ Gurriel Jr. has recorded multi-hit performances in his last 6 road games... his road streak of 2+ hit games is the second longest this season, behind Luis Arráez/SD (9 games).

BACK-TO-BACK: Last night, in the third inning, **Gabriel Moreno** and **Joc Pederson** marked the seventh occurrence of back-to-back homers this season (last: June 7 @ Padres, Ketel Marte and Lourdes Gurriel Jr.).

♦ The D-backs 7 occurrences of back-to-back homers are the most in the Majors this season, ahead of the Dodgers (5) and Braves (5).

PEDERSON SEEING IT WELL: **Joc Pederson** has had 4 multi-hit performances in his last 6 starts (since June 13), batting .476 (10-for-21)/1.508 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 8 runs, 11 RBI and 4 walks.

♦ His 14 multi-hit games are second in NL among primary DH's this season, behind K. Schwarber/PHI (22) and Marcel Ozuna/ATL (22).

MARTE MAKING HIS CASE: **Ketel Marte** leads all second basemen with a 3.9 bWAR, an .848 OPS, 33 extra-base hits, 146 total bases, 42 RBI, 12 defensive runs saved and 1.5 dWAR, is second with 15 homers, tied for second with 16 doubles and third with 81 hits.

♦ Marte's 3.9 bWAR is third in the NL (8th in MLB), behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (4.3) and Mookie Betts/LAD (3.9).

CARROLL'S COMEBACK: **Corbin Carroll**, over his last 12 games, is batting .310 (13-for-42)/.931 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 13 runs, 3 RBI, 8 walks, 4 strikeouts and 4 stolen bases.

SEWALD SAVES: **Paul Sewald** is 1 of 3 pitchers this season with 9+ saves and no blown saves (also: Evan Phillips/LAD, 12 SV and Kirby Yates/TEX, 11 SV).

♦ Over his 15 games this year, Sewald boasts a 0.66 ERA (1 ER in 13.2 IP, 4 H, 3 BB, 12 K).

NEXT STARTER: RHP SLADE CECCONI (2-5, 5.90)

♦ Won his last start on June 18 @ Nationals (0 ER in 6.0 IP), 6 K).

♦ Will make his first career start vs. Phillies.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Seventh start of the season, fourth on the road.
 • Recalled from Triple-A Reno on June 9...has made 2 appearances out of the bullpen since his call up (1-0, 9.95 ERA).
 • The D-backs have won 3 of his last 4 starts, outscoring opponents 35-23 in those games.

LAST START: Took the loss on April 29 vs. Dodgers (2 ER in 4.0 IP).

VS. PHILLIES: Third career start vs. Phillies, second @ Citizen's Bank Park.

VS. NL EAST: Ninth career start against the NL East.
 • In his last 3 starts, is 1-0 with a 1.53 ERA (3 ER in 17.2 IP).
 • The D-backs were 5-0 in his 5 starts from May 6-June 22, 2023.

ON THE ROAD: First road start since April 23 @ Cardinals (W; 1 ER in 6.0 IP, 6 K).
 • In 3 road starts this season, is 1-0 with a 2.81 ERA (6 R-5 ER in 16.0 IP) and 17 strikeouts.
 • Since 2023, is 5-2 in 11 road starts (2 quality) and has allowed 3 or fewer earned runs in his last 7.

OUT OF THE PEN: Since being recalled on June 9, made 2 relief appearances (June 9 @ Padres and June 15 vs. White Sox), totaling 6.1 innings.

LEFT AND RIGHT: In 3 road starts, is holding right-handed hitters to a .222 average (10-for-45) with 12 strikeouts, while lefties are hitting .250 (5-for-20) with 5 strikeouts.

RISPY BUSINESS ON THE ROAD: Holding runners in scoring position to a .125 average (2-for-16) with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts in 3 road starts.

2023 RECAP: In his first full season with the D-backs, went 5-4 with a 4.15 ERA (41 ER in 89.0 IP) in 17 games (16 starts).

- Began the season with Triple-A Reno, going 1-0 with a 6.33 ERA (15 ER in 21.1 IP) and 22 strikeouts in 4 starts.
- Recalled by the D-backs on April 24.
- On May 27 vs. Red Sox, retired 4 of the 5 batters faced over 1.1 scoreless innings in relief, marking his first professional career appearance out of the bullpen after a combined 66 starts between the Minors and Majors.
- On May 31 vs Rockies, tossed 7.0 scoreless innings for the first time in his career and tied a career high with 7 strikeouts (also: Aug. 19, 2022 vs. Cardinals)...also allowed a career-low 2 hits.
- In his 5 starts in June, Arizona went 5-0 and he recorded 24 strikeouts over 27.1 innings.

2023 ROAD RECAP: In 8 road starts in 2023, went 4-2 with a 5.05 ERA (24 R-23 ER in 41.0 IP, 34 K).
 • From May 22-June 30, 2023, was 3-0 with a 3.63 ERA (9 ER in 22.1 IP, 22 K).

HOW IT STARTED: Signed by the D-backs as a Competitive Balance-B selection (74th overall) in the 2019 draft.
 • Attended the University of Michigan, where he helped lead the Wolverines to the 2019 College World Series vs. eventual champion Vanderbilt University.
 • A Michigan native, attended Portage Northern High School, where he lettered in baseball and basketball.
