BY THE NUMBERS

The Mariners have the best starting rotation in the American League by the Mariners rotation features 3 of the top 10 pitchers in the AL by projected fWAR: Luis Castillo (2nd, 3.9), George Kirby (T5th, 3.5) and Logan Gilbert (T9th, 3.2).

Mariners batters have hit 8 home runs this spring, 4th-most in the Cactus League..

Scott Servais enters his 9th season as Mariners manager...in 8 seasons at the helm, Servais has led Seattle to a 616-578 (.516) record.

Outfielder Jonatan Clase had 79 stolen bases last season...Seattle currently has 10 SB which is T-3rd most in the Cactus league only behind Rockies and Angels (13 SB).

FanGraphs currently projects the 2024 Mariners with an 86-76 (.528) record, projected to have the 4th-highest win total in the American League and 6th-highest in MLB.

Seattle is one of 5 teams in the Major Leagues with 88+ wins in each of the last 3 seasons, along with the Braves, Astros, Dodgers and Blue Jays.

YESTERDAY'S GAME...the Mariners fell to the White Sox by a score of 6-5 in Peoria yesterday afternoon...Seattle right-hander **Bryce Miller** made his first start of the spring and Mariners top prospect (MLB.com) **Cole Young** hit his first Cactus League home run.

GETTING OFFENSIVE...today's game features 2 of the top 3 Cactus League offenses by OPS thus far in spring...the Rockies offense ranks 2nd in the Cactus League with an .804 OPS, while the Mariners rank 3rd with a .799 OPS...Seattle and Colorado trail only the Dodgers (.825 OPS) for the Cactus League lead.

VS. COLORADO... the Mariners and Rockies meet today for first of two matchups this spring...the clubs will meet again on March 19 at Peoria Stadium...overall, Seattle and Colorado have played 81 times in Spring Training...the Rockies own a narrow 37-38-6 advantage in the all-time series... the Mariners and Rockies will meet for a 3-game series during the 2024 regular season in Colorado from April 19-21.

FAMILIAR FACES AND IMPACT ADDITIONS...of the 40 players on Seattle's Major League, 40-man roster, 24 spent time in the Mariners organization in 2023...of the 16 newcomers, 14 are new to the organization while outfielder Mitch Haniger and right-hander Levi Stoudt return to the Mariners... of the 24 returnees from last season (13 pitchers + 11 position players), all but one (outfielder **Jonatan Clase**) appeared in the Majors with Seattle last season...the 14 players completely new to the organization include 7 pitchers: Cody Bolton, Jackson Kowar, Mauricio Llovera, Gregory Santos, Collin Snider, Carlos Vargas and Austin Voth, and 7 position players: catchers Blake Hunt and Seby Zavala; infielders Jorge Polanco and Luis Urías; infielder/outfielders Luke Raley and Samad Taylor; and designated hitter/catcher Mitch Garver.

THE ROSTER...the Mariners Major League, Spring Training roster is at 74 players (40 players on the 40-man roster + 34 non-roster invitees)...the roster features 36 pitchers (21 on 40-man + 15 NRI) and 38 position players (19 on 40-man + 19 NRI)...of the 36 pitchers (21+15), 30 are right-handed pitchers (19+10) with 6 lefties (2+4)...a breakdown of the 38 position players: 8 catchers (4+4), 16 infielders (5+11), 10 outfielders (7+3) and 4 infielder/outfielders (4+0).

THE COACHING STAFF...manager Scott Servais enters his 9th season as Seattle's skipper... returning to the Major League staff are Third Base Coach Manny Acta, Major League Coach & Director of Pitching Strategy Trent Blank, Hitting Coach & Director of Hitting Strategy Jarret DeHart, Infield Coach Perry Hill, First Base Coach Kristopher Negrón, Major League Field Coordinator Carson Vitale and Pitching Coach Pete Woodworth...additionally, Tony Arnerich transitions to Bullpen Coach...the Mariners added 3 coaches to their big-league staff: Bench Coach & Offensive Coordinator Brant Brown, Major League Pitching Strategist and Asst. Pitching Coach Danny Farquhar and Asst. Hitting Coach Tommy Joseph.

TOP PROSPECTS IN CAMP...three of the Mariners top-5 prospects according to *Baseball America* TOP PROSPECTS IN CAMP...three of the Mariners top-5 prospects according to Baseball America are in Major League camp: infielder Cole Young (#1 Mariners prospect, #44 in MLB), catcher Harry Ford (#2 Mariners, #51 MLB) and infielder Tyler Locklear (#5 Mariners)...in addition to the 3 in the top-5, right-hander Emerson Hancock (#9), outfielder Jonatan Clase (#10), infielder Ryan Bliss (#14), outfielder Alberto Rodriguez (#17), outfielder Spencer Packard (#20), infielder Brock Rodden (#22), right-hander Jimmy Joyce (#23), infielder Hogan Windish (#24), left-hander Reid VanScoter (#27) and right-hander Carlos Vargas (#30) round out the 13 players in Seattle's top-30 (Baseball America) in MLB camp...MLB.com's Top Prospects list will be announced on March 6.

OPENING MONTH OF THE SEASON... the Mariners will open the 2024 regular season at T-Mobile Park, with Opening Day against the Boston Red Sox on March 28...promotions during the first month of the season include 3 consecutive **Julio Rodríguez** "No Fly Zone" Bobblehead Nights from April 1-3 vs. Cleveland, with bobbleheads going to the first 10,000 fans each game... "Mariners Hoodie Night" on April 12 vs. the Cubs... "Salute To Armed Forces Night - Mariners Cap" on April 13 vs. the Cubs... 3 consecutive **Ken Griffey Jr.** "Home Run Robbery" Bobblehead Nights from April 15-17 vs. Cincinnati...other promotions include "Mariners Turn Ahead The Clock Jersey Night" on April 26 vs. Arizona, "90s Night - Mariners Neon Hat Night" on April 27 vs. Arizona, 2 Little League Days (April 14 & 28), Jackie Robinson Day on April 15 and "Bark at the Park" on April 29 vs. Atlanta.

SPRING BREAKDOWN...the Mariners have 29 remaining exhibition games in 2024 (28 in Arizona): 26 Cactus League games, 2 prospect games (Spring Breakout on March 15 vs. San Diego and March 23 vs. San Diego) and 2 games at San Diego on March 25-26...Seattle is set to play 18 total games at Peoria Stadium this spring.

MLB NETWORK TOP 100...MLB Network named its "Top 100 Players Right Now", with the Mariners landing 5 players in the Top 100: outfielder Julio Rodríguez (#10), right-hander Luis Castillo (#54), shortstop J.P. Crawford (#69), right-hander George Kirby (#75) and catcher Cal Raleigh (#93).

HEY GARY, AS YOU KNOW...Bryan Woo made 18 starts during his rookie season in 2023, going 4-5 with a 4.21 ERA (41 ER, 87.2 IP) with 31 walks and 93 strikeout, but...DID YOU KNOW?... today's outing against the Rockies will be Woo's first career Cactus League start?...Bryan has made only 1 other Cactus League appearance in his career, a scoreless 2.0 IP relief outing on March 16, 2023 vs. San Francisco with 2 strikeouts.

2024 Spring Training - Is making first appearance this spring.

- The Totals Went 4-5 with a 4.21 ERA (41 ER, 87.2 IP), 31 walks and 93 strikeouts in 18 starts.
- Major League Debut Made his MLB debut on June 3 at Texas...became the 2nd top 10 Mariners prospect to debut.
- In The Win Column Earned his 1st career win on June 22 against the New York Yankees...he carried a no-hitter into the 6th inning before giving up a 1-out single to Gleyber Torres...became the 5th Mariners pitcher to carry a no-hitter into the 6th inning.
- · August Review Finished the month of August with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER, 16.0 IP) and allowed just 4 walks with 14 strikeouts in 3 games started...his 1.69 ERA was the 5th best in MLB among pitchers who made at least 2 starts during the month.
- Among Mariners Greats His 93 strikeouts were 5th-most in Mariners history in a pitcher's first 18 career starts, trailing only Michael Pineda (113), Félix Hernández (112), George Kirby (102) and Logan Gilbert (97).
- Woo Hoo! In his first three starts of September he recorded a 2.87 ERA (5 ER, 15.2 IP) with 7 walks and 14 strikeouts...opponents were held to a .190 (11x58) batting average and he allowed just 3 extra-base hits...included in those three starts were two scoreless outings from Sept. 12-18 where he threw 10.2 innings and allowed just 7 hits and 4 walks while striking out 14 batters.
