THE TWINS: After completing their second roadtrip of the season with a record of 1-3 at Kauffman Stadium, the Twins began their second homestand of 2025 by going 1-2 against the Tigers over the weekend...tonight, the Twins will welcome the Mets for three games through Wednesday afternoon.

☞ Twins are looking for consecutive wins for just the second time this season, their previous being wins over the White Sox at Rate Field on April 1 and 2.

☞ Twins enter tonight having gone 0-5 in series openers this season...Minnesota has been outscored 13-30 (-17) in series openers.

☞ The Twins are playing just their fourth IL game of the season tonight, their other series was a three-game sweep in St. Louis

TWINS TAME TIGERS IN FINALE: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-1, avoiding the three-game sweep...Simeon Woods Richardson (1-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...Louis Varland (1.0), Cole Sands (1.0), Griffin Jax (1.0) and Jhoan Duran (1.0) all combined for 4.0 no-hit innings of relief, with one walk and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, two apiece from Byron Buxton, Willi Castro and Ty France...Buck hit his third home run of the season and Edouard Julien hit his first...Minnesota struck out just three times, matching their season-low (March 29 at STL).

BIG APPLE PLAY: The Twins and Mets are playing each other for the 29th, 30th and 31st times in their history this week...Minnesota is 11-17 all-time vs. the Mets, going 3-3 at Shea Stadium, 3-0 at the Metrodome, 3-8 at Citi Field, 2-6 at Target Field.

☞ These two last met for a three game series at Citi Field from July 29-31, 2024 as the Twins lost the first two and won game three...they were outscored 10-20 in the series.

☞ Last time these two met at Target Field was from September 8-10, 2023, as Minnesota won the first two games and lost the third...Twins outscored the Mets 13-8 in that series.

☞ Mets pitching coach, Jeremy Hefner, spent three seasons with Minnesota as the club's assistant pitching coach in 2019 and as an advance scout from 2017-18.

BUCK NATIONAL: Since the start of 2024, Byron Buxton has hit .299 (38-for-127) with four doubles, 10 home runs, 22 RBI, a .567 slugging percentage and a .915 OPS in 34 games against the NL...below is where Buck ranks in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play:

POWER IS BACK ON: After starting the season with just six home runs in their first 11 games (thru April 8), the Twins have hit six homers in their last five games (since April 9)...in games through April 8, the Twins were tied with three other teams for the fewest homers in baseball...since April 9, they are tied for fifth-most homers in baseball.

ED COUNT: Edouard Julien has hit safely in six-straight games, the longest by a Twin this season...below are his offensive comparisons over his first six games and his last eight games:

IEFFEL POWER: Ty France is hitting .440 (11-for-25) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, a .500 on-base percentage, a .760 slugging percentage and a 1.260 OPS in his last seven games...among players with a minimum of 60 plate appearances this season, France ranks tied for 14th in the AL in batting average and 16th in OPS.

☞ He ranks in the 97th percentile in baseball in strikeout percentage (6.5%).

☞ He is hitting .357 (5-for-14) off breaking pitches.

UNMATCHED WILL: Willi Castro has reached base safely in all 15 of his games played, tied for fourth-longest active on-base streak in baseball with Kyle Schwarber and Fernando Tatis Jr., trailing Kyle Tucker (17), Kristian Campbell (16) and Corbin Carroll (16).

☞ It marks the longest on-base streak for a Twin to start a season since 2018, when Brian Dozier reached in his first 17.

OPENING ACTS: In their first 10 games of the season, the Twins starting staff went 1-5, 6.90 ERA (45.2 IP, 35 ER), with 17 walks, 42 strikeouts, a .314 opponent batting average and 11 home runs allowed...in their last six starts, since last Tuesday, they have combined to go 2-1, 0.84 ERA (32.1 IP, 3 ER), with five walks, 28 strikeouts, a .174 opponent batting average and one home run allowed.

OUR SOTO > YOUR SOTO?: Low-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Charlee Soto has been named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week...Soto, 19, started for the Kernels on Friday vs. Beloit, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and six strikeouts...the Philadelphia, PA native was drafted by the Twins in the first round (34th overall) of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of Reborn Christian Academy in Kissimmee, FL...Soto is ranked as the club's eighth-best prospect by MLB.com and ninth-best by *Baseball America*.

- ☞ Making his fourth start of 2025 and 88th of his career...earned the victory in his last start, pitching 7.0 scoreless innings in Kansas City on April 9 (2 H, 0 BB, 4 K).
- ☞ Facing the New York Mets for the first time in his career...in 2024, went 1-2 in Interleague matchups.
- ☞ Since the start of 2024, is 5-4 with a 4.14 ERA (71.2 IP, 33 ER) in 12 starts at Target Field...has allowed 12 home runs with 10 walks and 77 strikeouts.

- ☞ Outing marked his 40th career quality start, leading active Twins (Pablo López trails Ryan with 39 career QS)...is just the fourth pitcher in franchise history to pitch 40 quality starts in less than 500 innings.
- ☞ Has not walked a batter since the seventh inning of his August 2, 2024 start vs. the White Sox...he is the only pitcher in baseball yet to walk a batter (among anyone with 15+ innings)...is the first Twins starter without a walk in four-or-more outings since Bailey Ober did so from July 18-August 4, 2023.

- ☞ TWO STARTS AGO: On April 3, took the loss vs. Houston at Target Field, his first loss at Target Field since May 16, 2024 vs. New York-AL...allowed four runs on five hits and struck out five over 5.0 innings...surrendered back-to-back home runs to Christian Walker and Jeremy Peña in the second inning, the first time in his career yielding back-to-back homers at Target Field.
- ☞ Struck out Jose Altuve, Isaac Paredes and Yordan Alvarez to start the game, becoming the first-Twins starter to strikeout the side in the opening inning of the home opener.
- ☞ His four runs and five hits were his most allowed since July 21, 2024 vs. Milwaukee (6.0 IP, 7 H, 4 ER)...has not given up multiple home runs in an outing since April 24, 2024 vs. Chicago-AL.

MEET THE METS: Is making his first career start against New York-NL, one of three teams Ryan has yet to face in his career (also, Philadelphia and Miami)...in 2024, went 1-2 with a 4.32 ERA (33.1 IP, 16 ER, 4 HR) in six interleague starts, walking seven and striking out 33...of the 26 home runs he's allowed against the National League in his career, just four were hit at Target Field.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Is making his second start of the season at Target Field...took the loss in his first home outing of the season on April 3 vs. Houston, allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts over 5.0 innings...in 2024, made 11 starts at home, going 5-3 with a 3.92 ERA (66.2 IP, 29 ER) and a 7.10 strikeouts-per-walk ratio...in his career, is 19-13 in 44 starts at Target Field, posting a 3.79 ERA (251.2 IP, 106 ER) with 37 home runs, a 1.03 WHIP and a 5.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

☞ His 293 career strikeouts at Target Field ranks third all-time among Twins pitchers, trails Kyle Gibson (417) and Jose Berrios (411); also, his 19 wins trail only Gibson (32), Berrios (32), and Brian Duensing (20).

HITTING HIS TARGET: Ryan has struck out five-or-more batters in 21 consecutive home starts, dating back to June 4, 2023 vs. Cleveland (4K)...in his career, has recorded four-or-fewer strikeouts in just six of his 44 home starts...has only allowed five-or-more runs in four home starts, the most recent coming on July 9, 2023 vs. Baltimore; the Twins are 0-4 in those starts and 17-6 in Ryan's 23 starts at home allowing 2 runs or less.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: So far in 2025, lefties have slashed .174/.208/.174 with two strikeouts against Ryan while righties have slashed .216/.275/.405 with two home runs and 13 strikeouts...in 2024, left-handed hitters slashed .203/.243/.373 with nine home runs, 11 walks and 61 strikeouts in 255 plate appearances, while right-handed hitters slashed .229/.269/.425 with 10 home runs, 12 walks and 86 strikeouts in 283 plate appearances.

☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .206 (178-for-866) with a .624 OPS...righties are .238 (230-for-968) with a .731 OPS.

THE ARSENAL: In his three starts of 2025, Ryan's pitch repertoire is as follows, per Baseball Savant:

☞ So far this season, his slider is yielding the highest whiff (50%) while his splitter leads his other pitches in put-away rate (25%).
