THE TWINS: Began the post-All-Star break portion of their schedule with consecutive losses to the Rockies at Coors Field and finished the weekend with a win on Sunday in Denver...tonight, they will begin a three-game series at Los Angeles against the Dodgers through Wednesday. **✦** Twins are seeking back-to-back road wins for the first time since June 19 at Cincinnati and June 27 at Detroit.

DENVER, CO-LEW-RADO: The Twins beat the Rockies on Sunday afternoon at Coors Field by a score of 7-1, avoiding the three-game sweep...Joe Ryan (10-4) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with no walks and a season-high tying 11 strikeouts (also, 4/27 vs. LAA)...Ryan's start marked his 11th career double-digit strikeout total, tying Francisco Liriano and Jose Berrios for seventh-most in club history...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from Christian Vazquez, setting a season-high...Royce Lewis homered twice for his first career regular season multi-homer game, doubling his season total from two to four...Matt Wallner also added a home run, his 11th on the season.

INGLEWOOD ALWAYS UP TO NO GOOD: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 26th, 27th and 28th times in their history this week...the Twins are 8-17 all-time vs. Los Angeles...in the regular season, Minnesota is 2-9 all-time at Dodger Stadium, 3-8 at Target Field and 3-0 at Metrodome. **✦** The Twins .320 winning percentage against LA is their second-lowest vs. any opponent in their history (since 1961), trailing Atlanta (.286 — 8-20). **✦** These two last faced each other for three games at Target Field from April 8-10, 2024 as the Twins lost the first two and won game three. **✦** The Twins last played in Dodger Stadium for three games from May 15-17, 2023, winning just the middle of the three games. **✦** Byron Buxton has hit safely in seven-straight games vs. the Dodgers, dating back to August of 2022...in that span, he is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with two doubles, two home runs, five RBI, two walks and a 1.008 OPS...he has hit safely in all four career games at Dodger Stadium, hitting .412 (7-for-17) with two doubles, two home runs and a 1.356 OPS...he started for the AL (Trout replacement) in the All-Star Game here in 2022, homering off Tony Gonsolin. **✦** Carlos Correa has an .805 OPS in 27 career regular and Postseason games against the Dodgers, including six home runs and 13 RBI...he won the 2017 World Series in this ballpark. **✦** Willi Castro has hit safely in all four career games at Dodger Stadium, hitting .357 (5-for-14). **✦** Matt Wallner started the Futures Game at Dodger Stadium in 2022, batting fifth and playing rightfield...he went 1-for-2 with a two-run homer off Kyle Harrison.

STADIUM ARCADIUUM: In the regular season, Minnesota is 2-9 all-time against the Dodgers at Dodger Stadium...including the Postseason, the Twins are 2-12 all-time at Dodger Stadium, going 0-3 in this ballpark during the 1965 World Series. **✦** The Twins first win at Dodger Stadium came on June 11, 2005, a 5-3 victory as Carlos Silva beat Derek Lowe...Justin Morneau and Torii Hunter both homered for the Twins in that game as Morneau had four RBI. **✦** Their other win was on May 16, 2023, a 5-1 victory as Bailey Ober beat Clayton Kershaw...Twins had 11 hits, including a home run from Kyle Farmer...Byron Buxton and Willi Castro each had two hits.

NATIONAL NEWS: Twins have gone 14-19 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10), 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13) and 1-2 at Colorado (July 18-20). **✦** Twins have four NL teams still to play (after the Dodgers): Nationals (July 25-27), Padres (August 29-31), D-Backs (September 12-14) and Phillies (September 26-28).

VIDEO GAME BUCK: Over his last 31 games, Buxton is hitting .339 (40-for-118) with eight doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 19 RBI, 29 runs scored, 10 walks, a .400 on-base percentage, a .729 slugging percentage and a 1.129 OPS. **✦** At 17 stolen bases, Buck needs three more to become the seventh different Twin (8th overall time) to join the 20/20 club...the others are Kirby Puckett (1986), Brian Dozier (2014), Corey Koskie (2001), Torii Hunter (2002 & 2004), Larry Hise (1977) and Marty Cordova (1995).

C4, IGNITING: Carlos Correa finished the Rockies series reaching base eight times in 13 plate appearances (5 walks, 3 hits)...he has now reached safely in nine of his last 10 games...over his last 24 games, Correa is hitting .337 (29-for-86) with five doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, nine walks, a .400 on-base percentage, a .465 slugging percentage and an .865 OPS. **✦** Over his last nine road games, he is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with six walks, a .432 on-base percentage and an .884 OPS.

OH JEEZ, PRETTY COOL: On this day in 2024, Joe Mauer was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame, along with Todd Helton, Adrian Beltré and Jim Leyland...Mauer became the third catcher elected to HOF on first ballot (Johnny Bench, Ivan Rodriguez)...he also became the fourth player to make HOF after being drafted first overall (Ken Griffey Jr., Chipper Jones, Harold Baines).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his career-high third win of the season in his start on July 9 vs. the Cubs opposite Cade Horton, a 4-2 Twins victory...allowed two runs on three hits, with two walks and a season-low tying three strikeouts over 5.1 innings of work...faced one batter over the minimum through three innings...loaded the bases with one out in the fourth on a single and two walks; an RBI single by Dansy Swanson scored Kyle Tucker and an RBI groundout by Nico Hoerner scored Seiya Suzuki...retired the last six batters he faced in order.

☞ Has not allowed a home run in six of his 10 major league outings this season; in 2024, he allowed a home run in seven of his 14 outings.

☞ The fourth inning marked just the third time all season in which Festa has loaded the bases, also April 11 vs. Detroit and June 22 vs. Milwaukee.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss in his start on July 3 at Miami opposite Eury Pérez, a 4-1 Twins defeat...allowed four runs on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and seven strikeouts over 6.0 innings of work...seven strikeouts tied his professional season high and set a new major league season high...6.0 innings tied his season and career high...allowed back-to-back singles to start the first inning, followed by an RBI groundout by Otto Lopez and a two-run home run by Agustín Ramirez...in the third, Xavier Edwards singled, stole second and scored on Jesús Sánchez's RBI single...one pitch later, Sánchez stole second; was then thrown out by Festa trying to steal third.

☞ Was his fourth career game and second this season allowing multiple stolen bases...of the four games, was the only in which he also caught a runner stealing...marked the first time in his career throwing out a runner at third base (3 career CS).

EAST COAST-WEST COAST: The Verona, New Jersey native is facing the Dodgers for the first time in his career...earned the win in his lone career outing against the National League West on June 27, 2024 in Arizona; allowed five runs on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and two strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work.

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: Is making his third consecutive start against the National League...in five Interleague games (4 starts) this season, is 1-2 with a 6.00 ERA (24.0 IP, 16 ER), three home runs, 10 walks and 23 strikeouts...NL batters are hitting .281 (27-for-96) with a .358 on-base percentage and a .764 OPS against Festa this season.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In four road starts this season, is 1-2 with a 6.63 ERA (19.0 IP, 14 ER), four home runs, six walks and 23 strikeouts, compared to 2-1 with a 4.34 ERA (29.0 IP, 14 ER), three home runs, 12 walks and 25 strikeouts in six home games (5 starts)...in 10 career road starts, is 3-4 with a 4.78 ERA (49.0 IP, 26 ER), six home runs allowed, 14 walks and 59 strikeouts; Twins are 5-5.

➤ Is pitching in the state of California for the second time in his big league career...took the loss in his start against the Athletics in Sacramento on June 5, 2025, allowing eight runs on six hits (3 HR), with two walks and six strikeouts over 3.2 innings of work.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties are hitting .222 (20-for-90) with four doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, 10 walks and 24 strikeouts against Festa, while righties are hitting .266 (25-for-94) with two doubles, five home runs, 13 RBI, eight walks and 24 strikeouts...in his career, lefties are slashing .229/.314/.376 with six home runs, 23 walks and 62 strikeouts in 210 at-bats, while righties are slashing .262/.323/.453 with ten home runs, 18 walks and 63 strikeouts in 225 at-bats.

THE ARSENAL: Through 10 major league appearances (9 starts) in 2025, Festa has relied on a four-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

☛ So far this year (801 pitches), Festa has a 29.8 percent chase rate, a 27.5 percent whiff rate, a 40.9 percent hard-hit rate and an average exit velocity of 90.2 mph...batters are striking out 23.2 percent of the time and walking 8.7 percent of the time.

CHANGE(UP) IS A GOOD THING: 23 of Festa's 48 strikeouts at the major league level this season have come via his changeup...on 231 changeups this season, he is inducing whiffs 43.3 percent of the time with a strikeout rate of 38.3%...among pitchers with 200-or-more changeups thrown this season, his strikeout rate ranks fourth and his whiff rate ranks sixth.

TRUE OUTCOMES: Festa's 125 strikeouts through his first 24 career games are the third most by a Twins pitcher in that span, trailing Joe Ryan (129 K) and Bert Blyleven (128 K)...among the five Twins pitchers that have recorded 115-or-more strikeouts through their first 24 career games, Festa's 16 home runs allowed are the fewest while his 41 walks are the second most behind Boof Bonser (44).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2025: 5-4, 3.95 ERA // CAREER: 10-10, 4.20 ERA)

Right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start tomorrow night's game against the Dodgers in Los Angeles...last started on July 13 vs. Pittsburgh but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 loss; allowed one run on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts over 4.2 innings...is facing the Dodgers for the first time in his career...in seven road games (6 starts) this season, is 1-2 with a 4.96 ERA (32 IP, 18 ER), six home runs allowed, 16 walks and 29 strikeouts.
