The Brewers are on pace for 98 wins, which would break the regular season franchise record of 96 accomplished in 2011 (96-66) and 2018 (96-67).

St. Louis Blues
The Brewers surrendered 15 runs to the Cardinals in last night's 15-4 loss.....it tied for the most runs ever allowed to the Cardinals in franchise history.....the Brewers also allowed 15 runs in a 15-2 loss on 4/16/03 at American Family Field.....the Brewers allowed 6 HR last night, tying the franchise record against the Cardinals.....the team also allowed 6 HR in an 11-2 loss 4/9/00 at old Busch Stadium.

Rising From the Ashes
Aaron Ashby made his Major League debut on 6/30 vs. Chicago-NL and allowed 7 runs (4er) on 4 hits in just two-thirds of an inning (3bb, Ok)..... since that outing, Ashby has gone 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA in 5 games / 3 starts (17.1ip, 11h, 4r, 4er, 3bb, 17k).

Darth Hader
Josh Hader is unscored upon in his last 11 outings (10.1ip, 4h, 3bb, 19k).

What's in the Box?!
Brad Boxberger has a 0.74 ERA over his last 25 appearances (24.1ip, 2er), including 10 consecutive scoreless outings (9.2ip).

Citizen Cain
In his last 30 games, Lorenzo Cain is batting .300 (30-for-100) with 4 HR and 20 RBI.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 36-30 at home, going 10-9-2 in series play.....had season-high 7-game home winning streaks from 6/3-6/13 and 6/25-7/8.....had a season-high 5-game home losing streak from 7/9-7/21.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 46-24 on the road, going 17-4-1 in series play.....had a season-high 8-game road winning streak from 7/7-7/30.....had a season-high 5-game road losing streak from 5/3-5/7.....are 1 win away from tying the franchise record for wins on the road set by the 1982 team (47-33).

ALL-STARs: The Brewers were represented at the All-Star Game by Corbin Burnes, Josh Hader, Freddy Peralta, Brandon Woodruff and Omar Narváez.....the five players selected tied a franchise record, all consecutively (also 2018 and 2019).....it marked the first time in franchise history that the team had three or more pitchers selected.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as manager (516-466) and sixth full season.....he is second in franchise history in wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617).....under Counsell, the Brewers made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history (2018-20).....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsay (3rd season), third base coach Jason Lane (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach Quintin Berry.

TONIGHT’S STARTER: #37 - RHP ADRIAN HOUSER (23g, 21gs, 7-6, 3.69)

HOUSER AT A GLANCE: Adrian Houser, 28, will make his 24th appearance and 22nd start....it will be his second start against the Cardinals....he last started last Saturday at Minnesota and took a 6-4 loss (5ip, 6h, 5r, 5er, 3bb, 4k, 2hbp, 94 pitches)....the team is 14-7 in his starts....he has 4 quality starts....opponents are batting .239 (99-for-414, 11hr)....he was on the injured list (COVID-19) from 8/7-8/21....Houser was acquired from Houston with LHP Josh Hader, OF Brett Phillips and OF Domingo Santana for OF Carlos Gómez, RHP Mike Fiers and International Signing Bonus Slot #76 on 7/30/15.

YO ADRIAN! I DID IT! On 5/8 at Miami, Houser became the 15th pitcher (17x) in the Modern Era (since 1900) to hit a home run, walk nobody and have 10+ strikeouts in a game.

CAREER: Is 14-19 with a 3.96 ERA in 79 games / 50 starts (295.1ip, 130er)....is in his fifth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2015, 2018-21)....is 9-19 with a 4.44 ERA as a starter (241ip, 119er) and 5-0 with a 1.82 ERA in relief (54.1ip, 11er).....underwent “Tommy John” surgery on his right elbow on 7/21/16.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 4-9 with a 3.53 ERA in 39 games / 23 starts (135ip, 53er)....is 2-3 with a 2.96 ERA in 12 games / 10 starts this season (54.2ip, 18er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 10-10 with a 4.32 ERA in 40 games / 27 starts (180.1ip, 77er)....is 5-3 with a 4.37 ERA in 11 starts this season (57.2ip, 28er).

CAREER vs. CARDINALS: Is 2-2 with a 3.76 ERA in 8 games / 5 starts (26.1ip, 11er), including a 9-5 win this season on 4/10 at Busch Stadium (5ip, 6h, 1r, 0er, 4bb, 3k, 1wp).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .070 hitter (4-for-57) with 2 HR and 2 RBI....has 3 walks and 43 strikeouts....has 5 sacrifice bunts.
