WEDNESDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles took the rubber match from the Red Sox, 6-1...**Corbin Burnes** tied a season high with 7.0 innings, allowing one unearned run, while **Gunnar Henderson** hit his second career grand slam in the second inning to tie for the MLB homer lead...The blast went 422 feet, tying his longest of the year.
☞ Henderson homered for the 50th time in his career.
☞ Burnes secured his 50th career win.
☞ **James McCann** scored his 300th run as a Major Leaguer.

WE DO BASEBALL HERE: Oriole Park at Camden Yards has drawn 764,016 fans to begin this season, up 27 percent from 602,069 during the first 30 games last year...The 27 percent increase is the second-biggest jump in the league behind the defending NL Champion Arizona Diamondbacks...The average attendance of 25,467 in 2024 is up from 20,069 in 2023.

MONTHLY DUES: With a winning record in May, the O's have now been above .500 in eight consecutive full months since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the team (min. 10 games played in the month) since May 1982 through September 1983, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*... Atlanta currently has the longest such streak in the majors at 11 (since June 2022), but it will end as the Braves enter today 12-14 in May this season.

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** is tied for the MLB lead with 18 home runs with New York-AL's Aaron Judge and Houston's Kyle Tucker...Henderson is the fifth player in MLB history age 22 or younger to homer at least 18 times in their team's first 54 games to start a season, joining Seattle's **Alex Rodriguez** in 1998 (20), Washington Senators' **Harmon Killebrew** in 1959 (19), Milwaukee Braves' **Eddie Mathews** in 1953 (19), and Washington's **Bryce Harper** in 2015 (18), per MLB's Sarah Langs (@SlangsonSports)...Henderson's blast on Wednesday was his 50th career home run...He ranks among MLB leaders in a variety of categories (see chart at right).

☞ In his 238th game, Henderson is the second-fastest player to begin their career as an Oriole to reach 50 career homers behind **Ryan Mountcastle** (231 G) and the ninth-fastest to reach 50 home runs in an O's uniform overall, joining Mountcastle, Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Frank Robinson** (157), **Mark Trumbo** (190), **Chris Davis** (216), **Rafael Palmeiro** (218), **Miguel Tejada** (219), **Albert Belle** (224), and Orioles Hall of Famer **Jim Gentile** (230); he's the fourth player in O's history to hit 50 career home runs before turning 23, joining **Manny Machado**, Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Eddie Murray**, and Orioles Hall of Famer **Boog Powell**.

START ME UP: On the season, O's starters have a 3.03 ERA (101 ER/300.0 IP), the third-best rotation ERA in MLB behind the Phillies (2.68) and Yankees (2.73)...Since April 29, the rotation's ERA is 2.28 (38 ER/150.0 IP), second-best in MLB during that time behind the Yankees (2.18).

THE ERAS TOUR: The O's have a 2.792 ERA (76 ER/245.0 IP) in their last 27 games since April 29, the third-best mark in MLB behind the Yankees (2.44) and Phillies (2.788)...During that time, the Birds have surrendered an MLB-low 175 hits.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles rank second in MLB with 79 home runs behind the Yankees (84), the fourth-most homers through the first 54 games of a season in O's history behind 1996 (85), 1987 (84), and 2016 (80); the most homers through Baltimore's first 55 games of a season is 87 by the 1996 team.
☞ The Orioles have six players with at least seven homers, the most in MLB: **Gunnar Henderson** (18), **Adley Rutschman** (10), **Anthony Santander** (9), and **Jordan Westburg** (8), and **Colton Cowser** and **Ryan O'Hearn** (7).

LEADING ACTORS: Baltimore leads MLB with six leadoff homers this season...**Gunnar Henderson** has hit five of those, tied with Philadelphia's **Kyle Schwarber** for the most in MLB this year, and tied for the fifth-most in a single season in O's history...**Jordan Westburg** has the other for the O's...Since the start of 2021, the Orioles have 23 leadoff blasts, ranked fourth in the AL and tied for eighth in MLB.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue a six-game homestand tonight with the first of three games against the Rays...Baltimore went 2-1 against the Red Sox from Monday through Wednesday before a scheduled off day yesterday...The O's are 19-11 (.633) at home, the fourth-best home winning percentage in the AL and tied for the fifth-best in MLB this season...The Birds are 68-43 (.613) at Oriole Park since the start of 2023, the best home winning percentage in the AL and fourth-best in MLB during that time.

RAYS UP: Baltimore and Tampa Bay meet for the first three of 13 games against each other this weekend at Camden Yards...The O's went 8-5 (.615) against the Rays last season, the best record against their AL East rival since 2016 (.684, 13-6)...The Birds will travel to Tropicana Field from June 7-10 (4 G) and August 9-11 (3 G) before the teams complete their regular season series in Baltimore from September 6-8 (3 G).
☞ Of the 13 games in 2023, two games went to extra innings while five games were decided by one run and three were determined by two runs; three games were won in the final at bat for the O's, including two walk-off victories.

AL BEAST: The Orioles have gone 18 straight sets against AL East opponents without a series loss, while going 13-0-5 in series during that time...That is the longest such streak in team history since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The O's are 39-19 (.672) overall against division opponents since the streak began on April 24, 2023...The O's went 32-20 (.615) against the AL East last year, the second-best winning percentage against the division by the team since 1981 behind the .618 (47-29) mark in 2014...The Birds won the season series against the Blue Jays (10-3), Rays (8-5), Red Sox (7-6), and Yankees (7-6), the first time since 2014 that the Orioles won the season series against each of their division opponents.
☞ Baltimore is 9-3 (.750) against AL East opponents this season, the best record by any team against its own division in 2024.

NEED FOR SPEED: **Cedric Mullins** ranks eighth in Orioles history with 104 career stolen bases; next on the list is **Don Baylor** (118)...**Jorge Mateo** is tied with **Melvin Mora** for 13th in team history with 82 stolen bases as an Oriole; next on the list is **Don Buford** (85).

☞ The Orioles are one of five teams with multiple players with double-digit stolen bases this year, along with the Nationals (4), Phillies and Royals (3), and Reds (2).
☞ Since the start of the 2022 season, the Orioles are the only team in MLB with multiple players with 60+ stolen bases; Mateo has 77 and Mullins has 64.

SCORING CHANGE: In the top of the fourth inning on May 27 vs. Boston, **Colton Cowser** reached base on what was originally scored an error on second baseman Vaughn Grissom...This has been changed to a base hit...As a result, Cowser's run that inning is now earned to Red Sox starter Cooper Criswell.

CITY CONNECT FRIDAYS: The Orioles will wear their City Connect jerseys at each Friday home game throughout the regular season...This year, every City Connect Friday will be dedicated to a Baltimore City public school...To learn more, visit Orioles.com/CityConnect.

☞ The O's own a 7-9 record when wearing their City Connect uniforms (5-8 in all black, 2-1 in black jerseys/white pants).

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 350 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his fifth start and 12th appearance of the season tonight against the Rays...Went 4-7 with a 3.92 ERA (47 ER/108.0 IP) for the Samsung Lions last year...Allowed 129 hits (3 HR) and 88 strikeouts in 19 Korean Baseball Organization appearances...Became a free agent following his release from the Lions due to a calf injury...Made 11 starts with the Venezuelan Winter League before signing with the O's; went 4-2 with a 3.79 ERA (23 ER/54.2 IP) with 62 hits (3 HR) and 24 strikeouts in 11 starts... Signed by the Orioles to a minor league contract on October 12, 2023... Began the season with Triple-A Norfolk...Originally signed by Tampa Bay as an international free agent on July 2, 2006.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on May 25 at Chicago-AL... Tossed 4.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits and two walks with three strikeouts...Marked his third scoreless start of the season...Threw 80 pitches, 50 strikes.

RAYS OF SUNSHINE: Making his second career start against his former organization...Did not factor into the decision in his only outing against the Rays on June 18, 2016 at Tropicana Field (w/SF)...Allowed three runs on five hits (3 HR) and two walks with four strikeouts across 4.2 innings...The three home runs surrendered are a career high.

BEAST OF THE AL EAST: Facing the AL East for the sixth time in his career... Owns a lifetime 1-0 record with a 5.29 ERA (10 ER/17.0 IP)...Will mark his first appearance against the division since July 20, 2016 at Boston (w/SF).

DAY 'N' NITE: Owns a 3-6 record with a 4.55 ERA (43 ER/85.0 IP) in 31 career night appearances (8 GS) compared to a 2-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (20 ER/60.0 IP) in 20 lifetime appearances (8 GS) during the day.

HOME SWEET HOME: Has posted a 2.63 ERA (4 ER/13.2) across five appearances (2 GS) at Oriole Park this season...Opponents are slashing .241/.268/.389 (13-for-54).

SIGH OF RELIEF: Has posted a 1-0 record with a 0.90 ERA (1 ER/10.0 IP) in seven relief outings this season compared to a 1-0 record with a 1.86 ERA (4 ER/19.1 IP) in four starts.

MR. WORLDWIDE: Pitched three seasons with the Yakult Swallows in Nippon Professional Baseball from 2019-2021...Owns a lifetime 10-8 record with a 3.00 ERA (54 ER/162. IP) and 134 strikeouts in 40 appearances with the Swallows...Also played for Samsung in the KBO for the 2022 and 2023 campaigns; posted a 3.04 ERA (95 ER/281.2 IP) across 49 appearances (48 GS) with the Lions.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the season with Samsung...Did not allow a run in three straight starts (19.0 IP) from July 4-25...Tossed 8.0 scoreless innings on four hits and four walks with four strikeouts on July 25 vs. Kia.

Scheduled to make his sixth start of the season and sixth career start against the Rays...Earned his first win of the year in his last time out on May 26 at Chicago-NL; tossed 7.0 no-hit innings, allowing four walks with a career-high-tying 11 strikeouts...Marked the longest no-hit bid of his career...Owns a lifetime 1-3 record with a 6.18 ERA (19 ER/27.2 IP) across five starts against Tampa Bay; is 1-2 with a 4.00 ERA (8 ER/18.0 IP) in his last three outings since the start of 2023.
