**BIRDLAND BITES:** Baltimore opened a six-game homestand yesterday against Philadelphia (1-0, 2 to play) and Los Angeles-AL (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a brief three-game road trip in Detroit, taking two of three from the Tigers...The Orioles have won 15 of 23 games since July 1 and are 10.5 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 1.5 games back in the Wild Card.

⚾ The Orioles earned their 26<sup>th</sup> come-from-behind victory, their 10<sup>th</sup> when trailing through six innings, and their second such win in as many games...The 10 such wins are tied for third in the majors with the Rockies, trailing the Brewers and Phillies (both 11).

⚾ **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** knotted the game, 4-4, with a pinch-hit, two-run double in the seventh frame...Marked his second career base knock as a pinch hitter, joining a three-run home run on July 18, 2023 vs. San Francisco.

⚾ **Gunnar Henderson** put the O's ahead, 6-4, with a two-out triple in the seventh frame...It marked his first multi-RBI performance since June 19 at Los Angeles-NL, snapping a 32-game streak with one or no RBI.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Following last night's game, the Orioles acquired minor league **OF Jhomnardo Reyes** from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for **RHP Dean Kremer**...Earlier today, **RHP Yamil Hiraldo** was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk.

⚾ Reyes, an 18-year old, left-handed hitting outfielder, is now ranked as the Orioles' No. 20 prospect according to *MLB Pipeline*.

**PINCH ME:** The Orioles lead all of MLB with 25 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (21) and Braves and Mets (both 20).

⚾ **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season while **Samuel Basallo**, **Colton Cowser**, **Christian Encarnacion-Strand**, **Jackson Holliday**, **Tyler O'Neill**, and **Adley Rutschman** are all tied for second with two pinch-hit RBI each.

⚾ The 25 pinch-hit RBI are the most by the Orioles since 1999 (also 25)...An O's club has not had more than 25 pinch-hit RBI in a season since 1991 (30).

**JULY HEAT:** The Birds finished July 15-8 (.652), the team's best record in a month since May and April 2024 (both .654, 17-9).

⚾ The only MLB team to own a better record than the Orioles in the month of July was the Boston Red Sox, who posted a 21-4 (.840) record.

⚾ The .652 winning percentage marked the Orioles' seventh-best July finish in franchise history (since 1954), trailing 1983 (.731), 1977 (.714), 1998 (.692), 2014 (.680), 1966 (.655), and 2023 (.654).

**WALKING IT OUT:** Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 101 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Mets (43 G).

⚾ Baltimore has secured a walk in 101 straight games for the sixth time in franchise history (since 1954)...The O's drew 1+ walk in a franchise-record 172 games from July 2, 2024-July 12, 2025.

⚾ The current 101-game stretch is the third-longest single-season streak in team history (since 1954), trailing streaks of 112 games (1995) and 104 games (1975).

⚾ **Taylor Ward** has 86 walks this season, 24 more than an Oriole had in 2025 and eight more than the team leader had in 2024...The last O's player with more than 80 walks in a season was **Adley Rutschman** (92 BB) in 2023...An Oriole has not reached 100 free passes in a season since Albert Belle (101) in 1999.

⚾ The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

⚾ Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 429 walks.

**HOLLIDAY SEASON:** In 23 July games, **Jackson Holliday** slashed .368/.500/.421 (21-for-57) with three doubles, nine runs, six RBI, and 16 walks against 11 strikeouts...The 16 walks were third most in the AL during July, trailing teammate **Taylor Ward** (20) and HOU's Yordan Alvarez (17), and ranked tied for seventh in the majors.

⚾ Holliday owns a 14.9 percent walk rate (28 BB/188 PA) across 58 games this season after recording an 8.6 percent clip (56 BB/649 PA) in 2025.

**NOT A PHAIR PHIGHT:** **Taylor Ward** has gone 11-for-30 (.367) with four doubles, two homers, eight RBI, and four walks (1 IBB) in eight career games against Philadelphia.

⚾ **Pete Alonso** has played in a team-high 105 career games against the Phillies, owning an .825 OPS with 25 doubles and 19 homers, including his two-run blast in the first inning yesterday.

⚾ **Tyler O'Neill** owns a .953 OPS against Philadelphia after having homered five times in 15 career games against them.

**KITT AND KABOODLE:** **Andrew Kittredge** has gone a career-high 15 straight appearances without allowing an earned run, tied for the third-longest active streak in MLB behind COL's Brennan Bernardino (22 G) and MIL's Abner Uribe (16 G).

⚾ It is the longest such streak by an Oriole since Seranthony Domínguez's 15-game stretch from May 26-June 30, 2025...The last Oriole to not allow an earned run in at least 16 straight games was Cionel Pérez in 2023 (23 G).

**MAKING THEIR PITCH:** The O's have posted a 3.58 ERA in 59 games since May 24, the fourth-lowest mark in MLB behind the Yankees (3.26), Tigers (3.28), and Red Sox (3.40)...Entering that day, the Orioles had a 4.95 ERA in the first 51 games of the year, second worst in MLB ahead of the Astros (5.16).

⚾ The rotation has posted a 3.83 ERA since May 24, the seventh-best starter ERA in the majors during that time...Entering that day, O's starters had a 5.13 ERA, second worst in MLB ahead of the Rockies (5.55).

⚾ Orioles relievers have a 2.63 ERA since June 16, third lowest in the majors behind the Yankees (2.32) and Rays (2.62)...Entering that day, the team's bullpen ERA was 4.53, ranked ninth in the AL and 21<sup>st</sup> in MLB.

**HALL OF FAME:** This weekend, the Orioles will be honoring the newest members of the Orioles Hall of Fame including former first baseman **Chris Davis**, former right-handed pitcher **Storm Davis**, and late former scout **Jim Russo**...The inductees will be honored during an on-field ceremony prior to tonight's game against the Phillies at 7:05 p.m. ET.

**QUICK HITS:** Baz is scheduled to make his 22<sup>nd</sup> start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision on July 26 vs. Atlanta after throwing a season-low 4.1 innings, allowing two runs (1 ER) on six hits with two walks and two strikeouts...Threw 90 pitches, 55 strikes.  
⚡ Marked his shortest start since tossing 4.0 innings on September 24, 2025 at Baltimore.  
⚡ Has not permitted a home run in 32.0 straight innings since June 23, the fifth-longest active streak among all MLB starters.

**RINGING THE BELL:** Baz is set to make his third career start against the Phillies, having gone 0-1 with an 8.31 ERA (8 ER/8.2 IP).  
⚡ Last faced Philadelphia as a member of Tampa Bay on May 7, 2025 and took the loss, allowing six runs on eight hits (1 HR) and two walks with three strikeouts over 3.1 innings.

**ROUNDING INTO FORM:** Over his last 12 starts since May 20, Baz has posted a 3.06 ERA (24 ER/70.2 IP) and a 1.29 WHIP after recording a 5.26 ERA (30 ER/51.1 IP) and a 1.52 WHIP across his first nine outings.

**TIME FOR A TURN AROUND:** Despite posting a 3.83 ERA (17 ER/40.0 IP) over his last seven starts since June 18, he is 0-3 in those outings, with the Orioles going 1-6 in his starts.  
⚡ The Birds have lost 15 of his 21 starts this season...Only KC's Noah Cameron (5-16) has a worse team record in his starts (min. 15 GS).  
⚡ Tonight, Baz looks for his first victory since June 12 at Seattle and his first win at Camden Yards since May 26 vs. Tampa Bay.

**CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL:** In 27 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted nine home runs over 150.1 innings (0.54 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 26 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).  
⚡ He has allowed one or zero home runs in each of the 27 outings, the third-longest active streak among all MLB starters behind KC's Kris Bubic (35 G) and STL's Andre Pallante (34 G).  
⚡ Baz is the only Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to pitch at least 4.0 innings without allowing more than one home run in each of their first 21 starts with the team, surpassing the previous record held by Jim Hardin (19 GS, 1967-68).  
⚡ His 0.66 home runs per nine innings signal the lowest mark by an Orioles starter (min. 20 GS) since Kevin Gausman (0.56 HR/9.0 IP) in 2014.

**MAKE 'EM (UN)EARN IT:** Baz has allowed 10 unearned runs, tied for fourth most in the majors behind NYY's Will Warren (12) and NYM's Nolan McLean/MIN's Joe Ryan (both 11).

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 38 doubles, ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (32)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.  
⚡ He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his 21 starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.  
⚡ Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).  
⚡ His 35 doubles were the most allowed by an Oriole pitcher in the first half of the season in club history (since 1954), ahead of Rodrigo López (34, 2006).

**KNUCKLE SANDWICH:** After holding the opposition to a .184 (9-for-68) clip on his knuckle curveball in May, opponents went .283 (15-for-53) against the offering in June and 13-for-37 (.351) off it in July.

**FIRST INNING STRUGGLES:** Baz owns a 5.14 ERA (12 ER/21.0 IP) in the first inning while allowing nine walks and an .852 opponent OPS.  
⚡ He has, however, been scoreless in each of his last five first innings after allowing two runs on June 23 at Los Angeles-AL and three runs on June 18 at Seattle.  
⚡ From innings 2-4, he has posted a 3.14 ERA (22 ER/63.0 IP) with 16 walks and a .679 opponent OPS.

**TEEBING OFF EARLY:** Opponents are slashing .368/.377/.632 (25-for-68) with 12 doubles and two home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat...His 1.009 opponent OPS on the first pitch is 10<sup>th</sup> highest in MLB (min. 60 BF).
