TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and Rockies play game three of this four-game series here at Coors Field...the Giants are 9-5 against the Rockies this season, winning each of the last three matchups...both teams have played close games lately, with each of the last 11 being decided by three runs or fewer.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP Jharel Cotton (#47), acquired by the Giants on a waiver claim this past Sunday, has reported to the Major League Club today...in addition, **IF Jason Vosler** (#32) has been recalled from Triple-A Sacramento... **RHP Sean Hjelle** was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento postgame last night... **OF Lewis Brinson** was designated for assignment.

THE NEW GUY: RHP Jharel Cotton went 2-2 with 2.83 ERA (11er, 35.0ip) in 25 relief appearances for the Twins this year...he last pitched on Sept. 9 for the St. Paul Saints, the Triple-A affiliate of the Twins...he logged 25.0 innings for the Saints this season, going 4-1 with a 2.88 ERA in 22 games.

KEEPING SCORE...: When Cotton makes his Giants debut, he'll become the 63rd player used by SF in total this season, already the second-most in a single season in Giants history all-time according to *Stats, LLC*...only the 2019 club used more (64)...the 62 players used by SF are tied for third-most in the Majors this year with the Angels and Pirates...only the Reds (65) have used more.

MEET THE NEW GIANTS OWNER: Earlier this morning the Giants announced that **Buster Posey** has become a member of the team's ownership group, marking the first time in franchise history that a former player has joined the organization as a principal partner and member of the Board of Directors...Posey joins the San Francisco Baseball Associates LLC ownership group as the 31st principal partner.

LONG DIVISION: Each of the Giants' final 14 games will all come vs. NL West opponents...within the division, the Giants have gone 23-39 (.371) with a -35 run differential...the Giants have not played well against NL West opponents lately, going 7-25 (.219) within the division, beginning July 21.

THAIRO AND THE NL WEST: IF **Thairo Estrada** has played very well against Colorado this season, hitting .408 (20-for-49) with five doubles, one triple, one home run and 12 RBI in 13 games...in fact, he's played great against the NL West overall this year with a slash line of .332/.382/.522...according to *Stats, LLC*, the only Giants player to have a higher average against the division in the last five seasons was **Buster Posey** last year (.364).

AGAINST MARQUEZ: Tonight will mark the 16th career start for RHP Germán Márquez against the Giants...SF has tagged him for a 6.98 ERA in 15 starts...IF Brandon Crawford has had the most success of Marquez, going 11-for-34 (.324) with three extra base hits.

GIANTS PITCHING: San Francisco pitchers have posted a 3.88 ERA in 148 games overall this year, the sixth-best earned run average in the National League behind the Dodgers (2.79), Braves (3.45), Mets (3.51), Cardinals (3.79) and Padres (3.87).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Giants are 2-0 on this two-city, seven-game road trip to Denver and Arizona (Friday-Sunday)...San Francisco is 5-3 in eight games at Coors Field and 1-5 in six games at Chase Field this year...the Giants have posted a 32-41 on the road and have dropped 20 of 31 games on the road since the break.

LAST TIME OUT: Webb struggled against LA last time out at Oracle Park last Friday in the Giants 5-0 loss...he permitted four runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings with two walks and two strikeouts in his 90-pitch effort....in four starts against the Dodgers this year, Webb went 1-2 with a 5.57 ERA (13er, 21.0ip)...against all other opponents this year, Webb has gone 12-7 with a 2.68 ERA (48er, 161.0ip)

SETTING THE PACE: Webb's 13 wins are a career-best, surpassing his 11 from last season...he has already thrown a regular season career-high 182.0 innings this year, up from the 148.1 innings he threw last year...if you include last year's postseason starts though, Webb worked a total of 163.0 innings in 2021...his start today will be his 31st this year, also a career-high surpassing the 26 regular season starts he made last year.

A NICE RUN....: Over his last 18 starts dating to June 14, Webb has posted a 2.53 ERA (31er, 110.1ip) with 92 strikeouts and an opponents batting average against of .241...Webb himself has gone 8-7 in that time while the Giants have gone 8-10 as a team...his 2.53 ERA since June 14 is eighth-best in the Majors and fifth-best in the NL.

IT'S BEEN A MINUTE: Webb has totaled 182.0 innings and struck out 151 batters this year in what has been his age 25 season...the last Giants righthanded starter to pitch at least 182.0 innings and strike out at least 150 batters in his age 25 age season or younger was **Matt Cain**, who worked 223.1 innings and struck out 177 in his age 25 season in 2010.

VS. COLORADO: Has made two starts against the Rockies this year, one at home and one here at Coors...he's 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA (5er, 12.2ip) in the two outings...at his start here in mid-May he spun 7.0 innings and allowed only three runs on four hits but the Giants lost 5-3...in five career starts overall here at Coors Field, he's 2-1 with a 5.46 EA (17er, 28.0ip) ..SF is 2-3 in Webb's five career starts here.

A TROUBLING RECENT TREND: Since the start of last year, the Giants as a team are 37-19 (.661) when Webb takes the ball in a starting capacity...however, the Giants are 8-12 in Webb's last 20 starts dating to June 4...Webb in that time has posted a 2.76 ERA (37er, 120.2ip)...of the 12 losses, seven have been by two runs or fewer.

GROUNDHOG DAY: Has a 56.5% groundball percentage this year that is second-best in the Majors (best in the NL) only to Houston's Framber Valez (67.5%)...it's a tick below Webb's career average (56.8%) and down from last year's 61.2% that led the Majors (min.140.0ip).

STAYING IN: His 0.54 homers/9.0ip ratio is third-best in the Majors behind HOU's Framber Valdez (0.44) and STL's Jose Quintana (0.48)...of the top-five lowest HR/9.0ip ratios among qualified starters in 2022, two play for SF (also **Carlos Rodón**: 5th, 0.59 HR/9).

THIRD TIME'S A CHARM: When Webb faces a lineup for a third time, he's limiting them to a .236/.293/.286 slash line with a .574 OPS...he's permitted a .656 OPS the first time through the lineup and a .692 OPS the second time through.
