**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals and division-rival Chicago Cubs continue with the second game of a three-game series tonight at Busch Stadium...St. Louis opened its homestand by dropping two of three to Houston over the weekend...entering today, the Cardinals lead Chicago by 1.0 game in the NL Central...St. Louis is 16-8 in July and co-leads MLB with 13 wins since the All-Star break (Giants).

**GYORKO TRADED TO DODGERS:** The Cardinals today acquired left-handed pitcher **Tony Cingrani** and minor league right-handed pitcher **Jeffrey Abreu** in exchange for infielder **Jedd Gyorko**, 2019/2020 International Cap Space and cash considerations. Cingrani, 30, is currently on the 60-day IL (left shoulder surgery) and has not pitched this season. Abreu, 19, is 2-0 with a 4.66 ERA in six games this season for the Arizona Rookie League Dodgers. The 6-4, 200-pound Abreu was an International free-agent signing by the Dodgers in July of 2017.

**HOME COOKIN':** For the first time since the Cardinals and Cubs began play in 1892, the home team has won each of the first 10 games to begin the season series (previous high was first eight games in **2001**). The last time the home team won each of the first 10 games in a season series involving the Cardinals was **1953** against the Brooklyn Dodgers where the home team won each of the first 13 at either Ebbets Field or Sportsman's Park/Busch I. The last time the home team won each of the first 10 games in a season series between any two MLB teams was **2009** between the Padres & Giants (first 11) *Elias Sports Bureau*.

**SWEEP STAKES:** The last time series sweeps covered the first four series was **1978** when the Cubs won the first 12 games. The most sweeps to begin a season between the two division rivals was in **1944** when St. Louis took each of the first five sets (13 games from April 21-Aug. 24).

**TAKE CARE OF BUSINESS:** The Cardinals are 25-19 in divisional play (13-6 at home) this season, winning their last six contests (Reds 1; Pirates 4; Cubs 1) and 10 of their last 12 since the All-Star Break. Their .568 divisional win pct. is tops among NL Central clubs (Milwaukee is 2nd at 27-21, .563)...32 of St. Louis' remaining 56 games (57.1%) this season are against divisional opponents: Chicago 9; Milwaukee 9; Cincinnati 8; Pittsburgh 6.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING!:** **Kolten Wong** has reached base safely in a career high 18 games since July 5 (.375/.463/.500), 3rd-longest active in MLB, 2nd-longest by a Cardinal in 2019 (**Yadier Molina**, 22g, April 9-May 6) and longest by a Cardinals second baseman since **Matt Carpenter** (19g, Sept. 1-24, 2013).

**BYE BYE BIRDIES:** The Cardinals' 40 homers in July rank 2nd in the NL (Dodgers, 42) and is 3rd-highest July total in franchise history, trailing 42 bombs hit in 2000 and 2004. St. Louis has homered in its last 13 consecutive games (July 17-present), the longest active streak in MLB and the club's longest since 16 straight last season (Aug. 7-24). **THE GOLDEN TICKET:** **Paul Goldschmidt** co-leads the NL with 11 July homers (**Eugenio Suárez**) and ranks T3rd in Cardinals history for July, behind **Mark McGwire** (16 - 1999) and **Jim Edmonds** (13 - 2004).

**CUB KILLER:** In 53 career games, **Paul Goldschmidt's** lifetime .649 slugging and 1.090 OPS vs. the Cubs are the highest marks among active MLB players and both rank 3rd all-time behind **Mark McGwire** (.832/1.285) & **Carl Everett** (.671/1.092).

**BIRD BYES:** The last time St. Louis defeated the Cubs in five straight games at home was May 15, 2012-June 17, 2013...**Yadier Molina**, **Matt Wieters**, and **Andrew Knizner** combine to lead MLB catchers this season in fielding pct. (.999), caught stealing pct. (57.1), fewest stolen base attempts (35) and fewest stolen bases allowed (20)...**Giovanny Gallegos** has stranded 29 of 32 inherited runners this season, with a 9.4% of runners who scored that ranks 3rd in MLB and is the lowest in Cardinals single-season history (**Tony Fossas** is 2nd at 10%, 6 of 60).

#### CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

**Dexter Fowler** played two seasons (2015-16) with Chicago...member of 2016 World Series champions...initially became a Cub via trade by the Astros for **Dan Straily** and **Luis Valbuena** (Jan. 19, 2005).

**Paul DeJong** graduated from Antioch (Ill.) Comm. High School...played college baseball at Illinois State University (2013-15) while majoring in biochemistry and pre-medicine.

**Daniel Ponce de Leon** was selected by the Cubs in the 14th round of the 2013 MLB Draft after his junior season, but failed his physical due to concerns about the ulnar nerve placement in his right elbow.

**Kolten Wong** (August 13, 2016 at Wrigley Field), **Dakota Hudson** (July 28, 2018 at Busch Stadium), **Tyler O'Neill** (April 19, 2018 at Wrigley Field), **Andrew Knizner** (June 2, 2019 at Busch Stadium), and **Tommy Edman** (June 8 2019 at Wrigley Field) all made MLB debuts against the Cubs.

**John Brebbia** earned his first Major League win against Chicago (June 17, 2018).

**Mike Maddux's** younger brother, **Greg Maddux**, was a Hall of Fame pitcher for Chicago for parts of 10 seasons (1986-92, '04-'06)...originally selected by the Cubs in the 2nd round of the 1984 MLB draft.

**Jason Heyward** played the 2015 season with St. Louis...originally traded by Atlanta with pitcher **Lordan Walden** to St. Louis for pitchers **Tyrell Jenkins** & **Shelby Miller** (Nov. 17, 2014).

As compensation for the departure of Heyward signing with the Cubs, **Dakota Hudson** was selected by St. Louis with the 34th overall pick in the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

**Daniel Descalso** played parts of five seasons in a Cardinals uniform (2010-14)...appeared in 44 postseason games and was a member of the 2011 World Champion Cardinals...originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2007 MLB Draft.

**Steve Cishek** appeared in 27 games with St. Louis in 2015...originally traded by the Marlins to St. Louis for **Kyle Barraclough** (July 24, 2015).

**Rowan Wick** was selected by St. Louis as a catcher in the 9th round of the 2012 MLB draft...played/pitched six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization before selected off waivers by San Diego (Feb. 16, 2018).

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Fame outfielder **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Cubs Bullpen Coach **Lester Strode** pitched for the Triple-A Louisville Redbirds (1987-88) in the Cardinals' minor league organization.

Cubs Director, Player Development **Jaron Madison** previously served as the Cardinals Assistant Director of Scouting (2008-09).

Cubs Catching Coach **Mike Borzello** played four seasons (1991-94) in the Cardinals minor league system...originally selected by St. Louis in 1991.

Cardinals VP/General Manager **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

TODAY’S GAME

- Makes his team-leading 22nd start of the season (64th career start) and 91st career appearance today.
- Has walked two batters or fewer in 36 straight starts dating back to July 4, 2018 (4 BB at Arizona). Marks Major League Baseball’s longest active streak and is tied for the 2nd-longest streak in Cardinals history by a starting pitcher (longest since Chris Carpenter, 36, from July 30, 2006-August 17, 2009).
- Is 1-2 with a 2.25 ERA in his four home starts against N.L. Central opponents holding his opposition to zero, one and two runs in his last three starts of that kind.
- Has walked one or fewer in 15 of his 21 starts, including no walks in seven outings.
- Has surrendered three earned runs or fewer in 16 of 21 starts this season.
- The Cardinals sport a 35-18 record (.660 win pct.) in his games pitched since 2018. Since July 4, 2018, St. Louis is 25-12 (.676) in his games started.

LAST TIME OUT

- Tossed 6.0 innings allowing three runs in a 6-3 win at Pittsburgh to complete a four-game sweep at PNC Park. Was his 36th straight start limiting his opposition to two walks or less. First road win since 5/1 at WSH.

- **NL Ranks:** Losses (10, T4th), highest pct. of pitches put in play (20.9, 1st), highest percentage of swings put in play (42.9, 5th), highest percentage of first pitch strikes (65.7, 11th), walks/9 IP (1.50, 4th), strikeouts/walk ratio (4.35, 11th), BB/BF (.041, 4th).
- Received only 52 runs of support while on the mound this season. His 3.62 run support average ranks as the 5th-lowest in the NL.
- Earned his second road win of the season and first since 5/1 at WSH in his start at PIT (7/25), closing out a four-game series sweep at PIT for the first time since 2004.
- Hurlled an eight-hit shutout in his 7/15 start vs. PIT, walking none and fanning three in a 100-pitch effort. It was his 2nd career shutout (5/21/18). He became the first Cardinals pitcher to throw a shutout with eight or more hits and no walks since Bob Forsch (9/8/1982 vs. MTL).
- Received seven runs of support in his 7/15 start after receiving only four runs of support over five June starts and eight total over a 10-start stretch (May 11-July 6) for 1.38 run support average, the lowest in MLB. Tampa Bay’s Blake Snell (3.08) had 2nd-lowest mark over the time period.
- 16 of his 58 runs allowed (27.5%) have been allowed in the 2nd inning (7.08 ERA).
- Is 5-4, 2.15 ERA (5th N.L.) in 10 home starts, but 2-6, 6.75 ERA in 11 road starts this season.
- Is 2-5, 4.10 ERA in 10 starts vs. NL Central this season; 9-2, 2.71 ERA last season.
- Allowing .226 opp. BA at home in 2019, but .335 mark with 12 HR’s on the road.
- His 20 quality home starts over past two seasons (2018-19) rank 5th in the N.L. (Max Scherzer, 1st with 27).
