YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the Royals, 9-7, in the second game of the three-game set at Kauffman Stadium...The Birds plated seven runs in the second inning, their second-most in a single frame this season behind the nine they scored in the sixth inning on March 30 vs. Los Angeles-AL...Tallied a season-high-tying 15 hits for the second time, joining April 16 vs. Minnesota.

\*\*O\*\* Corbin Burnes\*\* picked up his third win of the year after allowing three runs on four

- hits (1 HR) with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.2 innings; the 0's are 5-0 in Burnes'
- Jordan Westburg had a pair of singles in the second inning, the first Oriole with multiple hits in an inning since Adley Rutschman had two in the first inning on July 30, 2023 vs. New York-AL. Pis
- Anthony Santander set a career high with three doubles, becoming the first 0's batter with three doubles in a game since Austin Hays on April 28, 2022 at New York-AL.

KIMBREL COUNT: Craig Kimbrel recorded the 422nd save of his career last night at Kansas City, tying Billy Wagner for seventh in MLB history; only Boston's Kenley Jansen (425) has more among active players...Kimbrel has 1,206 strikeouts, the fourth-most all-time as a reliever; he trails Hoyt Wilhelm (1,363), Goose Gossage (1,340), and Lee Smith (1,225).

**BURNING RUBBER:** The Orioles and Royals square off in a rubber game in today's series finale...The O's are 1-1 in rubber games this year and went 12-8 in rubber matches in 2023.

**HOMER HAPPY:** Entering today's games, the Orioles lead MLB with 31 home runs, tied with the 1966 and 1996 clubs for the most homers through the first 20 games in 0's history; the

nost homers through the first 21 games is 32 by the 2020 team.

θ<sub>b</sub> Bird batters hit three home runs in five consecutive games from April 13-17, their first time doing so since August 6-10, 1996, and the longest such streak in MLB since the Braves also did so in five straight from June 11-15, 2022; the MLB record for consecutive games with at least three homers is six set by the 1987 Orioles.

THEY'VE GOT POP: Entering today's games, the Orioles lead the AL and rank second in MLB with a 90.3 mph average exit velocity, per *Statcast* (see box at right)...The 0's have 54 barrels, tied with the Royals for the most in MLB...**Gunnar Henderson** leads all hitters with a 96.8 mph average exit velo (see box at right).

**COMEBACK KIDS:** Eight of the Orioles' 12 wins this season have been in comeback fashion, the second-most in MLB behind the Braves (9).

**RUN IT UP:** Entering today's games, the Orioles rank second in the AL and fourth in MLB with 117 runs scored...Their +24 run differential is third in the AL and sixth in MLB, while their 5.85 runs per game leads the AL and ranks third in MLB.

**DOWN BUT NOT OUT:** The Orioles are slashing .191/.241/.351 (68-for-356) in two-strike counts...Entering today's games, they lead MLB in slugging, OPS (.592), and extra-base hits (30) with two strikes, and are second in home runs (13)...**Jordan Westburg** has hit .371/.405/.714 (13-for-35) in two-strike counts, with three doubles and three home runs...He leads MLB in two-strike average, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.120).

AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Colton Cowser was selected as the AL Player of the Week for the period of April 8-14 after slashing .435/.481/1.130 (10-for-23) with four doubles, four home runs, six runs scored, 12 RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games...During that time, he led MLB in slugging, OPS (1.611), extra-base hits (8), total bases (26), and RBI... He led the AL in homers, ranked tied for the lead in doubles, and ranked among the leaders in hits  $(T-3^{rd})$ , runs  $(T-3^{rd})$ , and average  $(4^{th})$ ...Marks the first career honor for Cowser, who is the first 0's player to win the award since **Gunnar Henderson** for the week of June 5-11, 2023...Each of the last three Orioles to win Player of the Week have been rookies, including Cowser, Henderson and **Ryan Mountcastle** in 2021.

STRIKE A POSE: Baltimore pitchers have fanned 178 batters so far in 2024, tied with the 2023 team for the most strikeouts through 20 games in 0's history...The most through the first 21 games is 190 by the 2023 Orioles.

OTHE PLACES YOU'LL GO: The Birds are on a six-game road trip against the Royals (1-1) and Angels (3 G)...The Orioles have a scheduled off day after the trip on Thursday, April 25...The O's wrapped up their first road trip of the season with a 4-2 record against Pittsburgh (1-2) and Boston (3-0) from April 5-11.

AGAINST THE ROYALS: The O's and Royals are meeting for the second and final series of the regular season in Kansas City this weekend...With a win today, the O's would clinch their fourth consecutive season series victory over Kansas City...The Birds took two out of three against the Royals in Baltimore from April 1-3, including two walk-off wins...The 0's went 5-1 against the Royals last year; they took two out of three at Kauffman Stadium from May 2-4 before completing a three-game sweep in Baltimore from June 9-11.

**SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE:** The Orioles have gone 98 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)... Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3).

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award... He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde was named the 20<sup>th</sup> manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018...His 328 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

Owned a 1-4 record with a 4.81 ERA (31 ER/58.0 IP) in 12 starts and pitched to a 3.26 ERA (7 ER/19.1 IP) in 12 relief appearances with the O's...Did not appear on the ALDS roster...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Kyle Virbitsky from the Oakland Athletics in exchange for INF Darell Hernaiz on January 26, 2023.
