AROUND THE HORN

TEACHER APPRECIATION NIGHT ON MONDAY: The D-backs will celebrate teachers and administrators with Teacher Appreciation Night, presented by FOX10...the Special Event Ticket Pack includes a limited-edition teacher-themed coffee mug and a pregame parade.

ASU NIGHT ON TUESDAY: The D-backs invite the Sun Devils to come together for the start of the school year with ASU Night...the Special Event Ticket Pack includes a co-branded D-backs x ASU Merrill Kelly jersey.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 6-3 in their last 9 games.

- The D-backs are 9-2 in their last 11 games vs. Giants.
- The D-backs are 5-1 in their last 6 road games @ Giants and 10-5 over their last 15 road games @ Giants.
- **Tim Tawa** has a career-best 14-game on-base streak, hitting .294 (15-for-51)/.878 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Nolan Arenado** has hit safely in 5 of his last 7 road games, since Aug. 1, at a .308 clip (8-for-26)/1.092 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 6 RBI and 3 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 10-6 @ Giants.

- **Lars Nootbaar’s** eighth career lead-off home run was the team’s fourth of the season...had a season-high 3 hits and was a triple shy of the cycle.
- **Corbin Carroll** hit a go-ahead, 2-run homer in the third inning and **Tim Tawa** tacked on a 3-run blast in a 5-run third inning.
- **Kohl Drake** worked 4.0 innings (5 R, 4 H, 1 BB, 4 K).
- The bullpen combined for 5.0 innings with 1 unearned run on 1 hit and 3 walks with 7 strikeouts.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs selected RHP **Derek Law** (No. 38) from Triple-A Reno, appointed LHP **Mitch Bratt** as the 27th man for today’s games and, following last night’s game, optioned LHP **Kohl Drake** to Triple-A Reno.

2 GAMES IN A DAY: The D-backs last played 2 games in a day last season on June 7 @ Reds...the first game was the completion of the June 6 game suspended due to rain...it resumed in the top of the seventh inning tied 7-7 before the D-backs lost 4-3 in 10 innings...the second game, the originally scheduled game on June 7, was a 13-1 loss.

DOUBLE DIP: Today is the D-backs’ 27th doubleheader all-time, first since Aug. 7, 2024 @ Guardians (W, 7-3; W, 5-3)...are 32-20 overall, 26-20 on the road.

- Second doubleheader @ Giants...first was caused by a rainout on April 16, 2000 and rescheduled for Sept. 23, 2000...the D-backs won 7-5 then lost 9-5.

NOOT: **Lars Nootbaar** has hit safely in 5 of 6 road games as a D-back, batting .350 (7-for-20)/1.081 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 3 RBI and 1 walk.

- Has reached base safely in 11 straight road games vs. NL West (.317, 13-for-41, .880 OPS, 7 BB).
 - Has reached base safely in 26 of his last 28 road games vs. NL West (.281, 27-for-96, .927 OPS, 23 BB).
 - Has reached base safely in 40 of 45 career road games vs. NL West (.300, 45-for-150, 1.020 OPS, 39 BB).
- Has reached base safely in 24 of his last 25 games vs. NL West (.274, 23-for-84, .785 OPS, 19 BB).

BACKSTOPS: D-backs Catchers among all teams (when batting as the catcher) rank first with a .285 AVG (ahead of MIN .266 and MIL .266) and 143 hits (ahead of MIL 139 and COL 133), second with a .344 OBP (to MIN .349), third with a .790 OPS (to COL .852 and DET .805) and fourth with a .446 SLG (to COL .537, DET .486, ATH .447).

APPROACHING 20 HR: Corbin Carroll, with 19 homers, is on the verge of his fourth straight 20+ homer season.

- Will become the fourth D-back with 4 or more straight seasons of 20+ home runs along with Ketel Marte (4 straight from 2023-26), Paul Goldschmidt (4 straight from 2015-18) and Luis Gonzalez (club-record 5 straight from 1999-2003).

HOMER HAPPY: The D-backs have homered in 4 straight games (6 HR) and 15 of their last 18 games (22 HR).

- Have homered in 7 straight road games vs. NL West (11 HR).

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 0.5 game behind the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5), 3.5 games behind the Phillies (WC2, lead season 2-1) and 4.5 games behind the Cubs (WC1, trail season 2-4).

WIN THE SERIES: The D-backs are 9-3-1 in their 13 series post-All-Star break.

LUCKY 13?: Entering this series, the D-backs were 7-4-1 in their last 12 series vs. NL West.

OVER THE LONG HAUL: The D-backs’ 27 wins (27-17) since July 9 are tied for second in the Majors with the Braves (27), behind the Red Sox (31) and ahead of the Brewers (26), Rays (26), Yankees (26) and Padres (26).

STREAKING VS. GIANTS: Geraldo Perdomo’s 16-game on-base streak vs. Giants is tied for the third-longest active streak vs. Giants with Sal Frelick/MIL (16), behind Kyle Schwarber/PHI (19) and Bryce Harper/PHI (28).

- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 13 of his last 14 games vs. Giants (.277, 13-for-47, .989 OPS, 14 BB).

DOMO-NATING AUGUST: Geraldo Perdomo has reached base safely in 9 of his last 10 games, batting .361 (13-for-36)/.869 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 RBI and 6 walks.

- In 25 games in August, is hitting .344 (33-for-96)/.865 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 11 walks.

COMEBACK KIDS: The D-backs’ 41 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (40).

- The D-backs’ 20 road comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (18) and Red Sox (17).
 - The 20 road comeback wins are tied with 1999 for second in franchise history behind 22 in 2011.

VS. GIANTS: The D-backs are 12-3 in their last 15 games.

- The D-backs have won 4 consecutive series.
- The D-backs are 7-2-1 in their last 10 series.
