Friday Night Lights

The Braves host the Diamondbacks here at Truist Park tonight, and enter play a perfect 10-0 in Friday night home games this season. Atlanta is the only undefeated team in baseball in such games this season.

Futhermore, the Braves on Fridays are the only team to go undefeated at home on any day of the week this season.

Since Truist Park opened in 2017, no team in baseball has been better by either total wins or winning percentage in Friday home games than Atlanta. The Braves are 78-44 (.639) here on Fridays since the park opened.

TONIGHT’S GAME: The Braves and D-backs tonight open a three-game weekend series with what is the fifth of seven scheduled meeting between the clubs this season...The two met at Chase Field in Arizona from April 2-5, in what was Atlanta's first road series of the season.

 The Braves went 2-2 in that series at Chase Field in April, winning the first two contests before dropping the final two...The winner of the series this weekend will claim the season set.

 Atlanta's two wins in Arizona earlier this year match its total against the D-backs from all of last season, when the club went just 2-4 across six total games...Last year's record marked the first time the Braves dropped the season series to the D-backs since 2019.

 Arizona swept all three games here at Truist Park last season, and is an even 12-12 here since the facility opened in 2017....The Diamondbacks are one of just two visiting teams in baseball with multiple sweeps of at least three games in this building (2019 & 2025), joining the Brewers (2024 & 2025).

 RH Brandon Pfaadt has never lost to Atlanta despite a career ERA of 5.68 (16 ER/25.1 IP) against the club, pitching to a 2-0 record over five total starts...Arizona is 4-1 in total in these turns... The 6-foot-4, 220-pound Louisville native faced the Braves on April 5 at Chase Field earlier this season, and allowed six hits and three runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision...The right-hander is a perfect 6-0 over his last eight starts in the majors dating to June 30, pitching to a 1.32 ERA (7 ER/47.2 IP).

CHRIS SALE: Makes the sixth start and seventh appearance of his career against Arizona tonight, and enters play 4-1 with a 2.33 ERA (7 ER/27.0 IP) and 33 strikeouts all-time against the club...His 2.20 ERA on the season ranks second among qualified pitchers in baseball.

 Only Jacob Misiorowski, with a 1.76 ERA, has a better mark...In MLB's live-ball era (since 1920), only six other pitchers have bettered Sale's ERA through 21 starts at age 37-or-older: Roger Clemens (1.46, 2005), Spud Chandler (1.84, 1946), Justin Verlander (1.85, 2022), Dutch Leonard (1.97, 1948), Kevin Brown (2.10, 2003) and Max Scherzer (2.15, 2022).

 The left-hander from Lakeland, FL, has not allowed more than three runs in 18 consecutive starts, dating to April 12...It's the longest active streak of its kind in the majors...Sale is 10-6 with a 1.93 ERA (23 ER/106.0 IP) and 135 strikeouts within this stretch...In 42 total appearances since the start of last season, he has allowed more than three earned runs just three times.

 Sale has earned the decision in 19 of his 21 total starts this season, second most in the majors.

AUSTIN RILEY: Fell a triple short of the cycle on Wednesday night, going 3-for-4 with his 18th double and 15th home run of the season...In 25 games since the All-Star break, Riley is batting .292/.340/.551 with an .891 OPS and six of his 15 total homers.

 With the caveat that it is an admittedly small sample size, Riley's counting stats since the All-Star break would extrapolate to 38 homers, 71 extra-base hits and 103 RBI over 162 games.

 His four batted balls on Wednesday left the bat at 105.2 mph (single), 110.4 mph (double), 108.5 mph (homer) and 98.2 mph (flyout)...Among all batters in baseball with at least 50 plate appearances since the break, Riley's average exit velocity of 94.9 mph ranks second behind just Pete Alonso (95.6).

 Over 11 games this month, Riley's line jumps to .351/.375/.703 with a 1.078 OPS and seven extra-base hits...It is the best OPS by any primary third baseman in baseball this month.

 In 36 career games against Arizona, Riley has batted .322/.355/.741 with a 1.097 OPS and 31 total extra-base hits (16 doubles, triple, 14 homers)... **Among the 311 players in baseball history to compile at least 150 career plate appearances versus the D-backs, Riley's 1.097 OPS ranks fifth...**Only Manny Ramirez (1.305), Barry Bonds (1.192), Vladimir Guerrero Sr. (1.111) and Alfonso Soriano (1.099) have a higher mark.

SCORING LATE: Atlanta scored three insurance runs in the bottom of Wednesday's seventh inning, and just three teams in baseball have more runs from the seventh inning or later this season.

 The Braves' 204 total runs in the seventh or later trail just the Nationals (226), Cubs (209) and Padres (205).

 No team in baseball has more home runs in the seventh or later than the Braves' 56 (the A's also have 56)...Mike Yastrzemski and Austin Riley went back-to-back to open the seventh on Wednesday.

LEFT FIELD: OF Lane Thomas started in left field for Atlanta on Wednesday and went 1-for-2 with his first homer for the club, while Mike Yastrzemski pinch hit and later manned the position while going 2-for-2 with a homer of his own and a double.

 Thomas and Yastrzemski marked the first Braves teammates to each homer and appear in left in the same game since Austin Riley and Charlie Culberson did so on May 15, 2019.

 Atlanta's left fielders this season have combined to bat .235/.293/.357 with 0.4 fWAR...Over the last three seasons, dating to 2024, the Braves' -0.4 combined fWAR from left field ranks 26th in baseball at the position...Twenty-one different players have appeared in left field for the Braves in that span since 2024, tied for seventh most in the majors.
