**THE TWINS:** After completing their three-game series/homestand with the Yankees by getting swept in three games, the Twins began their six-game roadtrip by getting swept by Cleveland in three games at Progressive Field...tonight, they will continue the trip with the first of three in Washington against the Nationals.

⚡ After going 17-3 in 20 games from April 22-May 12, the Twins have gone 0-6 since May 14. ⚡ Minnesota's current six-game losing streak marks a season-long and longest since August 20-24, 2022, when they dropped six straight to Texas (3 games) and Houston (3 games)...they came out of that losing streak winning each of their next five...their last losing streak of at least seven games was when they dropped eight straight from April 20-27, 2018.

**CRISP, CLEAN GAME ENDS WITH A MESS:** The Twins lost to the Guardians yesterday afternoon at Progressive Field by a score of 5-2...Chris Paddock was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (Andrés Giménez 2-run homer) on three hits in a career-high 8.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...Jhoan Duran (0-2) was issued the loss, his second of the series/trip, allowing a three-run walk-off homer to Will Brennan with two outs in the bottom of the ninth...the offense recorded just four hits, highlighted by a solo home run from Jose Miranda...Max Kepler added a double, his 11th of the season.

**ROCCO-FELLA RECORDS:** Rocco Baldelli enters today with 399 career managerial wins...he has been sitting on 399 since last Sunday's win in Toronto on May 12...since becoming the Twins manager in 2019, only two AL managers have won more than Rocco: Kevin Cash (446-310) and Aaron Boone (442-314)...14 active managers have reached the 400 wins mark (Bruce Bochy, Bob Melvin, Bud Black, A.J. Hinch, Dave Roberts, Cash, Craig Counsell, Ron Washington, Brian Snitker, Scott Servais, Boone, Torey Lovullo, Alex Cora and Dave Martinez)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

**INTERLEAGUE INFO:** The Twins are 2-3 in Interleague Play this season...their only two series this season were a two-game series in Milwaukee from April 2-3 (1-1) and a three-game series at Target Field against Los Angeles (1-2)...after this series, their next IL opponent will be the Pirates at PNC Park for a three-game weekend series from June 7-9.

⚡ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .322 (.28-for-87) with five doubles, nine home runs, 17 RBI, a .438 on-base percentage, a .690 slugging percentage and a 1.128 OPS vs. NL opponents since the start of 2023...Jeffers leads baseball in OPS in IL Play since the start of last season (chart lower right)...additionally, he has homered four times in his last seven games vs. the NL.

**MATCH-UPS AT THE MONUMENT:** The Twins are 10-11 all-time against the Montreal/Washington franchise, including 7-11 since the franchise moved to D.C....these two last played each other for three games at Target Field from April 21-23, 2023 as the Twins lost the series two games to one...the Twins have gone just 2-9 in their last 11 vs. the Nats, dating back to 2013.

**HISTORY LESSONS:** The Twins are just 1-5 all-time at Nationals Park, going 1-2 in 2013 and 0-3 in 2016...Minnesota's last visit here was for one exhibition game in 2018 before starting their season in Baltimore...the last regular season game in this park was on April 24, 2016 as Chris Heisey ended a 16-inning marathon by hitting a walk-off homer off Michael Tonkin that gave the Nationals a 6-5 win over the Twins...the game went into extra innings after Bryce Harper hit the first pinch-hit homer of his career off Kevin Jepsen to tie it at 4-4 in the 9th...Washington was down by a run again in the 15th when Danny Espinosa drew a two-out walk and stole second; out of pinch hitters, manager Dusty Baker let pitcher Oliver Pérez bat for himself and he laid down a bunt down near the third base line...catcher John Ryan Murphy picked it up and threw wildly to first base, allowing Espinosa to score, prolonging the game...the Twins struck out 20 times during the game...the getaway day game lasted five hours and 56 minutes.

⚡ For 60 years, the Washington Senators played baseball in our nation's capital, winning one World Championship (1924) and three AL pennants (1925, '33, '36). In 1961, owner Calvin Griffith moved the Senators from Washington, D.C. to Bloomington, Minnesota...the Senators played from 1901-1960, compiling a record of 4223-4864...the Senators beat the New York Giants in the 1924 World Series in seven games, marking the only World Series victory for the franchise during its first 60-year tenure in Washington.

⚡ The Twins enter tonight's game with an all-time club record (since 1961) of 4978-5033-8 and an all-time franchise record (Senators and Twins) of 9202-9896.

**LEFT SIDE STORY:** Twins hitters are slashing .269/.316/.419 with a .735 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .219/.297/.382 with a .679 OPS vs. right-handed pitching. ⚡ Twins are facing back-to-back lefties tonight and tomorrow night for the second time this season, the other being April 28 at Los Angeles-AL (Reid Detmers) and May 29 at Chicago-AL (Garrett Crochet) — both wins. ⚡ Since April 24, the Twins are slashing .308/.342/.469 (.811 OPS) vs. lefties — the highest batting average in baseball since that date. ⚡ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .308 (.8-for-26) with a .896 OPS in his last 13 games vs. lefties. ⚡ Willi Castro is hitting .417 (15-for-36) with a 1.058 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...in his last 14 games, he is 15-for-26 (.577) with a 1.423 OPS vs. lefties.

**DOUBLE LIFE:** The Twins enter today with 91 doubles, which leads baseball, ahead of Boston (89) and Los Angeles-NL (88)...they have doubled in 22 consecutive games, their longest streak since April 7-May 15, 2018, when they doubled in 32 straight. ⚡ Max Kepler has nine doubles this month, tied with Willie Calhoun and Aaron Judge for the most in baseball.

**#WOLVESBACK, FRIDAY NIGHT GAME TIME MOVED UP:** The Twins announced today that they have shifted the start time of their Friday, May 24 home game vs. the Texas Rangers at Target Field to a 6:10 p.m. CT first pitch, rather than 7:10 p.m. as previously scheduled...the Target Field gates will now open at 4:30 p.m. on Friday...moving first pitch time up by one hour was done to help accommodate ingress and egress to downtown Minneapolis throughout what is expected to be a busy evening, with Game 2 of the Western Conference Finals between the Minnesota Timberwolves and Dallas Mavericks scheduled for a 7:30 p.m. tip that night at Target Center.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last pitched May 15 vs. New York-AL, opposite Marcus Stroman, and took his third loss of the season as the Twins were shut out, 4-0...allowed three runs on a season-high 10 hits in 6.1 innings with no walks and three strikeouts...first run came on Aaron Judge's first-inning solo home run – the longest (467 ft.) and hardest-hit (113.0 mph) ball off López this season...Anthony Volpe added a run on a second-inning sacrifice fly, and Giancarlo Stanton on a third-inning RBI single...eight of 10 hits off López came in innings 1-3.

- ☞ Induced 10 whiffs on 52 swings (19.2%)...now ranks in MLB's 76th percentile with a 29.7 percent whiff rate.
- ☞ Allowed eight hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Yankees went 5-for-8 with the Judge home run and three doubles on those swings...López has allowed a 39.6 percent hard-hit rate this season, up from 34.8 percent in 2023.
- ☞ Has allowed a first-inning home run in four of nine starts this season...all were solo home runs.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started May 9 vs. Seattle, opposite Logan Gilbert, and earned his third-straight win in Minnesota's 11-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits in 6.1 innings, with no walks and 10 strikeouts...only run came on Luke Raley's second-inning RBI single...recorded six-straight outs via strikeout from innings 2-4...pitched into the seventh inning for the second time this season (3/28 at KC)...was pulled after Raley's one-out single; Kody Funderburk entered and got an inning-ending double play.

- ☞ Induced 15 whiffs on 43 swings (34.9%).
- ☞ Allowed just three hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph), each resulting in an out.
- ☞ Seventh career double-digit strikeout game, fifth with Minnesota (2023-present).

**NUMBERS VS. THE NATS:** Has made 13 career starts vs. Washington – 12 with Miami from 2018-22...has gone 4-3 with a 4.98 ERA (65.0 IP, 36 ER), 26 walks and 49 strikeouts...has started seven games at Nationals Park, going 2-1 with a 4.25 ERA (36.0 IP, 17 ER), 11 walks and 21 strikeouts.

- ☞ Has faced Washington the second most of any opponent (Atlanta, 14 GS)...his 65.0 innings are tied with New York-NL for his most vs. any opponent.
- ☞ Last faced Washington on April 22, 2023 at Target Field; allowed five runs on eight hits in a season-low 4.0 innings and took the loss.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Making fifth road start of 2024...has gone 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (22.0 IP, 11 ER), 0.91 WHIP and 11.86 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings on the road, compared to 2-2 with a 3.49 ERA (28.1 IP, 11 ER), 1.16 WHIP and 9.21 K/9 in five home starts...has allowed a .198 (16-for-81) batting average, .680 OPS and 2.05 home-runs-per-9.0-innings on the road, compared to .266 (29-for-109), .678 OPS and 0.64 HR/9 at home.

- ☞ Has allowed a first-inning home run in three of his four road starts, with the exception of April 28 at Los Angeles-AL.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** On May 15, New York-AL's left-handed hitters went 3-for-12 with a double and two strikeouts vs. López, while its righties went 7-for-15 with two doubles, a home run and one strikeout...through nine games vs. López this season, left-handed hitters have hit .235 (24-for-102) with a .627 OPS, 27.1 percent strikeout rate and 2.8 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .239 (21-for-88) with a .739 OPS, 30.5 percent strikeout rate and 4.2 percent home run rate.

- ☞ Has allowed a 33.8 percent hard-hit rate to lefties, 46.7 percent to righties.

☞ His last three home runs allowed (since April 28 at LAA) have come on 4-seamers.  
 ☞ Has thrown 29 sinkers between his last two starts; threw 33 total in his first seven starts.  
 ☞ 4-seamer has allowed a .153 batting average, eighth lowest in baseball (min. 50 PA)...the pitcher's 29.8 percent whiff rate ranks 10th.

**FEW FREE PASSES:** Ranks seventh among qualified MLB pitchers with 1.43 walks-per-9.0-innings...owns a career-best 4.0 percent walk rate; compares to 6.0 percent in 2023 and 2024 MLB average of 8.4 percent...has issued zero walks in back-to-back starts and four of nine starts this season...has issued just one four-pitch walk and one five-pitch walk...of the 21 pitchers to start 41-or-more games in 2023-24, López's 5.21 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks third behind George Kirby (9.42) and Zach Eflin (8.21).

- ☞ Threw 5.1 scoreless innings and won Opening Day start March 30 at Kansas City.
- ☞ Signed four-year extension April 21, keeping him under contract through 2027 season.
- ☞ Tossed first career complete-game shutout with 12 strikeouts vs. Kansas City on July 5.
- ☞ Selected to first All-Star team, pitching a scoreless ninth inning with two strikeouts.
- ☞ Set another career-high with 14 strikeouts September 10 vs. New York-NL, throwing eight scoreless frames in a 2-0 loss.
- ☞ Ranked in 98th percentile in baseball in pitching run value (26), 95th percentile in chase percentage (34.3%), 93rd percentile in xERA (3.00).
- ☞ Earned first Cy Young Award votes of his career and finished seventh in AL voting.
- ☞ Won Game 1 of ALWCs vs. Toronto on October 3 at Target Field, throwing 5.2 innings as Minnesota snapped an 18-game Postseason losing streak.
