YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell in the series opener to Marlins, 6-3...The O's recorded nine hits, all singles, snapping a streak of 52 straight games with an extra-base hit since May 23 which was the third-longest streak in the majors this season behind Minnesota (53, 4/3-5/31) and Kansas City (72, 3/28-6/15)...**Ryan O'Hearn** and **Ryan Mountcastle** both finished with two hits... Four relievers combined to throw 6.0 scoreless innings on two hits with six strikeouts, though two inherited runners scored.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The Orioles have lost seven of their last 10 games since July 9...At 60-40 (.600), the Birds are tied for the second-best record in MLB with the Guardians and trailing the Phillies (.634, 64-37)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 161-101 (.615), the best winning percentage and tied for the most wins in the majors during that time...The O's are 244-180 (.575) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.584, 248-177), Braves (.612, 259-164), and Dodgers (.638, 272-154).

⚾ This year marks the ninth time in Orioles history, including the second straight, with the team winning at least 60 of the first 100 games to begin a season, tied with 1964 and trailing 2023, 1997, and 1970 (62), 1966 (66), 1979 (67), and 1969 (69).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 157 home runs, 10 more than the second-place Yankees (147) and 18 more than the Dodgers (139), who rank third...The team record for homers in a season is 257, set in 1996...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record.

⚾ Baltimore has an MLB-best eight players with at least 10 home runs, the most in MLB: **Gunnar Henderson** (28), **Anthony Santander** (27), **Adley Rutschman** (17), **Jordan Westburg** (16), **Colton Cowser** (13), **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Ryan O'Hearn** (12), and **Cedric Mullins** (10); the Birds have eight players to 10+ homers before at the 100-game mark for the third time in team history, joining the 2000 and 1987 seasons.

⚾ Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 25 home runs, joining New York-AL's Aaron Judge (35) and Juan Soto (25); this marks the third time an O's team has had multiple players with 25+ homers through the first 100 games of a season, joining **Brady Anderson** (31) and **Rafael Palmeiro** (25) in 1996, and **Boog Powell** (27) and **Frank Robinson** (25) in 1969.

⚾ The Orioles lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).

⚾ The O's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August; Baltimore has hit 18 in July, tied for 21st in MLB this month, with five coming from **Anthony Santander**.

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** ranks third in MLB with 81 runs scored behind Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. and New York-AL's Juan Soto (82)...It's tied for the most runs scored through the first 100 team games to begin a season in Orioles history with **Frank Robinson** (1969)...He scored three runs on Friday at Texas for the eighth time this year, two more than the next closest player (Witt Jr.)...Henderson's 15 such games since the start of 2023 are five more than any other player in that time...He's on pace to become the second player in O's history to score 130 times in a season, along with **Roberto Alomar**, who set the team record with 132 runs in 1996.

⚾ Three players in team history have led the AL in runs scored - **Frank Robinson** in 1966 (122), **Cal Ripken, Jr.** in 1983 (121), and **Don Buford** in 1971 (99).

MASHED TATERS: **Anthony Santander** is slashing .277/.324/.630 (48-for-173) with five doubles, one triple, 18 home runs, 26 runs scored, 37 RBI, 12 walks, one hit-by-pitch, and one stolen base in 44 games since the beginning of June...His 18 homers lead the majors during that span.

⚾ He's in safely in a season-high nine straight games since 10 while batting .333/.385/.750 (12-for-36) during that time.

⚾ Santander is the ninth player in O's history to hit at least 25 homers in at least three straight seasons, matching **Frank Robinson** (1969-71), **Lee May** (1976-78), and **Manny Machado** (2015-17), and trailing **Eddie Murray** (1982-85) and **Rafael Palmeiro** (1995-98), who did so in four consecutive years, **Chris Davis** (2012-17) and **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1982-87), who had six, and **Adam Jones** (2011-17), who hit 25 or more homers in seven straight years.

⚾ He now has 15 multi-homer games, eighth-most in franchise history behind **Frank Robinson** (16), **Brady Anderson** (17), **Chris Davis** and **Manny Machado** (19), **Eddie Murray** and **Boog Powell** (20), and **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (21).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore continues a six-game road trip tonight with the second of three games (0-1) in Miami...The Orioles went 2-1 in Texas to open the trip...The O's are a league-best 30-18 (.625) on the road this year and 82-47 (.636) away from Oriole Park since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .585 during that time.

⚾ The Birds have won 10 of 15 road series to start this year; the .667 series winning percentage would be the best in club history ahead of the 2023 and 2012 teams, which both won 17 of 26 (.654) series away from home.

AGAINST THE MARLINS: The Orioles and Marlins resume their first series in Miami since 2021 tonight...Baltimore swept a three-game series at Camden Yards last year, the first sweep of any length against the Marlins in series history...The O's are 13-29 (.310) against the Fish since the teams first met in 1997, the lowest winning percentage against an opponent in team history.

⚾ The Birds are 3-15 (.167) all time in Miami, the worst winning percentage on the road against a franchise in team history.

⚾ Baltimore is 12-15 (.444) against the NL this season; of the eight series losses, four have come against NL opponents; the Orioles are an MLB-best 48-25 (.658) against the AL.

MONTHLY DUES: The Orioles have nine consecutive winning months (min. 10 games played) since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the O's since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...At 7-9 this month, the Birds will need to go 6-3 in their final nine games in July to extend the streak...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors.

ALL-STARS: Five Orioles were selected to the All-Star Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX: **Corbin Burnes**, **Gunnar Henderson**, **Adley Rutschman**, **Anthony Santander**, and **Jordan Westburg**...Head Athletic Trainer **Brian Ebel** also represented the O's on the AL staff...Buster (4x) and Rutschman (2x) were repeat All-Stars while Henderson, Santander, and Westburg were first-timers...Burnes (P), Henderson (SS), and Rutschman (C) all started for the first time in their careers.

⚾ Baltimore became the first AL team with at least five All-Stars, all of whom were under 30 years old at the time of the game, since New York-AL in 2017 (also 5); the Braves did so with eight such players last year.

⚾ Burnes and Rutschman became the first pair of teammates to form the starting battery at the All-Star game since 2016, when San Francisco's Johnny Cueto (P) and Buster Posey (C) did so in San Diego, and the first for the AL since 2006, when Detroit's Kenny Rogers (P) and Ivan Rodriguez (C) did so in Pittsburgh.

⚾ Santander scored the game-winning run in the fifth inning after recording a single and later scoring on a two-run homer by Boston's Jarren Duran, who earned MVP.

QUICK HITS: McDermott is scheduled to make his Major League debut tonight after having his contract selected from Triple-A Norfolk prior to today's game...Will become the fifth Oriole to make his Major League debut this season and second pitcher...Acquired by the Orioles from the Houston Astros as part of a three-team trade with Tampa Bay in which the Orioles also acquired RHP Seth Johnson from the Rays, the Astros acquired INF/OF Trey Mancini from the Orioles and RHP Jayden Murray from the Rays, and the Rays acquired outfielder José Siri from the Astros on August 1, 2022...An Indiana native, McDermott was originally selected by the Houston Astros as a compensation pick in the fourth round (No. 132 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Ball State University (IN).

NUMBER NEWS: McDermott will wear No. 60 after wearing No. 97 in Spring Training...The last O's player to wear No. 60 was Mychal Givens in 2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision in his last start with Norfolk on July 19 vs. Nashville...Allowed four runs (3 ER) on four hits with one strikeout in 1.0 inning; five of the first six batters reached to begin the game...Threw 22 pitches, 14 strikes.

HIGH TIDE: Has gone 3-5 with a 3.96 ERA (40 ER/91.0 IP), a 1.43 WHIP, and 129 strikeouts against 54 walks in 20 appearances (19 GS) for the Tides this year... Leads the International League in strikeouts, 22 more than second-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's Will Warren (NYY); the 129 strikeouts are tied for the most among all minor league pitchers with Lake County's Matt Wilkinson (A+, CLE)...Ranks among International League leaders in opponent average (3rd, .224) and ERA (5th).

PROSPECTING: Currently ranked as the No. 6 Orioles prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 7 overall by *MLB Pipeline*...He is ranked as the club's No. 1 pitching prospect by *MLB Pipeline*.

AWARD SHOW: Named the International League Pitcher of the Week twice this season, first for the week of April 29-May 5 after throwing 6.2 no-hit, shutout innings, allowing two walks with 11 strikeouts on May 3 at Nashville as part of a combined no-hitter...Earned his second honor for the week of July 8-14 after allowing one hit and four walks with seven strikeouts across 6.2 shutout innings.

SPRING TRAINING: Attended his first Major League Spring Training and made four appearances with the O's, going 0-0 with a 2.53 ERA (3 ER/10.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts...Reassigned to minor league camp on March 13...In his last outing before being reassigned, completed 3.0 shutout innings in relief, allowing two hits and one walk with six strikeouts on July 12 at Memphis.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Began the season with Double-A Bowie...Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on July 9...Combined to go 8-8 with a 3.10 ERA (41 ER/119.0 IP) with 69 hits (9 HR), 44 runs (41 ER), 68 walks, five hit batters, and 152 strikeouts in 26 games (22 starts) between both levels...Posted a 2.49 ERA (14 ER/50.2 IP) and a 1.01 WHIP for the remainder of the season following his promotion to Norfolk... Won back-to-back International League Pitcher of the Week awards on July 30 and August 6.
