AT HOME: The Brewers are 29-17 at home, going 10-4-1 in series play.....the team has lost its last two home series (1-2 vs. PIT, 1-2 vs. WSH) after winning nine home series in a row.....the team has gone 25-10 in its last 35 home games after a 5-7 start.....the Brewers had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from May 29-June 10.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 28-25 on the road, going 8-7-2 in series play.....the team has won its last 3 road games.....the Brewers had a season-high 4-game road winning streak from April 9-13.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing Bud Black in June (42-54).....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE**: The Brewers have made 25 replay challenges this season, going 15-10.....their last challenge (won) came on 7/21 at Minnesota as hit by pitch involving Austin Martin was overturned.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER: #36 - RHP TOBIAS MYERS [14g, 13gs, 6-3, 3.13]

MYERS AT A GLANCE: Tobias Myers, 25, will be making his 15th appearance and 14th start of the season.....Myers last pitched on 7/10 vs. Pittsburgh and earned a 9-0 win [8ip, 4h, 1bb, 6k, 103 pitches].....it was his second start this season with 8.0 shutout innings (also 6/7 at Detroit).....he is in his fourth stint with the team [4/17, 4/22-5/9, 5/21-5/31 and 6/5-current).....the team is 7-6 in his starts.....he has 5 quality starts.....opponents are batting .231 [61-for-264, 10hr].....he has gone 5-1 with a 1.79 ERA in his last 7 starts (45.1ip, 9er).....Myers made his Major League debut in a start on 4/23 at Pittsburgh....he also went 1-1 with a 1.45 ERA in 5 games/3 starts at Triple-A Nashville this season [18.2ip, 13h, 3r, 3er, 7bb, 24k, 2hr].....he signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 11/10/22.

LAST SEASON: In his first season in the organization, Myers went 10-5 with a 4.93 ERA in 29 games/26 starts between Double-A Biloxi (27g, 26gs) and Triple-A Nashville (2g).....he led all Brewers Minor League pitchers in wins (10), strikeouts (175) and innings pitched (140.2)....he led the Southern League in strikeouts (168) and innings pitched (137.2) and tied for second in wins (10).....also surrendered a league-leading 30 HR.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Has gone 43-37 with a 4.24 ERA in 141 games/123 starts (620.1ip, 601h, 331r, 292er, 213bb, 636k, 83hr).....has pitched for six organizations: Baltimore (2016-17), Tampa Bay (2017-21), Cleveland (2022), San Francisco (2022), Chicago-AL (2022) and Milwaukee (2023-24).....did not play in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic.....was selected by Baltimore in the sixth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Winter Haven (FL) High School.....Myers committed to the University of South Florida prior to being drafted.

AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-0 with a 3.78 ERA in 6 starts (33.1ip, 14er).....ON THE ROAD: Is 4-3 with a 2.56 ERA in 8 games/7 starts (38.2ip, 11er).

vs. CUBS: Is 0-1 with a 7.00 ERA in 2 starts (9ip, 10h, 7r, 7er, 6bb, 8k, 3hr).....he took a 6-5 loss on 5/4 at Wrigley Field (3ip, 3h, 4r, 4er, 4bb, 2k, 2hr) and had no decision in a 5-3 loss on 6/29 at American Family Field (6ip, 7h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 1hbp, 2bk).
