AROUND THE HORN

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 4-1 in their last 5 games and 14-6 in their last 20 games.

- The D-backs' 14 wins since July 9 are tied for second in the Majors with the Braves (14) behind the Red Sox (18) and ahead of the Yankees (13).
 - The 14 wins are tied for the most in the NL with the Braves ahead of the Padres (12), Brewers (11), Cubs (11) and Reds (11).
- The D-backs are 4-1 in their last 5 home games.
- Brandon Pfaadt**, in 7 home starts vs. NL West since 2025, is 4-1 with a 2.70 ERA (13 ER in 43.1 IP), an opponent .215 AVG (34-for-158)/.592 OPS, 12 walks and 33 strikeouts...this stretch includes a 6-2 win vs. Padres on August 4, 2025 (5.2 IP, 2 ER, 5 H, 3 BB, 4 K).

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 5-0 @ Guardians to wrap up their season-long-tying 11-day roadtrip (6-4).

- Merrill Kelly** took the loss (5.0 IP, 5 R, 8 H, 4 BB, 5 K).
- Taylor Clarke** (1.2 IP) and **Ryan Thompson** (1.1 IP) combined for 3.0 scoreless frames (0 H, 0 BB, 3 K).
- Tim Tawa** and **Geraldo Perdomo** had the 2 hits.

NL WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are tied for second in the NL Wild Card race with the Phillies, 4.0 games behind the Cubs, and 1.0 game ahead of the Padres.

HOME SWEET HOME: The D-backs' .585 home win pct. (31-22) is fifth in the NL, behind the Brewers (.643, 36-20), Braves (.643, 36-20), Marlins (.596, 34-23) and Dodgers (.589, 33-23).

WINNING VS. NL WEST: The D-backs' .656 division win pct. (21-11) lead the Majors ahead of the Brewers (.655, 19-10), Braves (.647, 22-12) and Rays (.629, 22-13).

- The D-backs are 11-5 at home vs. NL West, the Majors' fourth-best division home win pct. behind the Rays (.875, 14-2), White Sox (.813, 13-3) and Mariners (.769, 10-3).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The D-backs have won or split 6 of their last 7 series (2-2 @ Padres, 3-0 @ Dodgers, 2-1 vs. Cardinals, 2-1 vs. Athletics, 1-2 @ Nationals, 2-1 @ Pirates, 2-1 @ Guardians).

*Does not include the 1-game makeup win on July 23 @ Cardinals.

ANSWERBACKS: The D-backs' 35 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Braves (33), Dodgers (32), Brewers (31) and Padres (31).

- The 35 comeback wins through 112 games are the most in franchise history (34 in 2017, 32 in 2002, 30 in 1999 & 2013).

STARTING PITCHERS: D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 6 starts, have a 2.08 ERA (9 R-8 ER in 34.2 IP), opponent .242 AVG (31-for-128)/.645 OPS, 12 walks and 25 strikeouts.

- Includes Brandon Pfaadt's 7.0 scoreless innings on July 28 @ Pirates and Eduardo Rodriguez's 8.0 shutout frames on July 29 @ Pirates.

RUNS ON THE BOARD: Since the All-Star Break, the D-backs' 92 runs are third in the Majors behind the Tigers (98) and Padres (93) and ahead of the Nationals (91), Red Sox (89) and Braves (89).

IN THE 'PEN: **Taylor Clarke** has held opponents scoreless in 8 of his last 9 games with a 0.00 ERA (1 R-0 ER in 10.2 IP), an opponent .158 AVG (6-for-38)/.337 OPS, 1 walk and 6 strikeouts.

- Juan Morillo** has held opponents scoreless in 8 of his last 9 games with a 0.96 ERA (1 ER in 9.1 IP), an opponent .107 AVG (3-for-28)/.330 OPS, 3 walks and 10 strikeouts.

VS. NL WEST: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in 13 straight games vs. NL West, batting .370 (17-for-46)/.926 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 RBI and 11 walks.

- Ketel Marte** has reached base in 18 straight home games vs. NL West, since Sept. 23, 2025, batting .392 (29-for-74)/1.197 OPS (7 2B, 7 HR, 22 RBI).
 - Has reached base in 35 of his last 37 home games vs. NL West since May 16, 2025 (.318/.387/.588/.975).

McCANN STREAKING: **James McCann's** 8-game hitting streak, which is tied for the third-longest of his career (3 times), features a .552 average (16-for-29)/1.478 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 12 RBI and 1 walk.

- Had a 10-gamer from May 1-12, 2018 and 14-gamer from July 16-August 4, 2017.
- Has 4 hits and 3 hits in his last 2 games, his career-best-tying third time with 3+ hits in back-to-back games (May 27-28, 2019; April 22 & 24, 2019).

CARROLL, GEHRIG & DIMAGGIO: **Corbin Carroll** reached 300 career RBI on Saturday (595 G) to become the third player in MLB history with 50+ triples, 90+ homers and 300+ RBI within their first 600 career games, joining Lou Gehrig/NYY (1928, 61 3B/108 HR/496 RBI) and Joe DiMaggio/NYY (1940, 53 3B, 147 HR, 597 RBI).

SNAKEBITES: **Ryan Waldschmidt** has a 6-game hitting streak, batting .588 (10-for-17)/1.376 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 RBI and 1 HBP.

- Has reached base safely in 11 of his last 12 games, batting .405 (15-for-37)/1.009 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer and 5 RBI.
- Max Kepler**, in his last 5 games, is hitting .300 (6-for-20)/.791 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 RBI and 3 walks.
- Ildemaro Vargas** has hit safely in 6 of his last 8 games at a .304 clip (7-for-23)/.751 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 RBI and 2 walks.
- Corbin Carroll** has reached base in 15 straight games and 24 of his last 25 games.

VS. PADRES: The D-backs split their first 2 series vs. Padres (3-3): 1-1 in Mexico City Series from April 25-26 and 2-2 from July 6-9 @ Padres.
