YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles avoided the three-game sweep by winning yesterday's finale against the Brewers, 6-4...Corbin Burnes made his first career start against his former team but did not factor in the decision after allowing three runs (2 ER) on six hits (1 HR), two walks, and a balk with five strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Cedric Mullins, Ryan O'Hearn, and Colton Cowser each homered in the win...Jackson Holliday singled in the seventh HR), two walks, and a balk with five strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Cedric Mullins, Ryan O'Hearn, and Colton Cowser each homered in the win...Jackson Holliday singled in the seventh inning off Abner Uribe for his first career hit; later went first to third on a single by Gunnar Henderson and scored the go-ahead run on a GIDP by Adley Rutschman.

THE TIMES THEY ARE A-CHANGIN': The game between the Orioles and White Sox on Monday, September 2, has been changed to 3:05 p.m. ET (from 1:05 p.m. ET).

COMEBACK KIDS: Seven of the Orioles' nine wins this season, including each of their last four, have been in comeback fashion, the most in MLB...Baltimore's 55 comeback wins since the start of last season are the most in MLB...Their 91 come-from-behind victories since the start of 2022 are also the most in MLB.

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles have gone 96 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in 0's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3) pa Bay (0-3). The 2023 Orioles (52 series) were the fourth MLB team since 2000 to go a full regular

season without being swept in a series of at least two decisions, joining the Braves teams of 2022 (51 series), 2004 (52 series), and 2002 (52 series).

THE MILKMAN DELIVERS: Colton Cowser is slashing .441/.474/.971 (15-for-34) with six doubles, four home runs, seven runs scored, 13 RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in 14 games to start the season...Entering today's games, he ranks among MLB leaders in extrabase hits (T-5th, 10) and doubles (T-7th), and among AL leaders in extra-base hits (3rd), doubles (T-3rd), and RBI (T-6th)...Among MLB batters with at least 35 plate appearances, he ranks first in average, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.445), and seventh in on-base percentage... He leads AL rookies in most offensive statistics (see box at right)...For the period of April 8-14, Cowser slashed .435/.481/1.130 (10-for-23) with four doubles, four home runs, six runs scored, 12 RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games...During that time, he led the AL in homers, extra-base hits (8), total bases (26), slugging, OPS (1.611), and RBI, ranked tied for the lead in doubles, and ranked among the leaders in hits (T-3rd), runs (T-3rd), and average (4th).

Dirilled his fourth home run of the season yesterday against Milwaukee; has homered four times in the last four games, becoming the first Oriole to do so since **Ryan Mourcastle** from April 10-13, 2023 and the first O's rookie since Mountcastle

June 16-19, 2021.

Hit his first two Major League home runs Thursday night at Boston, becoming the seventh player since the team moved to Baltimore in 1954 to hit his first two career home runs in the same game, and first since Mountcastle on August 30, 2020 at Toronto's Sahlen Field, per the Elias Sports Bureau.

KIMBREL COUNT: Craig Kimbrel recorded the 420th save of his career yesterday against Milwaukee, two behind Billy Wagner for seventh in MLB history; only Boston's Kenley Jansen (424) has more among active players...Kimbrel now has 1,203 strikeouts, the fourth-most all-time as a reliever; he trails Hoyt Wilhelm (1,363), Goose Gossage (1,340), and Lee Smith (1.225)

STRIKE A POSE: Baltimore pitchers have fanned 139 batters so far in 2024, the most strikeouts through 15 games in 0's history (since 1954)...The total would be tied for the most in the first 16 games (2020)...Only three other times in team history has the pitching staff fanned 135+ batters through the first 16 games: 2020 (139), 2023 (137), and 2021 (136).

Ob The Birds went 49-32 (.605) at Oriole Park in 2023, the third-best record in ballpark history (since 1992), behind the 2014 and 2016 teams who went 50-31 (.617); marked the third-best home record in the AL last season behind Tampa Bay at 53-28 (.654) and Texas at 50-31 (.617), and tied for the fifth-best in MLB.

AGAINST THE TWINS: The 0's and Twins are meeting for a three-game series in Baltimore this week...The Birds will travel to Minnesota for the final three games of the regular season from September 27-29...The Orioles went 4-2 against the Twins last year, dropping two of three at Oriole Park from June 30 to July 2 before completing a three-game sweep at Target Field from July 7-9, their first sweep of at least three games in Minnesota since a four-game set from August 22-25, 2011...Marked Baltimore's first season series victory over Minnesota since 2016 (5-1).

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award... He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde was named the 20th manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018...His 324 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).
