**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (0-3 at St. Louis and 2-1 at Chicago-AL), the Twins began their three-game homestand with a loss to Houston in the Home Opener on Thursday afternoon...today, Minnesota will host the Astros for the second of three...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to Kansas City for four games from Monday-Thursday.

11 of the Twins' first 16 games are scheduled as day games...Twins are on day game number seven of this stretch...the Twins posted a .591 winning percentage (39-27) in day games in 2024, the fourth-highest mark in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (.651 // 28-15), Cleveland (.614 // 35-22) and Milwaukee (.600 // 39-26).

**HOME SICK:** The Twins cracked open Target Field for its 16th season on Thursday afternoon and lost to the Astros by a score of 5-2...Minnesota got a two-run lead in the first inning but allowed five unanswered runs the rest of the way...Joe Ryan made his second career Home Opener start, allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, two from Byron Buxton...Minnesota struck out 11 times and did not draw a walk.

**SHOOTING STARS:** The Twins and Astros are playing the second of six games in 2025...Minnesota went 4-2 against the Astros last season, going 2-1 at Minute Maid Park from May 31-June 2 and 2-1 at Target Field from July 5-7...they won the season series for the second-straight season (4-2 in 2023) and fourth time in their last five tries.

After going 0-6 against the Astros in 2022, the Twins have gone 8-5 in regular season games vs. Houston since the start of 2023.

The Twins are 43-47 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 32-38 since Houston joined the American League in 2013.

Jose Miranda is hitting .293 (17-for-58) with two doubles, two home runs and eight RBI in 16 career games against the Astros...since the start of last season, he is hitting .526 (10-for-19) with a 1.519 OPS in seven games against Houston.

Christian Vázquez hit .364 (4-for-11) with one double, one home run and four RBI in three games against Houston last season...in 37 career games against the Astros, he is hitting .319 (38-for-119) with an .831 OPS.

Byron Buxton has multiple hits in four consecutive games against the Astros, dating back to July 4, 2024...in that span he has eight hits in 16 at-bats, including one double, one home run, five runs scored and three RBI.

**C4-EVER MINNESOTA:** Since joining the Twins from the Astros in 2022, Carlos Correa has played in 364 games for Minnesota, hitting .269 (371-for-1380) with 74 doubles, five triples, 54 home runs, 184 RBI, 186 runs scored, 161 walks and a .794 OPS...below are some of his numbers each year since coming to Minnesota, excluding his seven games played this season:

**WEST WAS THE BEST:** The Twins went 25-8 against the AL West last season, going 6-1 vs. Oakland, 5-2 vs. Seattle, 5-1 vs. Los Angeles, 5-2 vs. Texas and 4-2 vs. Houston...Minnesota's .758 winning percentage against that division was the highest in their history since MLB switched to the current divisional format in 1994...25 total wins was second to their 1996 total of 27.

**WILL-TY CONSCIENCE:** Willi Castro has reached base safely in all seven of the Twins games after hitting safely in each of his first four, getting hit-by-a-pitch in his next two at Chicago-AL, followed by a single on Thursday...he is one of 10 players in the AL to reach safely in all of their games played (min. 7 games), joining Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (8), Kristian Campbell (8), Cal Raleigh (8), Julio Rodriguez (8), Jacob Wilson (8), Adley Rutschman (8), Isaac Paredes (7), George Springer (7) and Alex Bregman (7).

**THE WALKING'S DEAD:** Minnesota has not drawn a walk in two consecutive games, first time doing that since September 16-17 (1), 2022...their last walk was a Ty France eighth inning free pass on Tuesday in Chicago...of their seven games, they have gone walk-less in three of those...on the season, they have walked 15 times, the fewest in baseball...MLB's leader is the Cubs with 50.

The last time the Twins did not draw a walk in three-straight games came June 14-16, 2001.

**MINOR MATTERS:** High-A Cedar Rapids and Low-A Fort Myers both began their seasons last night...Double-A Wichita was scheduled to play at Springfield but was rained out.

Cedar Rapids beat Wisconsin by a score of 4-1...Charlee Soto was the starter, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, three walks and five strikeouts...Spencer Bengard pitched 4.0 no-hit innings of relief, walking one and striking out six...Gabby Gonzalez went 2-for-4 with a double.

Fort Myers lost to Palm Beach by a score of 8-2...Eli Jones was the starter for the Mighty Mussels, making his professional debut, allowing four runs (3 earned) on seven hits in 4.1 innings pitched...outfielder Byron Chourio reached four times, going 1-for-2 with three walks.

**ICYMI:** Right-handed pitcher Randy Dobnak cleared waivers on Wednesday and accepted his assignment to Triple-A St. Paul...Dobnak was on the Opening Day roster and pitched 5.1 innings on March 30 at St. Louis...he was designated for assignment on March 31, creating roster space for Darren McCaughan.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2014, Ron Gardenhire earned his 1,000th career managerial victory with a 7-3 win at Cleveland, managing his 1,950th career game...Gardy is second on the Twins all-time list for managerial victories with 1,068, trailing Tom Kelly's 1,140...in 2019, Jorge Polanco became the 11th player in club history to hit for the cycle, doing so at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia...he also became the 55th player in club history with five-plus hits in one game, going 5-for-5.
