REDBIRD RUNDOWN: The defending 2019 NL Central St. Louis Cardinals continue their five-day, eight-game Windy City road trip with today's finale of a three-game series against the Chicago White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field ... Beginning tomorrow, the Cardinals and division-rival Chicago Cubs face off in a five-game series at Wrigley Field, with doubleheaders planned for Monday and Wednesday.

SWEEP STAKES: With a win today, St. Louis would earn its first three-game series sweep of the White Sox since June 15-17, 2001 at Busch Stadium II ... Yesterday marked the Cardinals' first doubleheader sweep on the road since August 31, 2002, when they won 8-1 and 10-4 over the Cubs at Wrigley Field.

SECOND CHANCES: The Cardinals are scheduled to play 51 games (27 on the road) over the final 43 days of the season, including nine doubleheaders (53 games in 44 days, if necessary). **LET'S PLAY TWO:** The last time the Cardinals played three doubleheaders over a five-day span was September 15-19, 1979 (also four twinbills in eight days).

ELIAS SAYS: According to *Elias*, the last team to have a similar schedule was the 1975 Minnesota Twins, who had 54 games in 48 days, also including 11 doubleheaders ... The last time the Cardinals played 50 or more games in fewer than 50 days was in 1989 (Aug-Sep) when they had several stretches of 51 games in 49 days or 50 games in 48 days ... The worst stretch in Cardinals history came in 1931 when they had 58 games in 49 days spanning May to July.

STAYING GROUNDED: Today features the two top groundball pitchers in MLB from last year, with **Dallas Keuchel** leading at 61.0% and **Dakota Hudson** ranking 2nd at 57.1% ... Since his MLB debut (July 28, 2018), Hudson sports the 2nd-best ground ball pct. in the league (57.7%) trailing **Marcus Stroman** (57.9%).

THE WINDY CITY WEEK: This marks the 4th time the Cardinals face the White Sox and Cubs in back-to-back series (2001, 2015, 2018, 2020) and the first time in franchise history occurring in the city of Chicago. **MORE ELIAS:** The Cardinals are scheduled to become the 3rd team in MLB history to play eight consecutive games in the city of Chicago against either the ChiSox and/or Cubbies, joining the 1935 New York Yankees (4 DH vs. White Sox from Aug. 25-28) and the 1916 Philadelphia Athletics (3 DH vs. White Sox from July 29-Aug. 2, 1916).

SOUTH SIDE DEBUTS: With his start at first base today, **John Nogowski** becomes the ninth Cardinal all-time to make his Major League debut against the Chicago White Sox, joining **Max Schrock** (2020), **Jake Woodford** (2020), **Dylan Carlson** (2020), **Stephen Piscotty** (2015), **Marcus Hatley** (2015), **Eli Marrero** (1997), and **Luis Ordaz** (1997) ... The last time three Cardinals made their MLB debuts in the same game was 2008 Opening Day vs. Colorado on April 01, 2008: **Brian Barton**, **Rico Washington**, and **Kyle McClellan**. (*Elias*)

🔥🔥🔥: According to *Statcast*, **Alex Reyes** yesterday became the first pitcher this season to record three strikeouts at 98+ mph in the same inning ... Starters **Dustin May** and **Jacob deGrom** are the only pitchers to have three in an entire game this season ... Reyes's three strikeouts were his most since fanning six vs. Cincinnati (Sept. 26, 2016), and marked the first time he fanned the side in his career ... Prior to yesterday, Reyes's previous appearance for St. Louis was April 05, 2019 vs. San Diego.

DESIGNATED TO HIT: Since the beginning of interleague play (1997-present), the Cardinals lead MLB teams in batting average (.295), co-lead in on-base pct. (.368), and rank 2nd to the Red Sox (.513, .881) in slugging pct. (.498) and OPS (.866) from their designated hitters ... Today marks **Paul Goldschmidt**'s first appearance at designated hitter since joining the Cardinals and the eighth time in his career ... Goldy has gone yard in three of his last four games appearing at designated hitter.

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: St. Louis is 192-187 all-time in Interleague play, with a .507 win pct. that trails the Cubs (.517) and Mets (.517) for 3rd-best all-time among National League clubs...St. Louis has finished with a winning Interleague record 12 times in 23 seasons (since 1997)...St. Louis is 2-2 vs. the American League this season.

BIRD BYTES: **Matt Carpenter**'s next double will be the 286th of his career, moving him into a tie with **Frankie Frisch** (1927-37) for 13th all-time in franchise history ... **Andrew Miller** has held the White Sox scoreless over his last 27.2 innings, the longest scoreless innings streak against the White Sox since **Mariano Rivera** (34.0 IP from July 4, 1995-July 26, 1998) ... **Andrew Knizner** (.310/.370/.524, 13-42) has hit safely in each of his last 11 starts (July 17, 2019-present) for the longest active hit streak for a catcher in the Majors ... entering today's game, the Cardinals sport the highest all-time on-base percentage at Guaranteed Rate Field (.368) in 15 games, while their batting average (.288) and OPS (.833) rank 2nd to the Phillies (.303 BA, .929 OPS BA) who have played in five games at the ballpark.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (August 16, 1964): Outfielder **Curt Flood** collects eight consecutive hits during a doubleheader against Dodgers pitching. The Cardinals split the twinbill in Los Angeles, losing the opener to **Sandy Koufax**, 3-0, but take the nightcap when **Curt Simmons** tosses a six-hitter to give the Redbirds a 4-0 victory.

Andrew Knizner and **Carlos Rodón** were teammates while at North Carolina State University.

Jack Flaherty was high school teammates with White Sox pitcher **Lucas Giolito** and Braves pitcher **Max Fried** while at Harvard-Westlake High School in Los Angeles, Calif.

Dylan Carlson and **Nick Madrigal** were teammates at Elk Grove (Calif.) High School.

Ross Detwiler was born in St. Louis...graduated from Holt High School in Wentzville, Mo...pitched three seasons (2005-07) at Missouri State Univ.

Brad Miller played AAU baseball for former White Sox All-Star outfielder **Chet Lemon** in Florida.

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** managed Chicago for parts of eight seasons (1979-86)...began managerial career in 1978 in the White Sox minor league system with AA-Knoxville Sox of the Southern League...played two minor league seasons in the White Sox organization for the AAA-Denver Bears (1975) and AAA-Iowa Oaks (1976).

White Sox Pitching Consultant **Dave Duncan** served as St. Louis' pitching coach for 16 seasons (1996-2011)...under his watch, the Cardinals ranked third in the majors in overall ERA and third in starting-pitching ERA...coached Chris Carpenter to 2005 Cy Young Award and four Cardinals to 20 game-winning seasons (Carpenter, 2005; Adam Wainwright, 2010; Matt Morris, 2001; Darryl Kile, 2000)...awarded 2009 Meritorious Service Award by St. Louis BBWAA.

Steve Cishek appeared in 27 games with St. Louis in 2015...originally traded by the Marlins to St. Louis for Kyle Barraclough (July 24, 2015).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** pitched in 52 games for the White Sox in 1988...originally traded by the Cardinals with outfielder Lance Johnson and cash to Chicago for pitcher Jose DeLeon.

Cardinals VP/General Manager **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Cardinals broadcaster **John Rooney** spent 18 years (1998-2005) with the White Sox - one in TV followed by 17 seasons in radio...Rooney worked with the World Champion team in back-to-back seasons, following the White Sox win in 2005.

White Sox Assistant Hitting Coach **Scott Coolbaugh** played the 1994 season in the Cardinals organization where he was teammates with **Bryan Eversgerd** in St. Louis and Louisville (AAA).

White Sox Bench Coach **Joe McEwing** was selected by the Cardinals in the 28th round of the 1992 MLB Draft...played parts of two seasons with St. Louis (1998-99)...made his Major League debut with the Cardinals on September 2, 1998 at Florida...later traded to the Mets for pitcher **Jesse Orosco** (March 18, 2000).

White Sox Head Groundskeeper **Roger Bossard** designed and built new playing fields at Busch Stadium II and Busch Stadium III, as well as Roger Dean Stadium in Jupiter, Fla.

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his second start of the 2020 season and 34th career start (61st appearance).
- Pitching for the first time in 20 days (7/26 vs. PIT), has a 2-3 record with a 4.17 ERA in six starts with 6+ Days Rest in his career.
- Since making his MLB debut on July 28, 2018, has the 2nd-best ground ball pct. in the league (57.7%) trailing only Marcus Stroman (57.9%) who has opted out of the 2020 season.
- Has a 7-3 record with a 3.63 ERA in 19 career appearances (14 starts) in day games.
- Has yet to surrender a home run in a road day appearance, spanning five starts (7 app.) and 27.2 career innings (119 total batters faced).
- Is 7-2 with a 2.64 ERA in 19 career August appearances (6 starts); and is 4-1 with a 2.38 ERA in his six starts including earning the win in his last four straight.
- Ran off his career high 18.2 scoreless innings last August (8/14-24/2019).
- Recorded seven career wins (7-3, 3.94 ERA) on Saturday's, his highest win total day to pitch during the week.
- Has allowed more than three runs only twice (8/31/19 vs. CIN-2 & 7/26/20 vs. Pirates, 4 runs each) over his last 11 starts.

LAST TIME OUT

- Received the loss after allowing four earned runs over 4.1 innings, including home runs by Pirates 3B Colin Moran and OF José Osuna in the 4th inning. Only faced one batter with a runner in scoring position.
- Allowed 4+ runs for only the second time over his last 11 starts dating back to last season (8/9/19).
- Allowed multiple home runs for the first time since July 28, 2019 (vs. HOU, 3)

- Led all Major League rookies with 16 wins & finished T3rd overall among N.L. wins leaders with Clayton Kershaw (LAD).
- His team-leading 16 victories makes him the first Cardinals rookie to lead the team in that category since Matt Morris (12, 1997). His 16 wins are also the most by a rookie since Justin Verlander won 17 for Detroit in 2006 and the most by a Cardinals rookie since Dick Hughes won 16 in 1964.
- His .696 win pct. (16-7) was the best by Cardinals rookie since Dick Hughes (.727, 16-6) in 1964, while his 3.35 ERA was best by Cardinals rookie since Shelby Miller (3.06) in 2013. Both marks trailed Atlanta's Mike Soroka (.765, 2.68) among NL rookies.
- Was 9-2 with a 2.75 ERA in 17 starts at Busch Stadium this season with the Cardinals going 13-4 (.765) in his home starts. His nine home wins are the most by a St. Louis rookie since Shelby Miller had 10 in 2013, while his .818 winning pct. ranks 5th among all Cardinals rookie starters and highest since Harvey Haddix (.867, 13-2) in 1953.
- Hurled 174.2 innings in 2019, marking the most innings pitched by a St. Louis rookie in the regular season since Rick Ankiel had 175.0 IP in 2000.
- Crossed the 200.0 IP threshold (202.0 total IP) for his career in his last start with 5.0 scoreless frames 9/27 vs. the Cubs at Busch Stadium, which also marked his 5th start of at least 5.0+ innings without a run allowed after Aug. 14. Teammate Jack Flaherty (8) was the only other MLB pitcher with at least five such starts after Aug. 1.
- Is the majors 1st pitcher with 15+ wins & 1+ save in a season since Seattle's Randy Johnson (1993) who was 19-8 with 1 save. The last rookie to do so (min. 25 GS) was the Yankees' Ron Guidry (16-7, 1 save in 31 games/25 starts) in 1977.
- He joins teammate John Gant (11-1, 3 Saves) and Andrew Cashner (11-8, 1 save) as one of three Major League pitchers with at least 11 wins and one save in 2019.
