TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs Christine Neglev's Phillies that falls in the middle of a 6-game road trip to Wsh (2-1) and Wrigley Field (0-2) and an upcoming 4-game road trip to StL....the Reds' 2-1 series win at Wsh last week included victories by Tyler Mahle & Sonny Gray over Max Scherzer & Stephen Strasburg...the Redlegs are 21 games (8-13) into a stretch in which they will play 29 games in 31 days, including one scheduled day off and a rainout on 5/9 at Cle...are finishing this 31-day stretch with games on 13 consecutive days, concluding with the upcoming 4-game series at StL's Busch Stadium.

TRANSACTIONS: The Reds today reinstated from the 10-day injured list starting pitcher LHP Wade Miley and optioned to Class AAA Louisville LHP Cionel Pérez

MEMORIAL DAY: Since Memorial Day became a federal holiday in 1971, the Reds are 28-19 on the final Monday in May, including 20-11 beginning in 1990...in their most recent action on Memorial Day, in 2019, the Reds and Pirates split a doubleheader (8-3 loss, 8-1 win)...was the Reds' fourth doubleheader on Memorial Day, including 1975 vs Montreal (4-3 win, 5-4 win), 1980 vs LAD (4-0 loss, 5-4 win), 1997 vs Phi (8-5 win, 8-4 win) and 2019 vs Pit (8-5 loss, 8-1 win).

SERIES NOTES: Beginning tomorrow afternoon at Great American Ball Park. the Reds and Phillies will meet for the first time since September 2019...in the Reds win on 9/4/19 at Great American Ball Park, for the first time in modern Major League history home runs were hit by 4 batters who did not start the game, including pinch hitters Logan Morrison & Jay Bruce of the Phillies and pinch hitter José Iglesias & relief pitcher Michael Lorenzen of the Reds.

MAX OUT: The Reds will return Great American Ball Park to full capacity beginning Wednesday, following Gov. Mike DeWine's announcement ending Ohio's coronavirus health orders...beginning Wednesday, masks will be recommended but no longer mandated to be worn by fans at GABP... masks must be worn by media working in the main press box...outdoor auxiliary seating behind Sections 109-111 is available to members of the media who choose to not wear a mask.

SURGERY: IF/OF Nick Senzel on Friday had arthroscopic debridement to clean out cartilage on the undersurface of the patella in his left knee (Dr. Timothy Kremcheck)...a timetable for his return to baseball activity is to be determined...on 5/21, Senzel went on the 10-day injured list with left knee inflammation...he hasn't played since 5/17 vs SF.

DOT, DOT, DOT. .: The Reds went 7-6-3 in their 16 completed series. including 4-3-1 at GABP and 3-3-2 on the road...have 1 series sweep win (3g vs Pit) and 3 series sweep losses (3g vs Ari, 3g at StL, 4g vs SF)...are 0-18 when recording fewer hits than the opponent...are 19-17 when hitting at least 1 HR, **13-9** when hitting at least 2 HR and **3-11** when they don't homer... the game time on 6/17 at SD has been changed to 8:40et (from 10:10et) to

accommodate "San Diego's Opening Day" ceremonies and a post-game fireworks show

PLAYER THE WEEK: LHP Wade Miley was named National League Player of the Week after throwing a no-hitter in a 3-0 win on 5/7 at Cle...is his first weekly award...he is the first Reds player to win the award since RF Nick Castellanos won it after the first full week of last season and the first Reds pitcher to receive the recognition since 2014 (LHP Aroldis Chapman 7/13, RHP Johnny Cueto 8/10).

REDS HOF INDUCTION: Marty Brennaman, who spent 46 years in the Reds on Radio booth, will become the first broadcaster inducted into the Reds Hall of Fame during ceremonies on Fri, 8/27...the event will include an alumni softball game...former players scheduled to attend the festivities include Johnny Bench, Todd Benzinger, Jack Billingham, Bret Boone, Dave Bristol, Tom Browning, Leo Cardenas, Clay Carroll, Sean Casey, Norm Charlton, David Concepción, Zack Cozart, Eric Davis, Rob Dibble, Bill Doran, Adam Dunn, Rawly Eastwick, Doug Flynn, George Foster, Wayne Granger, Danny Graves, Tommy Helms, Barry Larkin, Brandon Larson, Jim Maloney, Corky Miller, Hal Morris, Randy Myers, Fred Norman, Ron Oester, Joe Oliver, Ted Power, Dave Parker, John Riedling, Jose Rijo, Arthur Rhodes, Pete Rose, Chris Sabo, Mario Soto, Brett Tomko, Greg Vaughn, David Weathers, Scott Williamson, Herm Winningham and Dmitri Young...ticket information will be announced at a later date.

SHIFTED: Since the left thumb injury to Joey Votto on 5/5, the Reds' starting lineup regularly includes Mike Moustakas and others at first base, rookie Jonathan India or Nick Senzel at second base, Eugenio Suárez at third base and Kyle Farmer at shortstop...Moustakas and Senzel went on the 10-day injured list last week...until Votto's injury, Moustakas made every start at third base and Suárez every start at shortstop...during spring training, Suárez switched from third base to shortstop and Moustakas switched from second base to third base...India led the team with 16 spring training starts at second base...in 2015, Suárez led the Reds in starts SS but in each of the previous 5 seasons led the team in starts at **3B...**he holds the National League record for **home runs** by a **third baseman** (49hr in 2019)...in the first 9 seasons of his Major League career through 2019, Moustakas made 1,042 apps at 3B and 47 apps at 2B... he received Rawlings Gold Glove Award votes for defensive excellence at third base in 2012, 2015, 2018 and 2019, finishing second in the balloting in 2012...last season played 2B full-time for the first time in his career and led Cin in games at that position.

Today's Pitcher - #22 Wade Miley, LHP

RED HOTS

- Today is coming off the 10-day injured list to make his ninth start of the season and his first appearance since 5/19.
- In the third inning of his most recent start, on 5/19 vs SF, suffered a left heel injury running out of the batter's box on a groundout...left the game with 2 outs in the top of the fifth inning...x-rays were negative and an MRI showed no damage, but the next day went on the 10-day injured list with a left foot sprain.
- In the 3-0 win on 5/7 at Cle threw his first career no-hitter, third career complete game and second career shutout...was the 17th no-hitter in Reds history and fourth in Major League Baseball on the 2021 season's 37th day, the second-fastest ever to 4 no-hitters in a single season (4 no-hitters in the first 25 days of the 1917 campaign)...the longest no-hit bids of his career had been 6.0 innings (7/17/15 for Bos at LAA, 7/30/16 for Sea at Cubs)...allowed 2 baserunners...Amed Rosario reached second base on a double error by 2B Nick Senzel with 1 out in the bottom of the sixth inning, and Cesar Hernandez walked 1 out later...at 34 years, 175 days old is the oldest Reds pitcher to throw a no-hitter (Tom Seaver 33 years, 211 days in 1978)...the Reds broke the scoreless tie with 3 runs in the top of the ninth inning...the start of the game was delayed 1 hour, 23 minutes by weather.
- In the 9-6 loss on 5/14 at Col, his first start since his no-hitter, allowed a season high 11 hits and 8 runs, his highest totals since he allowed 12 hits and 9 runs on 6/2/16 for Sea at SD...allowed a leadoff triple to Garrett Hampson.
- Following his no-hitter was named National League Player of the Week, his first weekly award.
- With the bases loaded in the 10th inning of the 5-1 win on 5/12 at Pit made the second pinch-hitting appearance of his career and popped out to the third baseman off Duane Underwood Jr.....made his only other pinch-hitting appearance in the 13th inning of the 14-inning, 5-4 Diamondbacks win on 8/14/13 vs
- Bal, lined out off Tommy Hunter.
 Began the season with 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings until José Ramírez homered with 2 outs in the first inning of his third start, on 4/18 vs Cle...in that 6-3 loss allowed all 4 runs on a pair of 2-out home runs (Ramírez solo, Roberto Pérez 3-run)...in the bottom of the seventh inning was ejected by 1B umpire Bill Welke after Jesse Winker struck out on a disputed foul tip...was Miley's second career ejection.
- Joined Anthony DeSclafani as the only Reds pitchers since 1893, when the pitcher's mound was moved to its current distance from home plate, to begin a season with consecutive starts of at least 5.0 scoreless innings...DeSclafani did it last season (5ip/3h, 6ip/2h)...courtesy @EliasSports.
- In his season debut in the 14-1 win on 4/6 vs Pit, threw 6.0 scoreless innings in the 250th start of his career.
- Is his second season with the Reds...joined the club in December 2019, when he signed a 2-year contract through this year.

- Is making the 197th start of his Major League career...will be his third career start vs the Phillies.
- Was hampered during spring training with a muscle strain in his back and began the regular season on the 10-day injured list.
- Made 1 Cactus League appearance, on 3/4 vs the Royals...didn't pitch in another "A" game the rest of the spring.

 In 55 apps beginning 8/25/18, his ERA of 3.06 (291ip, 99er) is sixth-best among Major League pitchers (Jacob deGrom 2.13, Hyun-Jin Ryu 2.36, Gerrit Cole 2.53, Walker Buehler 2.98, Clayton Kershaw 3.02).
- In his last 35 regular season starts beginning 6/28/19 is 14-9, 2.78 (197.2ip, 135h, 61er, 82bb, 244k, .190oba) with 21 quality starts.

 In his last 19 starts at Great American Ball Park beginning 6/16/19 is 11-3, 2.72 (106ip, 71h, 32er, 36bb, 141k, 15hr, .188), including wins in 7 straight home starts from 6/16-8/20 snapped by a 4-2 loss to the Brewers in his final appearance of 2019...became only the second pitcher ever to win 7 consecutive starts at GABP...Johnny Cueto won 7 straight starts from 6/6-8/18, 2012.
