REDS BATTERS

REDS BATTERS Road Trip: .219, 4 HR, 15 runs (2.50 r/g), 18bb, 50k • Among the National League leaders rank second in hitting and slugging percentage and third in on-base percentage.

• Homered in 37 of their 51 games, including 22 multi-homer games and a season-high 6-homer game in a 14-11 loss in 10 innings on 4/22 vs Ari...are on pace for 225 HR...the team record for HR in a season is 227 in 2019...the National League record is 279 HR (LAD, 2019)...

4 SHOGO AKIYAMA, of Road Trip: 1gs in CF, 3g as PH, 0-4, 1bb, 1sb • Last started in Thu's 3-0 win at Wsh, played CF...was his fifth start of the season, his first start since 5/19 vs SF. • In his last 4 starts went 5-for-13 (.385, 2rbi, 1bb), including a 2-hit game on 5/14 at Col and a 3-hit game on 5/16 at Col.

44 ARISTIDES AQUINO, of 10-Day Injured List • First name is pronounced are-iss-TEEDIS. • Has been on the injured list since 4/16 (left hamate fracture), when he had surgery to remove the hook of the hamate in his left hand...was transferred from the 10-day to the 60-day injured list on 4/25, when RHP Vladimir Gutierrez was reinstated from the restricted list.

16 TUCKER BARNHART, c Road Trip: 4gs, 3-13, 1 2b, 2rbi, 2bb, 1hbp • Caught Wade Miley's no-hitter, a 3-0 win on 5/7 at Cle...caught a no-hitter for the first time in his career. • In yesterday's 5-1 win at Cubs went 0-for-1 (1rbi, 2bb, 1hbp), snapping a 3-game hitting streak (3-12, .250, 1 2b, 1rbi).

0 ALEX BLANDINO, inf/of Road Trip: 4g, 2gs at 1B, 0-9 • Last played in Sat's 10-2 loss at Cubs, made his sixth straight start at 1B. • Last started at a position other than 1B on 4/27 at LAD (2B).

43 CIONEL PÉREZ, lhp

Road Trip: 2g, 1.2ip, 3h, 1er, 1bb, 1k

- First name is pronounced see-oh-NELL...accent mark in Pérez.
- Was promoted for his third stint with the Reds on Thu, when starter RHP Jeff Hoffman went on the 10-day injured list...was on the active roster for the completion of that afternoon's suspended game and was the Reds' "starter" when it resumed.
- Started Thu's portion of the suspended game at Wsh and threw a perfect bottom of the fourth inning.
- Was on the Opening Day roster...posted an 8.31 ERA in 10 apps before he was optioned to the Taxi Squad on 4/23 prior to the road trip to StL/LAD...was recalled on 5/5, when RHP José De León was optioned to Louisville, and posted a 6.75 ERA in 5 apps before he was optioned to Louisville on 5/18.
- In 2 apps overall for the Bats didn't allow a hit (2ip, 2bb, 3k).
- Pitched in 3 of the Reds' 9 extra-inning games.
- 4 times threw consecutive days (last, 5/13-5/14 at Col), including 3 straight days from 4/20-4/22 vs Ari.
- Retired the first batter in 14 of his 17 apps...stranded 5 of 10 inherited runners.
- On 4/9 at Ari recorded the final 2 outs of the ninth inning to preserve the 5-5 tie and then earned the win, his first for the Reds, when they scored in the top of the 10th.
- Is in his first season with the Reds.
- Was acquired from the Astros on 1/23/21 for minor league C Luke Berryhill.
- Spent most of 2020 Summer Camp assigned to the Astros' alternate spring training site in Round Rock.
- From 7/12-8/18 was on the minor league 60-day injured list.
- Made all his 7 apps for the Astros from 8/20-9/4 (4g, 4.1ip) and 9/6-9/15 (3g, 2ip).
- Was on the Astros' 40-player Postseason roster but was not added to the Wild Card, Division Series or NLCS active rosters.

39 LUCAS SIMS, rhp

Road Trip: 2sv, 3g, 2.1ip, 0h, 0r, 1bb, 3k

- Has 3 saves as a professional, all this season and including saves in each of his last 2 apps.
- Did not convert his first save chance but has converted each of his last 3 save opps.
- In the 3-0 win on 4/12 at SF earned his first professional save...entered the game in the ninth inning with 2 outs and a runner on base in relief of Tejay Antone, who had thrown 3.2 hitless innings, and struck out Evan Longoria.
- In Tue's 2-1 win at Wsh, in relief of Amir Garrett retired his only batter on 4 pitches to earn his second save (Starlin Castro, 5-3).
- In Thu's 7-inning, 3-0 win at Wsh threw a perfect seventh inning for his third save.
- 5 times threw more than 1.0 inning...twice threw a season-high 2.0 innings, in consecutive apps on 5/12 at Pit and 5/15 at Col.
- Pitched in 8 of the Reds' 9 extra-inning games, including each of the last 4.
- Retired the first batter in 13 of his 19 apps...stranded 6 of 10 inherited runners.
- From 4/20-4/22 pitched 3 consecutive days for the only time in his career...was pitching when the 4/20 game was suspended and returned to the mound when the game resumed on 4/21...pitched again on 4/22.
- Began spring training with tightness in his right elbow and was limited to 3 apps in "A" Games...made his first appearance in an "A" Game on 3/23 (1ip, 3h, 2er, 0bb, 1k).
- Made his second Opening Day roster, both with the Reds (2020).

37 TYLER STEPHENSON, c

Road Trip: 4gs at 1B, 2gs at C, 2-20, 2 2b, 2rbi

- Over his last 8 apps has 2 hits in his last 24 at bats, including a career-high 0-for-13 skid snapped by a double on Fri at Cubs.
- In the sixth inning of Sat's 10-2 loss at Cubs produced a 2-run double off Keegan Thompson that tied the game at 2-2.
- Has made 18 starts at catcher, most recently in Sat's 10-2 loss at Cubs.
- Made his other 7 starts at 1B (last, Sun at Cubs)...his 9 apps and 7 starts at 1B are his only Major League apps at a position other than catcher...made 7 of his last 10 starts at 1B.
- In the starting lineup has hit third (3gs, last on 5/22 vs Mil), fourth (5gs, last on 5/30 at Cubs), fifth (4gs, last on 5/29 at Cubs), sixth (2gs, last on 5/5 vs WSox), seventh (4gs, last on 5/12 at Pit) and eighth (7gs, last on 4/23 at StL).
- In the Reds' 8-run eighth inning on 5/13 at Coors Field (13-8 loss) hit his second career pinch-hit HR (2-run off Lucas Gilbreath).
- As a pinch hitter with 1 out in the 10th inning of the 3-2 win on 4/17 vs Cle produced the game-ending hit, an RBI-single to the outfield wall off Oliver Pérez...was his second pinch-hit, walkoff hit within his first 45 Major League plate apps...also hit a 2-run HR off Pit's Sam Howard in the 3-1 win in the opener of a DH on 9/14/20.
- In 2021, made his first Opening Day roster.
- Was selected by the Reds in the first round (11th overall) of the June 2015 first-year player draft...was the first catcher taken in the draft and was rated by both *Baseball America* and MLB.com that year's best player at that position.

7 EUGENIO SUÁREZ, inf

Road Trip: 4gs at 3B, 1gs at SS, 6-21, 3 solo HR

- First name is pronounced AY-you-hay-nee-oh...accent mark in Suárez.
- Made each of his last 5 starts batting leadoff, his first career apps in the top spot in the lineup...hit safely in all 5 of his games batting first (6-20, .300, 3 solo HR, 2bb, 6r, .364obp, .750slg, 1.114ops).
- In Tue's 2-1 win at Wsh made his first career start batting leadoff and in the sixth inning hit a solo HR off Max Scherzer that extended the Reds' lead to 2-0.
- In Thu's 3-0 win at Wsh hit his first career leadoff HR (off Stephen Strasburg).
- In his last 20 apps has 7 HR and 14 RBI...hit the Reds' last 3 home runs.
- In the absence of injured Joey Votto, started at 3B in 18 of the Reds' last 22 games while Mike Moustakas and others played 1B and Kyle Farmer played shortstop...made 10 of his last 11 starts at 3B...made each of his first 27 starts of the season at SS, 30 starts there overall...his appearance at SS on Sat at Cubs snapped a streak of 9 straight starts at 3B.
- Led the Reds in starts at SS in 2015, his first season in Cincinnati, but in each of the 5 seasons from 2016-2020 led the team in starts at third base...this season still leads the team in starts at SS (29).
- During 2021 spring training, after 8 apps was moved from third base to shortstop...Mike Moustakas moved from second base back to his native third base...Jonathan India became the starting second baseman.
- In Wade Miley's no-hitter on 5/7 at Cle made his first start of the season at 3B.
- 4 times hit sixth in the batting order, his only starts of the season at that spot in the lineup and most recently Sun vs Mil...prior to this season, hadn't hit as low as sixth in the starting lineup since he hit sixth in a 5-1 loss on 9/8/17 at NYM.
- This season has made starts batting first (5gs, last on 5/30 at Cubs), third (6gs, last on 5/19 vs SF), fourth (21gs, last on 5/22 vs Mil), fifth (12gs, last on 5/21 vs Mil) and sixth (4gs, last on 5/23 vs Mil).
- Became only the sixth shortstop in Reds history to homer on Opening Day (solo off Jack Flaherty)...was the first Reds shortstop to do it since Barry Larkin in 1995.
- In 2019 established records for home runs in a season by a player from Venezuela and by a National League third baseman (49).
- Is approaching 200 HR (173) and 500 RBI (493)...on 5/23 vs Mil made his 900th Major League appearance.

19 JOEY VOTTO, 1b

10-Day Injured List

- Beginning 5/7 has missed the last 22 games while on the 10-day injured list with a broken left thumb...the Reds went 8-14 in his absence.
- In the 10-inning, 1-0 win on 5/5 vs WSox made his 1,800th Major League appearance...in the bottom of the fourth inning was hit by a Dallas Keuchel changeup and left the game after the fifth with the broken left thumb.

33 JESSE WINKER, if

Road Trip: 7-23 (.304), 1rbi, 3bb, 1hbp, 3r

- Hit safely in 7 of his last 9 apps (14-36, .389, 5hr, 6rbi, 10r, .463obp, .806slg, 1.269ops), including a pair of 4-hit games and a 3-homer game on 5/21 vs Mil.
- From 5/21-5/23 vs Mil became the first Reds batter with 5 HR in a 3-game series since Willie Greene did it from 9/24-9/26, 1996 vs Cubs (5hr) and the first ML player since José Abreu did it from 8/21-8/23, 2020, also vs Cubs (6hr).
- On 5/21 vs Mil became the 31st player in Reds history to produce 3 HR in a game, accomplished for the 39th time (off Adrian Houser 2, Josh Lindblom).
- On 5/23 vs Mil hit a 456-foot HR off Freddy Peralta, the longest homer of his career and the second-longest by a Reds batter this season (Tyler Naquin, 5/21 vs Mil off Adrian Houser, 459 feet).
- Has 3 leadoff HR this season and 7 in his career.
- Hit safely in 35 of his 43 starts and reached base safely in 39 of his 43 starts.
- Hit safely in 35 of his 45 apps overall and reached base safely in 39 of his 45 apps.
- In the third inning of the 7-2 loss on 5/11 at Pit became the 41st player to hit a homer that reached on the fly or bounced into the Allegheny River (61st time).
- In the 10-inning, 1-0 win on 5/5 vs WSox produced his third career game-ending hit, an RBI-single off Liam Hendriks.
- Started at designated hitter in the Reds' only 2 interleague road games of the season, on 5/7 & 5/8 at Cle (2-7, .286, 1 2b, 1bb).
- On 5/7 at Cle was the designated hitter in Wade Miley's no-hitter, the Reds' first interleague road game of the season.
