TONIGHT'S GAME: The Brewers and Reds meet for the second and final time this spring.....the Brewers won, 8-7, on 2/22 in Phoenix.....they meet in the regular season from 4/3-4/6 (MIL), 6/2-6/4 (CIN), 8/15-8/17 (CIN) and 9/26-9/28 (MIL).

YESTERDAY'S GAME: The Brewers and Guardians played to a 12-12 tie in Goodyear.....CF Sal Frelick went 3-for-3 with 3 runs, a HR, 3 RBI and a stolen base.....2B Raynel Delgado went 2-for-2 with a 2-run homer.....LF Manuel Margot went 1-for-3 with a double and 3 RBI.

THE ROSTER: The team currently has 62 players in Major League camp: 30 pitchers, 7 catchers, 14 infielders and 11 outfielders.....there are 22 non-roster invitees in camp: 8 pitchers, 4 catchers, 6 infielders and 4 outfielders.

THE NEW BREW: LHP Tyler Alexander (free agent), RHP Grant Anderson (trade with TEX), LHP Nestor Cortes (trade with NYY), INF Caleb Durbin (trade with NYY), RHP Elvin Rodríguez (free agent), LHP Connor Thomas (Rule 5 Draft from STL) and LHP Grant Wolfram (free agent).

GONE FROM 2024: SS Willy Adames (SF), RHP Kevin Herget (NYM), LHP Wade Miley (CIN), LHP Hoby Milner (TEX), RHP Frankie Montas (NYM), RHP Colin Rea (CHC), RHP Joe Ross (PHI), C Gary Sánchez (BAL), RHP Devin Williams (NYY), RHP Bryse Wilson (CWS) and LHP Rob Zastryzny (CHC).

2024 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 93-69 and finished in first place in the NL Central, 10.0 games ahead of the Cardinals and Cubs.....the team tied the Padres for the fourth-best record in baseball, trailing only the Dodgers (98-64), Phillies (95-67) and Yankees (94-68).....the Brewers lost to the Mets, 2 games to 1, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight.....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons.....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 666 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the teams was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TONIGHT’S STARTER: #26 - LHP AARON ASHBY [* relief]

LHP Aaron Ashby, 26, went 1-2 with a 2.86 ERA in 14 games (2 starts) with Milwaukee last season.....he had three stints with the team (4/6-4/8, 6/5-6/6 and 8/25-end of season).....his first 2 outings came in starts, going 0-2 with a 6.23 ERA (8.2ip, 6er).....his last 12 outings came in relief, going 1-0 with a 1.37 ERA (19.2ip, 3er).....he also appeared in 25 games (14 starts) at Triple-A Nashville and went 4-7 with an 8.04 ERA.....Ashby missed all of 2023 with a left labrum tear.....he underwent surgery on 4/7/23, performed by Dr. Wiemi Douoguih.....Ashby was selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Crowder (MO) College.....he signed a 5-year contract with the team on 7/23/22 which runs through the 2027 season with club options for 2028 and 2029.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

LHP Tyler Alexander, 30, signed as a free agent on Feb. 12.....he went 6-5 with a 5.10 ERA in 23 games (9 starts) with Tampa Bay last season.....he set career highs in wins (6), innings pitched (107.2) and strikeouts (90).....Alexander pitched his previous five seasons (2019-23) with Detroit after he was selected in the second round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas Christian University.

RHP Trevor Megill, 31, went 1-3 with a 2.72 ERA and 21 saves in 48 relief appearances with Milwaukee last season.... he held opponents to a .200 batting average with 50 strikeouts in 46.1 innings.....his 21 saves led the team (9th in NL).

LHP Bryan Hudson, 27, went 6-1 with a 1.73 ERA in 43 relief appearances with Milwaukee last season after being acquired from the Dodgers on 1/3/24 in exchange for LHP Justin Chambers.....he held opponents to a .135 batting average with 62 strikeouts in 62.1 innings.....his 0.72 WHIP led National League relievers and ranked second in the Major Leagues behind the Guardians' Emmanuel Clase (0.68).

RHP Elvin Rodríguez, 27, signed as a free agent on Jan. 17.....he is signed through 2025 with a club option for 2026.... he pitched last season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Central League of Nippon Professional Baseball and went 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA and 1 save in 32 games (1 start).....he has pitched in the majors with Detroit (2022-7g, 5gs) and Tampa Bay (2023-1g).
