CARDINALS REMEMBER WHITEY HERZOG: The St. Louis Cardinals organization was saddened to hear of the passing of Hall of Fame Manager **Dorrel "Whitey" Herzog** at the age of 92 years-old. Herzog, known as the "White Rat" and the innovator of "Whitey Ball", a speed-based running offense and defense, managed the St. Louis Cardinals to three World Series in 1982, 1985 and 1987. He ranks 3rd on the Cardinals all-time managerial list with 822 wins trailing only Hall of Famers **Tony La Russa** (1,408) and **Red Schoendienst** (1,041). Herzog also managed the Texas Rangers, California Angels, and Kansas City Royals compiling an overall record of 1,281-1,125 (.532). He was a two-time National League Manager of the Year (1982 & 1985) and his No. 24 was retired by the Cardinals in 2010.

RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue on their two-city six-game road trip to Arizona (1-2) and Oakland (1-0) with the second of a three-game series against the Athletics in what could be their final visit to the Oakland Coliseum. St. Louis won 3-1 last night behind **Sonny Gray's** 6.0 scoreless innings en route to his 100th career win.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals open today's schedule in 5th place in the National League Central, 3.0 games out of first place behind Milwaukee (10-5) and Pittsburgh (11-6). St. Louis has spent one game over .500 on April 6 (5-4).

HAPPY BIRTHDAY NOLAN ARENADO!: Today, Cardinals third baseman **Nolan Arenado** celebrates his 33rd birthday. Since joining the Cardinals in 2021, Arenado has played a game on his birthday each season. Overall, Arenado is 8-for-29 (.276) on games on April 16 with a home run at San Diego in 2019. He has played seven Major League games on his birthday with six on the road entering today.

HISTORIC HOMECOMING: Last night, **Sonny Gray** returned to the Oakland Coliseum and earned his 100th career win. On August 15, 2013, Gray defeated the Houston Astros for his first Major League win coming at the Coliseum. He became the first Cardinals pitcher to win his 100th game at the same stadium as his 1st, but with a different team. In Major League Baseball history, only 20 pitchers have accomplished that feat, most recently former Cardinal **Jason Marquis** who won his first game with the Atlanta Braves at Turner Field on June 23, 2000 and then his 100th career win with the Washington Nationals at Turner Field on May 10, 2011. - *Courtesy Elias Sports Bureau*

WINN, WINN, WINN NO MATTER WHAT: Cardinals 22-year old shortstop **Masyn Winn** has compiled multiple hits in three straight games and leads the Cardinals with seven multiple-hit games this season (T-4th N.L.). The last Cardinals shortstop to rip off three or more straight multi-hit games at age 22 was **Edgar Renteria** in 1999. **Garry Templeton (1978)** and **Arnold Hauser (1911)** hold the Cardinals record for consecutive multi-hit games by a 22-year old shortstop with five.

WALKER'S SWINGING VS. THE A'S: With a hit tonight, Cardinals 21-year old outfielder **Jordan Walker** would be the first player in Cardinals history to begin his career with hits in his first five games against the Oakland Athletics. Walker has hit safely in his first four games vs. Oakland, dating back to August 14, 2023. Only three Cardinals have begun their career with hits in their first four games against the Athletics since Interleague play began in 1997: **Matt Carpenter**, **Andrew Knizner** and **Brendan Ryan**.

FOR THE GOOD OF THE TEAM: Last night, **Lars Nootbaar** dropped a sacrifice bunt in the 1st inning to move **Paul Goldschmidt** into scoring position before **Nolan Arenado** singled him home with the go-ahead/eventual game-winning RBI. Nootbaar became the first Cardinals player to drop a sacrifice bunt while batting in the No. 3 slot in the lineup since current teammate **Giovanny Gallegos** vs. Kansas City on May 22, 2019 (Game 1 of DH). The Cardinals were trailing 8-0 and Gallegos, who was in during a double shift, bunted **Matt Carpenter** and **Paul Goldschmidt** over before **Marcell Ozuna** hit an RBI single. The last player to start batting No. 3 to drop a sac bunt was Bay Area native and Stanford Baseball alum **Stephen Piscotty** vs. MIL on Sept. 9, 2016.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN': This year, the St. Louis Cardinals will play road series at all five California-based organizations. The 'Birds opened the season with the Los Angeles Dodgers (March 28-31), then drove down the Golden State Freeway to play the San Diego Padres (April 1-3). Today starts a series with the Oakland Athletics. May 13-15, the Cardinals will travel to Orange County with a series with the Los Angeles Angels. Finally, the Cardinals conclude the 2024 regular season across the Bay at the San Francisco Giants (Sept. 27-29).

OAKLAND CONNECTIONS

Sonny Gray was selected by Oakland in the 1st round (#18) of the 2011 MLB Draft...pitched parts of his first five seasons with the Athletics (2013-17) before traded to the Yankees with international bonus slot money for **Dustin Fowler**, **James Kaprielian**, and **Jorge Mateo** (July 31, 2017).

Andrew Kittredge made his MLB Debut vs. the Athletics (July 18, 2017 at Oakland)...fanned **Jaycob Brugman** (swinging) for his first batter faced.

Brandon Crawford was born in Mountain View, Calif., moved to Pleasanton in his youth and was a 2005 graduate of from Foothill High School.

Tommy Edman played college baseball at Stanford University (2014-16).

Daniel Descalso was born in Redwood City, Calif...graduated from Saint Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004...played college baseball at University of California, Davis (2005-07)...resides in Danville, Calif.

Willie McGee played 29 games for the Athletics in 1990 and a member of their AL Championship squad...traded by St. Louis to Oakland for **Daryl Green**, **Felix Jose**, and **Stan Royer**...was born in San Francisco, Calif...graduated from Harry Ellis High School in Richmond...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill...worked as an assistant coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo...resides in Hercules.

Dean Kiekhefer pitched in four games for Oakland during the 2018 season.

T.J. McFarland pitched in 66 games over two seasons for the Cardinals (2021-22).

Former 1999 Athletics 2nd round draft pick **Ryan Ludwick** and **Jason Isringhausen**, who pitched for the Athletics (1999-2001), are both Cardinals Player Development Special Advisors.

Athletics First Base coach **Mike Aldrete** was the Cardinals assistant hitting coach (2008-11) and

bench coach (2012-14)...member of the Cardinals 2011 World Championship team and 2013 National League pennant winner...his son, **Michael Aldrete**, was selected by St. Louis in the 39th round of the 2012 Draft.

Cardinals Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** previously served in a similar role with the Athletics from (1988-95)...is a native of nearby Santa Rosa, Calif.

Brandon Allen played in 44 games for the Athletics from 2011-12 & was the A's Opening Day 1st baseman in 2012.

Athletics Assistant Athletic Trainer **Brad LaRosa** spent three years in the same role with the Cardinals Springfield (AA) affiliate.

Hall of Famer **Dennis Eckersley** pitched nine seasons with Oakland (1987-95) and two with St. Louis (1996-97)...converted 386 of his 390 career saves between the Athletics (320) and Cardinals (66).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 4th start of the season and the 321st of his career (345th appearance).
- Making his 12th career start vs. the Athletics. Had one appearance vs. Oakland in 2023 with the Dodgers on August 1.
- Needs one strikeout to tie **Bill Doak** (1913-29) for 9th place all-time in Cardinals history with 938 strikeouts.
- Surpassed 1,900 innings in his last start vs. Philadelphia (4/10). Also passed **Kyle Lohse** (490.1) into second place at Busch Stadium III with 493.1 innings pitched and **Carlos Martínez** into 2nd place in strikeouts at the ballpark with 457.
- Pitched through the rain and tallied a season-high in innings pitched (5.0) and pitches thrown (94), despite the conditions. For the 2nd time in MLB history a pitching line read 5.0 IP, 1 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 4 BB, 6 SO (Brandon Woodruff, MIL, 2018).
- Was the Cardinals home opening starting pitcher for the first time in his career (4/4 vs. MIA).
- Is 76 strikeouts shy of 2,000 and 97.1 innings for 2,000.
- Returns to his original drafting team in 2024 for the first time since 2017 after pitching for the Twins (2018), Yankees (2018), Rangers (2019-20), White Sox (2021-23) and Dodgers (2023).
- Was teammates with current Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** in Quad Cities (2008) and Palm Beach (2009).
- Ranks 2nd behind only **Adam Wainwright** (29) with 24 postseason pitching appearances among Cardinals.
- Has five postseason wins as a member of the Cardinals, T-3rd in franchise history behind **Chris Carpenter** (10) and **Bob Gibson** (7).
- Won a career-high 18 games with St. Louis in 2012, his first full season as a starting pitcher.

LAST TIME OUT

- Pitched his third consecutive no decision through a game featuring a rain shower for the entirety. Allowed two unearned runs in the 1st inning on a dropped fly ball and didn't allow another hit through his next four innings, striking out six batters.
- Was only the second pitcher in MLB history since 1901 to post his pitching line of 5 IP, 1 R, 2 R, 0 ER, 4 BB and 6 SO, matching Brandon Woodruff from 2018 with Milwaukee.

- Has never pitched at Busch Stadium as a visitor. Before the Home Opener (4/4/23), his previous appearance in St. Louis was Sept. 28, 2017 vs. the Cubs (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 R, 5 K).
- His start today marks the 78th of his career at Busch Stadium III, passing **Jaime García** and tying **Kyle Lohse** for 2nd-most in stadium history (2006-present).
- Needs 6.0 innings pitched at home reach 490.0 for his career at Busch III to tie **Jaime García** and **Kyle Lohse** for 2nd in at Busch Stadium III history (2006-present).

CAREER

- Member of the 2011 Cardinals World Series Championship team and the 2013 National League Champions.
- Two-time All-Star with the National League (2012, did not pitch) and the American League (2021). Pitched a scoreless inning at Coors Field (7/12/21) in relief of starting pitcher **Shohei Ohtani**. Current teammates **Kyle Gibson** and **Andrew Kittredge** also pitched for the A.L. in that game.
- Placed in the Top 10 in the American League Cy Young Award voting in 2019 (5th), 2020 (6th) and 2021 (3rd).
- Recorded 26 double-digit strikeout games, 19th among pitchers since 2012, when he became a starting pitcher.
