**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals wrap up their season-opening six-game homestand with this afternoon's rubber game of a three-game series with the visiting New York Mets at Busch Stadium ... The Cardinals opened their 135th regular season of play in the National League by taking two-of-three from Tampa Bay over the weekend ... Tomorrow the Cardinals travel to Motown to begin a six-game road trip through Detroit (April 3-5) and Washington D.C. (April 6-8).

**POND SCUM:** A win today would give the Cardinals a winning homestand and second consecutive winning series over the Mets (May 2-4, 2025 at Busch III) ... St. Louis has won eight of its last 10 day games vs. the Mets at Busch dating back to July 8, 2017 ... The last time the Cards blanked the Mets in consecutive games was **1975** in a June 23 doubleheader at Shea Stadium (1-0 and 4-0) and the last time in St. Louis was **1968** on July 20 and July 21 (G1) in a pair of 2-0 shutouts at Busch II.

**NO FOOL'S GOLD:** The Cardinals are 6-5 all-time on April Fool's Day (2-3 at home), including a 1-2 record vs. the Mets:

- **2018:** Won 5-1 at Citi Field behind two homers from "Mr. Met" **Paul DeJong** and 5.0 innings of one-run ball from starter **Luke Weaver**.
- **2007 Opening Day:** Lost 6-1 at Busch III on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball in a rematch of the 2006 National League Championship Series ... **Chris Carpenter**, **Randy Flores**, and **Brad Thompson** made pitching appearances.
- **1996 Opening Day:** Lost 7-6 at Shea Stadium as the Mets scored seven unanswered in **Tony La Russa's** debut as Cardinals Manager.

**BACKSTOP BRILLIANCE:** **Iván Herrera** (17.0) and Atlanta's **Jonah Heim** (18.0) are the lone two Major League catchers with a perfect 0.00 catching ERA (min. 17.0 innings caught).

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING!!:** **JJ Wetherholt** has reached base safely in each of his first five career games, the first Cardinal to do so since **Jordan Walker** reached safely in his first 12 career games in 2023.

**GREAT SCOTT:** **Victor Scott II** is tied for the National League lead with three multi-hit games and ranks 4th in NL batting (.438) behind Washington's **Joey Wiemer** (.615), Cincinnati's **Sal Stewart** (.563), and Colorado's **TJ Rumfield** (.444).

**PETEY PEDRO POWER:** **Pedro Pagés** is lifetime 2-for-4 with a pair of home runs off **Freddy Peralta** ... Both homers were hit on September 2, 2024 at Milwaukee, the only multi-homer game of Pedro's career.

**NO APRIL FOOLS JOKE:** On April 1, 1987, St. Louis traded OF **Andy Van Slyke**, C **Mike LaValliere** and RHP **Mike Dunne** to the Pittsburgh Pirates in exchange for C **Tony Pena** ... La Valliere went on to win a Gold Glove with the Pirates in 1987 and Dunne was named the 1987 N.L. Rookie Pitcher of the Year by The Sporting News, but St. Louis won the National League title.

**THIS DATE IN BASEBALL HISTORY (April 1, 1985):** At Al Lang Stadium in St. Petersburg, Florida where the Mets and Cardinals share a Spring Training home, 28-year-old Mets pitching prospect **Sidd Finch** emerges in a Sports Illustrated article titled "The Curious Case of Sidd Finch" ... According to the **George Plimpton's** article, Finch wears one hiker's boot while pitching, plays the French horn, and throws his fastball 168 miles per hour.

#### NEW YORK METS CONNECTIONS

**Masyn Winn** (Aug. 18, 2023 at Busch III), **Chris Roycroft** (May 7, 2024 at Busch) and **Matt Swanson** (April 17, 2025 at Citi) made MLB debuts against the Mets.

**Ryne Stanek** pitched parts of the last two seasons with the Mets (2024-25).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** was born in Middletown, NY...graduated from Valley Central High School in Montgomery, NY...played college baseball at Seton Hall University.

**Luke Weaver** was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (No. 27) of the 2014 MLB Draft... pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18) before packaged in a trade to Arizona for **Paul Goldschmidt** (Dec. 5, 2018)...2016 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator **Scott Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

**Devin Williams** was born in St. Louis and is a Hazelwood West High School graduate.

**Oliver Marmol** was born in Elizabeth, NJ.

Mets Baseball Operations Special Assistant **Carlos Beltrán** played two All-Star seasons with St. Louis in 2012-13.

**Kyle Discoll** is a native of Toms River, NJ... played collegiately at Rutgers University...held multiple roles with the Mets organization from 2019-2023, including Pitching Data and Movement Analyst, Rehab Coordinator, Assistant Pitching Coordinator, and Triple-A pitching coach.

**Luis Garcia** pitched in 34 games for St. Louis in 2021.

Cardinals.TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** was traded to the Mets with **Jeromy Burnitz**, **Lou Collier**, **Jeff D'Amico**, and cash (January 21, 2002)... attended Spring Training with New York before being released (March 13, 2002).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **José Oquendo** played the first two seasons of his MLB career with the Mets...traded by NY with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis for **John Young** and **Angel Salazar** (April 2, 1985).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jason Isringhausen** was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of five seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

TODAY'S GAME:

- The 26-year-old Liberatore makes his 2nd start of the season and of the homestand this afternoon.
Libby will be making his 122nd career Major League appearance and his 55th career start.
The Cardinals are 13-13 in his 26 career starts at Busch Stadium, while Libby has gone 10-9 with a 3.71 ERA (131.0 IP/54 ER) with 9 quality starts.

LAST TIME OUT (Thursday, March 26 vs. Tampa Bay): W, 9-7; 5.0 IP, 7 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 2 SO, 78 pitches).

2025 HIGHLIGHTS:

CAREER YEAR: Joined the starting rotation in a full-time capacity and established career highs in wins (8), decisions (20), starts (29), quality starts (11), strikeouts (122), and innings pitched (151.2).

ST. LOUIS SOUTHPAWS: Libby's 29 starts in 2025 were the most by a St. Louis southpaw since Jaime Garcia (32 in 2011), and the most by any Cardinals left-hander age 25 or younger since the same 24-year-old Garcia in 2011.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS: Became the youngest Cardinals lefty to win eight games since 23-year-old Jaime Garcia (13 wins in 2010), while Libby's eight victories were the most by any Cardinals left-hander since Garcia's 10 wins in 2016.

LEFT IS RIGHT: Led all Major League left-handers age 25 or younger in strikeouts (122), co-led in quality starts (11), and ranked 2nd in wins (8) and starts (29).

THREE'S COMPANY: Limited his opposition to three runs or fewer in 21-of-29 starts, and two runs or fewer in eight consecutive from April 13-May 24, the longest streak by a Cardinal since Jack Flaherty ran off nine straight (July 7-Aug. 23, 2019).

LIMITING LEFTIES: Over his initial 13 starts of the season, held opposing left-handed batters to a .190/.254/.207 slash line (11-58) with one extra-base hit.

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher Sandy Koufax, whom he grew up admiring.
Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP Tink Hence.
Is a career 13-21 with a 4.81 ERA (258.0 IP) in his 55 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.

LIBERATORE vs. METS:

- Making his 3rd career start (5th app.) vs. the Mets, three of which have taken place at Citi Field.
His 1st start against the Mets was in a no-decision on 6/18/23 in Cardinals 8-7 win on a Nolan Arenado 9th inning home run.
In one meeting with the Mets last season, Libby threw a 2025 season-high 100 pitched and was saddled with the 3-0 loss (6.2 IP/2 ER) on 4/19/25 at Citi Field.

**WHIRLWIND OFFSEASON:** Acquired by Cleveland from Toronto in exchange for cash considerations on 12/17/25, and acquired by St. Louis from Cleveland in exchange for cash considerations on 1/6/26.

**vs. METS:** Has made 5 career relief appearances vs. Mets, the last on 5/19/23 while pitching for the Dodgers; 0-0, 6.23 ERA in 4.1 IP.
