ROSTER MOVE—Last night the Rays optioned RH **Louis Head** to Triple-A Durham...today the Rays reinstated RH **Diego Castillo** from a minimum stay on the 10-day IL due to right groin tightness...Castillo has a 3.14 ERA (14.1-IP, 5-ER) in 14 apps this season and was tied for the AL lead with 7 saves when he went on the IL...he is currently tied for 5th in the AL.

RAY MATTER—Last night the Rays defeated the Yankees, 9-1, to avoid being swept at home for the first time since April 19-21, 2019 vs. BOS...the Rays are 1-2 in their last 3 games, 2-4 in their last 6 games and 10-11 in their last 21 games, and would need a win tonight to avoid a .500 record for the 11th time in 40 games...their next loss will be the 20th of the season to tie their total from the 60-game 2020 season...the Rays are 3 GB of first-place Boston in the division but are in fourth place in the AL East.

- + Tonight the Rays continue a 6-game homestand against the Yankees (1-2) and Mets (3)...the Rays are 8-12 at home this season after going 20-9 last season...they are 1-4-1 in home series after going 6-0-4 in 2020, and 0-4-1 in their last five home series...the Rays have had back-to-back losing homestands for the first time since they went 2-4 from July 21-26, 2017 and 2-7 from Aug 4-13, 2017.
- + Castillo's reinstatement ends a stretch of a club-record-tying 13 players on the IL...this season the Rays have used 38 players (tied for 5th in majors), 22 pitchers (tied for 2nd) and 11 starting pitchers (2nd).
- + The Rays have nine comeback wins this season, overcoming a season-high 3-run deficit in 4 games...they have blown a lead in eight of their losses, tying their total from the shortened 2020 season.
- + The Rays have used 38 different batting orders in 39 games.

ABOUT THE OFFENSE—Last night the Rays offense scored 9 runs, their 3rd-highest output of the season behind April 20 at KC (14) and April 9 vs. NYY (10)...the 9 runs matched their total from the previous 5 games combined (May 7-12) and the 3 hits with RISP matched their total from the previous 4 games combined...last night's out-punt came after the Rays were held to 1 run on 7 hits in the first 2 games of the homestand, during which the Rays went a combined 0-for-9 with RISP.

- + This season the Rays are tied for 7th in the AL in runs (163), rank 13th in avg. (.219), 11th in on-base pct. (.300) and 11th in homers (40)...the .219 avg. would be the lowest in franchise history (.238 in 2020).
- + The Rays have struck out a major-league-most 413 times, ahead of the Brewers (387)...the Rays are on pace for 1,715 SO, which would be a major league record ahead of the 2019 Tigers (1,595)...the Rays have a majors-most 27 games of reaching double-digit strikeouts.
- + The Rays have scored 1 run (or fewer) nine times this season, tied for most in the majors, compared to six times during the abbreviated 2020 season (tied for 3rd-fewest in the majors)...the Rays have scored 4 runs (or fewer) in 25 of 39 games (64.1 pct.), tied with four others for 2nd among major league clubs behind the Athletics (26).
- + The Rays are batting .206 (134-for-650) at home, 28th in the majors ahead of the Indians (.206, by pct. points) and Mariners (.178)...they have scored 2 runs (or fewer) in eight of their last 11 home games.

CHICKEN ON THE BONE—This season the Rays are batting .200 (65-for-325) with RISP, last in the majors—in 29th place is the Brewers at .201...prior to this season, the lowest avg. with RISP in major league history was .210 by the 1981 Mets, and the lowest in AL history was .217 by the 1988 Orioles...with RISP and 2 outs, the Rays are batting .157 (24-for-153), 29th in the majors (30th: Nationals, .151)...prior to this season, the lowest avg. with RISP and 2 out in major league history was .173 by the 2011 Giants.

- + This season the Rays are batting .145 (22-for-152) with RISP at Tropicana Field, compared to .249 (43-for-173) with RISP on the road...they have 8 hits in their last 85 AB with RISP at Tropicana Field.
- + The Rays have struck out 116 times with RISP, most in the majors ahead of the Dodgers (111)—the closest AL team is the Red Sox (97)...**Willy Adames** and **Brandon Lowe** are tied for 3rd in the majors with 15 SO with RISP, while **Randy Arozarena** is tied for 8th (14).
- + The Rays have had 75 PA this season with a runner on third and less than 2 outs, and that runner has scored 35 times (46.7 pct.), 20th in the majors...the ML avg. in those situations is 48.7 pct.

THREE TRUE OUTCOMES—The Rays rank 11th in the AL with 40 HR, 4th in the AL with 133 BB and lead the majors with 413 SO...the Rays are 18-9 (.667) in games with a homer, 9-1 (.900) when hitting multiple homers and 2-10 (.167) when held without a homer...39.8 pct. (586 of 1,471) of their plate appearances this season have ended in a homer, walk or strikeout, 3rd-highest in the majors behind the Giants (40.1 pct.) and Tigers (40.0).

- + Last season the Rays were held without a homer 19 times but went 14-5 (.737) in those games, the highest winning pct. since the 1906 Cubs went 99-34 (.744) in homerless games...their 14 wins without the benefit of a homer last season were the most in the majors.

PITCHING PROPERLY—The Rays rank 11th in the majors and 4th in the AL with a 3.62 ERA (351-IP, 141-ER)...the Rays have pitched to a 2.53 ERA (106.2-IP, 30-ER) in their last 12 games and a 2.71 ERA (169.2-IP, 51-ER) in their last 19 games...the Rays are coming off a 3-game series where they allowed 5 runs (4 ER) in 27 IP and held the Yankees to 2-for-17 with RISP.

- + The Rays have yielded 3 runs (or fewer) 23 times, tied for most in the AL and tied for 2nd in the majors behind the Padres (25)...this includes nine of the last 10 games and 16 of the last 19...the Rays have 7 losses when allowing 3 runs (or fewer), tied for 2nd in the majors.
- + Rays pitching ranked as low as 28th in the majors with a 5.74 ERA through April 9...since April 10, the Rays have a 3.15 ERA (288.1-IP, 101-ER) in 32 games, which ranks 5th in the majors over that span.
- + The bullpen has a 2.51 ERA (89.2-IP, 25-ER) in the last 20 games, reducing its season ERA from 5.40 to 3.73...since April 10, the bullpen is 7th in the majors with a 3.08 ERA (146.1-IP, 50-ER) in 32 games.
- + The Rays have allowed 61 runs in the 7th inning or later, 7th-most in the majors...however, in the last 20 games the Rays have allowed 16 runs in the 7th inning or later, compared to 45 runs through the first 19 games...these 61 runs are one shy of matching their total from the abbreviated 2020 season...the Rays have yielded 4 HR in the 7th inning, 4 HR in the 8th, 3 HR in the 9th and 1 HR in extras.
- + The Rays are 10-11 in games decided by 2 runs (or fewer) this season after going a major-league-best 23-10 last season...similarly, they are 5-7 in 1-run games after going a majors-best 14-5 in 2020.

START ME UP—Rays starters rank 9th in the majors and 3rd in the AL with a 3.51 ERA (179.2-IP, 70-ER)...since April 10, the starters rank 2nd in the AL with a 3.23 ERA (142-IP, 51-ER) behind the White Sox (2.79)...over that stretch, Rays starters have yielded 1 run (or fewer) in 18 of 32 starts (56.3 pct.), including 14 scoreless starts...traditional starters (excluding openers) have yielded 1 run (or fewer) in 12 of 25 starts since April 10, including 10 scoreless starts...this comes on the heels of a 4.54 ERA through the first 7 games this season, which ranked 22nd in the majors.

- + Rays pitchers have made 12 starts this season of 5 IP (or more) and 1 run (or fewer), tied for 2nd in the AL—despite using an opener seven times—behind the White Sox (14)...in comparison, Rays starters accomplished that 11 times in the 60 games (18.3 pct.) last season.
- + Rays starters have gone 6 IP (or more) 14 times this season after doing so nine times in 2020, which tied for fewest in the majors.

RAYS vs. METS—Tonight the Rays begin a 3-game series with the Mets, the only series between the two clubs this season...the Rays went 2-1 against the Mets last season, clinching the third AL East title in franchise history with a win on Sep 23 at Citi Field...the Rays are 13-14 (.481) all-time against the Mets (5-7 at home, 8-7 on the road) and haven't faced them at Tropicana Field since winning two of three from Aug 7-9, 2015.

- + The Rays are 2-1 in interleague play this season (0-0 at home).

KING OF THE HILL—Last night **Rich Hill** went 6.2 scoreless to extend his scoreless streak to 17.2 IP, the longest by a major league starter 41 years (or older) since NYM **Bartolo Colon** (30 IP) from Aug 26–Sep 10, 2015...he recorded a career-high 19 swings-and-misses and finished with 9 SO.

- + At 41 years, 63 days, Hill became the oldest pitcher with 9 SO (or more) against the Yankees since **TEX Nolan Ryan** (45.155) on July 4, 1992 at home (13)...joined Nolan (four times) and **CLE Cy Young** (43.078) on June 15, 1910 at home (9) as the only age-41 (or older) pitchers in major league history with 9+ SO against the Yankees.
- + He became the oldest pitcher since **CLE Phil Niekro** (47.016) on April 17, 1986 to pitch at least 6.2 scoreless against the Yankees.
- + His scoreless streak of 17.2 IP is the longest by a Rays pitcher since **Ryan Yarbrough** (17.2 IP) from Aug 6-17, 2019.
