<b>Rhys' Pieces of Hitting</b> Rhys Hoskins is batting .462 (12-for-26) with 3 HR and 8 RBI over his last 8 games.....he carries a .533 OBP/.846 SLG/1.379 OPS in that span.		

<b>TONIGHT'S GAME:</b> Is game 5 (1-3) of a season-long 10-game, 11-day road trip to San Francisco (1-3), St. Louis (3g) and Chicago-AL (3g).....following this trip, the team returns to American Family Field for a 6-game homestand against Chicago-NL (3g) and Houston (3g).
<b>IT WON'T BE THE SAME:</b> This season marks just the second without <b>Bob Uecker</b> on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

<b>SERIES-LY SPEAKING:</b> The Brewers are 5-3-0 in series play. <b>Game 1:</b> 4-4, <b>Game 2:</b> 5-3, <b>Game 3:</b> 3-5, <b>Game 4:</b> 1-1 <b>Sweep Wins (-):</b> None..... <b>Sweep Losses (1):</b> at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)
<b>AT HOME:</b> The Brewers are 9-4 at home, going 4-0-0 in series play.
<b>ON THE ROAD:</b> The Brewers are 4-9 on the road, going 1-3-0 in series play.
<b>MANAGER:</b> Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.
<b>COACHES:</b> Returning from 2024 is associate manager <b>Rickie Weeks</b> (2nd season), field coordinator <b>Néstor Corredor</b> (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach <b>Chris Hook</b> (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach <b>Jim Henderson</b> (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach <b>Charlie Greene</b> (2nd season), hitting coach <b>Connor Dawson</b> (4th season), assistant coach <b>Daniel de Mondesert</b> (2nd season), infield coach <b>Matt Erickson</b> (2nd season) and third base coach <b>Jason Lane</b> (10th season/5th in current role).....first base coach <b>Julio Borbón</b> , lead hitting coach <b>Al LeBoeuf</b> and hitting coach <b>Eric Theisen</b> are all in their first seasons on the staff.
<b>LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:</b> The team has made two replay challenges, going 2-0.....their last challenge came on 4/22 at San Francisco as an out call at first base involving Vinny Capra was overturned.
<b>BREWING SUCCESS:</b> The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight.....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons.....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).
<b>BREWING CONSISTENCY:</b> The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 679 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TONIGHT’S STARTER: #39 - RHP CHAD PATRICK (5g, 4gs, 1-1, 2.11)

**PATRICK AT A GLANCE:** Chad Patrick, 26, will be making his sixth appearance and fifth start of the season.....Patrick last pitched last Saturday vs. Athletics and took a 3-1 loss (6ip, 7h, 2r, 2er, 0bb, 7k, 1hr, 94 pitches).....the team is 2-2 in his starts.....he has 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .244 (19-for-78, 3hr).....he made his Major League debut on 3/29 at Yankee Stadium, pitching in relief.....Patrick was acquired from Oakland on 11/15/23 in exchange for INF Abraham Toro.

**PATRICK STAR:** The Hebron, Indiana native was supported by 300+ guests for his first Major League start on 4/1 vs. Kansas City, including his parents, coaches, family friends and high school friends.....many of them returned to see his first Major League win on 4/6 vs. Cincinnati.

**LAST SEASON:** Patrick went 14-1 with a 2.90 ERA in 26 games/24 starts last season at Triple-A Nashville to earn International League Pitcher of the Year honors.....the 2024 International League All-Star led the league in wins, ERA, strikeouts (145) and WHIP (1.09) while ranking second in opponent batting average (.215).....he was added to the 40-man roster on Nov. 19.

**MINOR LEAGUE CAREER:** Patrick has gone 23-14 with a 4.06 ERA in 68 games/60 starts while pitching in the Arizona (2021-23), Oakland (2023) and Milwaukee (2024) organizations.....he has produced 334 strikeouts in 312.1 innings pitched.....Patrick was selected by Arizona in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft.....he was traded by Arizona to Oakland on 7/31/23 in exchange for INF Jace Peterson, who is now a consultant to the Brewers’ performance psychology department.

**AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** is 1-1 with a 1.69 ERA in 3 starts (16ip, 3er).

**ON THE ROAD:** Is 0-0 with a 3.38 ERA in 2 games/1 start (5.1ip, 2er).

**vs. CARDINALS:** This will be his first career appearance against the St. Louis, Missouri Cardinals.
