MAY 12 (6-8)
 2007 – Austin Kearns legged out the first inside-the-park homer in the history of the Nationals (2005-pres.). Kearns' 360-degree jaunt in the sixth inning sparked a 7-3 win that was not complete until Ryan Zimmerman hit a walk-off grand slam off Jorge Julio at 1:42 a.m.

NATIONALS NEWS

WE'RE ON TO CINCINNATI
 The Washington Nationals start a three-game series with the Cincinnati Reds tonight at Great American Ballpark... Tonight will be the first of 16 straight games for the Nationals without an off day..Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28.

- The Nationals have won three of five, four of seven and 8 of 14 games since April 25... They have also won three of their last five series overall and five of the first seven series on the road this year.
- Following this series, the Nationals will return home for a three-game series with the Baltimore Orioles, during Major League Baseball's Rivalry Weekend.

ROAD SWEET ROAD
 The Nationals come into today's game with a 13-9 record on the road, tied for the second-highest win total away from home in Major League Baseball, trailing only the Atlanta Braves (16 wins)..Washington has taken at least a share of four of the last five series away from home.

- The Nationals rank third in MLB with 117 runs scored on the road.
- Washington's pitching staff is eighth in MLB (sixth in NL) with a .235 opponents' batting average away from Nationals Park.

HIGH DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY
 Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.4 runs per game more than the league average team..Washington has played 23 games against teams with a record of .500 or better, the most in National League and second-most in Major League Baseball.

- 13 of the Nationals 19 home games have come against teams .500 or better.
- Washington is 10-13 (.435) against teams .500 or better this season and has already played four teams in the top six in wins in Major League Baseball.

OUT OF THIS WORLD
CJ Abrams is 15-for-46 (.326) with three doubles, a triple, two homers, 15 RBI, five walks, two stolen bases and eight runs scored over his last 12 games...He's reached safely in nine of the 12 (.392 OBP) and has hits in eight of the 12.

- He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (T1st, 36) and on-base percentage (7th, .385).

PRETTY OFFENSIVE
 The Nationals rank tied for second in Major League Baseball (2nd in NL) with 217 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 39 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 81 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 24 times this season, second-most in Major League Baseball.
- Luis Garcia Jr.** is 5-for-9 (.556) with a double, triple, three RBI and two runs scored over his last two games.
- Daylen Lile** has hits in four straight games: 5-for-14 (.357), two doubles, an RBI and a hit by pitch.

GOOD WOOD
James Wood leads Major League Baseball with an average exit velocity of 96.0 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (95.8).

- Wood is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 48 batted balls over 100 MPH rank fifth in Major League Baseball.

PITCH PERFECT
Simon Mathews' pitching staff ranks fourth in the National League (T7th in MLB) with a 3.38 ERA in 15 games since April 24...The staff has pitched to a 3.94 ERA in 25 games since April 14 after entering play that day with a 6.21 ERA through the first 15 games of the season.

- The starters rank third in the National League (4th in MLB) with a 3.09 ERA since April 24.
- The bullpen has pitched to a 3.44 ERA in 13 games since April 26.

SPECIFICALLY...
 Some pitching performances of note include:

- Foster Griffin** ranks fifth in the National League with a 2.12 ERA...His ERA is the third lowest by a Nationals pitcher (2005-pres.) through his first eight starts with the team, trailing only **Max Scherzer** (1.75 in 2015) and **Stephen Strasburg** (2.03 in 2010).
- Cade Cavalli** ranks 10th in Major League Baseball (min. 40.0 IP). with 9.82 strikeouts per 9.0 innings.
- Richard Lovelady** has not allowed a run in his last eight games (8.2 IP), going 1-0 with a scoreless start, a save, three holds, 10 strikeouts and just six hits allowed.
- PJ Poulin** has been The Opener five times...He's allowed just one earned run on five hits with five strikeouts and one walk in 6.1 innings pitched.

Two-time National League All-Star (2018, 2022) signed with the Nationals on Feb. 11...A veteran of 10 Major League seasons, most recently with the St. Louis Cardinals (2018-25).

- Is third in Major League Baseball with 135 starts and is sixth with 764.1 innings pitched since the start of the 2022 season...Is behind only Logan Webb (140) and Dylan Cease (138) for the most starts in MLB since 2022.
- Is 1-2 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) in four career Postseason games (three starts).
- Spent three seasons in Nippon Professional Baseball, pitching for the Yomiuri Giants from 2015-17.
- Participated in the 2018 All-Star Game at Nationals Park.

Mikolas earned his first win of the season after he tossed 5.1 innings, struck out three and gave up two earned runs on just three hits (1 HR) against the Minnesota Twins on May 6.

Miles Mikolas is set to make his 21st career start against the Reds...He has made 23 appearances against Cincinnati dating back to 2012.

- Mikolas owns a 5.45 ERA (71 ER/117.1 IP) with a 6-9 record against the Reds.
- Mikolas has not allowed a run in two of his last three starts at Great American Ballpark...He worked 7.0 shutout inning on May 25, 2023 and 5.1 shutout innings in his last start in Cincinnati on April 30, 2025.

Over his last four starts, Mikolas is 1-0 with a 3.71 ERA (7 ER/17.0 IP) with 11 strikeouts...He has held opposing hitters to a .222 average over that span (14-for-63).

- Mikolas has not allowed anymore than three runs in any of his last four outings and has issued just two walks during that span.
